
Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- Auburn is 39-9 all-time in season openers and 27-3 when playing its first game of the season at home
- Auburn has won 40 straight home openers, dating back to 1977-78
- Coach Terri Williams-Flournoy is 7-1 in season-openers at Auburn and 11-4 in her career
- Auburn is in its 49th season of women's basketball and has 936 program wins
- This is the first meeting between Auburn and Wofford in women's basketball
- Auburn is 33-13 all-time against current members of the Southern Conference
- This is Auburn's second all-time game on Nov. 6; the first was last season vs. Grambling
- Auburn is 140-40 all-time in the month of November; Coach Flo is 32-13 in November at Auburn
- Auburn returns three starters and eight letterwinners from 2018-19
- Last season, the Tigers went 22-10 overall, 9-7 in SEC play and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third time in four years
- Auburn finished the 2018-19 season ranked No. 5 nationally in both steals per game (12.3) and turnover margin (+8.0)
- The Tigers broke three school records last season: single-game 3-pointers (14 vs. Elon, 12/22/18); single-season 3-pointers (193) and fewest turnovers in a season (417)
- Auburn is 79-31 in non-conference games under Terri Williams-Flournoy and has won 19 of their last 21
- Senior guard Daisa Alexander (coaches) and junior forward Unique Thompson (coaches & media) were named Preseason All-SEC (2nd team)
- Alexander is Auburn's leading returning scorer after averaging 12.2 points/game in 2018-19; she also ranked 2nd in the SEC with 2.3 steals/game
- Thompson averaged a double-double with 12.2 points/10.3 rebounds in 2018-19; she's the first Auburn player to average a double-double since DeWanna Bonner in 2008 and the fifth in program history
- Thompson enters her junior season with 20 career double-doubles, which ranks 7th in Auburn history and is 2nd among active SEC players
- Auburn is one of eight programs nationwide with 3 or fewer upperclassmen on the roster
- Coach Terri Williams-Flournoy begins her eighth season at Auburn, her 16th as a head coach, and her 28th overall in college coaching
- In SEC preseason polls, Auburn was picked to finish 7th by the media and 8th by the league's coaches

- Daisa Alexander needs 158 points for 1,000 in her career

OPENING TIP

- » Auburn opens its 49th season of women's basketball on Wednesday, Nov. 6, as the Tigers host Wofford at Auburn Arena.
- » Auburn finished the 2018-19 season at 22-10 overall, 9-7 in SEC play, and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third time in four seasons. It was the winningest season for Auburn in the Terri Williams-Flournoy era, now beginning its eighth year.
- Wofford finished 16-15 overall in 2018-19, its first winning season since 2001-02, and went 7-7 in the Southern Conference.

LAST TIME OUT

- " Janiah McKay scored 19 points and Unique Thompson matched a career-high with 19 rebounds, but Auburn was unable to overcome a tough third quarter in a 73-64 loss to BYU in the first round of the NCAA Tournament in Stanford, Calif.
- The Tigers (22-10) trailed by as many as 15 points early in the fourth quarter but rallied to cut that to as few as four with less than two minutes to play. But BYU (26-6) scored on five of its final six possessions and Auburn was unable to get any closer.
- » McKay's 19 points tied for the game high along with BYU's Brenna Chase. She also finished with a game-high six assists and five rebounds. Thompson's 19 rebounds matched her career-high from earlier this season at New Mexico, and her 10 points gave her a double-double, the 13th of the season and 20th of her career.
- "The Tigers struggled from the field, especially early, shooting 32.0 percent for the game (24-75). Auburn attempted 16 more shots than BYU, thanks in large part to 21 offensive rebounds that led to 14 second-chance points. For the game, Auburn outrebounded the Cougars 46-39; the effort tied for Auburn's second-most rebounds this season.

UP NEXT

Auburn has a week off before its next game when the Tigers host Old Dominion on Thursday, Nov. 14, at 6 p.m. CT.

AN AUBURN WIN WOULD...

- » Boost the Tigers' record in season openers to 40-9 overall, 27-3 when opening the season at home.
- » Be Auburn's 41st straight win in a home opener.
- » Improve Coach Flo's record in season-openers at Auburn to 7-1 and her overall record in openers to 12-4.
- » Be Auburn's 14th consecutive home nonconference win.

AUBURN-WOFFORD SERIES

- >> This is the first meeting between Auburn and Wofford in women's basketball.
- Wofford will be the sixth Southern Conference team Auburn has faced. The Tigers are 33-13 alltime against five other SoCon opponents (Furman, Mercer, Samford, Chattanooga, Western Carolina).

SCOUTING WOFFORD

- Wofford finished the 2018-19 season at 16-15 overall, 7-7 in SoCon play. It marked their best regular-season record since 2001-02 and the fifthbest season in program history.
- >> The Terriers were piccked to finish fifth in

the SoCon media poll and second in the league's coaches' poll.

- Senior guard Chloe Wanink was named the SoCon's preseason player of the year; she averaged 18.8 points/game last season as a junior. Da'Ja Green returns as the SoCon's leader in assists after averaging 5.2/game last year.
- Wofford sophomore forward MaryMartha Turner and Auburn sophomore guard Robyn Benton were high school teammates at Greater Atlanta Christian School.

SCOUTING AUBURN

- Auburn returns three starters (Daisa Alexander, Erin Howard, Unique Thompson) and five other letterwinners from its 2018-19 team that finished 22-10 overall, 9-7 in SEC play, and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the third time in four seasons.
- Senior guard Daisa Alexander is the Tigers' leading returning scorer after averaging 12.6 points/game last season. She also leads Auburn returners in assists (1.8/game) and steals (2.3/game); she ranked 2nd in the SEC in steals last season. She is slated to start the season-opener at point guard, a position she has played sparingly in her college career. Alexander was a preseason All-SEC second team selection.
- y Junior forward Unique Thompson averaged a double-double (12.2 points, 10.3 rebounds) as a sophomore. She has 20 career double-doubles which ranks 7th in Auburn history and is currently 2nd among active SEC players. Thompson finished the 2018-19 season ranked 6th in the nation with 4.0 offensive rebounds per game. Thompson was a preseason All-SEC second team selection.
- Sophomore Brooke Moore, redshirt sophomore Kiyae' White and freshman Annie Hughes are slated to earn their first collegiate starts in the season opener.
- As a team, Auburn averaged 71.6 points per game last season while giving up 63.6/game. The Tigers were one of the nation's top defensive teams, ranking 5th nationally in steals per game (12.3) and turnover margin (+8.0).

TURNING UP THE PRESSURE

- Auburn ranked No. 5 in the nation in steals (12.3/game) and No. 10 in turnovers forced (21.0) for the 2018-19 season.
- Last year, the Tigers forced at least 20 turnovers in 22 of 32 games last year, including 8 games with at least 25 opponent turnovers.
- » Auburn averaged 22.9 points off opponent turnovers in 2018-19.

AUBURN IN SEASON OPENERS

- In 48 previous seasons, Auburn has put together a 39-9 record in season openers (home or away) and sports a 27-3 record when opening the season at home.
- » In the SEC era (since 1980), Auburn is 35-4 in season openers.
- >> The Tigers are winners of their last 27 season openers at home with the last time Auburn lost being a 71-56 loss to Talladega in the 1977-78 opener. Auburn has also won their first home game of the season 40 straight years.
- Head coach Terri Williams-Flournoy is 6-1 in season-openers at Auburn. She holds an 11-4 record in season-openers as a head coach, winning nine of her last 10.
