THREE POINTERS

- Colgate and Auburn meet for the first time Monday night in the 2019 Roman Legends Classic presented by Old Trapper. This is the third straight Power Five matchup on the road for the Raiders.
- Rapolas Ivanauskas is averaging 14.3 points per game to lead four Raiders in double figures. Will Rayman is averaging 12.7 points and 8.3 rebounds and is shooting over 54 percent (13-of-24) from the field.
- Colgate's most recent SEC opponent was then-ranked No. 6 and second-seeded Tennessee in the first round of last year's NCAA Tournament. Jordan Burns sank eight treys and scored 32 points, the most Tennessee had allowed to a single player all season, but the Raiders fell to the Volunteers in a narrow 77-70 decision.

A COLGATE WIN WOULD...

- » Be its first win over an SEC opponent since Dec. 1, 1995, when the Raiders defeated Ole Miss, 53-51.
- » Give the Raiders their first road win of the season.
- » Be the program's first win over a ranked opponent.

MATCHUP PREVIEW

- » Colgate returns to the hardwood Monday to take on No. 22 Auburn in its third consecutive trip to a Power Five opponent. This will be the first head-to-head matchup between the two teams.
- » The Raiders have four players averaging double figures. Rapolas Ivanauskas leads the way at 14.3 points per game, while Will Rayman is averaging 12.7 points and is hauling in 8.3 boards per game.
- » Jordan Burns has hit double digits in each of the first three games of the season. Burns led the Raiders with 12 points at Syracuse last Wednesday.
- » Auburn comes in 4-0 after dispatching Cal State Northridge 116-70 on Friday night.
- » Senior Samir Doughty comes in averaging 18.5 points per game after dropping 33 on Friday night. Three Tigers are averaging double figures this season.

PICKING UP WHERE WE LEFT OFF

- » Colgate is coming off a tough 70-54 loss to Syracuse on Wednesday night at the Carrier Dome.
- » The Raiders jumped out to an early 9-1 lead behind 3-pointers from Tucker Richardson, Will Rayman, and Jack Ferguson inside the first six minutes.
- » The two teams were tied 24-24 after back-to-back triples from Nelly Cummings and Jordan Burns, but Syracuse shot back with a 7-1 run to lead 31-25 at the end of the first half.
- » Syracuse took control in the second half, extending its lead to as many as 24 down the stretch. Jordan Burns got hot late, connecting on three of his four 3-pointers down the stretch to cut the deficit, but the Orange held on to preserve the 70-54 victory.
- » Colgate knocked down a season-high 13 3-pointers on 41 attempts in the defeat. Six different players connected from beyond the arc for the Raiders.
- » Rapolas Ivanauskas dished out a career-high six assists and finished with nine rebounds for Colgate.
- » Jordan Burns with 12 points reached double figures for the third straight game to start the season.

DEFENDING CHAMPS

- » Colgate claimed its first Patriot League regular season and tournament titles since 1996 last season, setting program records in total wins (24) and league victories (13) while going 15-1 at home.
- » The Raiders started the season 5-5 in Patriot League play before rattling off eight straight wins in the regular season to earn a share of the regular-season title with Bucknell.
- » Colgate won the tiebreaker and No. 1 seed in the Patriot League Tournament, extending its winning streak to 11 with playoff wins over Boston U., Navy, and Bucknell. The Raiders put it all together in the championship game with a 94-80 thrashing of the two-time defending champion Bison.

DANCED OUR SHOES OFF

- » Colgate earned the No. 15 seed in last year's NCAA Tournament and nearly stole the hearts in Columbus, Ohio, with a Cinderella effort.
- » The Raiders went toe-to-toe with No. 6 Tennessee in the first round, eventually falling by a final score of 77-70. Colgate roared back from a 16-point deficit and claimed a 52-50 lead in the second half.
- » Tennessee regained a slight advantage but the Raiders were within striking distance, 67-64, until Admiral Schofield hit back-to-back 3-pointers in the final two minutes to seal the win for the Vols.

BURNS, BABY, BURNS

- » Jordan Burns set a Patriot League Championship record with 35 points in last year's title win over Bucknell at Cotterell Court. He stole the show on 10-of-16 from the field and 6-of-9 from distance.
- » He followed that up with a game-high 32 points against Tennessee in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. Burns set personal bests in both field goals made (12-of-20) and 3-pointers (8-of-13).
- » His 32 points were the second-most in any NCAA Tournament game last season, and it landed him a clip on CBS' infamous One Shining Moment.

EYES ON IVANAUSKAS

- » Coming off an AP All-American Honorable Mention season, Rapolas Ivanauskas was named to the Lou Henson Award Watch List to start 2019-20.
- » Ivanauskas was Colgate's first Patriot League Player of the Year since Adonal Foyle in 1997 and averaged 15.9 points and 7.8 rebounds per game. His points total (558) and rebound average were the highest marks for a Raider since Foyle in 1997.
- » He opened the season with 24 points against NJIT -- his 12th career game of 20 or more points.

EVERYBODY LOVES RAYMAN

- » Will Rayman is closing in on a pair of all-time records during his senior season. He recently passed Jack Nichols '57 for eighth in career points and became just the fifth Raider ever to connect on 200 3-pointers in their career. He was the first Colgate player in history to go 7-of-7 from beyond the arc in a victory over Loyola last season on Feb. 9.
- » Rayman for his career in averaging 41.9 percent (203-of-485) from 3-point range, which would rank him No. 1 in program history. Nate O'Neil '94 holds the record with a 41.4 clip (116-of-280).
- » He's connecting on 66.7 percent (6-of-9) of his attempts from distance to start this season.

WHO'S RETURNING?

- » Colgate returns its top five leading scorers from a season ago, and the Raiders add junior Bowling Green transfer Nelly Cummings who sat out last season due to NCAA transfer regulations.
- » Those returning scoring leaders include Jordan Burns, Will Rayman, Tucker Richardson, Rapolas Ivanauskas, and Jack Ferguson. The first four were starters and earned All-League honors last season.
- » Zach Light is back for his sophomore campaign after seeing action in 15 games as a freshman last season. Light shot 50 percent from the field (6-for-12) in limited time, averaging 1.1 points per game.
- » Other returners include David Maynard and Milan Williams, who were both sidelined all of last season with Achilles tears. Both of their injuries occurred in the spring of 2018.

TRIP OF A LIFETIME

- » Colgate experienced the trip of a lifetime with 10 days in Italy Aug. 8-17. The Raiders during their tour spent days in Rome, Florence, Pisa, Cinque Terre, and Siena as part of their first tour since Spain 2015.
- » Players, coaches, staff, and family members experienced panoramic guides, landmark tours, and a unique culture through various daily activities. The Raiders capped the trip off with a perfect 3-0 record on the court with dominant victories against local semi-professional programs.
- » Head Coach Matt Langel's key takeaways from the trip were the importance of foreign trips to the team's chemistry and the overall depth of the roster.

SCHEDULE AT A GLANCE

- » Colgate has another difficult non-conference schedule, featuring three Power Five opponents and three teams coming off NCAA Tournament Appearances. The Raiders right out of the gates open a three-game road swing at Clemson, Syracuse, and Final Four participant Auburn Nov. 10-18.
- » Later in December, Colgate visits two-time defending AAC Champion Cincinnati, who was with the Raiders in the Columbus region of last season's NCAA Tournament.
- » The Raiders for the first time are competing in the Legends Classic presented by Old Trapper, and will play two games in Green Bay, Wis., against Cal State Northridge and the host Phoenix (Nov. 24-26).

FOUR GAMES TO AIR NATIONALLY ON CBS SPORTS NETWORK

- » Colgate's four nationally-televised games matches Army for the most in the league. The two teams meet for the first CBS Sports Network game of the conference season on Monday, Jan. 6, in West Point.
- » CBSSN is coming to Hamilton when the Raiders host Bucknell on Monday, Jan. 20, in what will be the first matchup since Colgate knocked off the Bison 94-80 in the Patriot League Championship March 13.
- » Colgate road games at Holy Cross (Feb. 1) and Boston University (Feb. 10) will both be aired on CBSSN. The Patriot League announced a flex game on the final day of the regular season on Saturday, Feb. 29. The league semifinals and championship will both be aired on CBSSN for the ninth consecutive season.

PRESEASON RANKINGS

- » Colgate was the unanimous favorite in the Patriot League Preseason Poll. The Raiders were picked to repeat with all the possible first place votes. Bucknell was picked second, while American rounded out the top three in the poll conducted by the league's head coaches and sports information directors.
- » Jordan Burns was the only junior on the Preseason All-League Team and he was joined by teammate Rapolas Ivanauskas. The duo helped lead the Raiders to their first championship in 23 years last season.

Building a Winning Culture

Matt Langel continues to establish a winning tradition for a Colgate Basketball program that is competing for Patriot League championships.

Since arriving in Hamilton in 2011, Langel has mentored a Patriot League Player of the Year, Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, two Patriot League Rookies of the Year, 13 All-Patriot League picks, four Patriot League All-Rookie members, four All-District honorees, and an AP All-American honorable mention.

The Raiders are 54-36 against Patriot League competition over the last five seasons. Colgate has finished in the top half of the Patriot League in each of the last five seasons, including a first-place finish in 2018-19 and two second-place finishes.

Professional Development

Langel has aided in the development of 13 professional basketball players, including recent student-athletes Alex Ramon '16, Austin Tillotson '16, Tom Rivard '18, Dylan Whitbread '18, Jordan Swopshire '18, Sean O'Brien '18, Jordan Robertson '18, and Francisco Amiel '19.

Colgate has rewarded Langel with back-to-back contract extensions after repeating as the Patriot League Coach of the Year and adding NABC District 13 and ECAC Coach of the Year honors in 2018-19.

Magical 2018-19 Season

The new deal comes after Colgate set program records in 2019 in wins (24), league wins (13), and home wins (15) on its way to its first Patriot League title since 1996. Langel, who is entering his ninth season at the helm, is now under contract through the 2026-27 season.

Colgate's magical 2018-19 season finished 24-11 overall and 13-5 in the Patriot League. Langel led Colgate back to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in 23 years with eight straight wins to claim the Patriot League regular-season title and No. 1 seed in the conference tournament.

Colgate went on to sweep the Patriot League Tournament, rallying the Hamilton community with triumphs over Boston University and Navy before dethroning two-time defending champion Bucknell 94-80 in front of a capacity Cotterell Court crowd in the championship game. The Raiders earned their highest seed ever in the Big Dance and took Tennessee to the wire in a 77-70 first round decision.

Championship Background

Langel was named the 20th head coach in the 114-year history of Colgate basketball on April 25, 2011. Langel came to Colgate after spending five seasons as an assistant coach at Temple University (2006-11).

Langel worked under the tutelage of Fran Dunphy, who is one of the all-time winningest coaches in Philadelphia Big 5 history and has twice been named Eastern College Coach of the Year.

Langel was also a two-year member of Dunphy's Penn staff and helped guide his alma mater to consecutive Ivy League championships.

College Playing Career

A 2000 graduate of Penn's Wharton School of Business, Langel helped lead the Quakers to two Ivy League titles and NCAA Tournament appearances during his four-year playing career (1996-2000). The Quakers went 27-1 in Ivy League action in his junior and senior campaigns and sported a 42-14 overall record. Langel was named Ivy League and Big Five Player of the Week numerous times and received the Big Five's Most Improved Player Award.

Langel etched his name in the Penn record books in several different categories. He is a member of the 1,000-point club with 1,191 points in a Red and Blue uniform. He stands second all-time in Penn basketball history in three-pointers made in a game with eight, is eighth in three-pointers made in a season with 70, and fourth in career three-pointers made with 201.

Professional Playing Career

Langel after graduation was drafted by Atlantic City of the USBL in 2000 and worked out in the Seattle SuperSonics camp. He then went overseas to play professionally in Europe, for Chene BC in Switzerland and ALM Evreux Basket in France.

The Moorestown, N.J., native participated in the Philadelphia 76ers summer camp in 2001, but returned to Europe to play for the MBC and Hagan in German Bundesliga I. His last professional stop before returning to Penn as an assistant coach was with the Eiffel Towers in Holland.
