» Auburn opens the season ranked No. 24 in the preseason AP poll. It is the sixth time the Tigers have been ranked in the annual preseason poll and just the second time in back-to-back seasons. Auburn opened the 2018-19 campaign at No. 11.

» The game Tuesday night is set to feature the highest-scoring matchup in college basketball on opening night with the two teams combining for 162.3 points per game a season ago. Georgia Southern averaged 82.6 points per game last year, good for 15th in the country, while Auburn totaled 79.7 points per contest, good for 34th in the NCAA.

» The Tigers are 82-31 all-time in season openers, including 60-9 at home. Auburn has won 38 of its last 45 season openers, including 8-1 inside Auburn Arena since it opened its doors in 2010.

» Auburn is a perfect 5-0 in its season openers under head coach Bruce Pearl with an average margin of victory of 19.8 points per game.

» The Tigers reached the Final Four for the first time in program history in 2018-19. Auburn is the first program from the state of Alabama to reach the Final Four. The Tigers became the only team to defeat Kansas, Kentucky and North Carolina - the three winningest programs in NCAA history - in consecutive games in NCAA Tournament history.

» Auburn set a program record with 30 wins in the 2018-19 season. The Tigers have won 74 games over the last three seasons, which are the most over a three-year span in program history. That total is good for the second-most in the SEC (Kentucky, 88).

- Has advanced to postseason play in 20 of 24 years as a head coach
- Set single-season wins records at four different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008; 30 at Auburn in 2019)
- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 17 of the 24 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg
- One of 12 coaches to lead three different DI programs to the Sweet 16, joining Rick Barnes, Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Lon Kruger, Frank McGuire, Ralph Miller, Rick Pitino, Bill Self, Tubby Smith, Eddie Sutton and Bruce Weber. Including his stint at DII Southern Indiana, Pearl is one of only three coaches to take four programs (with three at the DI level) to the Sweet 16, joining Lon Kruger and Eddie Sutton
- With the win over Kentucky that sent Auburn to its first Final Four in program history, Pearl notched his 100th win as head coach of the Tigers. He is the first coach in Auburn history to have 100 wins in his first five seasons
- Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)
- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the fifth straight time in 2018-19, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came was 1999-2000
- Auburn welcomed 138,650 fans inside Auburn Arena for the 2018-19 season. The total is the highest ever recorded in Auburn Arena history
- In 24 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 16 times
- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 18 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- In the past three seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 34-5 (.872), while scheduling regular NCAA Tournament teams in Arizona, Dayton, Duke, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech, UConn and Xavier

- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 23 graduates in five years – the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport
- Auburn recently secured its third perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history
- In the past four years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940
- Bruce Pearl has raised over \$1 million in only five golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl Fore the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families. Over \$200,000 was raised in the Bruce, Barkley & Basketball Golf Classic Oct. 23-24, 2016, benefitting the Auburn Basketball program
- Pearl started AURLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AURLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the AURLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease
- The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015
- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain

AUBURN VS. GEORGIA SOUTHERN SERIES

» Tuesday's matchup is set to be the eighth in series history between Auburn and Georgia Southern. The Tigers lead the series 7-0 and have won all six meetings on The Plains.

» In the last game between the two, Auburn came out on top, 92-62, on Nov. 20, 2015. In that game, the Tigers had six players with nine-plus points, including four in double figures to lead the way.

» Bruce Pearl is 1-0 all-time vs. the Eagles with the lone matchup coming with Auburn in 2015.

AUBURN IN SEASON OPENERS

» Auburn has an 82-31 (.726) record in season openers, including 60-9 at home, 13-16 on the road, 4-3 in neutral-site games and 5-3 in games played in unknown locations. This is the 12th straight season the Tigers have opened at home. The Tigers have won 38 of their last 45 season openers, including a 101-58 victory over South Alabama in Auburn Arena last season.

BRUCE PEARL IN SEASON OPENERS

» Bruce Pearl is 23-1 (.958) in season openers, including 5-0 at Auburn. The Tigers defeated South Alabama 101-58 last season, Norfolk State 102-74 in 2017, North Florida 83-66 in 2016, UAB 75-74 in 2015 and Milwaukee 83-73 in 2014 in Pearl's debut as Auburn's head coach. All five of Auburn's season openers under Pearl have been at Auburn Arena. Overall, Pearl has won 13 consecutive season openers.

TIGERS PERFECT VS. NON-CON AT HOME

» Auburn has posted a 21-0 home record against non-conference opponents over the last three seasons, including an 8-0 mark last season, 7-0 in 2017-18 and 6-0 in 2016-17.

» During Bruce Pearl's five years as Auburn's head coach, the Tigers have posted a 32-3 (.914) mark against non-conference opponents at Auburn Arena.

WHAT'S RETURNING?

» Auburn returns just two starters from last season's Final Four and SEC Tournament championship winning team in Samir Doughty and Anfernee McLemore.

» The Tigers return just 32 percent of their 3,188 points from a season ago. Auburn lost five of its top eight scorers, including its top three from last year's team.

WILEY PICKED PRESEASON ALL-SEC

» Austin Wiley was chosen Preseason Second Team All-SEC by the league's coaches. He was one of 20 players chosen to the annual list.

» In 29 games last season, Wiley averaged 6.9 points and 4.0 rebounds per game to go along with 37 blocks. The senior shot a team-best 57 percent from the floor and scored in double figures eight times.

THE GREATEST SEASON EVER

» The Tigers reached the Final Four for the first time in program history. Auburn is the first program from the state of Alabama to reach the Final Four.

» Auburn became the only team to defeat Kansas, Kentucky and North Carolina - the three winningest programs in NCAA history - in consecutive games in NCAA Tournament history.

» The Tigers won four games in four days to capture their second SEC Tournament title (1985) all-time.

PLAYER TO WATCH: J'VON MCCORMICK

Taking over the keys to the offense this season, senior J'Von McCormick is ready to lead the Tigers into the 2019-20 season. In his career, Auburn is 9-2 when McCormick plays 15-plus minutes. The New Orleans, La. native showed out in the exhibition win against Eckerd, notching 20 points on 8-of-13 from the field to go along with five assists in 23 minutes.



» Auburn set a program record with 30 wins in the 2018-19 season.

» Auburn broke the SEC record with 454 3-pointers as a team. The record was held previously by the 1995 Arkansas team with 361. The Tigers finished only 10 3-pointers away from matching the NCAA record of 464 currently held by the 2018 Villanova squad.

» The Tigers made their 10th NCAA Tournament appearance in program history and first in back-to-back seasons since 1999-2000. Auburn is 16-10 all-time in NCAA Tournament play.

» The Tigers won four straight games over AP Top-10 teams for the first time in program history following wins against No. 5 and No. 8 Tennessee, No. 3 North Carolina and No. 7 Kentucky. Auburn won five straight over top-25 opponents for the first time ever during its historic March run, which including triumphs over No. 5 and No. 8 Tennessee, No. 17 Kansas, No. 3 North Carolina and No. 7 Kentucky.

AS GOOD AS IT HAS EVER BEEN

» Auburn finished the 2018-19 season 30-10 after making the first Final Four appearance in program history, breaking the 1998-99 Tigers' program record of 29 victories. Auburn has compiled a 56-18 (.757) record over the last two seasons, including a 24-12 (.667) mark in the SEC. The Tigers went 26-8 and claimed the third regular-season SEC championship (1960, 1999 and 2018) in program history with a 13-5 conference record last season before advancing to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.

» This is the third time in program history that the Tigers have won 20-plus games in at least two straight seasons. It is the first time Auburn has strung together back-to-back seasons with 25-plus wins and the Tigers' set a new program record with its 30th win of the season in the Elite Eight against Kentucky. They strung together three-straight 20-win seasons from 1983-84 to 1985-86, winning 20 games in 1983-84 and 22 games in 1984-85 and 1985-86. After winning a program record 29 games in 1998-99, Auburn won 24 games in 1999-2000. The Tigers' 56 wins the last two seasons are a new school record, surpassing the old mark of 53 wins in 1998-99 and 1999-2000. Auburn, Kentucky and Tennessee are the only three SEC teams that have won at least 26 games in each of the last two seasons. Auburn won 18 games two years ago and currently has won 74 games in the last three seasons, which is a program record for wins in a three-year stretch. The Tigers won 71 games from the 1998-99 season to the 2000-01 season.

CLASS OF THE SEC: MOST GRADUATES SINCE 2014

When it comes to graduating players, nobody in the SEC has done it better than head coach Bruce Pearl and Auburn. Since 2014, the Tigers have had 23 student-athletes walk across the graduation stage and earn their degrees, which is the highest number in the SEC. Current senior Anfernee McLemore already has his degree in hand as he pursues a master's during the 2019-20 season.



AUBURN ARENA SELLOUTS

» Auburn posted six sellouts last year to bring its total to 28 in Auburn Arena history. Of the 28 sellouts, 23 have come in the five seasons under head coach Bruce Pearl. Twelve of the last 17 SEC games at Auburn Arena have been sold out. The average attendance of 8,156 last year marked the third time in the last 17 years, all in the last four years, the Tigers have had an average attendance of over 8,000.

100 SEC WINS ... AND COUNTING

» With a win at Vanderbilt on Feb. 16, Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl picked up his 100th SEC win. Pearl became the 23rd coach in conference history to amass 100 victories and just the fifth to accomplish the feat while coaching two schools.

» The other coaches to have 100 SEC wins while leading two programs include C.M. Newton (195, Alabama and Vanderbilt), Tubby Smith (139, Georgia and Kentucky), Don DeVoe (110, Tennessee and Florida) and John Mauer (103, Tennessee and Florida).

» Coach Pearl is one of just two active coaches to tally 100 conference wins in the league, joining Kentucky head coach John Calipari.

PEARL WINS HIS 100TH GAME AT AUBURN

» Auburn's win over Kentucky in the Elite Eight was Bruce Pearl's 100th win in his 171st game as Auburn's head coach. Pearl is the first head coach in Auburn history to win 100 games in his first five seasons. This includes a 5-3 mark in the NCAA Tournament as Pearl matches Cliff Ellis (5-3) for the second-most NCAA Tournament wins by a head coach in Auburn history. Pearl and Ellis only trail Sonny Smith, who led the Tigers to a 7-5 record in five straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 1984-88.

LET IT FLY

» Auburn led the country with 454 made 3-pointers last season, which was 60 more 3-pointers than any other team. The total is second-most in DI history, only trailing Villanova's 464 triples in 2017-18. For the season, the Tigers scored 42.7 percent of their points from long

range. Auburn led the SEC and was third nationally with 11.4 made 3s per game, which set a new SEC record, breaking the old mark of 10.04 triples by Kentucky in 1990, and was second in the league with a 37.7 3-point field-goal percentage, which is tied for fourth in program history. Auburn broke the program record for 3-pointers in a season at Alabama on March 5, topping the old mark of 324 triples from last season. The Tigers' set a new single-season SEC record for 3-pointers against South Carolina in the quarterfinals of the SEC Tournament. Auburn is the only school that has multiple seasons ranked in the top eight in SEC history in terms of 3-point field goals made. The Tigers led the league with 11.5 3-pointers (207-of-525) and was second with a 39.4 percent 3-point field-goal percentage in SEC play. Auburn made 53 3s in four games during its run to the SEC Tournament title and led the NCAA Tournament field with 58 3-pointers during the tournament.

» The Tigers made double-digit 3-pointers in 26 of 40 games last season, including 16 of 23 games against SEC opponents. Prior to topping 300 3-pointers in each of the last two years, Auburn had not previously done so in program history. The Tigers have made double-digit 3s in 71 of 172 games (41.3 percent) under head coach Bruce Pearl. Prior to Pearl's arrival, the Tigers had just 124 games with at least 10 3s in 855 games since the creation of the 3-point shot in college basketball for the 1986-87 season (14.5 percent).

RETURN TO SENDER

» Auburn finished 22nd nationally averaging 4.8 blocked shots per game in 2018-19. The Tigers blocked 190 shots last season, setting a new program record for blocked shots in a season against Kentucky in the Elite Eight, breaking the old mark of 180 blocks in 2017-18. The Tigers have had four of its program's top-11 single-season block totals during Bruce Pearl's five seasons on the Plains, including three of the top four in the last three seasons.

GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA

Built at a cost of \$86 million, Auburn Arena seats 9,121 fans for basketball games. Auburn Arena replaced the old Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum as the home of Tiger basketball for the 2010-11 season. The furthest seat in Auburn Arena is just 43 feet away from the court. Two-thirds of the seats are less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside offering a home environment that is unrivaled.

STEALING THE SHOW

» Auburn averaged 9.2 steals per game last year, which led all power conference teams and was fourth nationally. The Tigers recorded at least 10 steals in a game 18 times last season (17-1 record), including eight of the last 17. This includes 20 steals in their last non-conference game against North Florida on Dec. 29, which is one off the school record of 21 steals against Louisiana-Monroe on Dec. 6, 2008. 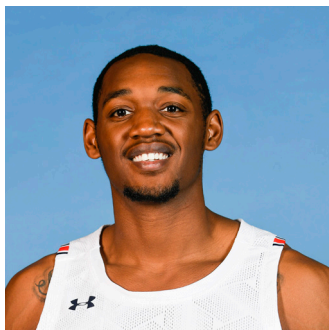
