» Auburn holds a 13-12 advantage over Arkansas at home all-time, but is 1-5 against the Razorbacks inside Auburn Arena. The win came last year, 88-77.

» The Tigers are not only one of the top offensive teams in the country, Auburn has held eight opponents to under 60 points this season, including three under 50, after allowing under 60 points just twice all of last season (34 games). The Tigers are third in the SEC allowing 67.9 points per game, an improvement of 5.3 points per game from last season. Auburn, who ranks the third in the SEC averaging 81.7 points per game, is the only SEC team ranked in the top 3 of the league in scoring offense and scoring defense.

» Auburn is third overall in the SEC and sixth in conference games averaging 15.2 assists per game games and 13.3 assists per game, respectively. The Tigers are 12-1 this season when they record at least 15 assists and 14-2 when they have more assists than turnovers.

» Auburn is 162-of-218 (74.3 percent) from the charity stripe over the last 11 games after going 188-of-282 (66.7 percent) in the first 14 games of the season. The Tigers have shot at least 75 percent from the line in seven of their last 11 contests after doing so just three times in the first 14 games of the season. Auburn is 10-2 when it shoots more free throws than an opponent and when it outscores an opponent from the line. The Tigers are 10-1 when an opponent attempts fewer than 20 free throws.

» Chuma Okeke has scored in double figures in nine of the last 10 games during which he has averaged 13.2 points, 8.0 rebounds and 1.7 steals per game. He has made a 3-pointer in nine straight games during which he is 14-of-35 (40.0 percent) from long range.

- Bruce Pearl is ranked second in the SEC among current head coaches in career winning percentage (.718), fifth in winning percentage as a SEC head coach (.622), fifth in average wins per year as a SEC head coach (21.0) and fifth in SEC games only win pct. (.540, 81-70)
- Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)
- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the fourth straight time in 2017-18, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came in the 1999-2000 season
- Auburn averaged 8,221 in its 15 home games during the 2017-18 season, which included seven sellouts in the nine SEC games. The 8,221 average is the highest in Auburn Arena history
- In 23 years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 16 times
- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 18 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- In the past two seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 23-3 (.885), while scheduling perennial NCAA Tournament teams in Dayton, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech and UConn.

- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 18 graduates in four years – the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport.
- Auburn recently secured its third perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history.
- In the past four years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940.
- Bruce Pearl has raised \$1 million in only four golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl Fore the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families. Over \$200,000 was raised in the Bruce, Barkley & Basketball Golf Classic Oct. 23-24, 2016, benefitting the Auburn Basketball program.
- Pearl started AURLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AURLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the AURLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease.
- The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015.
- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain.

AUBURN VS. ARKANSAS SERIES

» This is the 53rd all-time meeting between Auburn and Arkansas with the Razorbacks holding a 34-18 series lead. The Tigers lead 13-12 in games played in Auburn, but Arkansas has won five of the six matchups between the two teams at Auburn Arena.

» The two teams have split the last four games in the series after Arkansas had won the previous eight meetings. The series is tied 1-1 in neutral-site games, but Arkansas won the only SEC Tournament game between the two teams 75-67 in the 2000 SEC Tournament Championship.

» Bruce Pearl is 7-6 in his head coaching career against Arkansas, including a 2-3 mark at Auburn. Against the Razorbacks, Pearl is 4-3 at home, 2-2 on the road and 1-1 at neutral locations.

100 SEC WINS ... AND COUNTING

» With a win at Vanderbilt on Feb. 16, Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl picked up his 100th SEC win. Pearl became the 23rd coach in conference history to amass 100 victories and just the fifth to accomplish the feat while coaching two schools.

» The other coaches to have 100 SEC wins while leading two programs include C.M. Newton (195, Alabama and Vanderbilt), Tubby Smith (139, Georgia and Kentucky), Don DeVoe (110, Tennessee and Florida) and John Mauer (103, Tennessee and Florida).

» Coach Pearl is one of just two active coaches to tally 100 conference wins in the league, joining Kentucky head coach John Calipari.

DYNAMIC BACKCOURT

» Auburn has been led so far this season by its dynamic backcourt of Bryce Brown and Jared Harper. The duo is averaging 31.6 points and 6.0 3-point field goals per game. The pair has been even better in conference play, averaging 33.3 points and 6.2 3-pointers on 41.8 percent shooting from deep. Brown (3.4; 2nd) and Harper (2.6; 6th) are the only pair of teammates who rank in

the top six in the SEC in 3-point field goals per game and are also the only duo ranked in the top five in 3-point field goal percentage (Brown 40.5 percent, 4th; Harper 39.2 percent, 5th). They have made 150 3s - more than 34 DI teams.

» The duo has combined for 13 20-point games this season, including Auburn's win over Xavier in the first round of the Maui Invitational when Brown scored 26 and Harper added 25, season highs for each at the time. The pair has each had a 30-plus-point game this season. Against Dayton on Dec. 8, Brown scored a career-high 34 points, including 22 first-half points, on 10-of-18 field goals, 6-of-13 from 3-point range and 8-of-9 from the free-throw line, while Harper added 20 points on 4-of-7 shooting from long range and 6-of-6 from the free-throw line. He also dished out seven assists to just one turnover. In Auburn's win over UAB on Dec. 15, Harper scored a career-high 31 points, including 23 of the Tigers' last 30 points over the final 9:23 of regulation and overtime.

» Brown leads the SEC with 3.73-point FGM and a 45.8 3-point field goal percentage in SEC play, while Harper is fourth at 2.5 3-point FGM and a 37.0 3-point field goal percentage.

» Bryce Brown's 34 points vs. Dayton are the most by a Tiger since Toney Douglas scored 38 points against Nicholls State on Nov. 24, 2004, and are tied with Isaiah Joe of Arkansas for the third-most points scored in the SEC this season. He is sixth in the SEC averaging 16.2 ppg, while Harper is ninth at 15.4 points per game.

DOWNTOWN BRYCE BROWN

» Bryce Brown became Auburn's all-time career 3-point king in the Tigers' final game of the Maui Invitational against Arizona passing the old mark of 262 3-pointers set by Wesley Person. The record breaker came with 5:00 remaining in the game and gave Auburn a 66-51 lead. Brown has now made 326 career 3-pointers, becoming the eighth player to reach 300 career 3-pointers in SEC history in the Tigers' game against Kentucky on Jan 19. At Mississippi State on Jan. 26, he broke a tie with Vanderbilt's John Jenkins for

PLAYER TO WATCH: MALIK DUNBAR

A big reason for Auburn's success this season has been the play from its bench, particularly from Malik Dunbar. In his second season with the Tigers, the senior has increased his scoring output from 5.4 points per game to 7.5, while shooting better from all over the court. Auburn is 10-3 when the North Augusta, S.C. native scores in double figures.

» Against Florida, Brown became the 13th player in Auburn history to reach 1,400 career points. His 1,442 career points rank third among active SEC players. The senior has moved up 22 spots on Auburn's career scoring chart this season.

» Brown scored eight points in his last home game against Ole Miss, snapping a string of 12 straight games in double figures. He averaged 17.8 points per game and shot 48-of-101 (47.5 percent) from 3-point range in those 12 games. The senior made it 13 double figure scoring games in his last 14 contests with 14 points in the Tigers' win at Vanderbilt over the weekend. He has led Auburn in scoring a team-best 12 times this season. Six of his 17 career 20-point games have come this season, including four in Auburn's 12 SEC games this season.

» Brown, who has made at least four 3-pointers in 12 of 25 games this season, is the SEC's fifth-leading scorer in conference play at 17.3 points per game and leads the league in SEC play with 3.7 3s per game and a 45.8 3-point field goal percentage. He averaged 20.3 points and hit 13 3s in three games in the Maui Invitational. Brown extended his own Auburn career record with his 22nd game with at least five made 3s against Alabama on Feb. 2. He has had seven games with at least five 3s this season, including the Tigers' games at Texas A&M on Jan. 16 and against Kentucky on Jan. 19 where he was 11-of-18 from distance. He is second in the SEC averaging 3.4 made 3s per game this season. Since the beginning of last season, he is averaging 17.9 points on 49.2 3-point shooting in SEC home games.

» Brown is 326-of-841 (.388) from 3-point range in his career. His three triples in his last game at Vanderbilt move him ahead of Keenan Carpenter (84 3-point field goals in 1988-89) for seventh on Auburn's single-season 3-pointer list with 85. Brown's three triples at LSU on Feb. 9 gave him 81 on the season, which surpasses his total from his freshman season and Lance Weems in 1994-95 for eighth-most in a season in Auburn history. He is the only player in school history to have three of Auburn's top 10 seasons for 3FGM. Last season, he made 107 triples, coming within one 3-pointer of Lance Weems' school record, and he set an Auburn freshman record with 78 3-pointers in 2015-16.

» Brown is 10th in the SEC shooting 43.2 percent from the field. He is the only player who is ranked in the top 10 in the SEC in field-goal percentage who has taken over half his shots from beyond the arc. For the season, 210 of his 301 (69.8 percent) have been from 3-point range.

CHEF HARPER WITH THE POP, BOY

» Jared Harper, who was named to the Lute Olson Award Mid-Season Watch List earlier this season, scored an SEC career-high 25 points at LSU (7-of-11 FGs, 5-of-8 3s and 6-of-6 FTs) on Feb. 9, and he also registered seven assists against the Bayou Bengals. It is Harper's 17th career 20-point game, including seven this season. He has scored in double figures in 10 of the last 11 games, including leading the Tigers with 16 points and eight assists in their last game at Vanderbilt. The only game he did not score in double figures during that span was in the Tigers' game against Florida on Feb. 5 when he scored eight points in 27 minutes after missing some time in the first half with an ankle injury. He has played at least 30 minutes in Auburn's other 11 SEC games.

OFF THE COURT: ANFERNEE MCLEMORE

Anfernee McLemore is the perfect embodiment of what it means to be a student-athlete at Auburn University. The two-time Academic Top Tiger honoree recently served on the prestigious Southeastern Conference Men's Basketball Leadership Council. He also has logged hours at the "Breakfast Club" where he serves as a role model for young kids in the Auburn community.

» Harper is averaging 16.5 points and 5.6 assists over the last 11 games. He has 1,199 career points and 436 assists (9th all-time at Auburn), becoming the fifth player in Auburn history with 1,100 career points and 400 career assists at Mississippi State on Jan. 26, joining Wes Flanigan, Eddie Johnson, DeWayne Reed and Doc Robinson. Harper, who has made a 3-pointer in 19 straight games, has 180 career 3-point field goals.

» The Tigers' point guard and LSU's Tremont Waters are the only players in the SEC averaging 15 points and six assists per game. He is ninth in the SEC with 15.4 points per game and second in the SEC and 15th nationally with 6.2 assists per game, while playing 33.4 minutes per game, which is fourth in the SEC. He is sixth in the league with an 82.2 free-throw percentage and is fifth shooting 39.2 percent from 3-point range, while making 2.6 shots from long range per game, which is sixth.

» Auburn has scored 396 points off of Harper's assists this season. Harper has made or assisted on 272 of Auburn's 709 made field goals this season (38.4 percent). Harper's 436 career assists lead all SEC players and are seventh among all DI juniors.

» Harper has five career games with double-digit assists, including three this season, and he is third in the SEC with a 2.5 assist-to-turn-over ratio.

Two-thirds of the seats are less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside offering a home environment that is unrivaled.

» Auburn had its 12-game home winning streak snapped with an 82-80 loss to Kentucky on Jan. 19. The streak started with a 76-66 victory over Kentucky on Feb. 14, 2018. TOP OF THE PACK

» Auburn has fared well in the past two-plus seasons in the non-conference slate. The Tigers lead the SEC in both wins and winning percentage in non-league regular-season games over the last two-plus seasons. Auburn is the only SEC team that has won at least 11 regular-season non-conference games in each of the last three seasons. The streak is the longest in school history. The Tigers' 34 non-conference regular-season wins over that span tie a school record for the most nonconference wins over a 3-year span, which was previously set from 1998-2000.

» The Tigers have earned wins vs. notable opponents in Arizona, Dayton (twice), Middle Tennessee, Murray State (twice), Oklahoma, TCU, Texas Tech, UConn (twice), Washington and Xavier (twice).

AUBURN ARENA SELLOUTS

» In its game against Alabama, Auburn welcomed a sellout crowd of 9,121 to Auburn Arena. It is the fourth sellout this season and the 26th in the eight-plus years of the facility. Of the 26 sellouts in Auburn Arena history, 21 have come in the four-plus seasons under head coach Bruce Pearl. Ten of the last 14 SEC games at Auburn Arena have been sold out.

BLOWOUT WINS

» Auburn is 15th in the country with a +13.8 scoring margin. It is the Tigers' best mark through 25 games since the 1998-99 Tigers had a +23.4 scoring margin through the first 25 games. The current margin is on pace to be the third-best scoring margin for a season in program history. Fourteen of Auburn's 17 victories are by double digits, and eight are by at least 20 points. The Tigers' 17 wins are by an average of 23.3 points. Auburn has 33 double-digit wins since the start of last season, which is six more double-digit wins than the Tigers' had in the previous five seasons combined and is more than the overall win total of six SEC teams since the start of last season. Auburn leads the SEC with 16 double-digit wins in league play since the start of the 2017-18 season.

» All six of Auburn's SEC victories have been by 11 or more points and are by an average of 19.0 points, including the Tigers' 92-58 victory over Missouri on Jan. 30, which is tied for the Tigers' 12th-largest margin of victory in an SEC game in program history and the 17th time Auburn has defeated an SEC opponent by at least 30 points. The Tigers followed its victory in the battle of the Tigers with an 84-63 victory over Alabama. It is the first time the Tigers have won consecutive SEC games by at least 20 points since winning four straight conference games by 20-plus points from Feb. 3-13, 1999. The Tigers' 34-point victory over Missouri is Auburn's largest SEC win since the Tigers defeated Alabama 102-61 on Feb. 13, 1999, and the largest margin of victory in an SEC game in the history of Auburn Arena. After its 41-point victory over Alabama in the 1999 regular season, the Tigers defeated the Crimson Tide 93-61 in the SEC Tournament.

» Sixteen of Auburn's 19 SEC wins since the start of last season have been by double digits, including all six this season. The Tigers had 13 double-digit SEC wins in the previous eight years combined.

GLASS EATERS

» Auburn is averaging 13.3 offensive rebounds per game, which is 14th nationally, leading to an average of 12.6 second-chance points per game (316 in 25 games). Four times this season Auburn has outrebounded an opponent by 15, including 50-33 against Texas A&M, and has won the rebounding battle in 14 of 25 games. The Tigers are 13-1 in those games. Auburn has pulled down at least 15 offensive rebounds in 10 of 25 games this season.

» Chuma Okeke (2.8; leads the SEC), Horace Spencer (2.2), Austin Wiley (1.9), Anfernee McLemore (1.3) and Samir Doughty (1.2) lead Auburn in offensive rebounding.

KEEP IT 100

» Auburn scored 103 points vs. Mississippi College, the most points for the Tigers since a 119-85 victory over Winthrop last year. It is the second time the Tigers have reached the century mark this season after defeating South Alabama 101-58 and the seventh time in 157 games under head coach Bruce Pearl. Prior to Pearl's arrival, Auburn hadn't scored 100 points in the previous 337 games since a 105-66 victory over Grambling State Nov. 29, 2003.

BALANCED SCORING

» Auburn is third in the SEC and 24th nationally averaging 81.7 points per game because of a balanced attack that has six Tigers averaging at least 7.5 points per game including Bryce Brown (16.2), Jared Harper (15.4), Chuma Okeke (11.2), Austin Wiley (8.7), Samir Doughty (7.6) and Malik Dunbar (7.5).

» Six times this season Auburn has had at least five players score in double figures. Nine different Tigers have scored in double figures at least once this season. Auburn has topped the 80-point plateau in 14 of 25 games, plus AU has surpassed the 90-point mark seven times and has scored 100-plus twice. The Tigers are 12-2 when scoring at least 80 points. Auburn is on pace to be the seventh-highest scoring team in program history.

» Auburn is fourth nationally, and first among power conference teams, forcing 18.3 turnovers per game. The Tigers have forced at least 20 turnovers nine times this season. Auburn is forcing an average of 20.1 turnovers per game at home (282 in 14 home games). Auburn is averaging 13.1 turnovers and is third in the country with a plus-5.2 turnover margin.

» The Tigers are outscoring their opponents 23.4-12.3 on points off turnovers (586-307). Auburn has scored at least 20 points off turnovers 14 times this season (13-1 record), 30 points off turnovers eight times (8-0 record) and topped the 40-point plateau for the first time in their last

RETURN TO SENDER

» Auburn is eighth nationally averaging 5.2 blocked shots per game. This is on the heels of the Tigers setting a new program record with 180 blocks last season. Auburn has 131 blocked shots this season, which is 10th-most in program history. The Tigers have had four of its program's top-11 single-season block totals during Bruce Pearl's five seasons on the Plains. [1. 180, 2017-18; 3. 162, 2016-17; 10. 131, 2018-19; 11. 126, 2015-16]. Auburn and Tennessee are the only DI teams with two players with at least 140 career blocks as the Tigers currently have two of the program's top six all-time shot blockers on their roster.

» Horace Spencer blocked two shots against Missouri on Jan. 30 to become the fourth player to record 150 career blocks all-time at Auburn. Spencer's 154 career blocks are 29th among all active D1 players. Anfernee McLemore blocked a shot at Mississippi State on Jan. 26 to break a tie with Chris Morris for sixth on Auburn's career blocked shots chart, and his 143 career blocked shots are eighth among all active D1 juniors.

MAKE IT RAIN ON 'EM

» Auburn, which leads the SEC and is sixth nationally with 11.0 made 3s per game and also leads the league with a 37.3 3-point field goal percentage, has made 274 3-pointers this season, which is fifth on the school's single-season 3-point field goal list, after passing the 2009-10 Tigers (271 3-point field goals) and the 2015-16 Tigers (272 3-point field goals) in its last game at Vanderbilt. The Tigers lead the league with 11.5 3-pointers (138-of-345) and is second with a 40.0 percent 3-point field goal percentage in SEC play. To put in perspective how many more 3-pointers the Tigers have made than any other team in the SEC, if Auburn did not make a 3-point field goal in the next six games, the Tigers would be averaging 8.84 3s per game, which is still more than Florida, which currently ranks second in the SEC with 8.64 treys per game.

» Auburn is on pace to break the current SEC record of 10.04 3-pointers made per game by Kentucky in 1990 by almost 1.0 3-point per game. The Tigers have made double-digit 3-pointers in 15 of 25 games this season, including eight of 12 SEC games. Auburn's 274 3-point field goals put the Tigers 21 ahead of last year's squad's program record 253 3s through 25 games. Last year's Tigers went on to set a program single-season record with 324 3-pointers.

» The Tigers have made double-digit 3s in 60 of 157 games (38.2 percent) under head coach Bruce Pearl. Prior to Pearl's arrival, the Tigers had just 124 games with at least 10 3s in 855 games since the creation of the 3-point shot in college basketball for the 1986-87 season (14.5 percent).

» Auburn has four games this season with at least 15 3-pointers, including 16 3s against Missouri on Jan. 30 and at LSU on Feb. 9, which is one off the school record for 3-pointers in an SEC game (17 vs. Vanderbilt in 2018). The Tigers have 13 games with at least 15 3-point field goals all-time, including nine under head coach Bruce Pearl.

» At 11.0 3-pointers per game, Auburn is on pace to finish with the 25th-best mark in NCAA history for 3s made per game in a season. The Tigers are currently on pace to be the only SEC and Power 5 team ever to total 11.0 3-pointers per game in a season.

HALF A HUNDRED

» Auburn's 58-point effort in the second half against Missouri on Jan. 30 is a season high for points in a half for the Tigers and is the eighth time this season Auburn has scored 50 points in a half. It is the most points for the Tigers in a half of an SEC game since Auburn scored 64 points in the second half at Tennessee on Feb. 15, 2006.

Auburn has had a 50-point half in eight of its 14 home games and are 7-1 when scoring 50 points in a half. Auburn has scored 50 points in a half 20 times since the start of the 2017-18 season.

STRONG BENCH PRODUCTION

» The Tigers have scored at least 20 bench points 12 times, 30 bench points seven times and 40 bench points three times this season. Malik Dunbar, who scored 13 points in Auburn's last game at Vanderbilt, leads the Tigers with 10 games in double figures off the bench after having just three double-digit scoring games all of last season. Dunbar has scored in double figures four times in Auburn's first 12 SEC games after scoring in double figures just once in SEC play last season.

» Twenty-one times Auburn has had a player score double figures coming off the bench. Horace Spencer recorded his first career double-double with 14 points and 17 rebounds against Mississippi College coming off the bench. J'Von McCormick scored a career-high 14 points on 6-of-7 shooting to go with three assists, three steals and two rebounds at N.C. State. On average, Auburn outscore its opponents' bench, 24.3-17.4 (608-436).

STEALING THE SHOW

» Auburn is averaging 9.1 steals per game, which is second in the SEC and ninth nationally. The Tigers have recorded at least 10 steals in a game 11 times this season (10-1 record), including 20 in their last nonconference game against North Florida on Dec. 29, which is one off the school record of 21 steals against Louisiana-Monroe on Dec. 6, 2008. Auburn had three straight double-digit steals games from 12/19-12/29. Auburn's 13 steals against Alabama on Feb. 2 are its most in an SEC game since the Tigers registered 14 steals against the Crimson Tide last season. The Tigers are eighth nationally averaging 5.2 blocked shots per game. Auburn and Duke are the only two teams in the country that are in the top 10 in blocked shots and steals per game.

» Auburn is led by Chuma Okeke, who is tied for seventh in the SEC with 1.7 steals per game, and Samir Doughty, who is averaging 1.4 steals per game. Okeke has nine games with at least three steals this season (7-2 record), including three in the last five games.

TIGERS IN OVERTIME

» Auburn is 2-0 this season in overtime games. The Tigers defeated Xavier 88-79 on Nov. 19 in the first round of the Maui Invitational and defeated UAB 75-71 in Birmingham's Mike Slive Invitational in their last game. Prior to this season, Auburn's last overtime game was against Missouri in the 2017 SEC Tournament and its last OT win was at UConn on Dec. 23, 2016. Jared Harper has scored 15 of the Tigers' 23 points in overtime this season. Harper scored five of Auburn's 11 points in the extra period against Xavier and then notched 10 of the Tigers' 12 points in the extra session against UAB.

» Auburn is 5-2 in overtime under head coach Bruce Pearl, picking up wins against Xavier and LSU (2014-15), UConn (2016-17) and Xavier and UAB (2018-19).

NBA SETTING UP CAMP IN AUBURN

» Head coach Bruce Pearl brought the first-ever Pro Day to Auburn last year. The Tigers completed their second consecutive session in front of NBA scouts and executives in October.

» Between the two one-day events, 59 scouts came to watch Auburn's players go through drills and scrimmage live to showcase their talents.

LOCKDOWN DEFENSE

Auburn has ramped up its efforts on the defensive end during the 2018-19 season. Below is a list of the opponents' points per game entering the matchup and what Auburn allowed.

In its last game, Auburn held Vanderbilt to 53 points on 33.3 percent shooting from the field. The Commodores' 53 points are the fewest by a Tigers' SEC opponent since Auburn defeated Alabama 49-37 on Feb. 6, 2013. The Tigers are 14-1 this season when they hold an opponent to fewer than 75 points and 13-3 when they hold an opponent to under 45 percent shooting. Auburn has held five its last six opponents to 63 or fewer points and have held 13 opponents to fewer than 70 points after holding just 10 opponents to under 70 points in 2017-18 (34 games). Prior to holding Vanderbilt to 53 points over the weekend, Missouri's 58 points on Jan. 30 were the fewest for an Auburn SEC opponent since the Tigers held Alabama to 57 points on Jan. 24, 2015.

Seventeen times this season Auburn has held an opponent to under its scoring average entering the game, including each of the last six games. Eleven times the Tigers have held an opponent to more than 10 points under its season average.

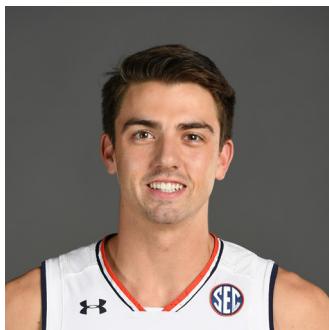

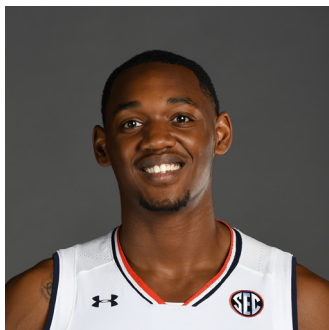
