

OPENING TIP

» Auburn begins a five-game road swing with the Gulf Coast Showcase, which runs Friday-Sunday in Estero, Fla. Up first for the Tigers, a date with Middle Tennessee at 10 a.m. CT Friday.

Auburn is 2-2 after defeating St. Joseph's 66-62 at home Sunday night.

» Middle Tennessee is 4-1 on the year and winners of three straight following a 78-62 home win over Furman Sunday.

LAST TIME OUT

» Career nights from redshirt sophomore Kiyae' White and freshman Lauren Hansen and a pair of late defensive stops led the Auburn women's basketball team to a 66-62 win over St. Joseph's at Auburn Arena Sunday night.

The Tigers (2-2) snapped a two-game skid with their best defensive effort of the season, turning 14 turnovers by St. Joseph's (2-3) into 17 turnovers and limiting the Hawks to just four 3-pointers on 15 attempts.

>> Hansen, making her second career start, led Auburn with a career-high 18 points on 6-of-10 shooting, including a 4-for-6 night from 3-point range. Hansen also led the Auburn defensive effort with a game-high four steals. White also shattered her previous career-high with a 12-point effort, going 3-for-4 from the floor and 6-of-8 at the freethrow line.

» Junior Unique Thompson made it 4-for-4 this season on double-doubles with a 17-point, 12-rebound night. Dating back to the final game of last season, Thompson has five consecutive double-doubles, a feat not accomplished by an Auburn player since Le'Coe Willingham in 2004. » Auburn leads 4-0 with prior meetings in home-and-home series in 1985-86 and 1998-88. This will be the first meeting at a neutral site.

LAST MEETING: Nov. 23, 1999 Auburn 93, Middle Tennessee 51

» Four Tigers scored in double-figures as Auburn jumped out to a big early lead and never looked back in a 93-51 win over Middle Tennessee at Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum.

» Tasha Hamilton led Auburn with 16 points, followed by LaKeisha Johnson with 12. Le'Coe Willingham scored 11 and Jackie Pugh had 10.

SCOUTING MIDDLE TENNESSEE

>> Middle Tennessee is 4-1 on the year with their only setback coming at the hands of then-No. 13 Kentucky.

>> The Blue Raiders were picked to finish second in Conference USA by the league's coaches.

Anastasia Hayes, a Tennessee transfer, leads MTSU in scoring with 17.0 points/game and is the team's second-leading rebounder. Her sister, Aislynn Hayes, leads the Blue Raiders in 3-point shooting (47.8%) and steals (2.4/game). The younger Hayes was named USBWA National Freshman of the Week Tuesday after averaging 18.5 points in two wins last week.

SCOUTING AUBURN

>> The Tigers are among the most inexperienced teams in the country with just two upperclassmen on their 13-player roster. With four freshmen and seven sophomores, Auburn is one of just eight teams nationwide with three or fewer upperclassmen on its roster.

» Junior forward Unique Thompson has four double-doubles through four games, averaging 19.8 points and 13.5 rebounds; she is the leading rebounder and second-leading scorer in the Southeastern Conference. She has 24 career double-doubles, which is tied for 6th in Auburn history and second among active SEC players.

>> Thompson averaged a double-double (12.2 points, 10.3 rebounds) as a sophomore. She finished the 2018-19 season ranked 6th in the nation with 4.0 offensive rebounds per game. Thompson was a preseason All-SEC second team selection.

» Senior guard Daisa Alexander is the Tigers' second-leading scorer (8th in SEC) through four games, averaging 16.8 points/game. She scored 22 points in the opener vs. Wofford and 17 vs. Old Dominion while playing point guard, a position she has played sparingly throughout her career. She poured in 20 points at UAB after returning to the shooting guard position. Alexander also ranks fourth in the SEC in steals (3.0/game).

» Alexander was Auburn's top returning scorer after averaging 12.6 points/game last season. She also led Auburn returners in assists (1.8/game) and steals (2.3/game); she ranked 2nd in the SEC in steals last season. Alexander was a preseason All-SEC second team selection.

» Sophomore Brooke Moore, redshirt sophomore Kiyae' White and freshman Annie Hughes all earned their first collegiate starts vs. Wofford in the season opener. Moore scored 15 points in each of the first two games, Hughes hit double-digits in the first two games, and White scored a careerhigh 12 in the win over St. Joseph's.

» Freshman Lauren Hansen earned her first career start at UAB on Nov. 21 in her second collegiate game. Hansen followed that up with an 18-point, 4-steal performance in a win over St. Joseph's.

» Auburn returned three starters (Daisa Alexander, Erin Howard, Unique Thompson) and four other letterwinners from its 2018-19 team that finished 22-10 overall, 9-7 in SEC play, and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third time in four seasons.



AUBURN-- Junior Unique Thompson and senior Daisa Alexander combined for 47 points, and the Auburn women's basketball team held off a late rally to earn an 84-82 win over Wofford Wednesday night to open the 2019-20 season.

The Tigers (1-0) led by as many as 17 points midway through the third quarter but saw the Terriers (0-1) storm back to take the lead just nine minutes later. But strong rebounding and free-throw shooting down the stretch allowed Auburn to withstand a second-half 3-point barrage from Wofford.

Thompson picked up where she left off with her 21st career double-double, scoring 25 points and pulling down 11 rebounds. Alexander finished with 22 points and was 9-of-12 at the free-throw line, including a 7-of-8 mark in the fourth quarter.

Sophomore Brooke Moore scored 15 points in her first career start, and freshman Annie Hughes finished with 10 points, a team-high four assists and two steals. Sophomore Kiyae' White pulled down a career-high nine rebounds as she started for the first time.

Three freshmen made their Auburn debuts. Hughes started and played just under 30 minutes, and Maliya Perry and Morgan Robinson-Nwagwu saw 11 minutes each off the bench.

Auburn shot 46.9 percent for the game (30-of-64) and was 20-of-28 at the free-throw line. The Tigers out-rebounded the Terriers 43-32, including 17 offensive rebounds that led to 22 second-chance points. Auburn also controlled the paint, outscoring Wofford inside 38-18. The Terriers, shot 48.1 percent from 3-point range, hitting 13-of-27 attempts from long range, including 9-of-16 in the second half.

After the teams finished the first 10 minutes tied 11-11, Auburn outscored Wofford in the second quarter 24-13 to take a 35-24 lead at the break. An 11-4 run over the first 5:13 of the third quarter pushed the Tigers' advantage to as many as 17 at 51-34. Auburn saw its lead shrink a bit by the end of the quarter but still took a 58-48 lead to the final 10 minutes.

AUBURN-- Auburn had four players in double figures, but a fourth-quarter surge from Old Dominion led the Monarchs to an 89-77 win over the Tigers in women's basketball action at Auburn Arena Thursday night.

The Tigers (1-1) trailed by just two points at the end of the third quarter, but Old Dominion (2-0) could scarcely miss in the final 10 minutes, shooting 90 percent (9-of-10) in the fourth period and 5-of-5 on 3-pointers to break open what had been a tight game.

Senior Daisa Alexander finished with 17 points and four steals to lead the Tigers. Junior Unique Thompson picked up her second double-double in as many games with a 13-point, 10-rebound performance that saw her go 5-of-6 from the floor.

Sophomore Brooke Moore recorded her second straight 15-point game and remained perfect at the free-throw line for her career, going 7-for-7. And freshman Annie Hughes scored 12 points and had two steals.

As a team, the Tigers shot 43.3 percent from the field (26-60) and hit 8-of-19 3-point attempts (42.1%). Auburn also out-rebounded the Monarchs 34-28. But Old Dominion shot a blistering 59.3 percent from the field and 50 percent (14-of-28) from 3-point range.

The Monarchs, who were just 1-of-13 from 3-point range in their first game, hit 8-of-17 from long range in the first half alone to lead most of the opening half and take a 41-39 lead at the break. Auburn led briefly in the second quarter when Hughes put back a missed free throw to give the Tigers a 33-32 advantage with 6:01 to play.

ODU jumped back ahead by as many as 10 points midway through the third quarter, but the Tigers closed the period on an 8-0 run, punctuated by a pair of 3-pointers from Erin Howard, to head to the fourth quarter down by just two at 60-58. After an Alexander free throw got Auburn within one 16 seconds into the fourth, the Monarchs missed just one shot the entire period and went on a 25-10 run over the next six-plus minutes to build a 16-point lead and secure the road win.

BIRMINGHAM-- Auburn's Unique Thompson scored 24 points and matched a career-high in rebounds, but the Tigers came up short in a back-and-forth battle at UAB Thursday night, 80-75.

In a game that featured 12 ties and 25 lead changes and neither team ever led by more than five points, the Tigers (1-2) shot 50 percent from the field and had 10 more rebounds than UAB (3-2). But the Blazers scored 23 points off 20 Auburn turnovers, hit 10 3-pointers and did not miss a free throw in the second half.

Thompson finished with a game-high points and tied her career-high with 19 rebounds, 10 of those coming on the offensive end and leading to 17 second-chance points for the Tigers. Alexander added 20 points on 9-of-14 shooting and also had a team-best four steals. Those were the only two Tigers in double-figures; Erin Howard added 9 points and 7 rebounds off the bench.

A back-and-forth first half that saw seven ties and 15 lead changes ended with the Blazers holding a one-point lead at 41-40. Alexander and three others missed some minutes in the opening half with foul trouble, and UAB took advantage, although neither team led by more than four at any point. The Tigers shot 55 percent from the floor in the half and outrebounded UAB 20-11, but the Blazers scored 16 points off 10 Auburn turnovers.

Auburn pulled ahead by as many as five points midway through the third quarter, taking a 54-49 lead on an 8-0 run that featured a steal-and-score from Alexander and back-to-back layups from Thompson. But the Blazers tied it up on a pair of free throws just before the end of the period to tie the game 58-58 after three.

The teams traded the lead for the next seven minutes and the game was tied 69-69 with just under four to play. A backbreaking sequence for Auburn saw a would-be Brooke Moore jumper wiped away after a shot clock review, and a desperation heave to beat the shot clock on the other end found the basket for UAB's Miyah Barnes to give the Blazers a 72-69 lead. UAB would never trail again, going 6-for-6 at the free-throw line in the final minute to secure the win.

A pair of trips to the free-throw line for St. Joe's allowed the Hawks to cut the advantage to two points inside of 30 seconds, but the Tigers forced a turnover on the Hawks' next possession before a pair of Thompson free throws sealed the win.
