- 1. The Iowa State women's basketball team (2-0, 0-0 Big 12) is set to compete in the semifinals of the Preseason WNIT against Auburn (3-0, 0-0 SEC) on Tuesday, Nov. 13 at 6:30 p.m. Iowa State is 2-0 all-time against the Tigers, having topped them most recently on Nov. 30, 2013, 68-57, in the SouthPoint Shootout in Las Vegas, Nevada.
- 2. ISU's appearance in this year's Preseason WNIT is the program's first. Iowa State looks to become the fourth different Big 12 school to claim the Preseason WNIT crown. The Big 12 has won the Preseason WNIT four times with Kansas State winning in 2002, followed by Texas Tech in 2003 and Baylor has won the tournament twice, both in 2011 and 2015.
- 3. Senior **BRIDGET CARLETON** (1,417) is just 33 points shy of passing Janel Grimm and Lyndsey Medders (1,449) for 10th in school history in scoring. She also needs just two blocked shots to pass Anna Prins and Tonya Burns (86) for seventh in school history.
- 4. Carleton enters the 2018-19 season with several preseason honors under her belt. She was most recently named to the Naismith Trophy Watch List and Wooden Award Preseason Top 30 list. She also earned a place on the Preseason All-Big 12 team and was recently named to the Cheryl Miller Award watch list. Last season, Carleton was a top-10 finalist for the award.
- Through two games this season, the Cyclones have four averaging double figures. Carleton (17.5) leads the way, followed by KRISTIN SCOTT (12.0), ASHLEY JOENS (10.5) and MADISON WISE (10.0). Only lowa State and Baylor have four student-athletes averaging double figures after multiple games this season.
- 6. Iowa State leads the Big 12 in blocked shots with 15 on the season, and averaging 7.5 per contest. Both Carleton and Scott are tied for third in the Big 12, averaging 2.5 per game. ISU also ranks second in defensive rebounds per game, averaging 38.5.
- 7. Iowa State returns three starters from last season in Carleton, MADISON WISE and MEREDITH BURKHALL. In all, Iowa State returns 73.8 percent of its scoring, 70.6 percent of its rebounding and 64.8 percent of its assists from the 2017-18 campaign.
- 8. The 2018-19 season marks the 24th in the tenure of Bill Fennelly. Fennelly has led Iowa State to 17 NCAA Tournament appearances. Fennelly boasts a 481-253 record at Iowa State and a 647-306 record in his 29-year career as a head coach. His 647 career wins lists him in the top-15 in the NCAA among active coaches in Division I and in the top-50 winningest coaches all-time.

The dean of Big 12 women's basketball coaches, Bill Fennelly built lowa State women's basketball into one of the nation's elite programs. He

gained instant credibility with student-athletes, administrators and fans, establishing a solid foundation that was based on academics, athletics and character.

Fennelly is one of the nation's most respected coaches and his numbers bear witness to the success he has achieved in his career. He has accumulated over 600 career wins and averaged more than 21 wins per season over his 21 years at lowa State. His teams have made 19 NCAA Championship appearances in his 25 seasons as a head coach and he ranks among the nation's top 25 active women's basketball college coaches in overall winning percentage.

overall winning percentage. Former ISU president Gregory Geoffroy and athletics director Jamie Pollard awarded Fennelly a lifetime contract following the 2006-07 campaign.

Fennelly invigorated the lowa State women's basketball program from the first day he arrived on campus. He took a program that won just 237 games in its first 20 years and has guided it to 17 postseason appearances, a pair of NCAA Elite Eight berths, a pair of Big 12 Championship titles, a regular-season conference crown and 12 20-win seasons in his 19 years at the helm.

Three times the Cyclones have claimed a school-record 27 wins, including the 2009 Elite Eight squad. In just his second season on campus, Iowa State earned its first NCAA Championship berth and since that time the Cyclones have won 17 NCAA Championship games.

lowa State shocked the women's basketball world when it knocked off top-seeded Connecticut to advance to the school's first NCAA Elite Eight in 1999. Ten years later, the 2009 Cyclones put their stamp on women's basketball history by overcoming a seven-point deficit with 1:30 left to defeat Michigan State and advance to the school's second NCAA Elite Eight. Under Fennelly, ISU has made five NCAA Sweet Sixteen appearances, including a streak of three straight from 1999 to 2001 and back-to-back berths in 2009 and 2010.

⇒STREAKS AND TRENDS

- lowa State has hit 200 3-pointers in a season for an NCAA record 15-straight years (2003-04-present). Iowa State netted nine triples in the season opener against Niagara.
- Iowa State has won 24-straight season openers under head coach Bill Fennelly.
- BRIDGET CARLETON scored in double figures in 33-straight games, and recorded twostraight double-doubles.
- The Cyclones hit at least five threes in 192 of the last 219 games.
- Iowa State has hit a 3-pointer in 737-consecutive games. In that time (since Feb. 18, 1995), ISU has hit 5,765 threes. That is equal to 7.82 three-pointers per game for the last 22 years.
- The Cyclones have finished in the upper half of the Big 12 in eight of the last 10 seasons.
- The Cyclones have made 10 of the last 12 NCAA Tournaments, one of just 19 teams nationally to do so.

⇒IOWA STATE TEAM QUICK FACTS

- Iowa State has 14 players on its roster from eight different states (Iowa, Ohio, Minnesota, Utah, Indiana, Tennessee, Texas and Virginia) and four different countries (Canada, Australia, Burundi and Sweden).
- Iowa State returned three starters from last season in Carleton, Wise and Burkhall. In all, Iowa State returns 73.8 percent of its scoring, 70.6 percent of its rebounding and 64.8 percent of its assists for the 2017-18 campaign.
- Carleton was named preseason All-Big 12 for the 2018-19 season and she was also named to the Cheryl Miller Award Watch List for the second-straight season.

BRIDGET CARLETON

-- Named an Honorable Mention All American by the Associated Press.

-- Named a Cheryl Miller Award Top-10 Finalist in 2017-18 & is a member of the initial watch list this season.

-Named to the 2018 Wooden Award & Naismith Trophy Watch Lists.

-- Was named to the Canadian National Team last summer and competed for Canada Basketball in the FIBA AmeriCup in 2017-18 and the Women's World Cup this season.

-- Currently third in the Iowa State career record book in free-throw percentage, connecting on 85.1 percent of her shots at the charity stripe.

---She is tied for fifth all-time in ISU history in career scoring average, netting 15.5 points per game.

-- She is a two-time unanimous selection to the All-Big 12 first team.

-- She was the only freshman in 2015-16 to earn an honor-



⇒LAST TIME OUT

- The Iowa State women's basketball team topped Northern Illinois 70-60 to advance to the • semifinals of the Preseason WNIT.
- lowa State outrebounded the Huskies 52-45 and blocked 10 shots en route to the win.
- BRIDGET CARLETON led the Cyclone effort with another double-double with 21 points, • 13 rebounds, six assists and four blocks. KRISTIN SCOTT netted 15 points and hauled in seven rebounds, while adding a pair of blocks. MADISON WISE rounded out the Cyclones in double figures with 12 points and six rebounds.

⇒CARLETON CLIMBING ISU RECORD BOOKS

Carleton has positioned herself well coming into her senior campaign to continue to climb the ISU record books in multiple categories. Carleton's impact on all sides of the ball and ability to stuff a stat sheet has made her one of the more versatile Cyclones in school history. She enters her senior campaign with 1,382 points, 561 rebounds, 209 assists, 132 steals and 81 blocks. No Cyclone has ever tallied over 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 200 assists, 100 steals and 100 blocks in their career.

⇒CARLETON AMONG NCAA'S ACTIVE LEADERS

- Bridget Carleton currently ranks 28th in the NCAA among active career leaders in points, with 1,417.
- Carleton has been lights out at the free throw line throughout her career, netting 85.5 percent, which ranks third among the NCAA's active career leaders.

⇒CARLETON NAMED TO SENIOR NATIONAL TEAM

- Senior Bridget Carleton reached one of her goals earlier in the summer when she was named to Canada's Senior Women's National Team roster for the FIBA AmeriCup. Carleton competed for Canada in the AmeriCup and hopes to make the Olympic roster in the 2020 cycle.
- Carleton was close to making her Olympic dream a reality in 2016, but was named an alternate for Team Canada just prior to the Olympics.

⇒ JOENS CAPTURES GOLD FOR USA BASKETBALL

- Iowa State freshman Ashley Joens captured a gold medal with USA Basketball this summer in the FIBA U18 Americas Women's Championship.
- Joens, who was the second-leading scorer for Team USA throughout the tournament, is the first lowa State women's basketball player to capture a Gold medal with USA Basketball. She also served as the captain for Team USA, averaging 10.7 points, 4.5 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.3 steals.

⇒REIGNING FROM THREE

- The 3-point shot continues to be a staple of Iowa State women's basketball in the Fennelly era, with Iowa State knocking down more 3-pointers than anyone in the nation over the course of the last 23 seasons.
- No team in the NCAA has attempted or made as many 3-pointers than lowa State since the 1995-96 season and lowa State's 5,756 3-pointers made and 16,314 3-pointers attempted reign supreme.
- lowa State has also knocked down more 3-pointers per game than anyone in Division I, with 7.84 3's made per game, one more than second-place Villanova (6.83 per game).
- Even more impressive, ISU's 5,756 3's made is 300 more than second-place UConn's 5,449. However, ISU accomplished the feat in 118 fewer game than the Huskies.
- Over the last 23 seasons, the Cyclones rank seventh in all of D-I in 3-point percentage, making 35.3 percent of their shots from deep.
- The Cyclones own the NCAA's longest streak in NCAA Division I basketball of seasons with 200 or more 3-pointers made. ISU has made 200 3-pointers every year since 2003-04, which is 15 seasons.
- Since 1995-96, Iowa State has netted 200 or more 3's in 20 of its 23 seasons and over 170 schools in NCAA DI have never hit more than 200 3's in a season.

⇒CYCLONES MAINTAIN ONE OF LONGEST TENURED STAFFS IN DI

- The lowa State women's basketball coaching staff holds one of the longest tenured coaching staffs in the country, ranking third nationally.
- The lowa State staff of Head coach Bill Fennelly, associate head coach Jodi Steyer, assistants Latoja Schaben and Billy Fennelly along with director of operations Josh Carper have worked together for seven-straight years.
- Their seven-year run sits behind Oklahoma and UCLA with eight-straight years. The Cyclones are tied with Tulane and Texas A&M at seven.

➡TOP-5 IN ATTENDANCE

- The Cyclones once again finished the season third in attendance nationally with 9,106 fans per game, marking the 10th straight year ISU has finished in the top-5.
- Iowa State has ranked in the top-10 in attendance for 18 straight seasons as well.
- Only South Carolina and Tennessee outdrew the Cyclones in fans per game on the season.

⇒#HILTONMAGIC

 The Cyclones have been phenomenal at home during Fennelly's tenure, compiling a 302-64 record (.824) in Hilton Coliseum, including a 153-5 (.968) mark against regular-season nonconference opponents. Iowa State has gone undefeated at home three times, most recently during the 2004-05 season.

⇒FREE HOOPS

 Iowa State is 20-13 in overtime games under head coach Bill Fennelly and 27-22 overall. In its last overtime game, Iowa State topped Kansas 71-69. ISU has won five of its last six home overtime games, but lost its last two on the road.

⇒ONE OF THE FEW

• Very few women's basketball programs across the country have enjoyed the postseason success the Cyclones have enjoyed over the last 10 years. Iowa State is one of just 19 teams to make 10 of the last 12 NCAA Tournaments.






