MATADORS BEGIN PLAY AT ROMAN LEGENDS CLASSIC

CSUN Men's Basketball kicks off play at the Roman Legends Classic presented by Old Trapper with a pair of campus site games at No. 22 Auburn on Friday at 4 p.m. and Richmond on Sunday at 1 p.m. (PST). Friday's game will air live on the SEC Network while ESPN+ will have coverage of Sunday's contest. Ghizal Hasan and Alan Zinsmeister are on the call in an audio broadcast on the CSUN Sports Network presented by Dignity Health for both games.

The Matadors dropped their home opener to Pepperdine 94-82 on Tuesday at The Matadome. The Waves stretched a 10-point halftime lead to 25 points with seven minutes to go in the second half. Terrell Gomez helped spark a furious rally down the stretch that saw the Matadors trim the Pepperdine lead to 12 points with a minute to play but the Waves held on in the final moments. Gomez finished with a career-high 33 points on 10-of-20 shooting including going 7-of-11 from 3-point range.

After his career night on the floor, Gomez is averaging a team-best 22.0 points through three games this season. Gomez is shooting a red-hot 56.0 percent from 3-point range (14-of-25). His scoring outburst also moved him further up the Matadors' career scoring leaderboard. After passing Mark Cooley (1964-67) and Todd Bowser (1986-91) Gomez is now up to 17th place on the career list with 1,069 points. Up next, Gomez could surpass Pat Bolden (1984-88) for 16th place with 13 points more points.

WE ARE CSUN

We are now "CSUN" (See-Sun) and request that CSUN be used to refer to the school and its Division I athletic programs. Please do not refer to the school as "Cal State Northridge," 'CS Northridge," "CSU Northridge," "CS North" or "Northridge." Both the men's and women's programs are the "Matadors" and there is no need to add "Lady" before any women's athletic program

In his first season with the Matadors, junior Lance Coleman II is second on the team in scoring at 11.7 points per game to go with 3.3 rebounds. Sophomore Darius Brown II is also averaging in double figures with 11.3 points per game while he is sporting a team-high 5.0 assists per game. Another sophomore, Elijah Harkless is filling up the stat sheet this season, averaging 8.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and 4.0 assists.

The Matadors will play Auburn for the first time in program history on Friday night. CSUN seeks its first-ever win over an SEC team as it comes in with an 0-5 record against the conference. The Matadors' last game versus an SEC team took place in Nov. 2015 against Texas A&M (95-73 loss). CSUN has not defeated a nationallu-ranked team since beating No. 23 Utah State, 63-62, in March 2004.

CSUN also takes on Richmond for the first time in men's basketball this Sunday. The Matadors are 0-2 all-time against Atlantic 10 teams with their last game taking place in Nov. 2016 against George Mason (78-73 overtime loss).

Following CSUN's first two games in the Roman Legends Classic this week, the Matadors will complete the tournament next week at the Green Bay Legends Sub Regional. The Green Bay Phoenix will host the three-team regional, which will also include Colgate. The Matadors take on Colgate on Sunday, Nov. 25 before facing host Green Bay on Monday, Nov. 26.

MATADORS' 2018-19 IN REVIEW

- CSUN posted its most overall wins last season since 2013-14
- The Matadors led the Big West in points per game (76.5), field goal percentage (46.0), steals per game (6.6) and block per game (4.5). CSUN finished second in 3-point percentage (36.1) and assists per game (15.1).
- Swept Cal Poly and UC Riverside during the league season while posting first win over UC Davis since 2014
- CSUN won the Continental Tire Las Vegas Classic Upper Division, beating SIUE and Rider during Christmas weekend. Lamine Diane earned MVP and All-Tournament honors.
- With a win over Pepperdine, the Matadors notched their first win over a West Coast Conference team since Nov. 2012 (San Diego) and their first road non-conference win since Dec. 2015 (Portland State).
- 26 of the Matadors' 34 games were decided by 10 points or fewer including 11 conference games

AN ALL-BIG WEST FIRST TEAMER

Junior Terrell Gomez has averaged a team-high 22.0 points per game through three games this season

- Recorded a career-high 33 points to go with seven 3-pointers vs. Pepperdine (11/12/19)
- Named 2019-20 Preseason All-Big West Team
- Earned All-Big West First Team honors after leading the league in 3-point field goals (117) in 2018-19
- Finished second in the Big West in points per game (19.2), third in free throw percentage (87.7), fifth in 3-point percentage (41.9) and 10th in assists per game (2.8)
- His 3-point total and minutes per game average both ranked eighth-best in the nation.
- Scored the second-most points (652) in a season in team history in 2018-19
- Became the third-fastest Matador in team history to reach 1,000 career points in just two seasons
- Took home Big West Freshman of the Year accolades in 2017-18

BROWN II LOOKING FOR AN ENCORE

Sophomore **Darius Brown II** has averaged 11.3 points per game and 5.0 assists this season

- Tallied 13 points, eight rebounds and four assists at Oregon State (11/5/19)
- Led the Big West with 176 total assists while he finished second in assists per game (5.2)
- Tied for first place in the conference in assist-turnover ratio (3.0) and tied for sixth in steals per game (1.4)
- His assist total was most ever by a CSUN freshman in team history; Finished fourth overall
- Reached double figures 11 times (averaged 8.3 points) and dished out double-digit assists twice

DIANE AMONG THE NATION'S BEST

Sophomore Lamine Diane was named an AP All-American and Big West Player of the Year last season

- Became first Big West player to win Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year and Newcomer of the Year awards all in the same season
- Also took home USBWA and NABC All-District IX honors
- Led the nation in field goals made (340) and finished sixth in points per game (24.8) and rebounds per game (11.3)
- Only player in the country to average above 24 points, 10 rebounds and two blocks (2.2)
- Led all freshmen in the country in rebounds per game and ranked second in points per game
- Broke school record for points (818), rebounds (368), field goals made, blocks (72) and double-doubles (20)
- Tied a CSUN Division I record with 39 points on 17-of-33 shooting at Cal State Fullerton (1/31/19)
- Scored 34 points vs. New Mexico (11/6/18) to set a team record for most points in a CSUN debut

MEET THE MATADORS

- Junior transfer Lance Coleman II is averaging 11.7 points and 3.3 rebounds in three starts this season.
 Coleman II scored a season-high 19 points on 8-of-16 shooting at New Mexico. He transferred from Fullerton College where he won a state championship.
- Freshman **Festus Ndumanya** has averaged 3.3 points and 3.0 rebounds while he has made two starts. He averaged a double-double in two seasons at Capistrano Valley Christian School.
- Junior transfer Dmytro Skapintsev competed in European SuperLeague with his hometown Cherkaski Mavpy in the Ukraine. He also played in European Cup in 2018-19, averaging 10 points and five rebounds.
- Junior transfer **Miles Brookins** spent two seasons at La Salle. He posted career-best averages of 5.0 points and 2.6 rebounds in 28 games last season. He also shot 51.0 percent from the field.

BACK FOR MORE

- Sophomore guard **Elijah Harkless** is averaging 8.0 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. He played in 18 games last season and averaged 3.9 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.1 assists.
- Sophomore center **Michael Ou** is posting 2.7 points and 1.7 rebounds in three games. He started 13 games last year and finished averaging 4.2 points and 2.4 rebounds.
- Redshirt sophomore forward **Jared Pearre** has posted 4.0 points and 2.7 rebounds this season. A season ago, he started 13 games while averaging 2.9 points and 2.7 rebounds.
- Sophomore forward Ron Artest III joined the Matadors at the beginning of Big West play last season and finished the year averaging 2.4 points and 2.1 rebounds over 12.4 minutes per game.

EXPERIENCED COACHING STAFF LEADING THE MATADORS

- Mark Gottfried has 11 NCAA Tournament appearances in his 21-year head coaching career. He spent six seasons at NC State, helping the Wolfpack advance to the Sweet Sixteens twice. Gottfried also guided Alabama to five NCAA Tournament trips including one Elite Eight. He won a National title as an assistant at UCLA in 1995.
- Assistant coach Jim Harrick led four schools to the NCAA Tournament including UCLA, Pepperdine, Rhode Island and Georgia. A former National Coach of the Year, Harrick guided UCLA to a NCAA Championship in 1995.
- Assistant coach Jeff Dunlap served as a head coach of the St. John's Edge of the National Basketball League of Canada. He worked as an assistant to Gottfried and Harrick in his extensive 31-year career.
- Assistant coach Mo Williams won an NBA Championship with the Cleveland Cavaliers in 2016, capping a 13-year career. A National Freshman of the Year, Williams played for Gottfried for two seasons at Alabama.

A CLOSER LOOK AT AUBURN

The Tigers are 3-0 this season after picking up a 70-69 win at South Alabama on Tuesday. The victory over South Alabama concluded play at the Veterans Classic, which also included a 76-66 Auburn win over Davidson. Auburn was picked to finish fourth in the SEC in the preseason media poll. Fifth-year head

coach Bruce Pearl led the Tigers to their first-ever Final Four appearance last season.

A CLOSER LOOK AT RICHMOND

The Spiders (1-0) overcame a 10-point deficit with less than two minutes to play to defeat Saint Francis (PA.) 100-98 last Friday in their season opener. A season after finishing 13-20, Richmond was picked to finish sixth in this year's Preseason Atlantic 10 poll. In his 15th season at the helm, head coach

Junior Nick Sherod scored 27 points while junior Jacob Gilyard added 24 points in the win over Saint Francis. The team's top two scorers from a year ago, junior Grant Golden and Gilyard both earned spots on the Preseason Atlantic 10 team. Golden posted 17.2 points and 7.1 rebounds while Gilyard averaged 16.2 points and 5.2 assists for the Spiders. Sherod also averaged in double figures, posting 12.7 points per game.

COACH MARK GOTTFRIED

Second Season • Alabama, 1987 • 415-264 Overall Division I Record

An 11-time NCAA Tournament coach, Mark Gottfried enters his second season leading the Matador men's basketball program in 2019-20. Gottfried is the sixth head coach in the history of the program.

Gottfried ushered in a new era of

Matador basketball this past season. He orchestrated a seven-game turnaround and guided CSUN to its most overall wins (13) and conference wins (7) in five seasons. The Matadors also played in a national postseason tournament for the first time since 2009 with an appearance in the College Basketball Invitational.

In 2018-19, CSUN's high-powered offense led the Big West in a host of categories including points per game (76.5), field goal percentage (46.0) and field goals made per game (28.5) while it finished second in 3-point percentage (36.1) and assists per game (15.1). The Matadors also paced the league in two defensive categories: steals per game (6.6) and blocks per game (4.5). During the year, the Matadors made team history by registering new records in field goals made (968) and blocks (154).

Under Gottfried, freshman Lamine Diane earned All-American honors and was named Big West Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year and Newcomer of the Year. Sophomore Terrell Gomez and Diane also earned All-Big West First Team accolades in Gottfried's first season.

Coaching in the Power Five Atlantic Coast and Southeastern conferences, Gottfried has a rich basketball background and track record of success in 21 seasons as a head coach, which includes stints at the University of Alabama, North Carolina State University and Murray State University. Prior to CSUN, Gottfried served as an assistant coach and scout with the Dallas Mavericks.

Gottfried has strong ties to the West Coast as an assistant coach under Jim Harrick at UCLA when the Bruins won the 1995 national championship.

Gottfried spent six seasons with NC State from 2011-17 where he led the Wolfpack to four NCAA Tournament appearances. He coached NC State to the Sweet Sixteen in his first season and backto-back 24-win seasons in 2011-12 and 2012-13. In his second season at the helm, Gottfried guided NC State to a victory over top-ranked Duke, 84-76. He would lead the team to another Sweet Sixteen trip in 2014-15 after eliminating No. 1 seed Villanova.

Prior to NC State, he coached his alma-mater Alabama for 11 seasons as the Crimson Tide won two SEC championships and advanced to five NCAA Tournaments over that time. After coaching Alabama to an NIT runner-up finish in 2000-01, Gottfried led the team to a 27-win season and a conference championship. For his efforts, Gottfried was named 2002 SEC Coach of the Year. The next season, Alabama earned a No. 1 ranking in the AP poll for the first time in school history. In the 2003-04 campaign, Alabama upset top-ranked and top-seeded Stanford in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, and then defeated national champion Syracuse to reach the school's first-ever Elite Eight.

He began his head coaching career at Murray State where he became the first coach to win three Ohio Valley Conference titles in his first three years. The Racers advanced to the NIT in his first season and the NCAA Tournament in back-to-back years in 1997 and 1998. Murray State ranked 25th in the final AP poll with a record of 29-4 in 1997-98.

Gottfried's time on the sidelines began at UCLA as an assistant.

After making six-straight trips to the Big Dance, the Bruins won their first National Championship in 20 seasons in Gottfried's final year in Westwood. He also helped coach UCLA to the Elite Eight in 1992 and the Sweet Sixteen in 1990.

Gottfried began his collegiate playing career at Oral Roberts in 1983. In his only season with the Golden Eagles, Gottfried earned freshman All-American honors. He transferred to Alabama, where he started 98 consecutive games and helped the Crimson Tide advance to the Sweet Sixteen three-straight seasons. Gottfried left Alabama as the school record holder for the most 3-point field goals in a single game (8) and the all-time leader in 3-point field goal percentage (.485). After his collegiate career, Gottfried was selected in the seventh round by the Detroit Pistons in the 1987 NBA Draft.

He earned a degree in communications from Alabama in 1987. Gottfried received the Hayden Riley Top Scholar Award and the Bryant Award as the school's top scholar-athlete in his senior campaign.


