Opening Words

- The Saint Peter's Peacocks conclude their toughest four-game road stretch on Wednesday, November 28 at nationally ranked Auburn.
- The game will be nationally televised on the SEC Network and the WatchESPN app with tip-off slated for 8 p.m. ET.
- After winning the season opener in overtime against Lafayette, the Peacocks have since dropped four straight, falling to Delaware at home and Bryant, NC State, North Texas on the road.
- Last time out, the Peacocks dropped their fourth straight contest of the young season, falling to North Texas, 75-66 at the UNT Coliseum in Denton, TX on Saturday night.
- For the second consecutive game and third time this season, redshirt senior guard Davauhnte Turner led the Peacocks in scoring (19) and assists (3), while it was the fourth overall time he led the team in scoring.
- Turner has scored 20 or more points in three out of Saint Peter's five games and he leads the Peacocks in scoring, averaging 19.4 points per game, and assists, at 4.0 a game.
- Samuel Idowu is the team's second leading scorer at 14.4 points per outing followed by freshman KC Ndefo who is scoring 9.8 points per game.
- Ndefo is the Peacocks' leading rebounder and shot blocker thus far, averaging 7.0 rebounds and 1.6 blocks.

First Meeting

- Saint Peter's and Auburn will be playing for the first time in each program's history.

Peacocks vs. The SEC

- This will be the 10th time in program history that Saint Peter's will face a current Southeastern Conference (SEC) opponent.
- The Peacocks hold a 3-6 all-time record against the current SEC, with two wins over Alabama and a victory in their only meeting against South Carolina.
- The last time Saint Peter's clashed with an SEC team was in 2010-11 when the Peacocks knocked off Alabama 50-49 in the US Virgin Island Paradise Jam.

Scouting the Tigers

- The No. 8 Auburn Tigers hold a 5-1 record.
- The Tigers have recent wins over Xavier and Arizona, only losing to then-No. 1 Duke, 78-72.
- Auburn is outscoring its opponents by a 22.5 scoring margin and has won four out of its five wins by double figures.
- Three starters and one reserve player are scoring in double figures per game for the Tigers.
- Bryce Brown is the team leader with 17.0 points, followed by Jared Harper's 16.0 points, Chuma Okeke with 11.8 points, and reserve Austin Wiley who is averaging 11.2 points.

Up Next

- The Peacocks return to Jersey City after a three-week hiatus to welcome Maine on Saturday, December 1.
- Tip-off with Maine is slated for 3 p.m.

Shaheen Holloway (Seton Hall '00)

Head Coach

1st Season



Shaheen Holloway became the 15th head coach of the men's basketball program at Saint Peter's University in April 2018.

Holloway brings superlative credentials to Jersey City after spending the past eight seasons as the associate head coach at his alma mater, Seton Hall, under Kevin Willard. With Holloway on the sideline serving as Willard's top assistant, Seton Hall became one of the BIG EAST's premier programs, winning the 2015-16 BIG EAST Tournament title for the first time since 1993. In the last three seasons from 2016 to 2018, Seton Hall recorded three straight 20-win seasons, the first time the program had done that since 1991-93, and three straight BIG EAST seasons of 10 wins or more for the first time in program history. Holloway helped Seton Hall advance to the NCAA Tournament in three consecutive seasons and in 2018, the Pirates won the program's first NCAA Tournament game since 2004 with him on the bench. The Pirates also climbed back into the national rankings on multiple occasions. The Pirates enjoyed being ranked by the Associated Press 15 times with Holloway aboard since 2010, and this included a No. 13 ranking on Jan. 8, 2018, the highest the program had reached since 2001.

With Holloway serving as the lead recruiter, the Pirates experienced an abundant amount of success during his tenure, producing three Associated Press All-America honorable mention selections, 12 All-BIG EAST selections, three BIG EAST All-Rookies and 36 BIG EAST All-Academic team selections. His recruiting ability helped Seton Hall produce a top-15 national recruiting class in 2014 which included Isaiah Whitehead, the program's first McDonald's All-American since 2001, who went on to become a 2016 NBA Draft pick; Angel Delgado, the 2018 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award National Center of the Year and BIG EAST all-time rebounds leader; and Khadeen Carrington, who finished his Seton Hall career as the ninth all-time leading scorer in program history.

Prior to joining Seton Hall, Holloway served on Willard's staff at Iona, where he helped turn the Gaels program around. Inheriting a team that went 2-28 in 2006-07, Holloway and Willard recruited and coached student-athletes to one of the greatest turnarounds in college basketball history as their 2009-10 team won 21 games to complete a 19-win turnaround in only the third year of the administration.

During his original stint on the Seton Hall coaching staff, Holloway was an administrative assistant for head coach Bobby Gonzalez from 2006-07. Holloway was responsible for coordinating film exchange, analyzing game tapes and assisting

with scouting of opponents. He supervised fall conditioning as well as the year-round weight training program. Holloway was also responsible for academic progress reports for team members as well as the organization of all aspects of team travel for the Pirates.

Holloway started his coaching career serving as an assistant coach at the high school level at Bloomfield Tech.

Holloway was a four-year standout at Seton Hall from 1996-00 and helped lead his team to the 2000 NCAA Sweet Sixteen, where he hit the game-winning layup in overtime to defeat Oregon in the NCAA first round. A 2012 inductee of the Seton Hall Athletics Hall of Fame, Holloway's preeminent playing career landed him in the Seton Hall record books as the all-time assist leader with 681, 17th in scoring with 1,588 points, fourth in steals with 231 steals, and eighth with 185 three-pointers in 116 games. In 2000, he was named the BIG EAST's Most Improved Player, while earning All-BIG EAST status three times and All-Metropolitan accolades in each of his four seasons at Seton Hall.

After his collegiate success, Holloway played professionally in England for the Chester Jets and London Towers as well as a season in Ulm, Germany and Istanbul, Turkey. Back in the U.S., he had stints with the Brooklyn Kings of the USBL and Newark, Las Vegas and Chicago in the ABA. He was invited to three preseason NBA camps with the Knicks, Nets and Golden State Warriors.

The Queens, NY native was a McDonald's All-American who played at St. Patrick's High School in Elizabeth, NJ.

Holloway has two children, a son, Xavier and a daughter, Shatanik. He is married to Kim Holloway.



SAINT PETER'S PEACOCKS NOTES**Following in the Footsteps of a Scoring Legend**

- Through the first five games, Davauhnte Turner has scored in double figures every game, with three 20+ point efforts, while leading the team in scoring in four out of the five games.
- Turner's 19.4 points per game average through the season's first five games are the highest points per game average for a Saint Peter's player since Peacock legend Keydren "Kee Kee" Clark averaged 20.8 points through the first five contests of the 2005-06 season.

Forcing Overtime Yet Again...

- The Peacocks forced an overtime period in the season opener and second game of the season after trailing by double digits late in the second half of both contests.
- Against Lafayette, the team trailed by 13 points with eight minutes left and versus Delaware, the Peacocks were down by 16 points with nine and a half minutes to play.
- This was the first time in the program's 89-year history that the team opened the season with back-to-back overtime games.

Peacocks Putting up Points

- The Peacocks poured in 93 points in the season opener against Lafayette after not hitting the 90-point plateau for almost two full years. (90 points on November 18, 2016 vs. Lipscomb).

Not One, But Two...

- Cameron Jones and KC Ndefo both recorded their first career double-doubles in the season opener against Lafayette. It was the first time since 2013 that two separate Peacocks logged a double-double in the same contest.

Overtime Opener

- Going into overtime in the season opener is not a common occurrence for Saint Peter's. The program last went into an extra period in the season's first game during the 1979-80 campaign.

New Opponents in 2018

- The Peacocks will face five new opponents during the 2018 non-conference slate.
- The new opponents include Delaware, Bryant, North Texas, Auburn, and Clemson.

MAAC Preseason Coaches' Poll

- The Peacocks were selected 10th by the coaches in the preseason coaches' poll, receiving 28 votes after finishing eighth last season and making a historical run into the MAAC semifinal round of the 2018 MAAC Championship.

Meet the 2018-19 Squad

- The Peacocks return two starters and nine letterwinners from last year's team, while adding six newcomers.

Returning Duo of Starters

- The Peacocks return the duo of Samuel Idowu and Quinn Taylor, who both started all 32 games last season for Saint Peter's.
- Idowu, a redshirt-senior, is the team's top returning scorer, rebounder, and shot blocker. He averaged 11.2 points, 5.9 rebounds, and 1.3 blocks per game last season.
- A junior, Taylor logged more minutes than any returning Peacock in 2017-18. He averaged 7.5 points, 5.7 rebounds, and 1.7 assists per outing a year ago. Taylor is the squad's top returning stealer, after making 33 steals last year.

Returning to the Squad

- The team returns seniors Davauhnte Turner and Mamadou Ndiaye, juniors Cameron Jones and Amir Hicks, sophomore Cameron Underwood, and redshirt-freshmen duo Manny Dixon and Mikko Johnson.
- Turner made 11 starts last season and averaged 10.6 points, 3.1 rebounds, and 2.0 assists. He is the Peacocks' top assists returner after handing out 61 assists last year.
- Ndiaye appeared in 31 games a year ago, with averages of 4.4 points and 3.3 rebounds.
- Jones appeared in all 32 games and made one start last season. He posted a stat line of 6.1 points, 2.6 rebounds, and 1.4 assists per game.
- Hicks saw action in three games last season.
- Dixon comes into the season after sitting out in 2017-18, but the redshirt-freshman is projected to be a starter in the upcoming season.

Welcome to Jersey City

- The Peacocks welcome six newcomers to Jersey City this season, which includes four freshmen and two transfers.
- The four freshmen joining the team this year are Klay Brown, Majur Majak, KC Ndefo, and Dallas Watson.
- The two transfers are Nazeer Bostick from Penn State and Derrick Woods from Delaware.
- Bostick will sit out the 2018-19 season, while Woods will become eligible in the second half of the season.

SAINT PETER'S PEACOCKS NOTES**Back Together Again**

- The Peacocks have two pairs of players who played their high school basketball together.
- The junior combination of Cameron Jones and Derrick Woods both played at Pennsbury in Pennsylvania and the freshmen duo of Klay Brown and KC Ndefo each played at Abraham Lincoln in Brooklyn, NY.

- Holloway and Whalen both coached at Iona previously, while Morton not only returns to the MAAC but also Saint Peter's, having served on the staff as an assistant from 2006-10

Seton Hall Ties

- Holloway's staff also has deep ties to Seton Hall.
- Holloway was a player and assistant coach for the Pirates, Whalen was an assistant coach there, Morton played for Seton Hall, and Petruzzelli worked a number of basketball clinics at the South Orange school.
