### ABOUT THE GAME

> This will be just the third meeting in the series, with Auburn winning the previous two games  
> The last time these two teams met was in 2014 when Auburn won, 92-42  
> The game with Auburn is one of two this season against an SEC opponent (Nov. 23 at Alabama)  
> GSU will face two Big 12 members (at Kansas on Dec. 9 and at Oklahoma State on Dec. 30)

### GRAMBLING STATE

> Grambling State is coming off one of its most successful seasons since 1999  
> GSU went 19-14 last season and 13-5 in conference play  
> Grambling State finished third in the regular season in the SWAC, but defeated Alcorn State, Texas Southern and Southern in the SWAC Tournament to advance to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament  
> GSU's SWAC Tournament Championship was the first for the school since 1999  
> Shakyla Hill returns this season to Grambling State as she made national attention last season when she became the fourth NCAA Division I women's basketball player to record a quadruple double

### GRAMBLING STATE PRESEASON HONORS

> Shakyla Hill was named to the Ann Myers Drysdale Watch List to begin the season  
> Shakyla Hill was selected the SWAC Preseason Player of the Year and Preseason Defensive Player of the Year

> Grambling State placed Shakyla Hill on the All-SWAC First Team and Jazmin Boyd on the All-SWAC Second Team

### THE SCHEDULE

> Grambling State will play 12 straight road games from Nov. 11 to Jan. 7  
> GSU will visit Auburn, Alabama, Kansas and Oklahoma State this season  
> In addition, Grambling State will compete at the Puerto Rico Classic against South Dakota, Indiana and Loyola Marymount  
> Grambling State will only play 10 home games, with one of those coming in the first week of the season (McNeese State)

### GRAMBLING STATE BY THE NUMBERS

> Grambling State returns six players off the 2017-18 team  
> Four players - Shakyla Hill, Justice Coleman, Ariel Williams and Jazmin Boyd - were key starters, with Boyd rotating off the bench  
> Hannah Henderson was red-shirted last season and will make her collegiate debut this season  
> There are four junior college transfers, five if you count Henderson, that are on the roster  
> Grambling State will welcome the addition of three freshman  
> Freddie Murray returns to the sidelines and enters his third season at the helm  
> In two seasons under Murray, Grambling State has appeared in the WNIT and the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Tournament  
> Murray guided his 2017 team to the SWAC's first postseason victory when GSU defeated Ole Miss in the opening round of the WNIT

### AUBURN

> Senior Jannah McKay and sophomore Unique Thompson were named to the Preseason All-SEC Team  
> McKay was Auburn's leading scorer in 2017-18, averaging 16.6 points per game. She also led the team in assists (4.5/game) and was second on the team in steals (2.3/game). McKay was also one of the conference's top free-throw shooters, hitting 130-of-157 attempts for an .828 percentage. She enters her senior season with 1,199 career points, which ranks 24th in program history  
> Thompson was an SEC All-Freshman Team selection a year ago after averaging 11.5 points and a team-leading 8.4 rebounds, the top rebounding average among league freshmen. She also recorded seven double-doubles last season, tying Auburn great DeWanna Bonner for the most by a Tiger freshman  
> There will also be plenty of new faces on the court this season, beginning with Duke transfer Crystal Primm and redshirt freshman Kiyae' White. Both practiced with the team last year. True freshman guards Brooke Moore and Robyn Benton have the ability to provide instant offense for Auburn when they're in the game  
> Auburn has two SWAC opponents on its schedule, first with Grambling State on Nov. 6 and Alabama State on Dec. 29

### UP NEXT

> Grambling State wraps up its opening week with a home contest on Friday against McNeese State  
> The game with McNeese State is the lone home game before the New Year. GSU will play 11 road games, including 10 straight, before SWAC play begins on Jan. 5

In order to arrange for player interviews, please provide at least 24 hours notice to Brian Howard, Sports Information Director. Player interviews may be conducted in the Fredrick C. Hobdy Assembly Center or in the Sports Information Office, located in the Football Stadium Support Facility. The Grambling State training room, women's basketball locker room, weight room and meeting rooms are off-limits to the media. Your cooperation is appreciated.

For telephone interviews, the student-athlete will be provided with the number and will make the call at a mutually-agreed upon time. Phone numbers of student-athletes will not be made available to the media.

For interviews with head coach Freddie Murray and/or Grambling State assistant coaches, please contact Brian Howard in the Sports Information Office. The best time for coach Freddie Murray to conduct interviews is weekday mornings.

**FREDDIE MURRAY** is entering his third year on the coaching staff for the Grambling State University women's basketball program and his first year at the helm as head coach.

Last season with the expectations at a program all-time high, Murray guided the Lady Tiger program to a 19-win season as Grambling State went 19-14 overall and 13-5 in SWAC play.

Grambling State enjoyed the national spotlight in early January when Shakyla Hill became the fourth NCAA Division I women's basketball player to record a quadruple double.

The Lady Tigers ended the regular season as third seed in the SWAC Women's Basketball Tournament as GSU defeated Alcorn State, Texas Southern and Southern to win the SWAC Championship for the first time since 1999.

In the NCAA Division I Tournament, Grambling State fell No. 2 Baylor to cap a great season for the Lady Tigers.

Shakyla Hill and Jazmin Boyd were named to the All-SWAC postseason teams, with Hill earning SWAC Tournament MVP honors.

During the 2016-17 season, Murray took over the program as the interim head coach following the departure of former head coach Nadine Domond. In the 2016-2017 season the Lady Tigers went on a stretch of winning 10 straight conference games. This streak helped the Lady Tigers win a share of the regular season SWAC Championship for the first time since 2000 with a record of 14-4 in conference play and an overall record of 18-14, earning the No. 1 seed in the SWAC Tournament. Grambling would win both of its first two SWAC tournament games by double digits, and make its first appearance in the SWAC title game 17 years.

Despite falling to Texas Southern in the SWAC Championship Game, Grambling made its first postseason appearance since 2000 earning a bid to the Women's National Invitational Tournament (WNIT). In the first round of the WNIT, Grambling made history, becoming the first SWAC school to win a postseason game, NCAA or WNIT, by defeating SEC opponent Ole Miss 78-75. The Lady Tigers would fall in the second round of the WNIT to Tulane University. The success of the program under Coach Murray's leadership earned him SWAC Coach of the Year honors and prompted Athletics Director Paul Bryant to promote him to be the permanent head coach of the Lady Tigers. Murray was also named BOXTOROW Co-Coach of the Year for the 2016-2017 season. Grambling would notch its second straight winning season, finishing with an overall record of 19-15.

For the 2016-2017 season point guard Shakyla Hill earned 1st team All-SWAC and BOXTOROW 1st Team All-American honors, averaging 15.0 points per game along with an average of 7.8 rebounds per game. Hill also shot a conference best 48.2% from the field and averaged a conference best 4.2 assists per game and 3.0 steals per game. Jazmin Boyd was selected as a Second Team All-SWAC pick

for the 2016-2017 season, averaging 11.8 points per game and was tied for 3rd in the conference in three-pointers made (50).

The veteran coach arrived at Grambling in 2015 and helped Coach Nadine Domond and the Lady Tigers reach an impressive 17-14 overall record and 13-5 record in conference play. Two players were selected as All-SWAC performers — Jazmin Boyd (SWAC Freshman of the Year) and Shakyla Hill (2nd Team All-SWAC). Hill was also selected as a 2nd Team BOXTOROW All-American. Coach Domond was selected as the SWAC Coach of the Year.

Murray was assistant women's basketball coach at Florida A&M University from 2010-2015. Murray assisted the FAMU Lady Rattler program to their best record in 2010 when they finished the season 22-8. During his time there he coached Antonia Bennett (2012) and Jasmine Grice (2014) to MEAC Player of the Year honors and later professional careers overseas. Grice would ultimately go on to lead the nation in assist and finish in Top-10 in scoring both achievements during the 2009 season.

Prior to joining the FAMU staff, he was an assistant coach at North Carolina A&T State University twice from (2003-2005) and (2007-2010). But it was during his return to North Carolina A&T (2007-2010) where he experienced more success helping to guide the Lady Aggies to three MEAC Regular Season Championships and trips to the NCAA and WNIT Tournaments.

In 2009-10 after winning the MEAC regular season title they participated in the WNIT inevitably advancing to the WNIT Sweet Sixteen, posting wins over Wake Forest and UNC-Charlotte in the first and second rounds becoming the first HBCU women's team to win two consecutive games in postseason play. They would later lose to Miami 84-77 in the third round ending their dreams of winning the WNIT. Miami would eventually lose in the Championship game.

In addition, the Lady Aggies also broke the school record for most wins in a season with 26 victories in 2008-09. During this period Ta'Wuana Cook went on to be the program's first MEAC Rookie of the Year, the school's second all-time leading scorer and all-time leader in assists, Lamona Smalley was a two-time MEAC All-Tournament Performer and Brittanie Taylor-James was MEAC Player of the Year (2009).

Prior to joining the North Carolina A&T staff, Murray coached at McNeese State University in Lake Charles, LA, where he served as assistant women's basketball coach from 2005-2007 and was later named interim head coach mid-way through the 2006-2007 season.

Coach Murray began his college-coaching career at his alma mater Jackson State University in Jackson, MS, first as a volunteer assistant with the men's program in 1999 and later as a graduate assistant coach (2001-2003). There he helped guide the Lady Tigers to the 2003 Southwestern Athletic Conference regular season title and finish with 23 wins that season. He also assisted in coaching 6'7 center Amie Williams who would be the SWAC Defensive Player of the Year and a first-team all-conference player in 2003.

Murray, a Jackson, Mississippi native, holds a bachelor's degree in Business Management from Jackson State (1990).










**HISTORY AT A GLANCE**

In 1920, athletic officials from six Texas HBCUs — C.H. Fuller of Bishop College, Red Randolph and C.H. Patterson of Paul Quinn College, E.G. Evans, H.J. Evans and H.J. Starns of Prairie View A&M, D.C. Fuller of Texas College and G. Whitte Jordan of Wiley College — met in Houston, Texas, to discuss common interests. At this meeting, they agreed to form a new league, the SWAC.

Paul Quinn became the first of the original members to withdraw from the league when it did so in 1929. When Langston University of Oklahoma was admitted into the conference two years later, it began the migration of state-supported institutions into the SWAC. Southern University entered the ranks in 1934, followed by Arkansas AM&N (now the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff) in 1936 and Texas Southern University in 1954.

Rapid growth in enrollment of the state-supported schools made it difficult for the church-supported schools to finance their athletics programs and one by one they fell victim to the growing prowess of the state-supported colleges. Bishop withdrew from the conference in 1956, Langston in 1957 and Huston-Tillotson (formerly Samuel Huston) in 1959, one year after the admittance of two more state-supported schools: Grambling College and Jackson State College.

The enter-exit cycle continued in 1961 when Texas College withdrew, followed by the admittance of Alcorn A&M (now Alcorn State University) in 1962. Wiley left in 1968, the same year Mississippi Valley State College entered. Arkansas AM&N exited in 1970 and Alabama State University entered in 1982. Arkansas-Pine Bluff (formerly Arkansas AM&N) rejoined the SWAC on July 1, 1997, regaining full-member status one year later. Alabama A&M University became the conference's tenth member when it became a full member in September, 1999 after a one year period as an affiliate SWAC member. Most of the former SWAC members that have left the conference are currently a part of the Red River Athletic Conference of the NAIA.

Current championship competition offered by the SWAC includes competition for men in baseball, basketball, cross country, football, golf, indoor track, outdoor track & field and tennis. Women's competition is offered in the sports of basketball, bowling, cross country, golf, indoor track, outdoor track & field, soccer, softball, tennis and volleyball.

**THE MISSION AND PURPOSE OF THE SOUTHWESTERN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE**

The Southwestern Athletic Conference, Inc. (the "SWAC", the "Conference") is organized exclusively for the purpose of encouraging, promoting, advancing, and conducting intercollegiate sports activities and other recreational and not-for-profit activities among the members of the Conference. Its purposes are:

- To uphold the principles of institutional control of, and responsibility for all collegiate sports conducted by the members of this organization in conformity with the Constitution and Bylaws hereof;
- To stimulate and improve intercollegiate athletic sports;
- To comply with satisfactory standards of scholarship and amateur standing and good sportsmanship;
- To preserve and maintain the collegiate athletic records of the members of the Southwestern Athletic Conference, and make them available upon request;
- To cooperate with other amateur athletic organizations in the promotion and conduct of intercollegiate athletic contests;
- To maintain fiscal management; and
- To legislate through Bylaws or Resolutions on subjects of general concern to the membership.

The members of the conference are committed to the philosophy of maintaining intercollegiate athletics as an integral part of the overall educational program. To this end, the conference believes in and subscribes to the fundamental principles of amateurism, institutional control, sound academic standards, financial aid, recruiting, and ethical conduct that governs intercollegiate athletics, and the enforcement of rules and regulations as adopted by the National Collegiate Athletic Association.
