» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn's 14-game winning streak is the second longest streak in the country and tied for the fifth longest streak in program history.
- The Tigers have outscored their opponents 99-38 during the streak.
- The team's 19 wins and .905 winning percentage are tied for fourth in the country this season.
- Auburn's 19-2 start is tied with the 1999 and 2018 teams for the second best record through 21 games in program history.
- The Tigers would become the third team in program history joining the 1997 and 1999 teams to start a season 20-2 with a win Friday.
- The Tigers have won back-to-back series in Starkville for the first time since winning three straight road series against the Bulldogs from 1993-97.
- Auburn and Mississippi State have each won 99 games since the start of the 2017 season.
- The 99 wins since in the last two-plus seasons are tied for the fourth most in the conference.
- Tanner Burns makes his 23rd straight start in an Auburn uniform this weekend.



Butch Thompson enters his fourth season at the helm of the program in 2019. Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to the Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his fourth season with the Tigers in 2019.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

Widely regarded as one of the premier pitching coaches in the country, he has seen 14 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including eight since 2014. Thompson has also turned 29 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a firstround selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 12 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008.


A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 26 Division I All-Americans and 38 all-conference performers. He has made 16 postseason appearances, including seven trips to the College World Series, and guided Birmingham-Southern to a NAIA National Championship in 2001 and was a national runner-up at Mississippi State in 2013.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has already made his mark in his first three seasons at Auburn as he became the fourth head coach in program history to notch his 100th win in his third season at the helm. Thompson has guided the Tigers to a 103-82 overall record and has taken the team to back-to-back NCAA regionals for the first time in 15 years. After tying the 2010 team for the most wins (43) in a season since 1999 and advancing to its first super regional since that same season, Auburn's 2018 team finished the year ranked No. 9 by USA TODAY, marking the program's highest ranking to end a season since 1998.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of the last four seasons, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent five seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World



Series in 2004. While there he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a thirdplace finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games, four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.

He earned a bachelor's degree in history at BSC in 1992 and completed a master's degree in sports administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters --- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail.

NEWS & NOTES

UP NEXT

• The Tigers take on Alabama (18-4, 1-2 SEC) in the 11th annual Capital City Classic at Riverwalk Stadium in Montgomery, Alabama, next Tuesday at 6:30 p.m. CT. The game will be broadcast on SEC Network.

SCOUTING THE BULLDOGS

- Mississippi State is 20-2 overall and 2-1 in conference play after winning its SEC opening series at Florida last weekend.
- · On the mound, Mississippi State has turned in the fifth best ERA in the country at 2.27. The Bulldogs have recorded 10 or more strikeouts in 19 of 22 games played this season. Mississippi State also ranks first in strikeouts per nine innings (11.9), second in strikeout-to-walk ratio (4.60) and third in WHIP (0.99).
- Offensively, Mississippi State is in the top five in the country in hits (244) and doubles (58). Senior outfielder Jake Mangum leads the team in batting average (.406), runs (25), hits (39) and doubles (10). Mangum recently moved into the top 15 on the SEC's all-time hits leaderboard.

WWWWWWWWWWWWIN STREAK

- Auburn's 14-game winning streak is the second longest in the country and tied for the fifth longest in program history.
- The Tigers would tie for the third longest winning streak
- in program history with a win Friday (1967 and 2018). · The program's longest winning streak stands at 17 straight games to start the 1997 season.

TURNING BACK THE CLOCK

- Auburn has won 99 games dating back to the start of the 2017 season, and the team's 80 wins from 2017-18 marked
- the most wins since winning 87 games from 1999-2000. • The Tigers 99 wins are tied with Mississippi State and
- Texas A&M for the fourth most in the SEC during the span
- Florida (117), Arkansas (111), LSU (107). Auburn's 19 wins and .905 winning percentage this


season are tied for the fourth best in the country.

- **SHUTTING 'EM OUT** • Auburn is tied for the national lead with six shutouts this season, all of which came in a 10-game span, and the
- team's 2.11 ERA leads the country. • The Tigers six shutouts are already one more than last season and the seventh most in a single-season in
- program history. The single-season record is nine in 1988. • The Tigers didn't allow a run in 33.1 innings from Mar. 6-9, marking a program record in the category.

SHOVING IT IN THE STRIKE ZONE

- Auburn's pitching staff also ranks in the top 10 in walks allowed per nine innings (2.76; 6th), WHIP (1.05; 7th) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.52; 8th).
- Starting pitchers have struck out 117 batters and issued 23 walks in 90.1 innings of work this season.
- The Tigers have struck out 211 batters through 21 games. It marks the second highest strikeout total through 21 games in the Stat Crew era (1993). The 1997 team struck out 246 batters through 21 games and went on to set the single-season record with 629 strikeouts.
- The team has walked just two batters in a three-game series on two occasions this season. The two walks issued against Cincinnati and UTSA are the fewest walks issued in a series since 1995.







PUTTING 'EM IN MOTION

- Auburn has stolen 40-of-44 bases this season and ranks 22nd in the country in the category.
- The Tigers stole 26 straight bases from Feb. 19-Mar. 17 and are 34 for the last 35.
- The team's six stolen bases in the series finale vs. Tennessee were the most in a game since 2016, and the 11 stolen bases in the series were the most in a series in the Stat Crew era (1993). They were also the most in a three-game span since 2012.
- The 40 stolen bases are the most through 21 games since the team stole 57 bases in the first 21 games of 2012. The total is also just 10 shy of the team's total in 66 games a season ago.
- Eleven players, including all nine members of Auburn's regular starting lineup, have stolen a base this season.

TB&J

- Tanner Burns and Jack Owen are a combined 6-0 with a 0.43 ERA this season.
- The sophomore duo has turned in a 0.61 WHIP and have struck out 81 batters while issuing just seven walks n 52.1 innings.
- Burns and Owen have allowed just one earned run in their last 46.0 combined innings pitched.
- They earned back-to-back SEC Pitcher of the Week honors after turning in the only two complete-game shutouts in the SEC this season.
- Burns and Owen also rank first and second in the SEC in ERA and WHIP this season.

THE DOCTOR WILL SEE YOU NOW

- Burns was named the SEC Pitcher of the Week, the NCBWA and Perfect Game/Rawlings National Pitcher of the Week, and the Golden Spikes Award Performer of the Week after tossing a complete-game shutout and matching the Auburn single-game record with 15 strikeouts vs. Cincinnati on Mar. 1.
- Burns hasn't allowed a run and has 34 strikeouts and just two walks in his last three starts and 22.2 IP. He is just an inning shy of tying Keegan Thompson's consecutive scoreless inning streak.
- In his last nine starts, Burns is 6-0 with a 1.23 ERA (8 ER in 58.1 IP).

TAKING THE NEXT STEP

- Owen made it back-to-back SEC Pitchers of the Week for the Tigers after turning in a complete-game shutout vs. UTSA on Mar. 9.
- Owen needed just 98 pitches to get through the game, marking the fewest pitches in a complete-game effort since Keegan Thompson finished a game in 90 pitches in 2014.
- Owen didn't allow a run in 20.2 innings prior to last Saturday and set the program record with 28.2 innings without alowing an earned run dating back to last season.

IT'S GOTTA BE THE NUMBER

- Casey Mize and Tanner Burns have served as Auburn's ace in the last two seasons and have both worn jersey number 32.
- Here is a comparison of their stats through non-conference play:

Casey Mize (2018): 5-0, 1.93 ERA, 32.2 IP, 15 H, 3 BB, 51 K, .134 B/AVG

Tanner Burns (2019): 3-0, 0.54 ERA, 33.1 IP, 15 H, 5 BB, 48 K, .133 B/AVG

SEC OPENERS

- Auburn has won each of its last three SEC opening series and is 8-1 in the nine games.
- The Tigers have won all four SEC opening games under head coach Butch Thompson.

LATE-INNING LEAD

- Auburn is 17-0 when leading after seven and 19-0 when leading after eight this season.
- The Tigers are 102-8 when ahead after seven and 118-6 when ahead after eight under head coach Butch Thompson.
- Conversely, Auburn is 0-1 when trailing after seven and 0-2 when trailing after eight this season. The Tigers are 7-63 and 2-67, respectively, under Coach Thompson.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- Auburn started the 2018 season 15-0, marking the second-best start in program history, and went 22-4 overall in non-conference play, including 11-1 on the weekend.
- Dating back to the 2017 season, the Tigers are 55-14 in the non-conference and 31-6 against non-conference foes on the weekend.

CONFERENCE SLATE

- Nine of Auburn's 10 SEC series are against teams that currently rank in the top 25 of at least one poll, and eight of the team's conference series are against NCAA Regional teams from a year ago, including four NCAA Super Regional teams and two teams that advaned to the College World Series in Arkansas and Mississippi State.
- The Tigers five road trips in league play are to Mississippi State, South Carolina, Texas A&M, Vanderbilt and LSU. All Five teams made the 2018 NCAA Tournament and three Mississippi State, South Carolina and Vanderbilt advanced to a super regional.

WOAH-LEY

- Rankin Woley leads the team in batting average (.325), hits (27) and doubles (seven) while rankings second in RBI (21) and tied for third on the team in runs (16).
- Woley was named a NJCAA First Team All-American in 2018 and set the Chattahoochee Valley single-season record for hits (93), doubles (27) and RBI (93).

DYNAMIC BULLPEN DUO

- Cody Greenhill and Elliott Anderson have made a combined 17 relief appearances this season and have posted a combined 1.30 ERA in 34.2 innings pitched.
- Anderson didn't allow a run in his first 13.1 innings this season and 15.2 innings dating back to last season. He has struck out 24 batters in 19.0 innings pitched and is holding opponents to a .200 average.
- Greenhill, who was to the 2019 NCBWA Preseason Stopper of the Year watch list, leads the team with three saves and is holding hitters to a .204 average.

CANADIAN CRUSHER

- Edouard Julien drove in the game-tying and go-ahead runs in the bottom of the eighth inning vs. Tennessee Sunday and has driven in two runs in each of the last three games.
- Julien broke Frank Thomas' freshman RBI record and led the SEC and all freshmen nationally with 69 RBI a season ago.
- He has recorded 22 HR and 91 RBI in his first 82 games at Auburn.

HOME SWEET HOME


- Auburn went 29-6 in games played at Plainsman Park last season, marking the most home wins in a season since 1997 (30) and the second-most home wins all-time.
- The Tigers are 44-7 at home since the start of the 2018 season and 67-20 at home since 2017.

CORE POWER

- The Tigers return 41 home runs between the core trio of Julien (17), Will Holland (12) and Williams (12). The 41 home runs between the three players are the most among any returning trio in the SEC this season.
- Julien, Holland and Williams also drove in a combined 172 runs last season, totaling 16 more RBI than any other returning trio in the SEC this season.

WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE

- The team's 43 returning home runs are the most since 2011 (62) and its 214 RBI are the most since 2016 (246).
- The Tigers also bring back 156 appearances, 25 wins, 362.0 innings pitched and 330 strikeouts. Those are the highest totals returning since 2016, 2014, 2014 and 2012, respectively.







THE GABE GROSS EFFECT

• In its first season under hitting coach Gabe Gross, Auburn set a program record for hitby-pitches (84) and ranked in the top 10 in program history in a number of additional offensive categories.

 Burns and Holland garnered a wealth of preseason recognition, including becoming the first Auburn duo to be named to the Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list in the same season.

 Burns: Preseason First Team All-SEC, Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list, Second Team Preseason All-American by D1 Baseball, Third Team Preseason All-American by Collegiate Baseball.

 Holland: Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list, Second Team Preseason All-American by Perfect Game, Third Team All-American by D1 Baseball and NCBWA.

BIG LEAGUE TIGERS

• In 2018, former Auburn pitcher Trey Wingenter became the 51st player in Auburn history to appear in the Major Leagues. He made his debut for the New York Yankees on July 14. Cooper, who has since been traded to the Miami Marlins, joined Toronto's Josh Donaldson and Los Angeles' Grant Dayton as former Tigers in the big leagues last season. Dayton has also since been traded to the Atlanta Braves.

TIGERS IN THE DRAFT

• Auburn had seven players selected in the 2018 MLB Draft, including the program's first No. 1 overall draft pick in Casey Mize.

• The seven players drafted were the most in a season since 2010 (11) and tied for the second most in program history.

 The Tigers have had multiple players drafted every year since 2006 and at least one player selected for 44 straight years, which is tied for the longest streak in the SEC.

PACKED HOUSE

• Auburn sold a record number of season tickets in 2019 (2,163), which surpassed its previous record of 1,991 tickets sold a season ago.


• The Tigers have welcomed 50, 885 fans through the gates of Plainsman Park this season, which ranks 12th in the country.

• Auburn has 11 players on its team that chose to attend Auburn rather than sign a professional contract, including four freshmen from the 2018 draft in June.


