- Auburn is ranked No. 14 in this week's AP poll. The Tigers have been ranked 21 straight weeks, which is the second-longest streak in program history, only trailing the 30-week streak in 1999-2000. Auburn has the eighth-longest active streak in the country.
- Auburn has started 13-3 or better for the second straight season. Prior to last season's 21-2 start, the Tigers only had one start of 13-3 or better in the past 17 years (15-3 in 2002-03).
- Auburn has won the last two games at Auburn Arena. With a win, the Tigers could accomplish a three-game home winning streak vs. Kentucky for the second time in program history (1974-76).
- Auburn and Kentucky are set to meet as top-15 foes for just the fifth time in series history. The two teams have met seven times total as ranked opponents.
- Auburn is the ninth-most efficient offensive team in the country with an average of 116.7 points per 100 possessions, according to KenPom. In addition, the Tigers are also the 36th-most efficient defensive team in the nation. Auburn allows just 94.3 points per 100 possessions. The Tigers tout the 12th-highest adjusted efficiency margin at +22.39.
- After being one of the youngest teams in the NCAA last year with one senior, Auburn boasts 13 upperclassmen and has 4,182 career points returning for the 2018-19 season eighth-highest in the country.
- Auburn is one of just seven programs without a scholarship freshman on its roster, joining Alcorn State, Bethune-Cookman, Louisville, South Alabama, Tulsa and UT Martin.

- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 17 of the 23 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg
- One of just seven active head coaches who has led his teams to at least 10 NCAA Sweet 16 appearances (10 total)
- Bruce Pearl is ranked second in the SEC among current head coaches in career winning percentage (.718), fifth in winning percentage as a SEC head coach (.622), fifth in average wins per year as a SEC head coach (21.0) and fifth in SEC games only win pct. (.540, 81-70)
- Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)
- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the fourth straight time in 2017-18, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came in the 1999-2000 season
- Auburn averaged 8,221 in its 15 home games during the 2017-18 season, which included seven sellouts in the nine SEC games. The 8,221 average is the highest in Auburn Arena history
- \bullet In 23 years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have fiished either first or second in conference play 16 times
- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 18 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- In the past two seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 23-3 (.885), while scheduling perennial NCAA Tournament teams in Dayton, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech and UConn.

- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 18 graduates in four years the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport.
- Auburn recently secured its third perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history.
- In the past four years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940.
- Bruce Pearl has raised \$1 million in only four golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl Fore the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families. Over \$200,000 was raised in the Bruce, Barkley & Basketball Golf Classic Oct. 23-24, 2016, benefitting the Auburn Basketball program.
- Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease.
- The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015.
- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain.

AUBURN VS. KENTUCKY SERIES

- » Auburn trails Kentucky 92-19 all-time, but the Tigers have won two of the last three against the Wildcats. The two teams have played once each of the last three years with the home team winning all three games. Auburn won 75-70 in 2016 and 76-66 last season, while Kentucky earned a 92-72 victory in 2017. Prior to the last three games, Kentucky had won 18 straight and 32 of the last 33 in the series. The two teams will play twice during the regular season for the first time since the 2012-13 season. Prior to that, they had not faced each other twice in the regular season since doing so for 27 consecutive seasons from 1965-91.
- » Kentucky leads 30-15 in games played in Auburn, including a 3-2 advantage at Auburn Arena. Auburn has won two straight home games over Kentucky for the fourth time, and a win would give the Tigers three straight home wins for just the second time in series history, and the first time since 1974-76.
- » Bruce Pearl is 6-12 in his head coaching career against Kentucky. Pearl is 2-3 against the Wildcats at Auburn, including 2-0 at Auburn Arena. At Tennessee, Pearl was 3-3 vs. Kentucky in Knoxville, 1-5 in Lexington and 0-1 at neutral sites.
- » Bruce Pearl is 5-9 against John Calipari. Pearl is 4-2 at home, 1-5 on the road and 0-2 at neutral sites in matchups between the two head coaches.

THE HUNT FOR 100 SEC WINS

- » Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl is just five victories away from picking up his 100th SEC win. Pearl would become the 23rd coach in conference history to amass 100 victories and just the fifth to accomplish the feat while coaching two schools.
- » The other coaches to have 100 SEC wins while leading two programs include C.M. Newton (195, Alabama and Vanderbilt), Tubby Smith (139, Georgia and Kentucky), Don DeVoe (110, Tennessee and Florida) and John Mauer (103, Tennessee and Florida).

» Coach Pearl would be one of just two active coaches to tally 100 conference wins in the league, joining Kentucky head coach John Calipari.

AUBURN VS. RANKED TEAMS

- » This is Auburn's third game of the season against an AP-ranked team. The Tigers have split the two previous matchups, defeating No. 25 Washington 88-66 at Auburn Arena and falling 78-72 to No. 1 Duke in the Maui Invitational semifinals.
- » Auburn is 62-205 (.232) all-time against ranked opponents. The Tigers are 3-7 all-time against teams ranked No. 12 in the AP poll. Auburn's last win over a team ranked in the top 12 of the AP poll was a 69-53 victory over No. 11 LSU on March 7, 2009, in Auburn's Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum. All-time, Auburn has compiled a 40-148 (.213) record against top-15 opponents.
- » This is the first-ever matchup between ranked SEC teams and just the second-ever overall between ranked teams in Auburn Arena history (Washington, Nov. 9).

AUBURN IN TOP-15 MATCHUPS

» Auburn is 1-9 all-time in top-15 matchups, including 0-4 in top-15 matchups against Kentucky. The Tigers' lone win in a top-15 matchup came on Jan. 3, 1959, when #9 Auburn defeated #8 Mississippi State 97-66 in Auburn.

SECOND TOP-15 MATCHUP OF 18-19

- » Auburn is playing in its second top-15 matchup of the season. The eighth-ranked Tigers lost 78-72 to top-ranked Duke in the Maui Invitational semifinals. This season is the fourth time in program history Auburn has played in at least two top-15 matchups in a season.
- » The 1958-59 Tigers defeated No. 8 Mississippi State 97-66 when Auburn was ranked ninth and the No. 2 Tigers lost to No. 3 Kentucky 75-56 in Lexington later that season. In 1998-99, No. 6 Auburn lost 72-62 at No. 7 Kentucky and the No. 4 Tigers lost 69-57 to No. 14 Kentucky in the SEC Tournament.

CONTINUING THE IMPROVEMENT: CONFERENCE WIN TOTALS

Auburn is one of just 13 teams in the country to have improved its win totals in conference play each of the last four seasons. The Tigers are one of only two power-five programs to accomplish the feat, joining USC. Auburn won four Southeastern Conference games in 2015, five in 2016, seven in 2017 and 13 in 2018 to become the SEC champions.

» The next year, the Tigers played in three top-15 matchups in a season for the only time in program history as No. 2 Auburn dropped a 68-57 decision to No. 7 Stanford, seventh-ranked Auburn fell 105-76 at No. 11 Tennessee and No. 13 Auburn lost 55-53 to No. 12 LSU.

STREAKING AT HOME

» Auburn enters the game on a 12-game home winning streak that started with a 76-66 victory over Kentucky on Feb. 14, 2018. Auburn is 24-1 at home since the beginning of the 2017-18 season, including a 13-game winning streak at Auburn Arena starting with a 89-78 victory over Missouri in the last home game of the 2016-17 season and ending with the Tigers' only home loss since the start of last season, an 81-80 loss to Texas A&M on Feb. 7, 2018. Bruce Pearl is the first coach in Auburn history to lead the Tigers on multiple home winning streaks of at least 12 games.

DYNAMIC BACKCOURT

» Auburn has been led so far this season by its dynamic backcourt of Bryce Brown and Jared Harper. The duo is averaging 31.3 points and 6.3 3-point field goals per game. Harper and Brown are the only pair of teammates who rank in the top six in the SEC in 3-point field goal percentage (Harper 40.2 percent, 5th; Brown 37.6 percent, 6th). They have made 101 3s, which is more than 34 DI teams.

- The duo has combined for 10 20-point games this season, including Auburn's win over Xavier in the first round of the Maui Invitational when Brown scored 26 and Harper added 25, season highs for each at the time. The pair has each had a 30-plus-point game this season. Against Dayton, Brown scored a career-high 34 points, including 22 first-half points, on 10-of-18 field goals, 6-of-13 from 3-point range and 8-of-9 from the free-throw line, while Harper added 20 points on 4-of-7 shooting from long range and 6-of-6 from the free-throw line. He also dished out seven assists to just one turnover. In Auburn's win over UAB, Harper scored a career-high 31 points, including 23 of the Tigers' last 30 points over the final 9:23 of regulation and overtime.
- » Brown and Harper have made 25-of-61 (41.0 percent) from 3-point range in SEC play, which matches Auburn's first three conference opponents' 3-point field goals total. Brown's 5.0 3-point FGM in SEC play are more than Kentucky is making as a team (4.8), while Harper is third in the league at 3.3 3-point FGM.
- » Bryce Brown's 34 points vs. Dayton are the most by a Tiger since Toney Douglas scored 38 points against Nicholls State on Nov. 24, 2004, and are tied with Isaiah Joe of Arkansas for the most points scored in the SEC this season. He is sixth in the SEC averaging 15.8 ppg.

DOWNTOWN BRYCE BROWN

- » Bryce Brown became Auburn's all-time career 3-point king in the Tigers' final game of the Maui Invitational against Arizona passing the old mark of 262 3-pointers set by Wesley Person. The record breaker came with 5:00 remaining in the game and gave Auburn a 66-51 lead. Brown has now made 297 career 3-pointers, which is fifth among all active DI players.
- » Against UAB, Brown became the 23rd player in Auburn history to reach 1,200 career points. Against Murray State, Brown passed Auburn assistant coach Wes Flanigan (1,208 points; 1993-97) for 22nd on Auburn's career scoring chart. He passed Darrell Lockhart (1,236 points; 1979-83) and Frank Tolbert (1,242 points; 2004-

08) to move into the top 20 of Auburn's career scoring chart with 23 points at Ole Miss. Brown scored 15 points against Georgia to move past Stan Pietkiewicz (1,265 points; 1974-78) for 19th. His 1,295 career points rank third among active SEC players. The senior has moved up 14 spots on Auburn's career scoring chart this season.

- » Brown has scored in double figures in each of the last five games. He is averaging 17.8 points per game and is shooting 23-of-52 (44.2 percent) from 3-point range over that span. At Texas A&M, Brown scored 22 points, including 20 in the first half and 18 straight points for Auburn at one point. It is the second time Brown, who scored 22 points in the first half against Dayton, has scored 20-plus points in a half this season. Four of his 15 career 20-point games have come this season. He is just five points away from becoming the 19th player in Auburn history to score 1,300 career points.
- » Brown has made at least four 3-pointers in nine of 16 games this season. He is 23-of-52 (44.2 percent) from long range over his last five games. He averaged 20.3 points and hit 13 3s in three games in the Maui Invitational. Brown extended his own Auburn career record with his 20th game with at least five made 3s at Texas A&M. He has had five games with at least five 3s this season. He is averaging 3.5 made 3s per game this season, which is second in the SEC.

OFF THE COURT: ANFERNEE MCLEMORE

Anfernee McLemore is the perfect embodiment of what it means to be a student-athlete at Auburn University. The two-time Academic Top Tiger honoree recently served on the presitigious Southeastern Conference Men's Basketball Leadership Council. He also has logged hours at the "Breakfast Club" where he serves as a role model for young kids in the Auburn community.



» For his career, Brown is 297-of-779 (.381) from 3-point range. With seven 3-pointers at Ole Miss, he passed Vanderbilt's Scott Draud and Lee Humphrey of Florida to move into ninth on the SEC's top 10 for career 3s. He added five at Texas A&M to move past Ronnie MaMahon of Vanderbilt for eighth. His 779 3-pointers attempted are tied with Barry Stewart of Mississippi State for seventh-most in SEC history.

CHEF HARPER WITH THE POP, BOY

» Jared Harper, who was named to the Lute Olson Award Mid-Season Watch List earlier this season, has 16 career 20-point games, with six so far this season, including a career-high 31 points in Auburn's win over UAB and 22 in the Tigers' win over Georgia. Harper scored 20 points on 4-of-7 3s to go along with seven assists, three rebounds and two steals against Dayton. In the season opener against South Alabama, Harper poured in 20 points on 7-of-13 shooting and

6-of-10 3-pointers and added 13 assists, five rebounds and two steals. He added 25 points, eight assists, six rebounds and three steals in Auburn's overtime win over Xavier in the first round of the Maui Invitational. He scored 22 points on 6-of-10 3-pointers and dished out six assists the next day against No.1 Duke.

- » Harper, who is the SEC's only player averaging 15 points and six assists per game, is eighth in the SEC with 15.1 points per game and first in the SEC and 11th nationally with 6.7 assists per game, while playing an SEC-high 33.6 minutes per game. He is also ninth in the league with an 83.9 free-throw percentage and is fifth shooting 40.2 percent from 3-point range.
- » Harper has five career games with double-digit assists, including three this season, and he is third in the SEC with a 3.1 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- » Harper was 15-of-16 from the free-throw line against UAB. The 15 made free throws are the most by a Tiger since KT Harrell made 15 against LSU on March, 13, 2015, in the SEC quarterfinals, and his 16 attempts are the most since Austin Wiley attempted 18 free throws against Alabama on Jan. 21, 2017.
- » Auburn has scored 265 points off of Harper's assists this season. Harper has made or assisted on 182 of Auburn's 484 made field goals this season (37.6 percent). Harper's 387 career assists lead all SEC players and are seventh among all DI juniors.
- » Harper has made 316 free throws in his career, moving past KT Harrell for eighth on Auburn's career free throws made list against UAB.

In his second season with the Tigers, Chuma Okeke leads the team with a plus-minus of plus-243 (plus-15.2 per game). In Auburn's 13 wins this season, Okeke has been a big factor contributing 10.8 points, 6.3 rebounds, 2.2 assists, 1.6 steals and 1.4 blocks per game while shooting 54 percent from the floor, including 36 percent from downtown and 71 percent from the charity stripe.

OLD, SAVVY VETERANS

- » Despite being a young team during Auburn's run to a conference title in 2017-18, the Tigers have turned into one of the most experienced teams in the country.
- » Auburn is one of just seven programs without a scholarship freshman on its roster, joining Alcorn State, Bethune-Cookman, Louisville, South Alabama, Tulsa and UT Martin.

TOP OF THE PACK

» Auburn has fared well in the past two-plus seasons in the non-conference slate. The Tigers lead the SEC in both wins and winning percentage in non-league regular-season games over the last two-plus seasons. Auburn is the only SEC team that has won at least 11 regular-season non-conference games in each of the last three seasons. The streak is the longest in school history. The Tigers' 34 non-conference regular-season wins over that span tie a school record for the most nonconference wins over a 3-year span, which was previously set from 1998-2000.

» The Tigers have earned wins vs. notable opponents in Arizona, Dayton (twice), Middle Tennessee, Murray State (twice), Oklahoma, TCU, Texas Tech, UConn (twice), Washington and Xavier (twice).

BLOWOUT WINS

- » Auburn is 11th in the country with a +18.0 scoring margin. It is the Tigers' best mark through 16 games since the 1998-99 Tigers had a +25.9 scoring margin through the first 16 games. The current margin is on pace to be the second-best scoring margin for a season in program history, behind only the +19.6 scoring margin of 1998-99. Ten of Auburn's 13 victories are by double digits, and six are by at least 20 points. The Tigers' 13 wins are by an average of 24.3 points. Auburn has 29 double-digit wins since the start of last season, which is two more double-double wins than the Tigers' had in the previous five seasons combined and is more than the overall win total of four SEC teams.
- » Auburn's 19-point win at Texas A&M in its last game was the Tigers' largest margin of victory in an SEC game since defeating Alabama last season and its largest SEC road win since beating LSU 98-75 in Baton Rouge on Feb. 21, 2017.
- » Twelve of Auburn's 15 SEC wins since the start of last season have been by double digits, including both this season. The Tigers had 11 double-digit SEC wins in the previous seven years combined.

TIGERS IN OVERTIME

- » Auburn is 2-0 this season in overtime games. The Tigers defeated Xavier 88-79 on Nov. 19 in the first round of the Maui Invitational and defeated UAB 75-71 in Birmingham's Mike Slive Invitational in their last game. Prior to this season, Auburn's last overtime game was against Missouri in the 2017 SEC Tournament and its last OT win was at UConn on Dec. 23, 2016. Jared Harper has scored 15 of the Tigers' 23 points in overtime this season. Harper scored five of Auburn's 11 points in the extra period against Xavier and then notched 10 of the Tigers' 12 points in the extra session against UAB.
- » Auburn is 5-2 in overtime under head coach Bruce Pearl, picking up wins against Xavier and LSU (2014-15), UConn (2016-17) and Xavier and UAB (2018-19).

RPI IMPROVEMENT

GLASS EATERS

- » Auburn is averaging 15.8 offensive rebounds per game, which is second nationally, leading to an average of 15.4 second-chance points per game (247 in 16 games). Four times this season Auburn has outrebounded an opponent by 15, including 50-33 against Texas A&M in its last game, and has won the rebounding battle in 11 of 16 games. The Tigers are 10-1 in those games. Auburn has pulled down at least 15 offensive rebounds in 10 of 15 games this season.
- » Chuma Okeke (2.8; t-3rd in SEC), Horace Spencer (2.8; t-3rd in SEC), Austin Wiley (2.3), Anfernee McLemore (1.8) and Samir Doughty (1.5) lead Auburn in offensive rebounding. Auburn is the only team to have two players ranked in the top 10 in the SEC in offensive rebounding.

KEEP IT 100

» Auburn scored 103 points vs. Mississippi College, the most points for the Tigers since a 119-85 victory over Winthrop last season. It is the second time the Tigers have reached the century mark this season after defeating South Alabama 101-58 in the season opener, and the seventh time in 148 games under head coach Bruce Pearl. Prior to Pearl's arrival, Auburn hadn't scored 100 points in the previous 337 games since a 105-66 victory over Grambling State on Nov. 29, 2003.

BALANCED SCORING

» Auburn is second in the SEC averaging 84.5 points per game because of a balanced attack that has six Tigers averaging at least 8.4 points per game including Bryce Brown (16.2), Jared Harper (15.1), Austin Wiley (10.8), Chuma Okeke (9.9), Samir Doughty (8.6) and Malik Dunbar (8.4). Six times this season Auburn has had at least five players score in double figures. Nine different Tigers have scored in double figures at least once this season. Auburn has topped the 80-point plateau in 10 of 16 games, plus AU has surpassed the 90-point mark six times and has scored 100-plus twice. The Tigers are 10-0 when scoring at least 80 points.

TURNING OVER THE OPPONENT

Auburn is third nationally, and first among power conference teams, forcing 19.9 turnovers per game. The Tigers have forced at least 20 turnovers seven times this season, including five times in the last 10 games. Auburn is forcing an average of 22.0 turnovers per game at home (198 in 9 home games). Auburn is averaging 13.3 turnovers and is second in the country with a plus-6.6 turnover margin. The Tigers are outscoring their opponents 26.3-11.1 on points off turnovers (420-177). Auburn has scored at least 20 points off turnovers in all but four games this season. The Tigers have scored 30 points off turnovers seven times and topped the 40-point plateau for the first time in their last nonconference game with 41 points off 33 North Florida turnovers, while setting a school record for turnovers forced.

BIG MAN ON CAMPUS

» Austin Wiley has eight games scoring in double figures and also has nine games with at least seven rebounds this season, including a career-high 12 rebounds at Texas A&M in the Tigers' last game. Wiley has blocked at least three shots in five of his 15 games this season including five blocks against UNC Asheville and Dayton. Against Murray State, he recorded his second career double-double, and first of the season, with 17 points and 10 rebounds in his first start of the season. For the year, he's averaging 10.8 points, 6.1 rebounds, 1.9 blocks (9th in the SEC) and is shooting 58.1 percent from the floor (61-of-105), which would be second in the SEC if he met the minimum requirements for attempts.

RETURN TO SENDER

- » Auburn is fourth nationally averaging 6.1 blocked shots per game. This is on the heels of the Tigers setting a new program record with 180 blocks last season. The Tigers have had three of its program's top-10 single-season block totals during Bruce Pearl's first four seasons on the Plains. [1. 180, 2017-18; 3. 162, 2016-17; 10. 126, 2015-16]. Auburn and Tennessee are the only DI teams with two players with at least 130 career blocks as they currently have two of the program's top seven all-time shot blockers on their roster.
- » Senior Horace Spencer has blocked 143 shots, which is fifth all-time at Auburn and two shy of Charles Barkley (1981-84) for fourth. Spencer is 25th among all active DI players in career blocks. Junior Anfernee McLemore has blocked two shots in each of his last four games to give him 138 career blocked shots. He is tied for sixth among all active D1 juniors.

BIG MAC

» Anfernee McLemore posted his second straight game in double figures with 13 points, including 3-of-4 shooting from 3-point range in Auburn's win at Texas A&M. McLemore also grabbed six rebounds. McLemore has scored in double figures in three of the last four games after doing so just twice in the first 12 games. He is averaging 7.0 rebounds while shooting 15-of-28 (53.6 percent) in those four games.

TIGERS FROM BEHIND THE ARC

Auburn leads the SEC and is fifth nationally with 10.9 made 3s per game and also leads the league with 13.0 3-pointers (39-of-98, 39.8 percent) in SEC play. The Tigers have made double-digit 3-pointers in 10 of 16 games this season. Auburn's 175 3-point field goals put the Tigers 20 ahead of the 2015-16 Tigers' previous record of 155 3s through 16 games. The Tigers are 22 ahead of last year's squad, who made 153 3-pointers in the first 16 games on its way to a program single-season record of 324 made 3-pointers. Auburn has made double-digit 3s in 55 of 148 games (37.2 percent) under head coach Bruce Pearl. Prior to Pearl's arrival, the Tigers had just 124 games with at least 10 3s in 855 games since the creation of the 3-point shot in college basketball for the 1986-87 season (14.5 percent).

HALF A HUNDRED

» Auburn scored 50 points in the second half of its last non-conference game against North Florida. In its previous game against Murray State, the Tigers tied a season high by scoring 55 points in the second half. Auburn has recorded a 50-point half six times this season.

STRONG BENCH PRODUCTION

- » The Tigers have scored at least 20 bench points 10 times, 30 bench points six times and 40 bench points three times this season. Malik Dunbar leads Auburn with eight games in double figures off the bench after having just three double-digit scoring games all of last season. Dunbar scored 11 points in each of the Tigers' first two SEC games, which surpasses his one SEC game in double figures from a season ago.
- » Nineteen times Auburn has had a player score double figures coming off the bench. Horace Spencer recorded his first career double-double with 14 points and 17 rebounds against Mississippi College coming off the bench. J'Von McCormick scored a career-high 14 points on 6-of-7 shooting to go with three assists, three steals and two rebounds at N.C. State. On average, Auburn outscores its opponents' bench, 27.4-16.8 (438-268).

STEALING THE SHOW

- » Auburn is averaging 10.0 steals per game, which leads the SEC and is tied for fifth nationally. The Tigers have recorded at least 10 steals in a game nine times this season, including 20 in their last nonconference game against North Florida, which is one off the school record of 21 steals against Louisiana-Monroe on Dec. 6, 2008. Auburn has seven double-digit steals games in the last 10 games, including three straight from 12/19-12/29. The Tigers are fourth nationally averaging 6.1 blocked shots per game. Auburn and Duke are the only two teams in the country that are in the top 5 in blocked shots and steals per game.
- » Chuma Okeke leads Auburn and is fourth in the SEC with 1.8 steals per game including five steals in the Tigers' last two nonconference games. Samir Doughty is tied for eighth in the SEC with 1.5 steals per game.

WELCOME TO AUBURN ARENA

- » The Tigers have won 10 straight games when playing in front of a sold-out crowd at Auburn Arena, and have posted a 15-9 record when there is a capacity crowd at Auburn Arena. Eight of the 10 SEC games since the beginning of last season have been sold out, including Auburn's SEC home opener against Georgia this season. The Tigers are 93-51 (.646) at Auburn Arena and have compiled a 24-1 home record since the beginning of the 2017-18 season.
- » Auburn is 21-0 against nonconference opponents at Auburn Arena since the start of the 2016-17 season, including 8-0 this season. The Tigers' eight home nonconference wins this season have been by an average of 31.6 points. Auburn has topped the 100-point plateau five times during the stretch including twice in eight home nonconference games this season. Sixteen of the Tigers' 21 wins during the streak have been by at least 16 points.
- » During Bruce Pearl's tenure at Auburn, the Tigers have posted a 32-3 (.914) home record against nonconference opponents.

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

Auburn has ramped up its efforts on the defensive end during the 2018-19 season. Below is a list of the opponents' points per game entering the matchup and what Auburn allowed.

The Tigers have limited 12 of its 16 opponents thus far below their scoring average. If only charting points allowed per game without overtime, Auburn has held 13 of 16 opponents below their scoring average.

Auburn has held six opponents to under 60 points this season, including three under 50, after allowing under 60 points just twice all of last season (34 games), and the Tigers are tied for second in the SEC allowing 66.5 points per game, an improvement of 6.7 points per game from last season. Auburn held UNC Asheville to 41 points, which is the fewest by a Tiger opponent since Auburn held Alabama to 37 points on Feb. 6, 2013.




