- » Auburn plays the final game of a three-game homestand Tuesday night. The Tigers opened the homestand with a 99-49 victory over Saint Peter's on Nov. 28 and then took down UNC Asheville, 67-41, on Dec. 4. It is one of two three-game homestands for Auburn this season. The Tigers host Missouri on Wed., Jan. 30, Alabama on Sat., Feb. 2 and Florida on Tues., Feb. 5.
- » Auburn is off to a 7-1 start for the second straight season after having just one 7-1 start in the previous 13 years. Last season, the Tigers extended their hot start to 16-1 after beginning 2016-17 with a 7-1 mark. In 2011-12, Auburn opened the season 8-1.
- » Auburn ranks third in the country with a scoring margin of +26.4. The Tigers are second in the SEC and 19th in the nation with an average of 86.4 points per game. On the defensive end, Auburn is first in the SEC and 15th overall, allowing 60.0 points per contest.
- » Auburn is the 13th-most efficient offensive team in the country with an average of 115.4 points per 100 possessions, according to KenPom. In addition, the Tigers are also the ninth-most efficient defensive team in the nation. Auburn allows just 91.3 points per 100 possessions. The Tigers tout the eigth-highest adjusted efficiency margin at +24.04.
- » After being one of the youngest teams in the NCAA last year with one senior, Auburn boasts 13 upperclassmen and has 4,182 career points returning for the 2018-19 season eighth-highest in the country.
- » Auburn is one of just seven programs without a scholarship freshman on its roster, joining Alcorn State, Bethune-Cookman, Louisville, South Alabama, Tulsa and UT Martin.

- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 17 of the 23 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg
- One of just seven active head coaches who has led his teams to at least 10 NCAA Sweet 16 appearances (10 total)
- Bruce Pearl is ranked second in the SEC among current head coaches in career winning percentage (.718), fifth in winning percentage as a SEC head coach (.622), fifth in average wins per year as a SEC head coach (21.0) and fifth in SEC games only win pct. (.540, 81-70)
- Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)
- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the fourth straight time in 2017-18, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came in the 1999-2000 season
- Auburn averaged 8,221 in its 15 home games during the 2017-18 season, which included seven sellouts in the nine SEC games. The 8,221 average is the highest in Auburn Arena history
- \bullet In 23 years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have fiished either first or second in conference play 16 times
- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 18 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- In the past two seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 23-3 (.885), while scheduling perennial NCAA Tournament teams in Dayton, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech and UConn.

- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 18 graduates in four years the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport.
- Auburn recently secured its third perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history.
- In the past four years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940.
- Bruce Pearl has raised \$1 million in only four golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl Fore the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families. Over \$200,000 was raised in the Bruce, Barkley & Basketball Golf Classic Oct. 23-24, 2016, benefitting the Auburn Basketball program.
- Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease.
- The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015.
- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain.

AUBURN VS. DAYTON SERIES

- » Auburn is 1-4 all-time against Dayton, but the Tigers defeated the Flyers 73-60 on the road last season in the two schools' last meeting. Dayton won 106-63 in 1972 in Auburn's only trip to Dayton prior to last year. The Flyers won 85-71 in the 1965 Sugar Bowl Tournament in New Orleans, La., Dayton handed Auburn a 60-59 overtime loss in the 2008 Chicago Invitational and knocked off Auburn 73-63 as part of the 2012 Charleston Classic in Charleston, S.C. Four of the previous five meetings in the series have been decided by at least 10 points.
- » Auburn's 73-60 victory at Dayton last season was the first game against the Flyers for Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl in his head coaching career.

DYNAMIC BACKCOURT

» Auburn has been led so far this season by its dynamic backcourt of Bryce Brown and Jared Harper. The duo is averaging 29.9 points per game and is shooting 51-of-129 (39.5 percent) from 3-point range. They have combined for four 20-point games this season, including Auburn's win over Xavier in the first round of the Maui Invitational when Brown scored 26 and Harper added 25, season highs for each.

BROWN SETS NEW 3-POINT RECORD

- » Bryce Brown went 4-of-8 from 3 against Arizona, all in the second half, to break Wesley's Person school record of 262 career 3-point field goals. The record breaker came with 5:00 remaining in the game to give Auburn a 66-51 lead. Brown now has 268 made 3-pointers in his career.
- » Brown, who has made at least four 3-pointers in five of eight games this season, led Auburn with 19 points against Arizona. He averaged 20.3 points and hit 13 3s in three games in the Maui Invitational. He is averaging 3.38 made 3s per game this season, which is 32nd in the country.

» For his career, Brown is 268-of-704 (.381) from 3-point range. He is 20 3-pointers away from cracking the SEC's top 10 for career 3s. His 704 career 3-pointers attempted are second in Auburn history behind Frankie Sullivan's 713 and put him just 48 from moving in the SEC's career top 10 for 3-pointers attempted.

BLOWOUT WINS

- » Auburn defeated South Alabama 101-58 (+43), Washington 88-66 (+22) and Mississippi College 103-52 (+51) to open the season. It is the first time the Tigers have opened the season with wins of 20 or more points in their first three games since the Tigers' SEC championship season of 1998-99.
- » Six of Auburn's seven victories this season have been by at least 16 points and the Tigers' seven victories are by an average of 31.0 points. Auburn's 26.4-point scoring margin leads the country and is the Tigers' best through eight games since Auburn outscored its first eight opponents by 30.0 points per game in 1998-99.
- » Auburn's 51-point victory over Mississippi College is the Tigers' largest margin of victory since defeating Stony Brook 100-45 on Jan. 2, 2000.

OLD, SAVVY VETERANS

- » Despite being a young team during Auburn's run to a conference title in 2017-18, the Tigers have turned into one of the most experienced teams in the country.
- » Auburn is one of just seven programs without a scholarship freshman on its roster, joining Alcorn State, Bethune-Cookman, Louisville, South Alabama, Tulsa and UT Martin.

CONTINUING THE IMPROVEMENT: CONFERENCE WIN TOTALS

Auburn is one of just 13 teams in the country to have improved its win totals in conference play each of the last four seasons. The Tigers are one of only two power-five programs to accomplish the feat, joining USC. Auburn won four Southeastern Conference games in 2015, five in 2016, seven in 2017 and 13 in 2018 to become the SEC champions.

» Auburn held a double-digit lead for all but 28:40 in its five home games. The Tigers held a double-digit lead for all but 11:33 seconds after the first media timeout in its five home games combined. Auburn held a double-digit lead at the first media timeout in its first four home games: 17-4 over South Alabama, 14-4 over Washington and 10-0 over Mississippi College and Saint Peter's. In fact, Auburn has had a 20-point lead for 119:14 of the 200 minutes played at home this season, including all but 9:45 in the second half.

TOP OF THE PACK

» Auburn has fared well in the past two-plus seasons in the non-conference slate. The Tigers lead the SEC in both wins and winning percentage in non-league regular season games over the last two-plus seasons.

- » Auburn won the rebounding battle five times including by at least 15 in three of its eight games. The Tigers have a plus-8.8 rebounding margin, which is 22nd in the country. Auburn has outrebounded its opponents 127-79 on the offensive glass, which has led to a 127-64 (15.9-8.0) advantage in second-chance points. The Tigers are averaging 15.9 offensive rebounds per game, which ranks fifth in the country.
- » Chuma Okeke (3.3), Horace Spencer (2.8), Anfernee McLemore (2.3) and Austin Wiley (1.9) lead the Tigers in offensive rebounding.

KEEP IT 100

» Auburn scored 103 points vs. Mississippi College, the most points for the Tigers since a 119-85 victory over Winthrop last season. It is the second time the Tigers have reached the century mark this season after defeating South Alabama 101-58 in the season opener, and the seventh time in 140 games under head coach Bruce Pearl. For the season, the Tigers are averaging 86.4 points per game, which is 19th nationally, and have scored at least 88 points in five of eight games.

TIGERS WINNING THE TURNOVER BATTLE

- » Auburn has a plus-7.5 turnover margin for the season, which is second in the country. The Tigers are fifth nationally forcing 20.4 turnovers per game, while only turning it over 12.9 times per contest themselves. Auburn has forced at least 18 turnovers in all but one game. The Tigers are outscoring opponents 28.1-8.3 on points off turnovers and has won the points off turnovers battle in all eight games. Auburn has scored at least 25 points off turnovers in six of eight games this season.
- » In its game against Saint Peter's, Auburn forced 26 turnovers and turned those turnovers into 38 points, both season highs. It is the most turnovers the Tigers have forced since forcing 28 turnovers against North Florida on Nov. 11, 2016. Auburn followed that up by forcing 25 turnovers against UNC Asheville in its last game. It is the first time the Tigers have forced at least 20 turnovers in consecutive games since Nov. 21 & 24, 2014, against Louisiana and Tulsa.

OFF THE COURT: ANFERNEE MCLEMORE

Anfernee McLemore is the perfect embodiment of what it means to be a student-athlete at Auburn University. The two-time Academic Top Tiger honoree recently served on the presitigious Southeastern Conference Men's Basketball Leadership Council. He also has logged hours at the "Breakfast Club" where he serves as a role model for young kids in the Auburn community.



» Because of its dominance on the offensive glass and with turnovers, Auburn has 124 more field-goal attempts than its opponents through eight games (15.5).

BMOC

» Austin Wiley has scored in double figures in five of the last five games, including 17 points on 7-of-11 shooting and nine rebounds against No. 1 Duke. The junior is shooting 32-of-50 (.640) from the field and is averaging 12.2 points, 4.6 rebounds and 1.9 blocks per game in just 16.6 minutes per contest on the season. He scored 18 points on 8-of-10 field goals and seven rebounds against Mississippi College, 18 points on 7-of-13 field goals, nine rebounds and three blocks against Saint Peter's, 14 points on 5-of-7 field goals five blocks and four rebounds against UNC Asheville and 11 points and three blocks against Xavier.

CHEF HARPER WITH THE POP, BOY

- » Jared Harper has three 20-point games this season, including 20 points on 7-of-13 shooting and 6-of-10 3-pointers to go with 13 assists, five rebounds and two steals in the season-opening win over South Alabama. Harper added 25 points, eight assists, six rebounds and three steals in Auburn's overtime win over Xavier in the first round of the Maui Invitational. He poured in 22 points on 6-of-10 3-pointers and dished out six assists the next day against No. 1 Duke. For the season, Harper is scoring 13.9 points, 6.8 assists, 3.1 rebounds and 1.1 steals per game while shooting 42.9 percent from 3-point range and 88.2 from the free-throw line.
- » Auburn has scored 130 points off Harper's assists this season. Harper is averaging 6.8 assists per game, which is tied for 15th nationally. He has made or assisted on 90 of the Tigers' 248 field goals this season (36.3 percent).
- » The junior has made 284 free throws in his career, which puts him three away from cracking the top-10 all-time at Auburn.

RETURN TO SENDER

- » Auburn set a new program record with 180 blocks last season. The Tigers have had three of its program's top-10 single-season block totals during Bruce Pearl's first four seasons on the Plains. [1. 180, 2017-18; 3. 162, 2016-17; 10. 126, 2015-16]. The Tigers have two of its top-8 all-time shot blockers on its current roster. Senior Horace Spencer has blocked 141 shots, which is tied with Chris Morris (1984-88) for fifth all-time at Auburn and four shy of Charles Barkley (1981-84) for fourth. Junior Anfernee McLemore ranks eighth at Auburn with 126 career blocks.
- » As a team, Auburn is averaging 6.3 blocks per game, which is ninth in the country.

» Auburn is averaging 11.6 made 3s per game, which is tied for seventh nationally, and the Tigers have made double digit threes in five of eight games. Auburn has five players averaging at least one made 3-pointer per game.

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

» Auburn held UNC Asheville to 41 points in its last game, which is the fewest by a Tiger opponent since Auburn held Alabama to 37 points on Feb. 6, 2013. It is the fifth time in eight games this season that Auburn has held an opponent to

under 60 points after holding just two opponents to under 60 points in 2017-18.

» Auburn forced UNC Asheville into 25 turnovers and scored 20 points off those turnovers the last time out. It is the fourth time this season the Tigers have forced at least 20 turnovers, including 26 in their last game against Saint Peter's. Auburn has forced at least 20 turnovers in back-to-back games for the first time since Nov. 21 & 24, 2014, against Louisiana and Tulsa.

STRONG BENCH PRODUCTION

- » Auburn scored 26 bench points in its last game against UNC Asheville led by Austin Wiley's 14 points. Malik Dunbar has scored in double figures four times this season after doing so just three times last season. Ten times Auburn has had a player score in double figures coming off the bench led by Wiley, who has done it five times, and Dunbar, who has done it four times. Horace Spencer recorded his first career double-double coming off the bench against Missispipi College with 14 points and 17 rebounds. The Tigers have scored at least 20 bench points six times and 30 bench points three times this season. On average, Auburn's reserves outscore its opponents' bench, 29.4-14.9.
- » Over the last four games, Auburn is outscoring its opponents 124-35 in bench points.

ARENA RECORDS

» The Tigers set a pair of Auburn Arena records in its game against Saint Peter's with 25 assists and 16 steals against Saint Peter's. Auburn's previous record of 24 assists came against Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 30, 2013. The former mark of 15 steals came in a game against Presbyterian on Dec. 18, 2010.

TIGERS DOMINATING NON-CON AT HOME

» Auburn has posted an 18-0 home record against non-conference opponents over the last two-plus seasons after a 5-0 start to the season. The Tigers posted a 7-0-mark last season and 6-0 in 2016-17 at Auburn Arena against non-conference opponents. Auburn has topped the 100-point plateau five times during the streak including twice in five home games this season. Fifteen of Auburn's 18 wins during the streak have been by at least 16 points.

PLAYER TO WATCH: BRYCE BROWN

It's no secret that Bryce Brown has a major impact on the game for the Tigers. During Auburn's 20-1 stretch at home over the last two seasons, Brown has averaged 17.2 points per game. In that timeframe, Brown has knocked down 77 3-pointers (3.7 per game) and has shot 44 percent from behind the arc. The senior has also recorded 27 steals in the last 21 games inside Auburn Arena.



» During Bruce Pearl's tenure as Auburn's head coach, the Tigers have posted a 29-3 (.906) mark against non-conference opponents at Auburn Arena.

I'LL TAKE THAT

» Auburn is averaging 10.3 steals per game, which is tied for sixth in the country and has six players averaging at least a steal per game led by Samir Doughty, who is averaging 1.8 steals per game.

HOMECOURT ADVANTAGE

» Auburn is 20-1 at Auburn Arena since the start of last season. The Tigers' lone home loss over that period was by one point, 81-80, to Texas A&M last season. During that span, Auburn is outscoring its opponents by 21.9 points per game (89.3-67.4) at home. The Tigers have reached the 80-point plateau in 16 of those 21 games and have scored at least 76 points in all but one game. Auburn is averaging 11.1 made 3-pointers per game. Also, the Tigers have forced 353 turnovers, an average of 16.8 per game.

AUBURN ARENA SELLOUTS

» There have been 23 sellouts in Auburn Arena, which is in its ninth season. Under Bruce Pearl, Auburn has had 18 sellouts in four years (65 games) compared to only five in the 72 games prior to Pearl's arrival in 2014-15. The Tigers have won nine straight games played in front of a soldout crowd at Auburn Arena.

- » When head coach Bruce Pearl took the job at Auburn, he made a commitment to make sure his kids focused on their school work.
- » In May, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004.
- » The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport.
- » Auburn has three consecutive perfect APR scores of 1,000.
- » The Tigers boast 995 multi-year score from 2013-17, the best in program history.
- » Auburn has graduated 18 student-athletes in the last four years the most by any program in the SEC.

TOP-10 CLASS


