>> Auburn is 1-2 after dropping a back-and-forth 80-75 contest at UAB Thursday night.

>> St. Joe's is 2-2 following a home 55-45 loss to Big 5 rival Penn on Wednesday.

#### LAST TIME OUT

» Auburn's Unique Thompson scored 24 points and matched a career-high in rebounds, but the Tigers came up short in a back-and-forth battle at UAB Thursday night, 80-75.

» In a game that featured 12 ties and 25 lead changes and neither team ever led by more than five points, the Tigers (1-2) shot 50 percent from the field and had 10 more rebounds than UAB (3-2). But the Blazers scored 23 points off 20 Auburn turnovers, hit 10 3-pointers and did not miss a free throw in the second half.

» Thompson finished with a game-high 24 points and tied her career-high with 19 rebounds, 10 of those coming on the offensive end and leading to 17 second-chance points for the Tigers. Alexander added 20 points on 9-of-14 shooting and also had a team-best four steals. Those were the only two Tigers in double-figures; Erin Howard added 9 points and 7 rebounds off the bench.

#### **UP NEXT**

Auburn begins a season-long five-game road swing with a trip to Estero, Fla., for the Gulf Coast Showcase. The Tigers will face Middle Tennessee in the first round of the tournament at 10 a.m. CT Friday.

#### LAST MEETING: Dec. 6, 2018 Auburn 81, St. Joseph's 70

» Janiah McKay scored a season-high 21 points, and Auburn held off a furious late rally by St. Joseph's to pick up an 81-70 win on the road.

» McKay's 21 points led all scorers and she was key in the fourth quarter when she scored nine points and hit 6-of-8 free throws in the closing minutes. But the victory was not without its tense moments as St. Joseph's went on a tear in the second half to nearly erase a 15-point Auburn lead.

>> Auburn shot a season-high 53.7 percent from the floor and was 18-of-23 (78.3%) at the free-throw line. The Hawks, meanwhile, scored a season-high 70 points – 20 points above their season average – while making a season-best 13 3-pointers.

#### **SCOUTING AUBURN**

>> Auburn is 1-2 after falling on the road at UAB Thursday night.

The Tigers are among the most inexperienced teams in the country with just two upperclassmen on their 14-player roster. With five freshmen and seven sophomores, Auburn is one of just eight teams nationwide with three or fewer upperclassmen on its roster.

>> Auburn returns three starters (Daisa Alexander, Erin Howard, Unique Thompson) and four other letterwinners from its 2018-19 team that finished 22-10 overall, 9-7 in SEC play, and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third time in four seasons.

» Junior forward Unique Thompson has three double-doubles through three games, averaging 20.7 points and 14.0 rebounds; she is the leading rebounder and second-leading scorer in the Southeastern Conference. She has 23 career double-doubles, which ranks 7th in Auburn history and second among active SEC players.

» Thompson averaged a double-double (12.2 points, 10.3 rebounds) as a sophomore. She finished the 2018-19 season ranked 6th in the nation with 4.0 offensive rebounds per game. Thompson was a preseason All-SEC second team selection.

» Senior guard Daisa Alexander is the Tigers' second-leading scorer (3rd in SEC) through three games, averaging 19.7 points/game. She scored 22 points in the opener vs. Wofford and 17 vs. Old Dominion while playing point guard, a position she has played sparingly throughout her career. She poured in 20 points at UAB after returning to the shooting guard position. Alexander also ranks second in the SEC in steals (3.3/game).

» Alexander was Auburn's top returning scorer after averaging 12.6 points/game last season. She also led Auburn returners in assists (1.8/game) and steals (2.3/game); she ranked 2nd in the SEC in steals last season. Alexander was a preseason All-SEC second team selection.

>> Sophomore Brooke Moore, redshirt sophomore Kiyae' White and freshman Annie Hughes all earned their first collegiate starts vs. Wofford in the season opener. Moore scored 15 points, Hughes added 10 and led the Tigers with four assists and three steals, and White pulled down a career-high 11 rebounds.

>> Freshman Lauren Hansen earned her first career start at UAB on Nov. 21 in her second collegiate game.

>> As a team, Auburn averaged 71.6 points per

AUBURN-- Junior Unique Thompson and senior Daisa Alexander combined for 47 points, and the Auburn women's basketball team held off a late rally to earn an 84-82 win over Wofford Wednesday night to open the 2019-20 season.

The Tigers (1-0) led by as many as 17 points midway through the third quarter but saw the Terriers (0-1) storm back to take the lead just nine minutes later. But strong rebounding and free-throw shooting down the stretch allowed Auburn to withstand a second-half 3-point barrage from Wofford.

Thompson picked up where she left off with her 21st career double-double, scoring 25 points and pulling down 11 rebounds. Alexander finished with 22 points and was 9-of-12 at the free-throw line, including a 7-of-8 mark in the fourth quarter.

Sophomore Brooke Moore scored 15 points in her first career start, and freshman Annie Hughes finished with 10 points, a team-high four assists and two steals. Sophomore Kiyae' White pulled down a career-high nine rebounds as she started for the first time.

Three freshmen made their Auburn debuts. Hughes started and played just under 30 minutes, and Maliya Perry and Morgan Robinson-Nwagwu saw 11 minutes each off the bench.

Auburn shot 46.9 percent for the game (30-of-64) and was 20-of-28 at the free-throw line. The Tigers out-rebounded the Terriers 43-32, including 17 offensive rebounds that led to 22 second-chance points. Auburn also controlled the paint, outscoring Wofford inside 38-18. The Terriers, shot 48.1 percent from 3-point range, hitting 13-of-27 attempts from long range, including 9-of-16 in the second half.

After the teams finished the first 10 minutes tied 11-11, Auburn outscored Wofford in the second quarter 24-13 to take a 35-24 lead at the break. An 11-4 run over the first 5:13 of the third quarter pushed the Tigers' advantage to as many as 17 at 51-34. Auburn saw its lead shrink a bit by the end of the quarter but still took a 58-48 lead to the final 10 minutes.

AUBURN-- Auburn had four players in double figures, but a fourth-quarter surge from Old Dominion led the Monarchs to an 89-77 win over the Tigers in women's basketball action at Auburn Arena Thursday night.

The Tigers (1-1) trailed by just two points at the end of the third quarter, but Old Dominion (2-0) could scarcely miss in the final 10 minutes, shooting 90 percent (9-of-10) in the fourth period and 5-of-5 on 3-pointers to break open what had been a tight game.

Senior Daisa Alexander finished with 17 points and four steals to lead the Tigers. Junior Unique Thompson picked up her second double-double in as many games with a 13-point, 10-rebound performance that saw her go 5-of-6 from the floor.

Sophomore Brooke Moore recorded her second straight 15-point game and remained perfect at the free-throw line for her career, going 7-for-7. And freshman Annie Hughes scored 12 points and had two steals.

As a team, the Tigers shot 43.3 percent from the field (26-60) and hit 8-of-19 3-point attempts (42.1%). Auburn also out-rebounded the Monarchs 34-28. But Old Dominion shot a blistering 59.3 percent from the field and 50 percent (14-of-28) from 3-point range.

The Monarchs, who were just 1-of-13 from 3-point range in their first game, hit 8-of-17 from long range in the first half alone to lead most of the opening half and take a 41-39 lead at the break. Auburn led briefly in the second quarter when Hughes put back a missed free throw to give the Tigers a 33-32 advantage with 6:01 to play.

ODU jumped back ahead by as many as 10 points midway through the third quarter, but the Tigers closed the period on an 8-0 run, punctuated by a pair of 3-pointers from Erin Howard, to head to the fourth quarter down by just two at 60-58. After an Alexander free throw got Auburn within one 16 seconds into the fourth, the Monarchs missed just one shot the entire period and went on a 25-10 run over the next six-plus minutes to build a 16-point lead and secure the road win.

UAB 80. Auburn 75

BIRMINGHAM -- Auburn's Unique Thompson scored 24 points and matched a career-high in rebounds, but the Tigers came up short in a back-and-forth battle at UAB Thursday night, 80-75.

In a game that featured 12 ties and 25 lead changes and neither team ever led by more than five points, the Tigers (1-2) shot 50 percent from the field and had 10 more rebounds than UAB (3-2). But the Blazers scored 23 points off 20 Auburn turnovers, hit 10 3-pointers and did not miss a free throw in the second half.

Thompson finished with a game-high points and tied her career-high with 19 rebounds, 10 of those coming on the offensive end and leading to 17 second-chance points for the Tigers. Alexander added 20 points on 9-of-14 shooting and also had a team-best four steals. Those were the only two Tigers in double-figures; Erin Howard added 9 points and 7 rebounds off the bench.

A back-and-forth first half that saw seven ties and 15 lead changes ended with the Blazers holding a one-point lead at 41-40. Alexander and three others missed some minutes in the opening half with foul trouble, and UAB took advantage, although neither team led by more than four at any point. The Tigers shot 55 percent from the floor in the half and outrebounded UAB 20-11, but the Blazers scored 16 points off 10 Auburn turnovers.

Auburn pulled ahead by as many as five points midway through the third quarter, taking a 54-49 lead on an 8-0 run that featured a steal-and-score from Alexander and back-to-back layups from Thompson. But the Blazers tied it up on a pair of free throws just before the end of the period to tie the game 58-58 after three.

The teams traded the lead for the next seven minutes and the game was tied 69-69 with just under four to play. A backbreaking sequence for Auburn saw a would-be Brooke Moore jumper wiped away after a shot clock review, and a desperation heave to beat the shot clock on the other end found the basket for UAB's Miyah Barnes to give the Blazers a 72-69 lead. UAB would never trail again, going 6-for-6 at the free-throw line in the final minute to secure the win.




