## THE OPENING TIP...

- Saint Louis has won five in a row and enters Saturday's game against Auburn in Birmingham, Alabama, with an 8-1 record.
- Auburn (8-0) is ranked No. 10 in the Coaches Poll and No. 12 in the AP Top 25.
- This is the second game against a ranked opponent for the Billikens this season. SLU lost 83-66 against No. 12 Seton Hall earlier this year at Chaifetz Arena.
- The Billikens are coming off an 86-62 victory against Tulane on Sunday in Phoenix, Arizona. SLU drilled a school-record 17 3-pointers in the win. Junior forward **Hasahn French** (18 points, 11 rebounds, five assists) was named Most Outstanding Player of the game, which was part of the Jerry Colangelo Classic.
- Saint Louis is the only team in NCAA Division I with two players averaging double-doubles - junior guard **Jordan Goodwin** averages 15.4 ppg and 11.0 rpg, while and junior forward **Hasahn French** turns in 14.9 ppg and 10.4 rpg.
- Freshman guard **Gibson Jimerson** is the back-to-back A-10 Rookie of the Week. He led SLU with 22 points in the win against Tulane.
- Freshman guard **Yuri Collins** is third in the A-10 in assists per game (5.9 apg). He is first among freshmen in the NCAA, through games of Dec. 9.
- SLU is honored to play in the **Mike Slive** Invitational. Slive was the Commissioner of the Great Midwest Conference and Conference USA during the Billikens' time in those leagues.
- Auburn finished 30-10 last season, won the SEC Tournament, and advanced to the Final Four. The last time SLU played a Final Four team from the year prior was in the 2013-14 season against Wichita State.
- Up next, the Billikens host Maryville at Chaifetz Arena on Dec. 17 at 7 p.m.

### ABOUT SATURDAY'S GAME

- Saint Louis takes on No. 12 Auburn on Saturday, Dec. 14, at Legacy Arena in Birmingham, Alabama.
- It is the Mike Slive Invitational, a game held in Birmingham each year to honor Mike Slive and The Mike Slive Foundation for prostate cancer research.
- The game will be televised on ESPN2, with **Mike Morgan** and **Jimmy Dykes** calling the action.
- Saturday's radio broadcast airs on 101 ESPN (101.1 FM). As always, Billiken Hall of Famers **Bob Ramsey** and **Earl Austin Jr.** will call the action.

### LAST TIME OUT

- Saint Louis drilled a school-record 17 3-pointers in an 86-62 victory over Tulane on Sunday in the Jerry Colangelo Classic at Talking Stick Resort Arena in Phoenix, Arizona.
- The Billikens have won five straight and improve to 8-1. Tulane falls to 7-2.
- **Gibson Jimerson** (game-high 22 points) and **Demarius Jacobs** (18 points) led SLU's 3-point shooting barrage with six treys apiece. As a team, the Billikens finished 17-of-28 (60.7 percent) from beyond the arc.
- SLU broke the previous school record of 15 3-pointers in a game, which was accomplished twice in 2004 and 2007.
- **Hasahn French** scored 18 points, grabbed 11 rebounds and dished out five assists. He was named Most Outstanding Player of the SLU win in the Jerry Colangelo Classic.
- **Jordan Goodwin** registered his fourth-straight double-double with 12 points and 16 boards. He also dished out five assists and posted two steals.

### "DOUBLE" DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- Junior forward **Hasahn French** and junior guard **Jordan Goodwin** are the only teammates in NCAA Division I averaging a double-double in points and rebounds.
- Goodwin has double-doubles in four-straight games. French is the Billikens' active career leader with 18 double-doubles in his three-plus seasons.

### BILLIKENS FROM DEEP

- Saint Louis is coming off a school-record shooting performance on Sunday against Tulane, where the Billikens broke a school record with 17 3-pointers.
- The previous school record was 15 treys made in a game.
- The Billikens were a much improved 3-point shooting team even prior to the Tulane game. SLU's 3-point shooting percentage (.369) is fourth in the A-10. Last year, the Billikens finished near the bottom in the league in 3-point shooting percentage.

### JUNIOR LEADERSHIP

- Juniors **Jordan Goodwin** and **Hasahn French** are leading the Billikens both on and off the court.
- On the court, the duo accounts for 41 percent of the Billikens' scoring and 51 percent of the team's rebounds.

### BILLIKENS AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS

- This is the second game this season against a ranked opponent, and the fourth of the **Travis Ford** era at SLU.
- The Billikens have lost 10 straight games against a ranked foe.
- The Billikens' last win against a ranked opponent was a 62-56 win over No. 25 VCU in the 2013 Atlantic 10 Conference Championship game at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y. That was part of a five-game winning streak against ranked opponents, with the Bills posting wins against No. 20 New Mexico, No. 9 Butler, No. 24 VCU, No. 15 Butler and No. 25 VCU.

### BEASTS ON THE BOARDS

- The Billikens lead the A-10 are tied for 13th in the NCAA with 42.4 rebounds per game, through games of Dec. 9.
- Junior guard **Jordan Goodwin** (t-11th) and junior forward **Hasahn French** (21st) both rank in the top 25 in the NCAA in rebounds per game with 11.0 rpg and 10.4 rpg, respectively.
- Both have had big rebounding games - French pulled down 24 rebounds (tied for the most in the NCAA this season) against Belmont, and Goodwin snagged 19 boards (tied for the seventh most in the NCAA this season) against SIU.
- Led by **Hasahn French's** 24 boards and **Jordan Goodwin's** 13, the Billikens out-rebounded Belmont 60-38 on Nov. 23. The 60 rebounds are tied for the 13th most in a game in the NCAA so far this season. It also marked the first time since

1986 that the Billikens posted 60 or more rebounds in a game.

►The Billikens are at a +8.0 in rebounding margin through their first nine games this season.

►Last year, the Billikens led the Atlantic 10 Conference and ranked in the top 20 nationally in rebounding margin (+6.5) last season. They finished among the NCAA leaders in offensive rebounds per game.

►SLU's 1,427 rebounds last year were the most in school history in the modern era, surpassing the 1,375 rebounds brought down by the 1988-89 Billikens.

### BLOCK PARTY

►Junior forward **Hasahn French**, who is second on the Billikens in scoring (14.9 ppg) and rebounding (10.4 rpg), is SLU's all-time career blocked shots leader with 149 rejections and counting.

►He surpassed **Ian Vouyoukas'** previous school record (135) in the High Point game, the fifth game of his junior season and the 73rd game of his career.

►French is tied for 14th among all active NCAA Division I players with 149 career blocked shots. He is third among juniors on that list.

►French was named A-10 co-Player of the Week on Nov. 25 after big games against High Point and Belmont the week prior.

►French registered 66 blocked shots a year ago, tied for third most in a single season in school history. He posted a SLU freshman-record 59 blocked shots as a freshman.

►French posted 10 double-doubles last season, joining Billiken great **Anthony Bonner** as the only Billikens who have recorded 10 or more double-doubles in a season. His 18 career double-doubles leads all active Billikens.

### GOODWIN DOES IT ALL

►Junior guard **Jordan Goodwin** is averaging team bests of 15.4 ppg, 11.0 rpg and 2.1 spg.

►He is 11th in the nation with 11.0 rpg, which is third among guards in the NCAA and first among players 6-foot-3 or less.

►Goodwin surpassed **Kevin Lisch** for eighth on SLU's all-time career steals in the Boston College game and now has 137 career steals. The next Billiken great for Goodwin to catch on the steals list is **Erwin Claggett**, who sits in seventh with 145 steals. **Anthony Bonner** is the Billikens' all-time steals leader with 192.

►Goodwin's 66 steals last year were the fifth-most in school history in a single season.

►Last season, Goodwin led all NCAA guards in offensive rebounding with a 3.5 orpg average. His 127 offensive rebounds last season are the most by a Billiken since offensive rebounds began being tracked in the mid 1980s.

### JIMERSON IS THE BACK-TO-BACK A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

►Freshman guard **Gibson Jimerson** has earned back-to-back A-10 Rookie of the Week awards. He earned this week's after his game-high 22 points (thanks in part to six treys) in the win against Tulane.

►Jimerson is fourth in the A-10 and 30th nationally (sixth among NCAA freshman) in 3-point field-goal percentage (.453, 24-of-53).

►Jimerson dropped 25 points in the win against High Point on Nov. 20. Those were the most points by a SLU freshman since **Jordan Goodwin** went for 28 points against La Salle on Feb. 10, 2018.

### COLLINS PUTTING ON A SHOW

►A true "pass-first" point guard who routinely mentions in interviews that all he wants to do is set up his teammates to score, freshman point guard **Yuri Collins** leads all NCAA freshmen with 5.9 assists per game. That also ranks third in the A-10.

►He dished out a career-high 11 assists in the Billikens' game against Eastern Washington. The last freshman to record 11 assists in a game was **Jordan Goodwin** at George Mason on Jan. 13, 2018.

►Collins' game hasn't been unexpected. He led St. Mary's High School (St. Louis) to its first ever state semifinal appearance last year. He is widely considered one of the top point guards ever from the St. Louis area prep scene.

### JACOBS HAS BIG GAMES

►Sophomore guard **Demarius Jacobs** had a breakout game against Valparaiso on Nov. 9, scoring 20 points on 5-of-8 shooting from the field.

►Jacobs was 6-of-7 from 3-point range for 18 points in the win over Tulane.

►He scored eight points in all of 2018-19 as he appeared in just 19 games after suffering through injuries.

### SPEED LIMIT 80

►The Billikens scored 80 or more points in each of the first three games of the season for the first time since 1993-94. The 2000-01 team was the last Billiken squad to score 80 or more points in three straight games at any point during the season.

►The Billikens' 89 points against Florida Gulf Coast in the season opener were the most points scored by SLU in the **Travis Ford** era. Also, they were the most points scored in a season opener since the 1982-83 season.

### RECAPING LAST YEAR

►Saint Louis went 23-13 overall and 10-8 in the A-10 a season ago.

►SLU won the A-10 Championship in thrilling fashion, winning four games in four days as a six seed at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, New York.

►The Billikens made the NCAA Tournament, their fourth this decade, but lost to fourth-seed Virginia Tech in the First Round in San Jose.

### MORE ON THE BILLIKENS' RUN TO THE A-10 CHAMPIONSHIP

►As a No. 6 seed at the 2019 A-10 Championship in Brooklyn, N.Y., the Billikens won four games in four days at Barclays Center to capture its second A-10 Championship crown.

►Billiken Hall of Fame radio analyst **Earl Austin Jr.** coined SLU's march through the A-10 Championship "The Billiken Redemption Tour." All four opponents the Bills defeated (Richmond, Dayton, Davidson, St. Bonaventure) beat the Billikens the last time they met in the regular season.

►It was Saint Louis' second A-10 Championship title. The Billikens last won the A-10 crown in 2013, when they became the very first collegiate team to cut the nets down in a then brand-new Barclays Center.

### BACK IN THE NCAAS

►The Billikens made their 10th appearance overall and fourth this decade in the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship last season, earning the No. 13 seed and playing Virginia Tech in San Jose, California.

►Saint Louis last was in the NCAA Tournament in 2014, completing a stretch of three straight appearances. SLU won a game in each of them.

### PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

►SLU was predicted to finish seventh in the Atlantic 10 Conference race in the annual preseason poll of A-10 head coaches and media.

►Junior **Hasahn French** was named preseason second-team All-Conference and was voted to the league's preseason All-Defensive team. Junior guard **Jordan Goodwin** was voted to the preseason third-team.

### STRICKLAND INKS WITH BILLIKENS

►Wing **Markhi Strickland** signed an NLI and begins his four years of eligibility in the 2020-21 season.

►Strickland (first name pronounced Mark-eye) graduated from IMG Academy in Bradenton, Florida, and is attending prep school this year at Victory Rock Prep in Bradenton.

►Strickland's father, Mark, played in more than 280 games in the NBA.

### FORD IN FOURTH SEASON

►**Travis Ford** is in his fourth season with the Billikens and his 23rd overall. He is 57-51 in four years at SLU, 393-317 in 23 seasons overall.

►SLU has improved its win total in all three seasons under Ford.

►Last season marked the 11th time that Ford guided his team to the postseason, and it was his seventh NCAA Tournament appearance.

### HISTORY LESSON

►This is the 105th season of Saint Louis University men's basketball.

►The Billikens won the 1948 National Invitation Tournament. That team was led by Easy **Ed Macauley**, who went on to an NBA Hall of Fame career. Macauley's No. 50 is retired by SLU.

►The AP poll was first released the next season, and SLU was the first-ever No. 1 in the inaugural poll on January 17, 1949.

►**Anthony Bonner** (1986-90) is the Billikens' school-record holder in points (1,972) and rebounds (1,424).

►SLU owns two regular-season A-10 titles (2013 and 2014), and it won the A-10 Tournament in 2013 and 2019 at Barclays Center in Brooklyn, N.Y.

►The Billikens have made 10 NCAA Tournament appearances. SLU made three straight NCAA Tournaments from 2012-14, winning its opening game in all three.

# HeadCoach **TRAVIS FORD**



In three years as Saint Louis University's head men's basketball coach, **Travis Ford** has reinvigorated the program and reestablished its place on the national stage.

Hired in March 2016, Ford inherited a program that won 11 games in each of the two years prior. He proceeded to improve the Billikens' win total in each of his first three seasons, highlighted by last season's 23-13 record, an Atlantic 10 Conference Championship, and a bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The Billikens entered the 2018-19 season with high expectations, being picked to win the league despite finishing in a tie for fifth in the league standings in 2017-18.

Ford had the Billikens playing their best basketball late in the season. Saint Louis entered the Atlantic 10 Conference Men's Basketball Championship as the No. 6 seed, and SLU would go on to win four games in four days for the conference title.

SLU was a No. 13 seed in the NCAA Tournament, Ford's seventh appearance as a head coach in the NAAs and 11th in a postseason in his career.

In 23 years as a collegiate head coach, Ford's career record stands at 396-317. In four years at Saint Louis, he holds a 60-51 record.

In addition to his four years at SLU, Ford has had head-coaching stints at Oklahoma State (eight years, 2008-16), Massachusetts (three years, 2005-08), Eastern Kentucky (five years, 2000-05) and Campbellsville University. Ford has led his team to the NCAA Tournament seven times. He has coached six players who have gone on to play in the NBA and six who have been named a conference player of the year.

Ford came to SLU after eight seasons as head coach at Oklahoma State University, where he led the Cowboys to a 155-111 record and five NCAA Tournament appearances.

Ford spent three years as head coach at the University of Massachusetts. He led the Minutemen to a pair of 20-win seasons in 2006-07 (A-10 regular-season co-champions, NIT second round) and 2007-08 (NIT finalist).

Over the span of five seasons at Eastern Kentucky, Ford engineered a turnaround that saw the Colonels post 22 victories his final year after they registered seven in each of his first two seasons. In 2004-05, ECU won the Ohio Valley Conference title to give the program its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 26 years.

Ford began his first foray into coaching in 1997 with a three-year stint at Campbellsville University, an NAIA school in Kentucky.

Ford played the majority of his collegiate career at the University of Kentucky, helping the Wildcats to NCAA Tournament appearances in each of his three seasons (1992, 1993, 1994). He was a junior on the 1993 Wildcat team that advanced to the NCAA Final Four. Ford transferred to Kentucky after one season (1989-90) at the University of Missouri.

Ford, is a native of Madisonville, Kentucky. He and his wife, Heather, have three children: Brooks, Kyleigh and Shane. Ford earned a bachelor's degree in communications at the University of Kentucky in 1994.
