OPENING TIP

- Honoring the late Mike Slive with the inaugural Mike Slive Invitational, the UAB men's basketball team and Auburn meet for the 21st time in program history on Saturday night at Legacy Arena. The Blazers and the Tigers are deadlocked at 10-10 in the all-time series.

- The Blazers had their three game winning streak snapped last time out after a 94-76 defeat at Memphis last Saturday. The Blazers enter the game at 6-3 overall.

- Senior forward Lewis Sullivan is putting together a tremendous senior season as the Hazel Green, Ala. native averaged 15.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game in two contests last week. He tallied his second career double-double with 16 points and 11 boards against North Alabama, and followed that up with a team-high 14 points and six rebounds at Memphis. For the season, he is average 10.6 ppg and 6.3 rpg.

- UAB is getting it done on the glass as the Blazers lead Conference USA and rank 26th nationally in rebounding margin at 7.8 per game. UAB has been specifically good on the offensive glass as its 14.0 offensive rebounds per game rank 16th most in the country.

- Since this rivalry has been renewed in 2015, Auburn has won all three games but only by a combined 10 points. 2015 at Auburn: 75-74, 2016 at UAB: 74-70, 2017 at Auburn: 85-80.

- Zack Bryant is the team's leading scorer this year, averaging 12.9 points per game. He is also tops on the team in assists (27) and steals (15).

- The Blazers made nine 3-pointers at Memphis, while eight of them coming in the first half.

HEAD COACH
3RD SEASON
RECORD: 43-32

Robert Ehsan is in his third season as head coach of the UAB men's basketball program and his seventh season on the staff after serving as associate head coach under former Blazer head coach Jerod Haase from 2012-16.

During the 2017-18 campaign, Ehsan led the Blazers to their third 20-win season in four years and the sixth in the last 10 years, clinching the team's fifth consecutive winning season in the process.

He produced three All-Conference players during his second season in Zack Bryant (All-Freshman), Chris Cokley (First Team) and William Lee (All-Defense). Bryant broke the all-time scoring record by a UAB freshman with 448 points, while Lee broke the school record for career blocks with 292 swats.

Cokley and Lee were rewarded for their outstanding careers with invitations to the 2018 NBA Summer League from the Charlotte Hornets and the Memphis Grizzlies, respectively.

In his first season as head coach, Ehsan guided UAB to 17 wins and directed the Blazers to their fourth consecutive winning season. Under Ehsan, UAB continued to serve as one of the top defensive teams in the country, ending the year first in Conference USA and 25th in the NCAA with 4.9 blocked shots per game.

Lee became the first player in school history to win the Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year award in consecutive seasons, finishing the year first in the league and 20th in the country with 2.4 blocks per game. Lee was also selected to the All-Conference USA Second Team, marking the third-straight year in which he was named all-conference.

Lee is also only the fourth player in league history to be named Conference USA Defensive Player of the Year twice. In addition, Lee earned a spot on the All-Conference USA Second Team.

As an assistant coach, Ehsan played a key role in the resurgence of UAB basketball, as he helped the Blazers capture the 2015 Conference USA Tournament championship and an automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament. UAB would go on to make shockwaves in the second round of the 2015 NCAA Tournament, as the 14th-seeded Blazers knocked off No. 3 seed Iowa State, 60-59, to advance to the NCAA Round of 32.

Ehsan and UAB enjoyed more success the following season when the Blazers won the 2016 Conference USA Championship with a 16-2 record inside the league. Additionally, UAB set school records for overall wins (26), Conference USA wins, road wins (10) and consecutive wins (14).

Individually, Robert Brown, Cokley, Lee and Nick Norton were named all-conference, while Lee was tabbed the C-USA Defensive Player of the Year and Dirk Williams the Sixth Man of the Year. A second consecutive trip to the postseason capped the year when the Blazers earned a berth in the NIT for the 12th time in school history.

Prior to his time at UAB, Ehsan spent a season as an assistant coach at Virginia Tech University under Seth Greenberg and six seasons under Gary Williams at the University of Maryland, where he was heavily involved with many aspects of the program, including coaching, player development, recruiting, academics, scouting, scheduling and fundraising.

At Maryland, Ehsan was instrumental in securing two Top 25 recruiting classes, and developed players like Jordan Williams, All-ACC, and ACC Player of the Year Greivis Vasquez. He was also involved in the recruitment of Brown, who was originally recruited by Ehsan at Virginia Tech before transferring to rejoin him at UAB, as well as UAB standout Lee and others.

Ehsan played four seasons at UC Davis and started his last two seasons for the Aggies, serving as team captain in his senior year. Ehsan finished 23rd in the nation in free-throw percentage as a junior for UC Davis, which was in a transition period while moving from NCAA Division II to Division I. At UC Davis, Ehsan received the Gordon S. Baranco Award, symbolizing exceptional leadership, unselfishness, work ethic and commitment to the team.

Ehsan earned a bachelor's degree in economics at UC Davis and completed a Master of Business Administration degree at Maryland. Ehsan is a native of Sacramento, Calif., and is married to the former Lindsey Rattray. They have one daughter, Katelyn, and a son, Davis.

UAB AND AUBURN DEADLOCKED

The winner of Saturday's game will walk out of the BJCC with a one-game lead in the all-time series. UAB won eight of 10 games in the series from 1989-1997, but Auburn has won the past five.

UAB VS. AUBURN

This is the fourth of a four-game agreement between the two programs. The series was played almost annually from 1982-1997, but then stopped until it was renewed on Nov. 13, 2015.

UAB VS. SEC

UAB is 31-38 all-time against current teams from the SEC, with Auburn being the most common opponent. Mississippi State is a distant second as UAB and the Bulldogs have only met six times.

HOT START

This is the second-straight year the Blazers have started the season 6-3, and last year's season resulted in 20 wins, marking the third time in the past four years, and six of the past 10 UAB has reached the 20-win plateau.

HOMESTAND

This is the first of six-straight games in Birmingham for the Blazers. Despite this game not being in Bartow Arena, UAB is 46-8 at Bartow dating back to the start of the 2015-16 season.

NON-CON WARRIORS

UAB has been dominant at home against non-conference opposition since the 2012-13 season, boasting a 44-6 record in those games. Under Coach Ehsan, UAB is 17-2 in those games and a 4-0 record at home this season.

SWEET HOME BARTOW ARENA

In 29 seasons, the Blazers are 366-87 (.808) on their home floor. Furthermore, the Blazers own an impressive 143-36 (.798) home mark since the beginning of the 2007-08 season and a 29-8 record under head coach Robert Ehsan.

SHARING THE WEALTH

Through eight games this season, UAB has had six different players score in double figures and four (Zack Bryant, Jalen Perry, Tyreek Scott-Grayson, Lewis Sullivan) score at least 15 points. Bryant is the only player this season to eclipse the 20-point mark after scoring a career-best 26 against Canisius at the AdvoCare Invitational on November 25.

BALANCED ATTACK

The Blazers' balanced attack has shown on the box score as UAB has had at least three players score in double figures in six of their eight games this season. With four players scoring in double figures against North Alabama and five vs. Memphis, the team has seen four players in double figures five times this year.

WIN THE GLASS

UAB's ability to rebound the ball has played a large part in their success this season. The Blazers are currently out-rebounding their opponents by a margin of 7.8, good for 26th in the NCAA. UAB has also been good on the offensive glass with 14.0 boards per contest, ranked 16th in the NCAA.

OUR STATE

The Blazers enter play against the Tigers sporting an all-time record of 89-24 (.784) against schools from the state of Alabama. UAB is 4-0 against in-state teams this year.

800 CLUB

The Blazers made history on November 18 when they claimed program win No. 800 with a 77-47 victory over West Alabama. With 40 years of basketball history, the Blazers are one of the youngest programs in the country to eclipse the 800-win mark.

TOURNEY TIME

UAB's 68-58 victory of Canisius in the AdvoCare Invitational snapped a six-game losing streak in November tournament contests and was its first win since defeating George Washington, 81-74, on Nov. 22, 2016, at the CBE Hall of Fame Classic in Kansas

SEASON-OPENING SUCCESS

UAB improved to 28-13 all-time in season openers after defeating Mercer, 75-67, on November 6. The Blazers are now 34-7 all-time in home openers and have won six of their last seven, including a 3-0 record under Ehsan.

20-POINT PERFORMANCE

Zack Bryant went off in UAB's win over Canisius, scoring a career-best 26 points off the bench. His previous career high was 25 points, which he recorded against Florida Atlantic last year in the Conference USA Tournament. Bryant now has two 20-point games in his career, the most by a current Blazer.

UAB FOR 3

After a sluggish start to the season from long range, the Blazers' shooters came alive in their 77-47 victory over West Alabama with 13 made 3-pointers. The total was most since UAB hit 14 against Alabama A&M last year.

DOUBLE DOWN DEBUTANT

Lewis Sullivan has two double-doubles this season, with his most recent coming in a 16 point, 11 rebound effort vs. North Alabama. 11 points and 10 rebounds vs. New Orleans. He is the only Blazer with a double-double this season.

EYE-OPENING DEBUTS

Six Blazers made their debuts in the Green and Gold against Mercer, led by starters Tavin Lovan (10 points, 7 rebounds) and Will Butler (4 points, three rebounds, 2 blocks). Other Blazers making their first appearances were Tyreek Scott-Grayson, Jeremiah Bell, Luis Hurtado and Tamell Pearson.

LAST MINUTE ADDITION

After transferring from Milwaukee and anticipating sitting out this season, Jeremiah Bell was granted immediate eligibility by the NCAA prior to the Mercer game. Bell made his first appearance for the Green and Gold against the Bears, scoring two points pulling down two rebounds in nine minutes of play.

RING THE BELL

Two games after finding out he was immediately eligible, transfer Jeremiah Bell stole the show against West Alabama, pouring in a career-best 13 points, shooting 67.7 percent (4-of-6) from the field and 60 percent (3-of-5)

from long range.

NEW FACES

UAB enters the season with nine new faces on the roster, the third-most in Conference USA behind UTEP and Middle Tennessee.

PRESEASON POLL

Ahead of the 2018-19 season, the league's head coaches and media members voted UAB to finished in eighth in the league standings. WKU was picked to win the league in the poll with nine first-place votes.

BASKETBALL FOR A CAUSE

UAB kicked off the season earlier than most everyone in the country when it played host to Georgia for a charity exhibition game benefiting the Red Cross on October 18. The Blazers had a chance to tie the game on the final possession, but could not get a bucket to drop, falling the Bulldogs, 56-54.

EXHIBITION SUCCESS

In the team's final tune-up game of the season, UAB hosted Morehouse College on November 1 and defeated the Maroon Tigers by a score of 75-54. Three Blazers finished the game in double figures, with newcomer Jude Akabueze leading the way 13 points in 12 minutes off the bench. UAB is now 2-1 under head coach Robert Ehsan in exhibition play.

20-WIN SEASONS

With last season's 20 wins, the Blazers clinched its third 20-win season in the last four season and the sixth in their last 10.

OFFENSIVE SHOES TO FILL

With the departure of four starters from a season ago, the Blazers will have big shoes to fill the season as they will look to replace 58 percent of their total scoring.

SCOOTIE WATCH

Coming off a stellar freshman campaign, Zack Bryant was named to the Conference USA Preseason Team, as voted on by the league's head coaches. Bryant was stellar for the Blazers last season, averaging 13.6 ppg and 3.2 rpg, while finishing second on the team with 101 assists en route to garnering a spot on the C-USA All-Freshman team. As the only returning starter from the 2017-18 season, Bryant will be tasked with being the general for UAB's new-look attack.

RECORD-BREAKING ROOKIE

Bryant etched his name in the record books as one of the top freshmen in program history, setting the single-season school record for points by a freshman with 407. The previous record of 349 was set by Demario Eddins during the 2002-03 season.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP

UAB will turn to its two senior leaders in Lewis Sullivan and Jalen Perry to help guide the young Blazer squad. The duo returns 7.5 points per game and 7.2 points per game, respectively. Sullivan, who recorded 19 blocks a year ago, will also be tasked with serving as a defensive anchor for UAB after the departure of William Lee, who finished with a program-record 292 blocks over his four seasons.

FAMILIAR FACES

Sophomore Makhtar Gueye saw valuable minutes during the 2017-18 season, averaging 2.2 points and 1.6 rebounds per game. Anderson McCoy and Luis Hurtado were also members of last season's squad, but did not see any playin time and will look to compete for playing time this year.

BIG BOY BASKETBALL

After the departure of William Lee and Chris Cokley, UAB had some holes to fill in its frontcourt and it did just that with some serious size. The Blazers' frontcourt welcomes in three players at 6-foot-8 or better in Will Butler, Jude Akabueze and Tamell Pearson.

FILLING THE DEPTH CHART

UAB also welcomes in added depth to the guard corps, including Hargrave Military Academy product Tavin Lovan, who joins the Blazers after averaging almost 16 points per contest. Graduate transfer Wil Bathurst, junior college transfers Nolan Bertain and Tyreek Scott-Grayson and freshman Joshua Sippial also bring scoring prowess and will provide a spark to UAB's offense. Lovan started both exhibition games for the Blazers and is primed for a strong inaugural season in the Green and Gold.

CONTINUING AT THE HELM

Head coach Robert Ehsan will continue to lead the Blazers as he was given a one-year extension to remain as the head coach of the Blazers through the 2022 season. Ehsan currently holds a 38-29 overall record.
