## FURMAN PALADIN POINTS

◆ Furman concludes its four-game road swing Thursday night with a 9 p.m. ET tip-off versus the 14th-ranked Auburn Tigers at Auburn Arena. Thursday's game marks just the sixth meeting between the Paladins and Tigers with Auburn holding a 4-1 series advantage. The Paladins won the first meeting, 44-22, during the 1923 season before Auburn claimed four straight, including a 64-50 verdict in the last meeting on December 15, 2012, at Auburn Arena.

◆ Last time out, South Florida handed Furman its second loss of the season with a 65-55 decision in Tampa, Fla., on Monday night. The Bulls limited Furman to a 35.7% shooting night and just a 7-for-28 effort beyond the arc. Xavier Castaneda came off the bench to score a career-high 18 points for USF. Sophomore Noah Gurley led Furman with 19 points on 7-of-12 shooting, while junior Clay Mounce finished with 14 points and 12 rebounds.

◆ Clay Mounce was named Southern Conference Player of the Week on Monday after averaging 16.0 points, 10.3 rebounds, 3.7 steals and 2.0 assists per game in guiding the Paladins to a 2-1 record over the past week. The Elkin, N.C., product scored 20 points and registered a career-best five steals in a 97-61 win at Elon last Tuesday before notching his first double-double of the season with 14 points and 12 rebounds in a 58-57 win over UT Arlington less than 24 hours later. Mounce concluded the week with another 14-point, 12-rebound effort at USF on Monday.

◆ The Paladins picked up a pair of victories in the mainland portion of the Bad Boy Mowers Battle 4 Atlantis in Elon, N.C., last week. On Tuesday night, Furman rolled to its third consecutive win over Elon with a 97-61 decision at the Schar Center. Furman connected 17 three-point attempts to match the most in school history versus NCAA Division I competition, tying the Paladins' 17 threes versus Davidson in 2005, The Citadel in 2018 and last December versus UNC Wilmington. Wednesday afternoon, Furman overcame a 13-point second half deficit to down Sun Belt Conference member UT Arlington, 58-57, when Bothwell converted a three-point play with 3.8 seconds remaining. Mounce posted 14 points and 12 rebounds, while Jordan Lyons added 14 points on 4-of-9 shooting behind the arc.

◆ Wednesday's victory helped Furman match last season's school record of seven wins during the month of November. In 2018-19, Furman posted a 7-0 record in the opening month en route to a 12-0 start.

◆ Furman sports a 23-4 record in its last 27 regular season non-conference outings. The only losses during the stretch came on the road at the hands of Tennessee, LSU, Alabama and USF. The Paladins have also won nine of their last 11 regular season contests away from Timmons Arena.

◆ A 7-1 start to the season helped Furman climb to No. 6 in this week's CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25. Gonzaga continues to hold the top spot in the poll. As of Tuesday, the Paladins are ranked 75th out of 353 Division I teams in the Pomeroy Ratings (KenPom.com).

◆ Furman is 67-134 all-time versus current SEC schools with its most recent win, a 91-75 decision versus South Carolina, coming on December 22, 2010. In the Paladins' last encounter with an SEC foe, Alabama held off the Paladins, 81-73, on November 19, in Tuscaloosa. Last season, LSU halted No. 24 Furman's season opening 12-game winning streak with a 75-57 verdict in Baton Rouge. The Paladins were edged 66-61 at nationally-ranked Tennessee during the 2017-18 campaign.

### What You Need To Know About Furman...

- ✓ Furman was tabbed to finish third in preseason polling of the Southern Conference's head coaches.
- ✓ The Paladins boast a 78-31 record since the beginning of the 2016-17 season and have reached the postseason in three of the past four years.
- ✓ Last season, Furman (25-8) downed 2018 Final Four participant Loyola Chicago and defending national champion Villanova en route to school-record 25 wins and its first NIT berth since 1991.
- ✓ The 2018-19 Paladins, who opened the season with 12 straight wins, made their first appearance in the Associated Press Top 25 and climbed as high as No. 23. Furman spent three weeks in the AP poll and appeared at No. 25 in the USA Today Coaches Poll on December 17.
- ✓ Furman claimed a share of the 2017-18 SoCon regular season title, its first since 1990-91.
- ✓ Furman, which reached the NCAA Tournament five times during the 1970's, is in search of its first trip to the Big Dance since 1980.

♦ Among America's Best Colleges; *U.S. News and World Report* ranks Furman University the No. 1 college in South Carolina and 46th nationally on its list of national liberal arts and sciences colleges. *Forbes* recognizes Furman 21st on its list of "Top 25 Colleges in the South." Furman consistently appears among the nation's elite for campus beauty, including a recent No. 9 ranking on the *Times Higher Education* list of "Ten Most Beautiful Universities in the U.S."

## DID YOU KNOW...

♦ Among Furman's most notable graduates are **Charles Townes**, Nobel Prize-winning inventor of the laser; John Watson, the "father of behavioral psychology"; **Keith Lockhart**, conductor of the Boston Pops; **Alexander Stubb**, former prime minister of Finland; **Richard Riley**, former governor of South Carolina and U.S. Department of Education Secretary; **Mike McConnell**, former vice admiral, Director of the National Security Agency, and Director of National Intelligence; **Betsy King** and **Beth Daniel**, Ladies Professional Golf Association Hall-of-Famers; **Clint Dempsey**, member of the 2006, '10, & '14 (captain) U.S. World Cup Teams and recently retired star of the Seattle Sounders; **Brad Faxon**, nine-time winner on the PGA & Champions Tours; **Sam Wyche**, former head coach of the NFL's Cincinnati Bengals; **Bear Rinehart**, lead singer/songwriter of the popular band NeedToBreathe.

♦ **Frank Selvy** is Furman's most decorated hoops standout having been named SoCon Player of the Year three times and UPI National Player of the Year in 1954. The No. 1 overall pick of the Baltimore Bullets in the 1954 NBA Draft, Selvy scored 100 points in Furman's 149-95 victory over Newberry College on February 13, 1954.

♦ Furman's women's cross country team placed ninth at the NCAA Championship in November, while the men's team garnered a 14th place finish. The Paladin football team earned a berth in the FCS Playoffs.

♦ The Paladins produced the nation's scoring leader in four consecutive seasons from 1953-56. Selvy averaged 29.5 points per game in 1953 before averaging a then NCAA record 41.7 per contest to lead the country in 1954. Fellow All-American Darrell Floyd paced the NCAA with a 35.9 per game average in 1955 and 33.8 per contest the following season.

♦ The Paladins captured six SoCon Tournament titles and advanced to the NCAA's six times from 1971-1980.

♦ Furman forward Tre Clark is the son of former Notre Dame football standout Willie Clark, who went on to play five seasons in the NFL for the San Diego Chargers and Philadelphia Eagles.

♦ The Paladins' Clay Mounce is the youngest member of an athletic family. His father played basketball at Montreat-Anderson College and his mother was a volleyball standout at Appalachian State. Oldest brother Chase played college basketball at Tusculum University, while brother Carson currently plays for UNC Pembroke.

♦ Furman has posted a 78-32 record over the past three-plus seasons and a 40-14 mark in SoCon play since the start of the 2016-17 campaign. Following a run to the 2015 SoCon Tournament finals, Furman went 19-16 during the 2016 season. In 2016-17, the Paladins finished 23-12 overall, claimed a share of the league's regular season title with a 14-4 SoCon worksheet and advanced to the

semifinal round of the CollegeInsider.com Tournament (CIT). The following season, head coach Bob Richey's first year, Furman fashioned a 23-10 overall mark, a then school-record 22 regular season victories and finished third in the league at 13-5. This past season, Richey led Furman to a 25-8 record, 13-5 SoCon mark and its first trip to the NIT since 1991. He has compiled a 55-21 mark since taking over the reigns of the Paladin program and his .724 winning percentage ranks in the top 20 among active NCAA D1 coaches.

♦ Prep standouts Joe Anderson and Garrett Hien signed on November 13, to join the Furman basketball program in 2020-21. Anderson, a point guard out of Maryville High School in Maryville, Tenn., garnered 2018 and 2019 Tennessee Sports Writers Association AAA All-State honors. The Knox News All-PrepXtra first team selection averaged 20.6 points, 4.8 assists and 3.1 steals per game last season. Hien, a 6-foot-9 wing, was a NCISAA AAA All-State pick and All-Metrolina Conference choice last season for Concord First Assembly Academy in Concord, N.C. The versatile Hien averaged 15.5 points, 7.3 rebounds and 5.7 assists per game as a junior.

♦ Sophomore Noah Gurley netted a career-high 25 points to pace the Paladins to an 83-61 victory over Southern Wesleyan on November 15. The Fayetteville, Ga., native connected on all 10 of his field goal attempts to become the second player in school history (Russ Hunt, 14-for-14 vs. App State, Dec. 9, 1971) to record a perfect night from the field on 10 or more attempts.

## HEAD COACH BOB RICHEY

Bob Richey recently completed his second season as head coach of the Furman men's basketball team and his eighth as part of the program.

Under his leadership, the 2018-19 Paladins reached new heights with a school-record 25 wins, including victories over defending national champion and eighth-ranked Villanova and 2018 NCAA Final Four participant Loyola Chicago. Furman finished the season with a 25-8 overall record, 13-5 league mark and earned the school's first trip to the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) since 1991.

Furman's 2019 senior class finished with a school-record 90 wins over four seasons, including a 48-18 overall record and 26-10 Southern Conference mark in Richey's first two seasons. Since the beginning of the 2016-17 campaign, Richey has helped the Paladins to their most successful three-year stretch in program history with a 71-30 overall record that includes a stellar 37-9 worksheet inside Timmons Arena.

Senior Matt Rafferty, who paced the country in win shares and defensive win shares, finished the season as the only player in the SoCon to rank in the top 10 in points (17.5ppg), rebounds (9.0rpg), assists (4.3apg), steals (2.5spg), blocks (1.1bpg) and field goal percentage (61.5%). The first team All-SoCon selection also ranked among the league leaders in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.1) and free throw percentage (76.7%).

Junior Jordan Lyons earned third team All-SoCon honors after a standout season that included a 54-point performance and NCAA record-tying 15 three-point baskets versus North Greenville. Forward Noah Gurley garnered SoCon All-Freshman honors.

In his first season as head coach in 2017-18, Richey guided the Paladins to school record-tying 23-win season that included a then school-record 22 regular season victories. Under his leadership, Furman placed three players on All-Southern Conference teams and the 2018 senior class finished their careers with 76, now third best in school history.

Guard Devin Sibley earned first team All-SoCon honors, while forward Matt Rafferty and guard Daniel Fowler garnered second team all-league accolades. The Paladins ranked second in the SoCon averaging 79.4 points per game and ranked third in scoring defense at 68.5 points per contest. Furman posted a 13-3 home record at Timmons Arena, including a 7-2 mark against SoCon opposition.

"I am excited to have Bob Richey as the face of the Furman program moving forward," said Furman Athletics Director Mike Buddie, at the time of Richey's hiring. "The trajectory of our program is due in large part to Bob's efforts and I know that trajectory will continue in the right direction. After a record-setting season, to be able to maintain continuity is fantastic. Bob is well qualified and will continue to run a program that will make the Furman family extremely proud."

A native of Florence, S.C., Richey, who served six seasons as a member of the Paladin coaching staff before moving into the head coaching role, helped Furman to a school record-tying 23 total victories and 14 Southern Conference wins in 2017, while the program earned a share of its first Southern Conference regular season championship in 21 years and a trip the CollegeInsider.com (CIT) Postseason Tournament semifinals. The 2016-17 Paladins, who also won a school record 12 road games, notched back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time since 1974-75, and captured postseason victories in consecutive seasons for the first time in school history.

"I am truly humbled to be given the opportunity to lead the Furman basketball program moving forward," said Richey, at the time of his hiring. "To have the chance to continue to work at this great university and sustain the relationships I have established is quite an honor. I look forward to continuing the success that we have built on the court, while we recruit and align with the overall mission of Furman University. With our basketball program, outstanding liberal arts degree, beautiful campus, and city, Furman will continue to attract the best student-athletes and prepare them for success in all areas of their lives. We look forward to the days ahead!"

Richey, who has served as position coach for the Paladins' guards since joining the Furman staff prior to the 2011-12 campaign, has recruited and developed back-to-back Southern Conference Players of the Year. Guard Stephen Croone, who finished his Furman career with 1,936 points, earned consensus SoCon Player of the Year honors in 2016 before joining the NBDL's Sioux Falls SkyForce for the 2016-17 season. Junior Devin Sibley followed Croone by earning 2017 SoCon Player of the Year honors, first team All-SoCon accolades, and first team NABC All-District laurels. Sibley was joined on both the All-SoCon squad and NABC All-District Team by fellow Richey recruit Kris Acox, who capped his career with 1,051 points and ranked among the SoCon's top rebounders over the past two seasons.

In 2016, Richey played a key role in Furman's return to the postseason as the Paladins fashioned a 19-16 overall record, finished third in the SoCon with an 11-7 mark, and advanced to the second round of the CIT with a buzzer-beating victory over Louisiana Monroe at Timmons Arena in first round action. Furman won a school record 14 home games, including 11 in a row, while Croone earned player of the year and first team All-SoCon accolades.

The previous season, Richey helped lead the Paladins to their first Southern Conference Tournament finals appearance in 13 years as the Paladins downed No. 2 seed Chattanooga and No. 3 seed Mercer to advance to the league championship game.

Richey's recruits have garnered all-conference honors in nine consecutive seasons, including Furman recruits Stephen Croone (2014, '15, '16 All-SoCon), Kris Acox (2017 All-SoCon), and Devin Sibley (2017 All-SoCon). He has also helped recruit six players over the last five seasons who have garnered SoCon All-Freshman honors, including Sibley, who won 2015 SoCon Freshman of the Year accolades.

An associate head coach for the Charleston Southern Buccaneers during the 2010-11 campaign, Richey helped CSU achieve its highest win total in 14 years in 2011. In five seasons as an assistant at CSU, he recruited five players who went on to garner All-Big South Conference honors, high-

lighted by the school's No. 2 all-time leading scorer Jamarco Warren and 2013 all-league performers Saah Nimley and Arlon Harper. Richey helped the Bucs improve their conference record in each season, culminating with a squad that ranked in the top 50 nationally by averaging 74 points per game in his final season.

During his five years at Charleston Southern, Richey recruited five of the top 11 scorers in CSU history in Warren (1,968 points, 2nd all-time), Nimley (1,866 points, 3rd all-time), Harper (1,633 points, 5th all-time), Kelvin Martin (1,483 points, 8th all-time) and Jeremy Sexton (1,253 points, 11th all-time). Two of his recruits earned Big South Freshman of the Year honors in their rookie seasons, and he placed at least one player on the Big South All-Freshman squad in four consecutive seasons. Basketball analyst Jeff Goodman rated Richey as the No. 4 assistant coach in the Big South Conference in 2010, while Richey also ranked as the youngest coach on the list.

♦ The Paladins posted a dominating victory with a 91-47 triumph at Charleston Southern on November 12. On the strength of 19 points from Clay Mounce and a suffocating defense, Furman raced out to a 48-14 halftime lead before fashioning its largest margin of victory in a road contest since downing College of Charleston, 114-67, in January of 1953.

♦ The opening week of the season featured two big wins for the Paladins. In the season opener, Furman halted Gardner-Webb's 14-game home winning streak with a 70-63 triumph at Paul Porter Arena in Boiling Springs, N.C. Noah Gurley paced the Paladins with 18 points, while Alex Hunter totaled 13 points. Three days later, Furman raised the curtain on its home schedule with a decisive 87-63 victory over 2019 Missouri Valley Conference regular season champion Loyola Chicago. Jordan Lyons poured in 24 points and Clay Mounce added 22 as Furman topped the Ramblers for the second straight season.

♦ Highlighting Furman's list of four returning starters this season is 2019 All-Southern Conference selection, 2020 preseason all-league choice and Lou Henson Award (mid-major POTY) Watch List member Jordan Lyons. The native of Peachtree City, Ga., who was tabbed by Andy Katz as one of the top 25 seniors in college basketball entering this season, averaged 16.2 points per game last year while connecting on a school-record 105 three-point attempts in 33 games. The guard poured in 54 points, the most by an NCAA Division I player since 2009, and matched a Division I record by draining 15 three-pointers as part of a school-record 21 treys by the Paladins in a 107-67 win over North Greenville on November 15, 2018. His 54 points ranked as the eighth highest single-game total in Furman history and most since Darrell Floyd scored 62 versus The Citadel in 1956. In Furman's NIT clash versus Wichita State, Lyons netted 19 points to become the 45th player in school history to surpass 1,000 career points.

♦ Despite returning four starters this season, Furman faces a major task in replacing first team All-SoCon forward Matt Rafferty. The Hinsdale, Ill., native put together one of the most outstanding seasons in school history last year averaging 17.5 points, 9.0 rebounds, 4.3 assists, 2.5 steals and 1.1 blocked shots per game. He became one of just a handful of players in the history of Division I college basketball to average 17 points, nine boards, four assists and two steals per game and was named by Sports Illustrated as one of the top 50 players in college basketball last season. Rafferty finished his career ranked 23rd in school history in scoring (1,340 points), eighth in rebounding (857), sixth in blocked shots (98), fourth in field goal percentage (57.6%), 12th in assists (311) and fourth in steals (186). His field goal percentage of 61.5% last season ranked second best in school history and he established a new school record with 84 steals as a senior. Rafferty and fellow senior Andrew Brown fashioned a new school record by winning 90 games over their four years. Senior Jordan Lyons has helped the Paladins to 78 wins in his first three-plus years at Furman.

♦ Furman opened the 2018-19 season with 12 consecutive wins, which marked the first time the Paladins had won 12 in a row since head coach Lyles Alley's team accomplished the feat during the 1952-53 season and the first time a SoCon team started the season 12-0 since Lefty Driesell's Davidson squad began the 1963-64 campaign at 15-0. The Paladins won a school-record 18 consecutive regular season games during the 2018-19 campaign, beginning with a 76-52 win over Wofford on February 10, 2018, and ending with a 93-50 win versus UNCW on December 15.

♦ The 2018-19 Paladins first garnered national attention on November 9, with a dramatic 60-58 come-from-behind victory at 2018 NCAA Final Four participant and Missouri Valley Conference preseason favorite Loyola Chicago. Trailing by as many as 13 points in the second half, Furman rallied to tie the game and Clay Mounce delivered a win with a slam off of a pass from Matt Rafferty with 1.6 seconds remaining. Mounce's dunk was tabbed as the No. 2 play of the day on SportsCenter's Top 10 and was featured as the lead story by host Scott Van Pelt on the midnight edition of SportsCenter. Rafferty connected on 7-of-16 shots to pace the Paladins with 18 points, seven rebounds, four assists, two blocks and two steals in the victory over the Ramblers.

♦ Junior Jordan Lyons, named the SoCon's Player of the Week on November 20, 2018, poured in 54 points, the most by an NCAA Division I player since 2009, and matched a Division I record by draining 15 three-pointers as part of a school-record 21 treys by the Paladins in a 107-67 win over North Greenville on November 15. Lyons, who matched the three-point mark established by Marshall's Keith Venney in 1996 and tied by Robert Morris' Josh Williams this year, scored 31 points in the first half on nine treys before sinking six more in the second half. His 54 points ranked as the eighth highest single-game total in Furman history and most since Darrell Floyd scored 62 versus The Citadel in 1956. Furman's single-game scoring record of 100 points was set on February 13, 1954, by All-American and NBA No. 1 draft pick Frank Selvy in a 149-95 win over Newberry.

**ORIGIN OF THE PALADIN**

Furman University athletic teams were known by different names until the 1961 school year. The baseball team was "Hornets," the football team "Hurricane," and the basketball team "Paladins."

The basketball team was dubbed "Paladins" by a Greenville sportswriter in the 1930s. By vote of the student body, all Furman athletic teams became the "Paladins" on September 15, 1961. A Paladin is a knight on a horse and the recognized mascot of Furman University's athletic teams.
