**HEAD COACH
MARK BYINGTON**

- ▶ Named Georgia Southern's 13th head men's basketball coach April 1, 2013.
- ▶ Signed extension in February of 2018 that will keep him at GS through 2022.
- ▶ Has led the Eagles to top-3 finishes in four of their five seasons in the Sun Belt.
- ▶ His win total in first six seasons is the most for any coach in the school's Division I era.
- ▶ Led the Eagles to consecutive 20-win seasons for the first time in 30 years.
- ▶ Led the Eagles to a 22-9 mark, a second-place finish in the Sun Belt and the Sun Belt Championship title game in 2014-15. It was the first 20-win season since 2005-06 and the Eagles' first conference championship game appearance since 1992.
- ▶ Won the 2015 Whack Hyder Georgia College Coach of the Year Award, joining his mentor Bobby Cremins, and former Eagle coaches Jeff Price and Frank Kerns as recipients.
- ▶ Named National Association of Basketball Coaches District 24 Coach of the Year and chosen by NBC Sports as the Sun Belt Coach of the Year.
- ▶ Every senior has graduated since Byington joined the Eagles in the spring of 2013.
- ▶ Joined the Eagles after a one-year stint at Virginia Tech in 2012-13.
- ▶ Coached seven seasons at College of Charleston under legendary coach Bobby Cremins.
- ▶ Was named Interim Head Coach at College of Charleston in 2012 for the final 11 games of the season. Earned a 7-4 record over that span, including a victory over Kent State in an ESPN Bracketbusters Game.
- ▶ Coached NBA Draft Picks Erick Green (Virginia Tech) and Andrew Goudelock (College of Charleston).
- ▶ Played collegiately at UNC Wilmington, scoring more than 1,000 career points while earning All-CAA Honors and a spot on the All-CAA Defensive Team as a senior.
- ▶ Named Virginia High School Player of the Year in 1994 as a senior at Salem High School in Salem, Va.

SETTING THE SCENE

- Georgia Southern opens its 90th season and 49th Division I campaign of men's basketball Tuesday when the Eagles travel to No. 24/23 Auburn.
- The game will be televised on the SEC Network and can be streamed on WatchESPN.com.
- The Eagles are 4-2 under head Coach Mark Byington in season openers.
- GS is 32-15 in season openers in the Division I era and 3-11 in season openers on the road.
- Georgia Southern was picked third in the Sun Belt in the conference's Preseason Men's Basketball Coaches Poll. Quan Jackson was named first-team All-Sun Belt, Ike Smith was named second-team all-league and Isaiah Crawley was named third team all-conference.
- The Sun Belt poll follows a trend of preseason praise for the Eagles. Athlon, Lindy's, Street & Smith's and The Blue Ribbon College Basketball Yearbook all have the Eagles picked in the top-3 of the conference.
- The Eagles posted 20 wins in consecutive seasons for the first time in 30 years. The last time GS won 20 games two years in a row was in 1987-88 (24-7) and 1988-89 (22-6). GS has three 20-win seasons in the last five years.
- GS ranked fourth in the country in field goal percentage (.499) and 15th in scoring, averaging 82.6 points a game last year. The Eagles scored 80-plus 18 times, 90-plus seven times and over 100 three times. GS shot 50 percent or better in 17 contests and 60 percent or better three times.
- Senior Ike Smith received a medical hardship waiver to regain a year of eligibility. Smith, who has amassed 1,480 career points and 492 rebounds, played in the first 10 games of the 2018-19 season and averaged 14.7 points and 5.7 boards for the Eagles.
- Smith needs 21 points and eight rebounds to become the fifth Eagle with 1,500 career points and 500 rebounds, joining Jeff Sanders (1,861 pts, 893 reb), Kevin Anderson (1,843 pts, 986 reb), Matt Simpkins (1,684 pts, 642 reb) and Louis Graham (1,581 pts, 908 reb).
- Coming off the program's first-ever Final Four appearance, Auburn begins the season ranked No. 24 in the preseason Associated Press Top 25 Poll and 23rd in the Coaches Poll.
- It is the sixth time the Tigers have been ranked in the annual preseason poll in program history and just the second time in back-to-back seasons. Auburn opened the 2018-19 campaign at No. 11.
- The Tigers were picked fourth in the SEC Preseason Poll.

- Georgia Southern is 1-11 against ranked opponents in its Division I era (since 1971-72) and 0-7 on the road.
- Georgia Southern's lone win was an 83-67 decision over No. 18 Southern Illinois in 1976 at home.

TEAM STORYLINES

- The Eagles have notched 22 wins away from home (road and neutral site) in the last two seasons and notched 11 in 2018-19, posting a 6-3 record in road Sun Belt games. The most wins away from home in a season in school history is 12 in 1988-89.
 - Georgia Southern has finished in the top-5 in four of their five seasons in the Sun Belt. GS, UTA and Louisiana are the only Sun Belt schools to reach double-digit conference wins in each of the last five seasons. The Eagles have 58 Sun Belt conference victories.
 - The Eagles won five games in which they trailed by double digits during the contest last season (George Mason -22, Pepperdine - 11, Bradley - 13, UTA -10 (Jan. 5), 14 - ULM (Jan. 10).
 - GS trailed at halftime in 18 games and came back to win eight of those. The Eagles averaged 43.8 points and shooting 51.7 percent in the second half of games.
 - Mark Byington is coaching in his 207th career game and his 196th at Georgia Southern. He became the fifth coach to win 100 games at Georgia Southern with the Eagles' 79-78 victory over ULM Jan. 10. His win total in his first six seasons at Georgia Southern is the best of any coach in the modern era. He posted a 7-4 record at College of Charleston in 2012, filling in as the interim coach for Bobby Cremins.
 - Under Byington, Georgia Southern is 75-15 in games when leading at half and 96-13 when leading with five minutes to go.
 - Georgia Southern posted an RPI of 74 last year, the lowest in school history. It's just the second time GS has finished a season with an RPI lower than 100, and four of the Eagles' seven lowest RPIs have come in the last five seasons.
 - Georgia Southern's top-5 seasons in 3-pointers made and attempted have all come during Mark Byington's tenure.
 - The Sun Belt will feature a 20-game conference schedule for the first time since the 2015-16 season. Appalachian State and Coastal Carolina will visit Hanner Fieldhouse for the first time since the 2016-17 campaign.
 - In-state rival Mercer will visit Statesboro for the first time since November of 2007.
 - The Eagles finished the year 10-4 in Hanner Fieldhouse and are 60-22 under Mark Byington and 35-12 in Sun Belt contests.

- Twenty-seven of Georgia Southern's games will be broadcast or streamed on the ESPN family of Networks.
 - All 20 of the Eagles' Sun Belt Conference games and five

THE SERIES

- The Eagles trail the series 7-0 and lost the last meeting 92-62 in Auburn Arena in 2015.
- The Eagles are 0-5 against Auburn on the road.
- Fifth-year senior Ike Smith is the only Eagle on the roster who played against the Tigers in the last meeting.
- **Last Meeting - 11/20/15 - Auburn Arena:** Cinmeon Bowers tallied 15 points and 13 boards to lead Auburn to a 92-62 home win over Georgia Southern.
- Georgia Southern erased a 10-point first half deficit in the final minutes of the first half with a 10-2 run to trail by just one at the halftime break. The Tigers, however, went on a 24-10 run over the first eight minutes of the second half to extend the lead to 61-48 with 12 minutes left in the game.
- The Eagles committed 26 fouls, sending the Tigers to the free throw line where they made 25-of-33. Auburn ruled the paint with 38 points inside while the Eagles converted 14 Auburn turnovers into 12 points.
- Mike Hughes led the Eagles with 15 points and was 5-of-10 from the field with four rebounds while Ike Smith grabbed seven rebounds to go with 13 points.

- This year's men's basketball championship contest will air on ESPN2 at 2 p.m. ET March 15, and the remaining Sun Belt Tournament games will be broadcast on ESPN+.

TEAM CAPTAINS

- Ike Smith, Isaiah Crawley and Quan Jackson have been named the captains in a vote by the team.
- Smith is a captain for the third straight season.

CAROLINA CONNECTIONS

- Five Eagles hail from North Carolina.
- Redshirt junior Simeon Carter is from Charlotte, junior Trey Dawkins is from Forest City, freshman Elijah McCadden is from Rocky Mount, freshman Will Dillard is from Greensboro and freshman Eito Yuminami is from Mooresville.

A STAFF OF HEAD COACHES

- In addition to head coach Mark Byington, assistant coaches Ben Betts and Jon Cremins have experience in the first chair.
- Betts compiled a 52-41 record at South Carolina State from 2003-06. His squad won the MEAC regular-season title after posting an 18-11 record in 2003-04.
- Cremins spent two seasons as the head coach at Spartanburg Methodist College and led the Pioneers to a combined 55-11 record and consecutive appearances in the NJCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship. He was named the Region X Coach of the Year and District X Coach of the Year for the second straight season after guiding Spartanburg Methodist to a top-25 national ranking and 29-4 overall record in 2016-17.
- Byington, Cremins and assistant coach Andrew Wilson all coached together at College of Charleston from 2010-12.

FREE HOOPS

- Georgia Southern is 38-43 in overtime contests, 6-7 in its last 13 and has won its last two. GS topped Bradley 79-74 in Hanner Fieldhouse Dec. 18, 2018, in its last overtime game at home and won 88-86 at South Alabama Jan. 19, 2019, in its last overtime game on the road.
- The win at South Alabama was also their last overtime game in Sun Belt action.

A LOOK BACK AT 2018-19

- Tookie Brown was named Sun Belt Player of the Year and first-team all-conference and became the first four-time first-team all-conference player in league history. He is the only player in Sun Belt history with over 2,000 points and 500 assists and ranks fourth on the Sun Belt career scoring list. Brown as also named All-America Honorable Mention by the Associated Press.
- GS ranked fourth in the country in field goal percentage (.499) and 15th in scoring, averaging 82.6 points a game. The shooting percentage is the fifth-highest in program history and the best since the 1988-89 campaign. The scoring average is the fourth-best in program history and

the highest since the 1991-92 season.

- The Eagles scored 80-plus 18 times, 90-plus seven times and over 100 three times. GS shot 50 percent or better in 17 contests, including the first five games of the year, and 60 percent or better three times.
- The Eagles shot 60 percent or better in a half 12 times, 70 percent or better twice and shot 77.8 percent in the second half against George Mason, the highest since making 80.8 percent in the second half against UIC Nov. 28, 2005. The Eagles shot 61 percent for the game at Troy (1/17), their highest against a Division I opponent since the aforementioned 89-69 win over UIC in Hanner Fieldhouse, and shot 60.8 percent against Arkansas State (3/2).
- Montae Glenn (2nd, .620), Simeon Carter (7th, .582) and Isaiah Crawley (11th, .563) all had shooting percentages this season that rank in the top-11 in school history.
- GS finished the non-conference portion of its schedule with an 8-5 record, and the slate is rated the 19th most difficult in the country in the latest edition of the NCAA Net (through games March 17), making it the most difficult in the Sun Belt. Twenty of the Eagles' games this year were against teams with a net rating under 170, and the Eagles notched victories over NCAA Tournament participants Bradley and Montana. The Eagles opened the Sun Belt schedule at Texas State Jan. 3, marking the fourth time in their five seasons in the conference that they opened the league schedule on the road.
- Eleven GS games were decided by five points or less, and the Eagles went 5-6 in those contests.
- Injuries kept Georgia Southern from having its full roster available for any game, and three opening day starters missed a combined 28 contests. Ike Smith played in just 10 games, and the Eagles posted a 13-9 record without him.
- Mark Byington became the fifth coach to win 100 games at Georgia Southern when the Eagles defeated ULM 79-78 on a buzzer-beating Quan Jackson 3-pointer Jan. 10. His win total in his first six seasons at Georgia Southern is the best of any coach in the modern era.
- The Eagles' 80-77 win over Montana Nov. 18 in the Islands of the Bahamas showcase championship game was the Eagles' first in-season tournament title since winning the Islander Classic in Corpus Christi, Texas, in 2003.
- Georgia Southern won three games in three days despite losing Jackson, who was the team's leading scorer at the time, late in the opening game of the weekend, and starting forward Isaiah Crawley missed the second half of the championship game with an injury.
- GS started 5-0 for the second straight season. The last time the Eagles started the campaign 5-0 in consecutive years was in the 1949-50 and 1950-51 seasons.
- GS overcame a 22-point deficit with 2:16 left in the first half against George Mason, the Eagles' biggest come-from-behind win since erasing a 24-point halftime deficit in a 91-88 overtime win over Little Rock Feb. 28, 1991.
- The Eagles shot 77.8 percent (21-27) in the second half against George Mason, the highest since making 80.8

- GS shot 61 percent (36-59) at Troy Jan. 17, their highest against a Division I opponent since Nov. 28, 2005, an 89-69 win over Illinois-Chicago in Hanner Fieldhouse. The Eagles shot 60.8 percent (31-51) vs. Arkansas State March 2.
- Against Carver, the Eagles broke the school record for points in a game in the Division I era with a lay-in by Trey Dawkins off a Daniel Cooper assist with 3:07 to go. The previous mark was 126, set against Georgia State in 1974.
- The Eagles were one point shy of tying the school overall mark of 140, set against High Point Dec. 17, 1955.
- The 88-point margin of victory was also the second-highest in school history to the Eagles' 90-point win over Georgia State Feb. 24, 1951.
- Quan Jackson had eight steals against Carver to tie the school single-game record. He shares it with Johntavious Rucker, who tallied eight against Reinhardt in 2010.
