
- UAB has recorded back-to-back 25+ win seasons. The Blazers were picked to finish fourth in Conference USA, the Green and Gold finished second
- a season ago. UAB returns four starters and seven lettermen while adding four newcomers this season.
- Rachael Childress and Miyah Barnes were tabbed to the Preseason All-C-USA team. Both players were All-Conference selections a season ago.
- Childress is the NCAA's active career leader in threepoint field goals made and Barnes was named to the Nancy Lieberman Watch List for the top point guard in the country.
- Head coach Randy Norton ranks third all-time in wins at UAB with 117 over six seasons.
- UAB advanced to the postseason for the 10th time in program history last year advancing to the second round of the WNIT for the second consecutive season.

Credentials can be picked up prior to game day in the media relations office and will be available for day-of-game pickup at the will call window of the main entrance to Bartow Arena.

Weekly Interviews

Head coach Randy Norton and UAB players will be made available for interviews in person or by telephone on a regular basis during the season. All interviews with UAB student-athletes must be coordinated through the media relations office and requested at least 24 hours in advance. Please direct all interview requests to UAB women's basketball contact Katie Moseley at (615) 720-0970 or kmose@uab.edu.

Bartow Arena Media Room

The Bartow Arena Media Room opens two hours prior to game time. For stand alone women's games, meals will be served 60 minutes before game time to tip-off. Media credentials are required to enter the media room and for meals. Media information sheets, game notes and flip cards are provided to all media members at their courtside sets prior to the game and are also available in the working portion of the media room. Final statistics books will be available after the game. Complimentary wireless Internet is available on press row and in the Bartow Arena Media Room.

Postgame Interviews

UAB is committed to a policy of equal access for both male and female reporters and photographers, therefore, the UAB locker room is closed to the media. Interviews with head coach Randy Norton and players will be conducted following the NCAA-mandated 10 minute coolingoff period.

BARTOW ARENA



- Bartow Arena is in its 31st season as the home court for the women's basketball, men's basketball and volleyball teams.
- . Bartow Arena has afforded the Blazers a solid home court advantage, as UAB posts a 288-155 (.650) record in the building.
- . The arena was dedicated on December 3, 1988. The first win for the Blazers came on December 6, 1988, against Southern University, 66-64. The facility was renamed Bartow Arena on Janruary 25, 1997.
- . Bartow Arena is a spacious 18,000 squarefeet floor space with lower level seats retracted, enough room for three full courts (basketball or volleyball).
- With a maximum capacity of 8,500, Bartow Arena has 6,500 permanent seats and 2,000 retractable.
- Over the years, improvements have been made, such as state-of-the-art video boards. administrative office towers annexes, a new locker room for football, a new paint scheme for both the permanent and portable floors, and major renovations to the Green and Gold and Champions Club rooms.
- Bartow Arena was the site of the 1991 Sun Belt Women's Tournament and the 1996 Conference USA Women's Championship. The Conference USA Tournament returned to Bartow Arena from 2015-2017.

Prior to UAB, Norton spent three years as the Associate Head Coach at Missouri and seven years as an assistant at Illinois State under Robin Pingeton. In ten years as an assistant, Norton helped guide his teams to six postseason berths, including the 2005 and 2008 NCAA Tournament.

Playing Career

A 1986 graduate of the University of Iowa, Norton played both basketball and baseball for the Hawkeyes. On the hardwood, he was a guard on 1979 Big Ten Conference title team and the 1980 team that advanced to the NCAA Final Four.

On the diamond, Norton was a four-year letterwinner for the Hawkeyes. He spent three seasons in the Montreal Expos (now Washington Nationals) organization before moving into coaching.

Personal

An Iowa City, Iowa, native, Norton and his wife Claire, have four children: Tom, Carly, Allie and Nick, and five grandchildren. Tom and Allie graduated from Truman State, while Carly graduated from St. Ambrose, where all three played college basketball. Nick is a graduate from UAB where he was a three-year starter at point guard for the men's basketball team before finishing his career at Drake University.

UAB NOTES

UAB vs. Auburn

The Blazers and Tigers have met on 33 previous occasions with Auburn winning 29 of the meetings including 17 in a row dating back to 1992. The last time the two teams met was in November of 2015 when the Tigers defeated the Blazers 85-71 in Auburn, Coach Norton's only meeting with the in-state foe. The last time UAB hosted Auburn at Bartow Arena was in 2008.

Barnes Means Business

After earning C-USA player of the Week honors a week ago senior point guard Miyah Barnes continued to put up impressive stats leading the Blazers in scoring (19.7) and assists (5.0).

Barnes put up 23 points with five rebounds, four assists and three steals against Boise State in a high-scoring affair. It was Barnes second game in a row with 20+ points and the 13th of her career. The Memphis native was 5-6 from beyond the arc tying her career high of five three-pointers in a game.

Barnes recorded a career high 25 points in the Blazers loss to Oklahoma where she shot 58.8% from the field.

The senior point guard is averaging a team-leading 35.3 minutes per game shooting 56.1% from the field and 52.9% from three-point range.

1-0-0

Seniors Rachael Childress and Miyah Barnes played in their 100th game for the Blazers last Friday against Boise State. The seniors have been staples in the UAB line-up since their freshman season and have earned multiple C-USA honors including preseason All-Conference Team honors this season. Barnes has been a starter in 97 of her 100 games while Childress has started in 92.

Magee Minutes

Trista Magee has found her way into the Blazers starting line up for the first time in her career at UAB and she is making the most of it.

The redshirt senior put up 14 points against Oklahoma, 11 coming in the 4th quarter. She opened the 4th quarter on an 8-1 run for the UAB by herself to narrow the Oklahoma lead.

She picked up where she left off in Norman against Boise State dropping 14 points in the first quarter including three 3-pointers.

Magee is averaging 11.3 points a game with six assists one steal and one block. She is shooting 42.9% from the three point line while providing some crucial minutes for the Blazers averaging 31 per game.

Thomas Time

Senior forward Katelynn Thomas saw her first action of the season last Friday against Boise State. The Birmingham native saw 15 minutes of action in which she scored 8 points shooting 50.0% from the field.

Thomas was a key part of the Blazers offense a season ago leading the team in FG% (62.0%), good enough for seventh in the NCAA. She was second on the team in points averaging 12.8 per game.

Thomas holds the third and fourth best singleseason FG% in UAB history and is currently the UAB leader in career FG% shooting 61.1% in her time with the Blazers.

Records Rewritten

Rachael Childress became UAB's all time leading 3-point shooter after knocking down her eighth three against South Alabama at 5:10 in the fourth quarter. The senior's 320 threes surpassed former UAB guard Amanda Peterson's 319 and moved Childress into third place in C-USA history.

All the Awards

Miyah Barnes was one of 20 point guards named to the Nancy Lieberman Watch List. The senior was one of the top point guards in the country last season averaging 10.9 points and 4.8 assists while holding the sixth best assist/turnover ratio (3.5) in the country. She led the Blazers in minutes played last season with 1133 (34.3 per game).

Block Party

Angela Vendrell is on pace to move her way up the UAB blocked shots record book. The senior sits in sixth place with 86 blocks in her career and is nine blocks away from entering the Top-5.

Underdogs?

UAB was picked to finish fourth in Conference USA this season behind defending champion Rice, arch rival Middle Tennessee and WKU. The Blazers finished 2018-19 second in the conference and won C-USA two seasons ago. With six seniors and four starters returning to the Blazer line up UAB sits as a potential underdog going into the year.

Norton Notables

Head Coach Randy Norton has guided his team to back-to-back 25+ win seasons and a top two conference finish in each of the last two seasons. Going into his seventh season Norton already sits at third place in UAB history in wins. He reached his 100th win last season against Alcorn State in December.

Senior Success

The 2019-20 UAB senior class is one of the most accomplished and successful in program history. In three years they have recorded a 68-29 (.701) record, broken the school records for 3-pointers made in a season (291), 3-point FG % (.376), assists (590), assist/turnover ratio (1.5) and single game records for 3-pointers made (18) and assists (34).

The senior class was also a crucial piece to the 2017-18 C-USA Championship season. Each of the six seniors has played a pivotal role in the success of the program and the back-to-back 25+ win seasons and consecutive WNIT appreances.

How May I Assist You?

UAB led the confernce in assists (567) and assists per game (17.2) last season marking the second consecutive season the Blazers led the league in those categories. Miyah Barnes was top of C-USA in assists with 158. Two other Blazers (Kuzmanic and Vendrell) were also top 15 in the conference in assists.

The Blazers also held the best assist/turnover ratio in the conference (1.5), which was good enough for fifth in the nation. The Blazers know how to take care of the rock and prove that sharing really is caring.

They're Baaaack

UAB returns four starters and 11 letterwinners to the court including 2018-19 All-Conference USA selections Rachael Childress (First Team) and Miyah Barnes (Second Team). Childress and Barnes were also selected to the Preseason All-Conference Team for 2019-20.

Seniors Angela Vendrell, Imani Johnson, Trista Magee and Katelynn Thomas return as major pieces to the Blazers line-up. Meanwhile redshirt junior Lea Kerstein and sophomores Margaret Whitley, Sara Rosenfeldt and Emily Frasco all return with some valuble experience under their belts.

Fresh Faces

The UAB lineup features four new faces with three freshmen and one transfer. Freshmen Sam Mitchell (Downers Grove, Ill.), Jasmine Gracie (Huntsville, Ala.) and Summer Schloss (Gastonia, N.C.) begin their first collegiate season in 2019-20 and Zakyia Weathersby (Collins, Miss.) comes to UAB as a junior college transfer from Jones College in Ellisville, Miss.

AUBURN, Ala. -- The UAB women's basketball team fell short Friday as it dropped an 85-71 decision to Auburn in Auburn Arena.

Senior Chelsee Black led the Blazers offensive push. She finished with a team-high 22 points. Brittany Winborne recorded 10 rebounds to go along with eight points.

UAB shot an even 50 percent from the floor and an outstanding 50 percent from beyond the arc in the game's opening 20 minutes. Black was 5-of-9 in the first half for 13 points, including 3-for-6 from three.

Deanna Kuzmanic added two treys for six of her eight first half points. Bianca Dufelmeier also totaled eight points as the Blazers enjoyed a 36-35 lead following a Chelsee Black three at the buzzer to end the first half.

Auburn (1-0) took a 56-49 lead into the final period and scored the first nine points of the fourth quarter in a crucial two-minute stretch, setting the tone for the remainder of the contest.

Deanna Kuzmanic burried her fourth and fifth treys of the night to keep the Blazers close, cutting the Tiger lead to 67-57 with 4:53 left to play in the contest.

Despite the valiant UAB comeback attempt Auburn was able to hit key free-throws down the stretch to hold off The Green and Gold.

The Blazers (0-1) finished with a 47.3 shooting percentage (26-for-55) and went 12-for-28 (40 percent) from 3-point range and 14-for-28 (50 percent) from the free throw line. Kuzmanic finished the night with 17 points on 4-of-11 shooting from downtown.

Junior Brandy Montgomery of Auburn had a game-high 24 points, 15 of which came in the second half.

BIRMINGHAM- UAB came up short in an offensive battle in Birmingham, falling to Boise State 83-81 on Friday evening at Bartow Arena.

Mivah Barnes staved hot for UAB leading all scorers with 23 points with five rebounds, four assists and three steals in the loss to the Broncos

The two teams started the game trading three-pointers, a trend that would continue throughout the evening. By the 6:41 mark in the first quarter both teams had made three triples with the Blazers a perfect 100 percent from beyond the arc.

UAB (1-2) got out to the early lead thanks to the deep ball as Barnes, Trista Magee and Rachael Childress each knocked down threes in the first 10 minutes of play. Barnes' 3-pointer at the 1:48 mark of the first quarter put the Blazers up 26-15, the largest lead either team would have in the game.

It was Boise State (3-1) who would close the guarter on a 7-2 run to cut the Blazers lead to 28-22 at the end of the first.

The Broncos continued where they left off in the first scoring six unanswered points in the beginning of the second quarter to tie the game at 28.

The second guarter was a back-and-forth battle as each team went on a run, with the Broncos' Mallory McGwire hitting a last second jumper in the paint to put Boise State up 40-38 at halftime.

UAB started the second half on an 11-3 run to reclaim the lead before Boise State came surging back with a run of its own. Both sides caught fire in the third quarter scoring 24 points apiece with Boise State knocking down five three-pointers and UAB hitting four from beyond the arc.

At the 3:42 mark in the third quarter Barnes scored her fifth three of the game to put the Blazers up by two and bring her points total to 20. Riley Lupfer would answer with a three of her own to regain the lead for the Broncos and become Boise State's all-time three-point shooter.

It was Boise State once again that knocked down a shot in the closing seconds of the quarter to take the 64-62 lead going into the final 10 minutes of play.

The fourth quarter mirrored the third as both teams scored 19 points in a back-and-forth battle to the finish. Boise State went on a 7-0 run in the middle of the fourth to put up a nine-point lead with 2:33 remaining in the game. UAB came blazing back with a 7-0 run before Braydey Hodgins made a circus shot to put the Broncos up four with less than a minute to play.

With 19 seconds remaining in the game Childress knocked down her fourth three of the evening to bring UAB within one. The Blazers fouled to send Boise State to the line where Hodgins missed one of her free throws keeping it a three-point game.

With seven seconds remaining and no one open on the perimeter Barnes drove down the lane for a layup to once again bring the game within one 82-81. Hodgins again went 1-2 from the line setting UAB up with the opportunity to have the last shot with four seconds on the clock down 83-81. Barnes drove down the floor and threw up a jumper from 17 feet out that hit off the rim as time expired.

"You have two really outstanding teams playing each other in Boise State and UAB," said head coach Randy Norton. "They have won the Mountain West three years in a row and they were the preseason pick again this year. They have some great players as we do, and we are planning on competing for the Conference USA championship. When you have two teams matched up like that it comes down to attention to details. We know we had some breakdowns defensively that can make a difference in a game like that. All-in-all I saw a lot of positives out there and we will take that and learn from this game."

The game saw nine ties and nine lead changes as both teams traded blows and knocked down a total of 23 threes.

Barnes finished the night shooting 66.7 percent from the field with 23 points and five three pointers for UAB.

"What you see is how Miyah plays," added Norton. "She puts in the time to be a great player; she practically lives in the gym. As a fouryear starter for us so nothing surprises me when I watch her. She knocked down some open shots, she made some tough drives to the basket and she is truly one of the best point guards in the country."

Childress and Imani Johnson each put up 16 points of their own with Childress knocking down four threes and Johnson going to the charity stripe eight times.

Magee's 14 points all came in the first quarter as the redshirt senior ran into foul trouble and eventually fouled out in the closing

Angela Vendrell once again led the team in rebounds grabbing eight boards while also tallying two blocks, five assists and one steal.

Senior Katelynn Thomas saw her first action of the season scoring eight points and grabbing four rebounds in 15 minutes of play.

Boise State also saw four players hit double figures as McGwire led the Broncos with 20 points followed by Hodgins' 19 and Lupfer's 17.

The Blazers outshot their opponent for the third time this season hitting 48.2 percent of their field goals and knocking down 52.2% from three-point range.






