» Auburn enters the season ranked No. 11 in the country in the preseason AP poll. It is the highest the Tigers have been ranked to open a season since 1999. Auburn is ranked in the preseason AP Poll for the fifth time in program history. The Tigers opened the 1999-2000 season at No. 4. Before that, Auburn began the 1985-86 and 1986-87 seasons at No. 10 and No. 12, respectively. The Tigers were first ranked in the annual preseason poll prior to the 1975-76 campaign when they were No. 20.

» Auburn returns three starters from a 26-win team a season ago, highlighted by All-SEC guards Bryce Brown and Jared Harper. Forward Anfernee McLemore returns to the floor after recovering from a season-ending injury in the final weeks of the regular season.

» Auburn has faced South Alabama nine times in program history. The local foes will square off for their first meeting since 2006. The Tigers have won the last, both in Auburn, at Beard-Eaves-Memorial Coliseum.

#### **SERIES HISTORY**

» Auburn leads its all-time series against South Alabama, 5-4. The Tigers have won two straight and four of their last five over the Jaguars. Auburn used a 16-0 run early in the second half to erase a seven-point deficit and went on to win 82-71 on Dec. 6, 2006, at Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum in the last meeting between the two programs. The Tigers won the only other season-opening game between the two schools 120-67 in Birmingham, Ala., on Nov. 27, 1987.

#### **BRUCE PEARL VS. SOUTH ALABAMA**

» Auburn head coach is 1-0 against South Alabama. Pearl led Tennessee to a 87-69 victory over the Jaguars in Knoxville, Tenn. on Jan. 4, 2006.

#### **AUBURN IN SEASON OPENERS**

» Auburn has an 81-31 (.723) record in season openers, including 59-9 at home, 13-16 on the road, 4-3 in neutral-site games and 5-3 in games played in unknown locations. This is the 11th straight season the Tigers have opened at home. The Tigers have won 37 of their last 44 season openers, including a 102-74 victory over Norfolk State in Auburn Arena last season.

» Auburn is 34-4 in season openers against in-state opponents. The Tigers have won three straight and 23 of their last 24 season openers against opponents from the state of Alabama. Auburn defeated UAB 75-74 at Auburn Arena to open the 2015-16 campaign in its last opener against an in-state opponent.

#### **BRUCE PEARL IN SEASON OPENERS**

» Bruce Pearl is 22-1 (.957) in season openers, including 4-0 at Auburn. The Tigers defeated Norfolk State 102-74 last season, North Florida 83-66 in 2016, UAB 75-74 in 2015 and Milwaukee 83-73 in 2014 in Pearl's debut as Auburn's head coach. All five of Auburn's season openers under Pearl have been at Auburn Arena. Overall, Pearl has won 12 consecutive season openers.

#### **DOWNTOWN BRYCE BROWN**

» Senior Bryce Brown, who set an Auburn freshman record with 78 made 3-pointers in 2015-16, enters this season with 241 career 3-pointers, putting him just 21 shy of Wesley Person's Auburn career record of 262. Brown's 107 3-pointers last season fell just one shy of tying Lance Weems' single-season record at Auburn of 108 3-pointers made in 1995-96. He has two of the top 9 seasons on Auburn's single-season 3s made list.

» For his career, he is 241-of-631 (.382) from long range. His 631 career 3-pointes attempted are also second-most all-time at Auburn, behind Frankie Sullivan's 713.

## TIGERS FROM DEEP

» Auburn set a new program single-season record with 324 3-point field goals made last season, eclipsing the old mark of 289 the previous season. All four of Bruce Pearl's teams at Auburn rank in the top-8 all-time for single-season 3-pointers made [1. 324 (2017-18); 2. 289 (2016-17); 5. 272 (2015-16); 8. 252 (2014-15)]. The Tigers' shot 35.7 percent from long range last season, which ranks ninth in program history.

## **PRE-GAME QUOTES**

#### Head Coach Bruce Pearl

#### On the season opener...

"This will be a really challenging opener for us. South Alabama is good. Richie Riley is really good. ... They're really going to challenge us."

On what J'Von McCormick brings to the team... "He brings the ability to break the defense down. I think he's good with the ball in his hands on the break. He's a great teammate and he's hard working. Quickness and speed – I'd like to see him continue to be more effective defensively. He will be one of our leaders in steals based on the minutes he plays. He's able to get out and jump passing lanes and make things happen defensively."

#### PLAYER TO WATCH: BRYCE BROWN

» Heading into his final season, Bryce Brown is looking to start the 2018-19 season as well as he did last campaign. The Stone Mountain, Ga. native poured in a career-high 31 points in a 102-74 victory vs. Norfolk State. His 31 points were just four shy of the single-game record for points in a season opener, held by Lee DeFore's 35 vs. Rice in 1965. Brown went 12-of-16 from the floor, including 4-of-8 from behind the arc.



#### TIGERS PERFECT VS. NON-CON AT HOME

» Auburn has posted a 13-0 home record against non-conference opponents over the last two seasons, including a 7-0 mark last season and 6-0 in 2016-17. The Tigers are outscoring their opponents by 20.3 ppg (91.2-70.9) and have topped the 100-point plateau three times during the streak. Ten of Auburn's 13 wins during the streak have been by at least 16 points.

» During Bruce Pearl's four years as Auburn's head coach, the Tigers have posted a 24-3 (.889) mark against non-conference opponents at Auburn Arena.

#### **TOP OF THE PACK**

» Auburn has fared well in the past two seasons in the non-conference slate. The Tigers lead the SEC in both wins and winning percentage in non-league regular season games since the start of last campaign.

#### HARPER WITH THE ASSIST

» Jared Harper was third in the SEC with 5.4 assists per game last season. Harper led the SEC with 15 games of at least seven assists last season. He has 280 career assists in 66 games, an average of 4.2 per game.

#### **MAYORS OF SWAT CITY**

» Auburn set a new program record with 180 blocks last season. The Tigers have had three of their top-10 single-season block totals in program history during Bruce Pearl's first four seasons on the Plains. [1. 180, 2017-18; 3. 162, 2016-17; 10. 126, 2015-16]. Auburn has two of its top-10 all-time shot blockers on its current roster. Senior Horace Spencer has blocked 136 shots, which ranks sixth in program history, while junior Anfernee McLemore ranks eighth with 110 career blocks.

#### WHAT'S RETURNING?

» Auburn returns four players who started at least 13 games last season for the regular-season SEC champions. The Tigers return six of their top eight scorers. In total, Auburn returns 64.1 percent of its scoring and 58.0 percent of its rebounding. Additionally, the Tigers return players who accounted for 247 of its record 324 3-pointers made a season ago.

#### **AUBURN'S BIG MEN DOMINATE**

» Auburn's two centers Anfernee McLemore and Horace Spencer put up strong performances in the Tigers' exhibition win over Lincoln Memorial. McLemore finished with 13 points on 5-of-6 shooting while also pulling down six rebounds, blocking two shots and dishing out an assist in his first action since suffering a season-ending injury last season at South Carolina on Feb. 17. Spencer scored 14 points on 6-of-9 from the field and added eight boards and an assist.

## **OKEKE WITH THE DOUBLE-DOUBLE**

» Sophomore Chuma Okeke posted a double-double with 11 points and 11 rebounds in Auburn's exhibition win over Lincoln Memorial. Okeke stuffed the stat sheet as he also recorded five assists, four blocks and a steal. Last season, as a freshman, he tied for the team lead with three double-doubles.

#### **BACKCOURT NAMED ALL-SEC**

» Auburn guards Bryce Brown and Jared Harper were named Preseason Second Team All-SEC by a select panel of Southeastern Conference and national media members. The Tigers were the only team to have both members of their backcourt selected to the annual all-conference team.

» After leading Auburn to its third conference title in program history, both players were voted All-SEC. Brown picked up first team honors from the Associated Press and second team laurels from the league coaches. Harper was picked to the second team by both the Associated Press and SEC head coaches.

#### WATCH LIST SZN

» Auburn has three players on national award watch lists heading into the 2018-19 season.

» Jared Harper was tabbed to the Bob Cousy Award Watch List, given annually to the nation's top point guard.

» Bryce Brown was selected to the Jerry West Award Watch List, given to the country's best shooting guard.

» Austin Wiley earned a nod on the Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Award Watch List, handed out to the best center in the nation.

» Auburn, Gonzaga and Kansas are the only three programs to have representatives on the three national watch lists.

## **RETURN FROM THE NEXT LEVEL**

» Auburn has three returners who put their named into the 2018 NBA Draft pool and worked out for select NBA teams.

» Austin Wiley was invited and participated in the NBA Combine where he showcased his talents. He tested well at the NBA Combine: 5% body fat (T-10th overall, 1st among centers at the combine); 28" standing vertical (4th among centers); 33.5" max vertical (3rd among centers); 9'3" standing reach (4th overall); 7'5" wingspan (T-4th overall); 3.31 shuttle run (3rd among centers); 3.3 3/4 sprint (4th among centers).

» Bryce Brown and Jared Harper also worked out for professional organizations and decided to return for another year together in the backcourt.

#### **CONTINUING THE IMPROVEMENT:** CONFERENCE WIN TOTALS

» Auburn is one of just 13 teams in the country to have improved its win totals in conference play each of the last four seasons. The Tigers are one of only two power-five programs to accomplish the feat, joining USC. Auburn won four Southeastern Conference games in 2015, five in 2016, seven in 2017 and 13 in 2018 to become the SEC champions.



#### WHOLE LOTTA DUBS

» Bruce Pearl has led Auburn to its 10th 20win season all-time in his fourth season. Pearl is the sixth head coach to lead Auburn to a 20win season and the second-fastest to do so, only trailing Mike Papke, who led Auburn to a 20-2 record in 1927-28

#### MAKE IT RAIN ON 'EM

» Bryce Brown became the 36th player in program history to reach 1,000 career points after dropping 29 in the 2017-18 regular-season finale against South Carolina. He has 1,036 points through three seasons on The Plains.

» Brown is the 18th player in the Auburn record books to tally 1,000 career points prior to the end of their third season.

## **BEST SHOW IN TOWN**

» Auburn sold out seven of its last eight games to close out this season at Auburn Arena, the longest string of sellouts in the 8-year history of the facility. There have been 16 sellouts in Bruce Pearl's four seasons at Auburn (63 games) compared to just five in the first four years of Auburn Arena (72 games).
