### THREE HITS

**1** No. 1 Auburn kicked off the 2018-19 season with a 15-4 victory on the road at then-No. 10 UT Martin.

**2** The Tigers swept the MOP honors vs. the Skyhawks with all four going to seniors - Caitlin Boyle (Fences), Ashton Alexander (Flat), Lauren Diaz (Horsemanship), Blair McFarlin (Reining).

**3** McFarlin and classmate Kelsey Jung picked up big scores in their respective events vs. UT Martin. McFarlin led all Reining riders with a 73.5, while Jung had a 75.5 in Horsemanship.

### NO. 1 AUBURN WELCOMES NO. 9 SOUTH CAROLINA TO THE PLAINS

The No. 1 Auburn equestrian team welcomes No. 9 South Carolina to the Plains for the team's official home opener of the 2018-19 season. The two squads will go head-to-head at 3 p.m. CT at the Auburn University Equestrian Center.

"I'm really excited to start conference play at home," head coach Greg Williams said. "The team is riding very well right now so we're expecting to see some exciting rounds."

### AUBURN LINEUP

The Auburn competition lineup is senior heavy, boasting eight over the four events. The lineup also includes one junior, three sophomores and two freshmen.

Senior All-Americans Ashton Alexander, Caitlin Boyle and Hayley Iannotti highlight the Hunt Seat portion of the meet as the trio will compete in both Equitation Over Fences and Equitation on the Flat. Joining the crew is a pair of freshmen in Emma Kurtz and McKayla Langmeier. The start in both events is the first for Kurtz, while Langmeier enters the week with a 1-0 mark in both Flat and Fences.

Senior Alex Ladove is slated to ride exhibition in Fences, while junior Becky Kozma will ride exhibition in Flat. The pair will flip flop as alternates.

On the Western side of competition, a pair of seniors in Lauren Diaz and Kelsey Jung are set to lead the Horsemanship corps. Both picked up big wins at UT Martin last week. The two will be joined by junior Kara Kaufmann and freshmen Deanna Green and Taylor Searles. Green returns to the Plains as the SEC Freshman Horsemanship Rider of the Year, while Searles capped the 2017-18 with big wins in the postseason.

Senior Megan Rauh will ride in exhibition for the Tigers in the event, while freshman Ellie Becker is the alternate.

Seniors Betsy Brown, Ali Fratessa and Blair McFarlin highlight the Reining crew as all three picked up victories vs. the Skyhawks last week. McFarlin earned MOP honors after scoring a meet-best 73.5, while Brown returns for her final campaign as the SEC Reining Rider of the Year. Sophomore Terri-June Granger and Green are also slated to ride for the squad. Kaufmann will go as alternate.

**SEVENTEENTH SEASON OF VARSITY EQUESTRIAN**

The 2018-19 season marks the 17th year of varsity equestrian at Auburn. Head coach Greg Williams has guided the Tigers since the program was recognized by the Athletics Department and has amassed an impressive 141-57 overall record.

In 16 years, Auburn has earned five NCEA Championships (2006, 2011, 2013, 2016, 2018), one Southeastern Conference title (2016), three Southern Equestrian Conference crowns (2004, 2010, 2011), four NCEA Hunt Seat championships (2008, 2011, 2013, 2018) and one NCEA Western championship (2018).

Individually, Auburn boasts 59 All-Americans and 54 All-SEC selections. The Southeastern Conference first began sponsoring equestrian in 2012-13.

**UP NEXT**

After a week off, the No. 1 Tigers will host Ole Miss in an exhibition meet at the Auburn University Equestrian Center. Auburn and Ole Miss will go head-to-head at 3 p.m. CT on Oct. 12.

**AUBURN OPENS SEASON AS NCEA NO. 1**

The defending NCEA champion Auburn equestrian team will enter the 2018-19 season ranked No. 1 according to the National Collegiate Equestrian Association Preseason Poll, the selection committee announced.

"I believe the team has earned that ranking and their attitude this year looks like they all want to work hard enough to back it up," Williams said. "All the coaches are eager to get a new season kicked off and we are excited about what's to come. We are looking forward to this season being something special in its own right."

The Tigers hold the top spot, while SEC rivals Georgia and Texas A&M come in at second and third, respectively. Oklahoma State is fourth and SMU rounds out the Top 5.

**AUBURN-SOUTH CAROLINA SERIES HISTORY**

Auburn holds the edge in the series history with a 21-18 mark vs. the Gamecocks.

The Tigers have won nine-straight meetings vs. the Gamecocks and are 9-6 at home in Auburn.

**LAST MEETING - FEBRUARY 24, 2018**

The No. 2 Auburn equestrian team extended its winning streak

to four, defeating No. 9 South Carolina, 12-7, at the Auburn University Equestrian Center.

The Western corps put together a dominate showing for the squad, going 7-2 against the Gamecocks.

Auburn went 4-1 in Horsemanship to kick off the meet. Kara Kaufmann opened up the team points with a 75-72.5 win over Quinn Brandt. Kelsey Jung and Deanna Green each earned their eighth win of the year as Jung topped Madison Thiel, 72-70.5, and Green bested Megan Overberg, 75.5-72. Green, of Pilot Point, Texas, was awarded Most Outstanding Performer honor for her ride.

Taylor Searles finished out the event with a 74.5-72 victory over Paige Stopperich.

Auburn edged the Gamecocks in Equitation on the Flat with a 3-2 record. Hayley Iannotti earned her ninth Flat win of 2017-18, besting Lizzie van der Walde, 56-46. Caitlin Creel edged Lauren Fabiano, 66-65, and Taylor St. Jacques remained undefeated in the event with a 67-57 victory over Louisa Brackett.

The Gamecocks closed in on Auburn's 7-3 intermission lead, besting the Tigers in Equitation Over Fences with a 3-2 edge. St. Jacques rode to an 87-84 win over Lizzie van der Walde and Alex Ladove capped the event with 86 points in her victory.

The Reining corps put together another solid performance for the squad to close out the full day, besting the Gamecocks, 3-1. After SC captured the first match up, Blair McFarlin rode to a 67-67 tie vs. her opponent. Alexa Rivard gave Auburn its 10th point with her 68.5 points and Betsy Brown extended her winning streak as she topped Bridgett White, 70.5-69.5. Terri-June Granger led all student-athletes with 71 points in her win to seal the 12-7 team victory.

**LAST TIME OUT - AT UT MARTIN - SEPT. 20, 2018**

The No. 1 Auburn equestrian team kicked off the 2018-19 season with a 15-4 victory over No. 10 UT Martin on the road at the Ned McWherter Agricultural Center.

"This was one of our better season openers from top to bottom," Williams said. "There were very few mistakes than what we normally see in the first meet of the year. I love that this team really took heart the importance on working on fundamentals and we feel good about that."

» Freshman McKayla Langmeier kicked off her collegiate career with a pair of wins at UT Martin. She scored 80 points in her Equitation on the Flat victory and followed with 81 points in Equitation Over Fences.



The Tigers swept the Most Outstanding Performers awards as a quartet of seniors shined during competition. Caitlin Boyle picked up honors in Equitation Over Fences, while Lauren Diaz was awarded MOP in Horsemanship. Blair McFarlin was the high scorer and MOP winner in Reining and Ashton Alexander earned the honor in Equitation on the Flat.

"The seniors rode extremely strong today," Williams said. "Every single one in the lineup today is somebody that can ride with anyone in the country. Not only do I like what they are doing in competition, but I really like how they are developing a great leadership style for this team."

Auburn went into intermission with a 7-2 lead over the Skyhawks after solid performances from Equitation Over Fences and Horsemanship.

Boyle kicked off the scoring in Fences with an 86-84 win over Kelby Kane and Alexander followed with a 10-point win vs. Randi LaChance. Competing in her first collegiate meet was freshman McKayla Langmeier and the East Granby, Conn., product bested her opponent, 81-65. Senior Hayley Iannotti capped the event with an 83-68 win over Monika Zorowski.

Senior Megan Rauh was a big scorer for the Tigers in Horsemanship, opening the event with 74 points in her win. Diaz rode to a 73.5-70.5 win over Devon Woods and senior Kelsey Jung earned the high score of the day with 75.5 points to top Tess Baumann's 70.5.

Following the break, the Reining corps came out hot and finished the Western side of competition with a 4-1 win over the Skyhawks.

McFarlin led all student-athletes with a 73.5 on her ride, besting her opponent's 66.5. Seniors Ali Fratessa and Betsy Brown followed with more wins for Auburn. Fratessa topped Hannah McDonald by a point, 69.5-68.5, while Brown's 65.5 was four better than her competition. Sophomore Terri-June Granger picked up where she left off last year, earning a 67-66 victory over Liana Nowak.

After dropping the first point, the Flat crew bounced back to take the final four match ups and win 4-1. Langmeier capped her successful first meet with an 80-66 win and Alexander followed

with her MOP ride, scoring 86 points. Iannotti put together an 81-76 victory, while sophomore Taylor St. Jacques closed out the day with a 76-67 win over LaChance.

**SENIOR STRONG**

The 2018-19 season is the year of the senior as the Tigers boast one of its largest senior class.

Hunt seat seniors include - Ashton Alexander, Caitlin Boyle, Hayley Iannotti, Kennedy Knapic, Alex Ladove, Mackenzie Michaels and Casey Schmitz.

Western senior are - Betsy Brown, Lauren Diaz, Ali Fratessa, Kelsey Jung, Blair McFarlin, Emma Paul and Megan Rauh.

Alexander, Boyle and Iannotti have multiple All-America honors under their belt. Boyle is on pace to be one of the top Hunt Seat riders in program history, while Iannotti and Alexander will also finish among the Top 5 in both Hunt Seat events.

Diaz has been in the Auburn Horsemanship lineup since her freshman campaign and is also on pace to set records in the event. Jung broke the single season wins record in Horsemanship last year.

Brown and McFarlin will conclude their careers among the program's best in Reining in all categories.

# EQUESTRIAN 101: SCORING AND RULES

## GENERAL RULES

1. In equitation/horsemanship classes, only the rider is being judged therefore no penalty should be assessed because of the horse's conformation, color or movement.
2. Falling off a horse results in elimination.
3. Three refusals over jumps by a horse results in elimination.
4. Any rider not having her mount under sufficient control shall be removed from the ring by the show stewards and shall be disqualified or remounted at their discretion.
5. Riders must remain on the same mount throughout all phases of an equitation or horsemanship class unless the judge or coaches requests a re-ride.

## COMPETITION RULES

Riders from opposing teams compete on the same horse. Each rider receives a score. The competitor with the highest score receives one point for their team.

Each rider from each team is given a 4 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Equitation on the Flat and Equitation over Fences.

- Riders from Home team will warm up with each other. Riders from Visiting Team will warm-up with each other. Riders in Equitation over Fences are only allowed to jump 4 fences in their warm-up.

Each rider from each team is given a 4 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Horsemanship.

- Riders from Home team and Visiting Team will warm-up together at the same time if the size of the ring allows for this.

Each rider from each team is given a 5 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Reining.

- Riders from Home team will warm up with each other. Riders from Visiting Team will warm-up with each other.

## HUNT SEAT RULES

General-- The rider should have a workmanlike appearance, seat and hands light and supple, conveying the impression of complete control.

### Equitation on the Flat

Scoring: Scored out of 100. There are 9 movements as well as a collective mark. These are based out of 1-10 points for each movement and overall position. 1 meaning not executed and 10 meaning excellent.

### Equitation over Fences

Scoring: Scored out of 100. Based on the rider's equitation, complete control of the horse, executing the jumps in correct form, and staying consistent.

## WESTERN RULES

General-- The rider will be judged on seat, hands, and the ability to control and show the horse. Results as shown by the performance of the horse are not to be considered more important than the method used by the rider in obtaining them.

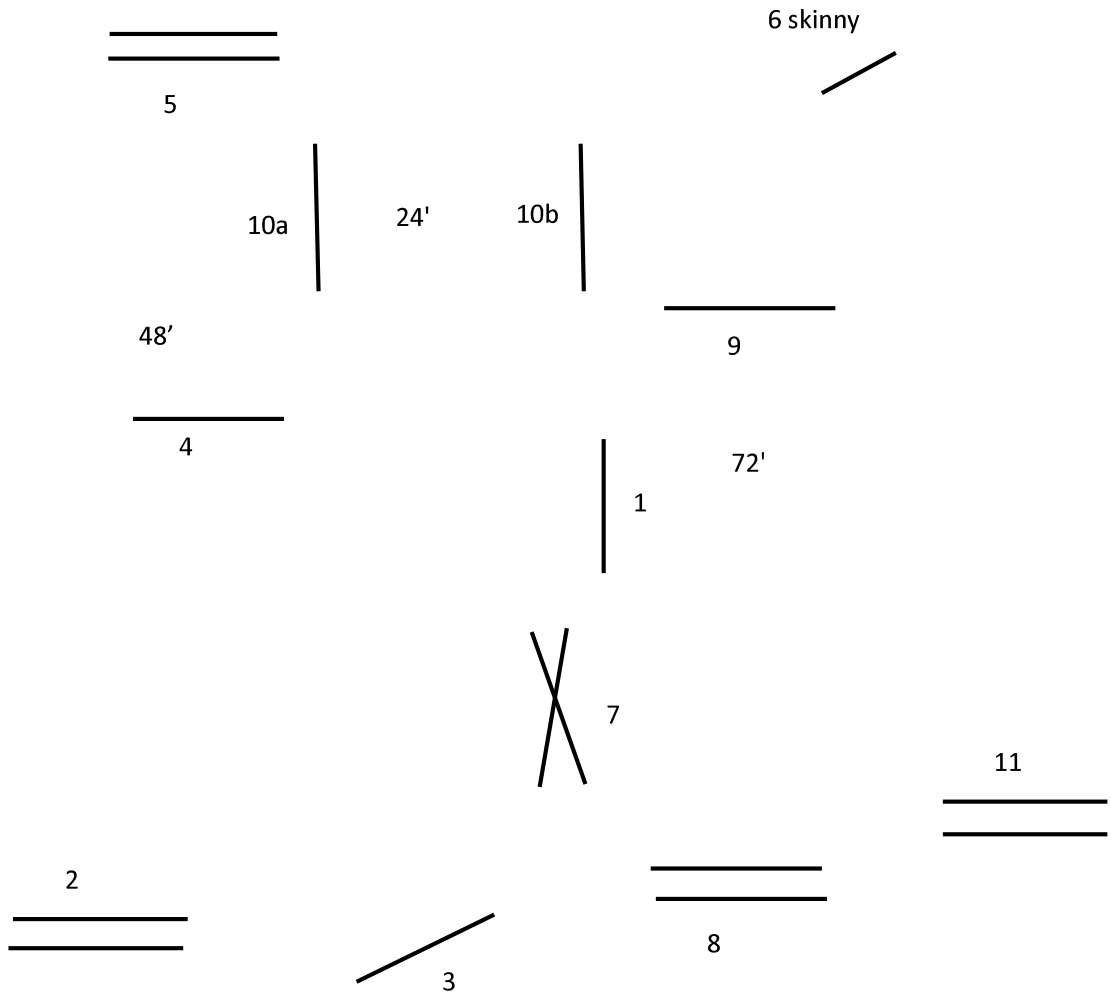
### Reining

Scoring: Base score is a 70. There are 7-8 maneuvers depending on the pattern, as well as a collective mark. NRHA/AQHA patterns 1-10 must be used. In these patterns, there are spins, circles, lead changes, stops, rollbacks, and back. Within each maneuver one can score anywhere from a -1.5 to +1.5 points... -1.5 is extremely poor, +1.5 is excellent, and 0 points added to the maneuver means it was done correctly. There are also penalties such as kick outs, break of gait, missing leads, etc. that can be anywhere from -.5 to 5 penalty points.

### Horsemanship

Scoring: Base score is a 70. There are 7-9 maneuvers depending on the pattern, as well as a collective mark. Within each maneuver one can score anywhere from a -1.5 to +1.5 points... -1.5 is extremely poor, +1.5 is excellent, and 0 points added to the maneuver means it was done correctly. There are also penalties such as kick outs, break of gait, missing leads, etc. that can be 1,3 or 5 penalty points depending on severity.

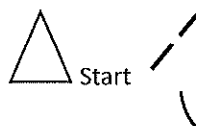

## HORSEMANSHIP PATTERN

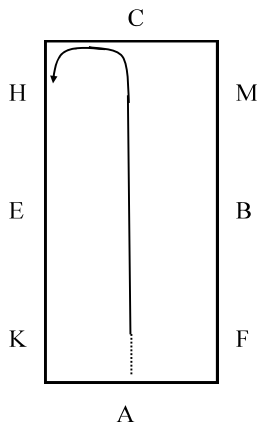


Note: The drawn description of this pattern is only intended for the general depictions of the pattern. Riders should utilize the arena space to best exhibit their horses.

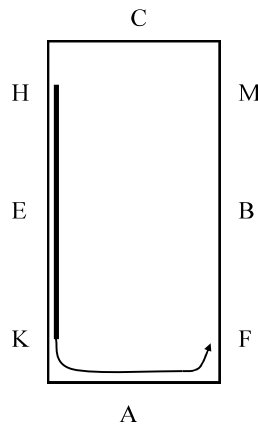


1. Enter at the exterior corner.

6. Break to the exterior corner.
7. 90° turn left. Back to the exterior corner.

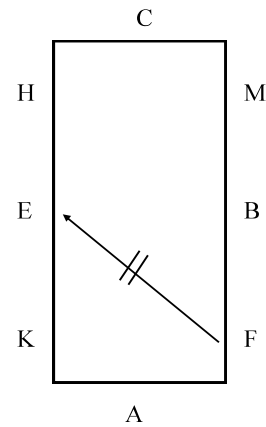

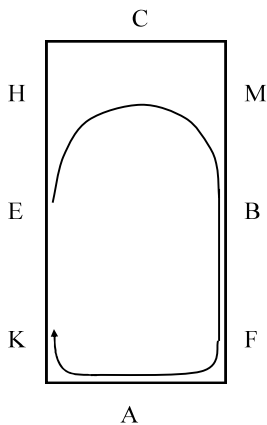

## REINING PATTERN



○ MARKER

1. Beginning, and staying at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the walls or fence, lope straight up the left side of the arena, circle the top end of the arena, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback - no hesitation.
2. Continue straight up the right side of the arena staying at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence, circle back around the top of the arena, run straight down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback - no hesitation.
3. Continue up the left side of the arena to the center marker. At the center marker, the horse should be on the right lead. Guide the horse to the center of the arena on the right lead and complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
4. Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads in the center of the arena.
5. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Continue up the left side of the arena staying at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence, circle the top of the arena, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up at least 10 feet (3 meters). Hesitate.
6. Complete four spins to the right.
7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Rider may drop bridle to the designated judge.
