ABOUT AUBURN

- Alabama and Auburn will meet for the 296th time in series history when the two teams square off on Tuesday night. The contest in Montgomery will be the 11th all-time meeting in the MAX Capital City Classic at Riverwalk Stadium, with the Tigers holding a 9-1 advantage in the non-conference series.
- The two teams last met from April 20-21, 2018, in Tuscaloosa. The Crimson Tide suffered a series sweep at the hands of 25th-ranked Auburn across Friday night and a Saturday doubleheader. Alabama and Auburn's last MAX Capital City Classic pairing saw the Tigers come away with a 5-2 win on March 27, 2018.
- Butch Thompson is in his fourth year leading the Auburn program, sporting a 103-82 record entering the 2019 campaign, and is in his fifth season overall as a head coach, coming into the new year with a 142-94 career mark. A graduate of Birmingham-Southern, Thompson is assisted by Karl Nonemaker and Gabe Gross along with volunteer assistant Steve Smith
- Auburn returns 15 letterwinners, including six positional starters and nine pitchers, from the 2018 team that finished 43-23 overall and 15-15 in SEC action to finish third in the West. AU advanced to an NCAA Super Regional a season ago, falling to the Florida Gators, 2-1, in Gainesville The 2019 roster is without 14 lettermen from last year's squad, a number that includes four positional starters and five pitchers. The 2019 Tigers roster features 19 newcomers.
- The Tigers were selected to finish fourth in the West and seventh overall in the SEC in the league's preseason poll, as voted on by the conference's head coaches.

SCOUTING ALABAMA

- Alabama closed out the week at 2-2 once again, pitching two shutouts across the Tide's four games at Sewell-Thomas Stadium. The first blanking came against Maine on Tuesday by a score of 16-0. UA's second shutout win of the week came on Saturday, as the Crimson Tide held ninth-ranked Arkansas off the board for a 10-0 victory.
- The Tide recorded a season high for runs in the 16-0 shutout win over the Maine Black Bears on Tuesday. Alabama's bats collected 16 hits and 11 walks on the way to a season-high 16 runs.
- UA saw eight of its nine starters record at least one hit, led by three-hit performances from sophomore Tyler Gentry and freshman Drew Williamson. Gentry closed out his night at 3-for-5, just a triple short of the cycle, and added two RBI and a team-high tying three runs scored. Williamson was a perfect 3-for-3 and contributed two runs scored, with his three-hit performance setting a new season-high total for the first-year starter.
- Joining Gentry with a home run was junior **Morgan McCullough** and freshman **T.J. Reeves**. McCullough's home run was a solo shot, his first of the season, while Reeves kept his in the park for the Tide's first inside-the-park home run since 2015. The freshman also contributed three RBI, a pair of walks and three runs.
- On the hill, the Tide used five arms to secure the shutout victory. In total, the Alabama pitchers struck out 13 while walking only four with each arm collecting at least one strikeout by night's end. Freshman Tyler Ras led the way, earning the win with a career-long 5.0 innings of three-hit baseball. The right-hander walked only one while striking out five before handing it over
- · Alabama suffered a 12-3 loss at the hands of ninth-ranked Arkansas on Friday. The Razorbacks scored one in the first before putting up six in the second and another single tally in the third to put the game out of reach. Arkansas widened their lead with two apiece in both the eighth and the ninth to end their scoring at 12. Alabama was able to post three runs in the ninth, but the late rally was not enough in the end.
- The Crimson Tide turned the tables on Saturday, blanking the Razorbacks by a score of 10-0. Alabama excelled on both sides of the ball, posting 10 runs while shutting out the high-powered Razorback offense. All nine Crimson Tide starters reached base safely, with eight of the nine collecting at least one RBI and seven of the starters recording one or more runs scored.
- Keith Holcombe finished his day at 2-for-5 with a double and his third home run of the season. The senior added one RBI and a team-high tying two runs scored. Also recording two hits was *Kolby Robinson*, with the junior going 2-for-5 and crossing a team-high three RBI to go with his one run scored.
- On the mound, redshirt junior **Brock Love** earned his third win of the season thanks to a career-long 5.1 scoreless frames. The right-hander allowed two hits and three walks while striking out one across his 83 pitches before turning it over to the bullpen. Brock Guffey followed, with the sophomore matching his career-long for innings at 2.2 before freshman Connor Shamblin closed things out with a scoreless ninth.
- The Crimson Tide fell to Arkansas by a score of 10-2 on Sunday afternoon. The Razorbacks got on the board first with two runs apiece in the first and third frames. Alabama cut the early lead in half with a two-run fourth, but four runs in the fifth and another pair in the eighth secured the series-clinching win for the Hogs.
- Alabama returned 13 letterwinners while losing 18 from the 2018 squad. The 2019 Crimson Tide welcomed back three positional starters and two starting pitchers while hosting 22 newcomers.

CAPITAL CITY CLASSIC SERIES HISTORY

- · Alabama and Auburn will meet again in the MAX Credit Union Capital City Classic, the 11th time in the history of the event. · Auburn leads the all-time Capital City Classic, going 9-1 across the first 10 contests. Below is a recap of all 10 games:
 - + 2018: Auburn 5, Alabama 2

Auburn put up a four-spot in the second to put the game out of reach. The Tide battled for one in the sixth but was matched by the Tigers' one tally in the seventh. Alabama scored one more in the top of the eighth and had the tying run at the plate but was unable to come away with the win

+ 2017: Auburn 4, Alabama 3

The Tigers took an early 3-0 lead in the third, but Alabama answered with single tallies in the third, fourth and fifth frames to make it a 3-3 contest. One run in the top of the sixth by Auburn ended the night's scoring and helped AU claim the one-run win in Montgomery.

+ 2016: Auburn 10, Alabama 1

Alabama had run scoring opportunities in each of the first three innings but could not hold off the AU offense from building a 7-1 lead over that time. The Tigers notched single tallies in the fourth, fifth and sixth innings for the win.

+ 2015: Auburn 5, Alabama 3

The Tigers received a solid start from Keegan Thompson, with the righty tossing 7.1 frames and allowing three runs with 12 strikeouts. UA rallied in the ninth, bringing the go-ahead run to the plate but could not score.

+ 2014: Alabama 4, Auburn 3

The Tide scored the game-winning run in the top of the ninth on a bunt from Ben Moore that led to an errant throw to first Alabama's Thomas Burrows was named MVP for his 3.0 scoreless innings pitched.

+ 2013: Auburn 6, Alabama 3

Alabama committed three errors, leading to four unearned runs for Auburn.

+ 2012: Auburn 8. Alabama 3

Auburn put the game out of reach with three runs in the eighth inning to move ahead by five for the eventual 8-3 final. + 2011: Auburn 2, Alabama 1

The Tigers and Tide were knotted up at 1-1 until a two-out double in the second inning gave Auburn the final lead.

+ 2010: Auburn 8, Alabama 6

The score stayed at 5-4 from the fourth inning until the seventh, when an RBI single to center widened the gap for AU. + 2009: Auburn 8, Alabama 7

Auburn scored two runs in the ninth inning to erase a one-run deficit en route to an 8-7 win over Alabama.

ALABAMA FIRST PITCH - MACK WILSON

- Former Alabama football linebacker Mack Wilson will be throwing tonight's ceremonial first pitch.
- Wilson, a Montgomery native who attended Carver High School, starred at The University of Alabama each of the last three seasons.
- He earned second team All-America accolades in 2018 and was an All-SEC second team selection while also being tabbed a semifinalist for the Butkus Award as a junior.
- Wilson totaled 119 tackles for his career across 42 games of action, including 17 starts, and earned two SEC Championship titles to go with one national championship in 2017.
- Regarded as one of the top linebacker prospects coming out of college this season. Mack is currently preparing for the NFL Draft.

FREE PASSES

- The Crimson Tide has been patient at the plate in 2019, drawing 157 total walks through 25 games to average 6.3 free passes per game. At the current rate, Alabama would finish the regular season with 352 walks, which would come close to matching the program record of 367 from the 1999 season and be well past last year's total of 270.
- Alabama's walk total leads the SEC and is fourth nationally. The current Division I leader is Florida State at 168.
- Junior Morgan McCullough and freshman Drew Williamson share the Alabama lead in walks with 22 to tie for 24th in the country and fourth in the league. Tied for 13th in the conference in walks is junior Justin King who has accumulated 18 free passes to rank second on the Tide.
- The Tide has also been hit by 29 pitches this season, tied for fifth in the conference and 73rd nationally.
- · Senior Keith Holcombe has been plunked by six pitches to rank 10th in the SEC while junior Brett Auerbach along with senior Joe Breaux have each recorded five to tie for 11th in the SEC.
- The combined free passes have helped Alabama maintain a team on-base percentage of .405. That mark is third in the league and 16th in the country.
- Williamson leads the Tide starters in OBP at .477 which is seventh in the SEC. Right behind him is Holcombe at .473, a total that ranks ninth in the league.

CRIMSON TIDE ARMS STARTING STRONG

- Alabama's pitching staff has put together a strong start to the 2019 campaign. The Tide arms have maintained a 2.92 ERA (74 ER/228.0 IP), good for 17th nationally and fifth in the Southeastern Conference.
- UA's pitching staff has combined for 226 strikeouts compared to only 74 walks. The 3.05 strikeout-to-walk ratio is fourth in the league and places the Tide at No. 16 in Division I. Alabama's lowly walk total per nine innings of 2.92 is third in the SEC and ranks 12th nationally.
- The Tide pitchers have also limited opposing hitters to a .224 average and allowed 48 extra-base hits (35 doubles, three triples, 10 home runs) in 25 games. Alabama has allowed 7.42 hits per nine innings to rank seventh in the SEC and 32nd overall in Division I
- Alabama pitchers also sport a 1.15 WHIP (walks + hits / innings pitched), a total that is sixth in the SEC and 16th nationally.

ALABAMA BULLPEN HOLDING TOUGH IN 2019

- The Crimson Tide bullpen had a solid season in 2018 and has carried that success over into the new campaign.
- Alabama's 2019 bullpen holds a 2.62 ERA (38 ER/130.2 IP) and has limited opposing hitters to a .214 average. The Tide relievers have collected 136 strikeouts and issued only 49 walks for a 2.78 strikeout-to-walk ratio.
- In total, 15 arms have made a relief appearance with only senior Sam Finnerty not making an appearance out of the pen.
- Six of those 15 relievers sport a perfect 0.00 ERA with all but six relief arms holding an ERA of 2.00 or below.
- Graduate Jeremy Randolph is tied for the team lead in relief outings (9) and maintains a perfect 0.00 ERA (13.2 IP). The Tide closer has punched out 24 batters and allowed just one extra-base hit - a double. Randolph leads all relievers in strikeouts and has four saves in as many chances, a total that is tied for seventh among SEC relievers.
- Following closely behind Randolph in innings is redshirt junior Davis Vainer with 13.0. The right-hander holds a 0.00 ERA (13.0 IP) across his seven appearances and has struck out 16 compared to four walks while limiting opposing hitters to a 0.71 average, the lowest among all relief arms for the Crimson Tide.

THE TIDE DEFENSE HAS BEEN IMPRESSIVE

- Alabama's defense has played a key role in helping the team get off to an 19-6 start to the 2019 season.
- The Crimson Tide currently sports a .982 fielding percentage, good for second in the SEC and sixth in Division I.
- UA has 684 putouts and 201 assists with only 16 errors across 901 total chances.
- The Tide has also fielded 17 double plays on the season to tie for third in the conference. Second baseman Morgan McCullough and first baseman Drew Williamson are tied with 14 double plays turned to pace UA and tie for second in the league. The duo is followed closely by shortstop Kolby Robinson with 13, a total that ties for sixth in the SEC.

HOLCOMBE CARRIES HOT STREAK IN 2019 SEASON

- Senior Keith Holcombe has been red hot to start the 2019 campaign after an impressive 15-game stretch to close out 2018.
- Holcombe has contributed in a big way through this season's first 25 games, playing in 23 all starts. The senior leads the Crimson Tide in RBI (25) and slugging percentage (.640) while ranking second in virtually every other offensive category.
- His impressive start to this season has seen the senior collect a .473 on-base percentage to rank ninth in the SEC. Holcombe also ranks 12th in the SEC in batting average at .373 and ties for eighth in the league in doubles (9). The Tide left fielder has added a team-high .640 slugging percentage, good for seventh in the conference.
- Spanning this season and last, Holcombe reached base safely in every contest from game two of the doubleheader vs. Auburn on April 21, 2018, through March 19 of this season, a 36-game streak.
- He closed out last season with a 15-game stretch that started in game two of the doubleheader with Auburn. During that time, Holcombe maintained a team-leading .346 (19-55) average. He also led the Tide in hits and totaled at least one hit in 12 of the 15 contests, including four multi-hit efforts during that stretch.
- Holcombe also led the Tide in RBI in that 15-game period, collecting one or more RBI in nine of the 15 games, including seven of the final nine SEC contests. He added five outings of two or more RBI in that stretch.

THE 12-GAME WINNING STREAK

- · Alabama went on an impressive 12-game winning streak from Feb. 24 against Ball State through the March 12 matchup against Middle Tennessee. It was the longest winning streak under head coach Brad Bohannon and ties for the eighth-longest streak in Crimson Tide history. The streak was also UA's longest since the 1999 season when the Tide rallied off 16 straight wins.
- That 12-game stretch saw the Tide outscore its opponents, 86-23, to average 7.2 runs per game while batting .305 at the plate.
- The Tide pitchers maintained a lowly 1.43 ERA (18 ER/113.0 IP) and posted three shutouts across the stretch. Alabama's arms also limited the opposition to a .184 batting average while striking out 117 compared to only 26 walks.

TOUGH SLATE IN 2019

- Alabama faces a tough schedule during the 2019 season.
- The Crimson Tide is scheduled to have faced off with nine teams that were ranked in the top-30 of at least one of the five major preseason polls (Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball News, D1Baseball.com, NCBWA, USA Today Coaches).
- Those nine teams are all SEC opponents with the exception of only South Carolina not earning a top-30 ranking. The Crimson Tide is slated for 28 games against preseason top-30 squads, made up of three-game weekend series plus the MAX Capital City Classic in Montgomery against Auburn.
- From that group of nine, seven teams were in the top-15 of at least one of the polls with six teams cracking the top-10 of at least one polls' rankings. LSU (CBN, USA Today) and Vanderbilt (Baseball America, D1Baseball.com, NCBWA) occupied the top spot across the five sets of rankings.
- In addition to the stiff competition in league play, Alabama will have squared off with teams selected to either win or be in the top three of their respective conference by their preseason league polls. Jacksonville State (Ohio Valley Conference) and South Dakota State (Summit League) were both tabbed as the second-place squad in their respective divisions with Ball State (MAC) and Samford (SoCon) each selected as the third-place team in their respective leagues.

HIGHLY REGARDED RECRUITING CLASS

- UA's 2019 roster features a highly regarded recruiting class as its core, with 22 newcomers spotting the roster.
- The 22 newcomers ties for second-most in college baseball with Arkansas also sporting 22 additions to the 2019 squad. The NCAA leader for newcomers is East Tennessee State at 25.
- Alabama's current crop of freshmen and junior college transfers was selected as a top-25 class by three separate outlets. The 2019 Crimson Tide class was No. 23 by Perfect Game USA while earning a No. 15 ranking by Baseball America. The Tide was ranked highest by Collegiate Baseball News, with the outlet tabbing the '19 class as its No. 10 group.
- Baseball America's season preview also tabbed freshman Tyler Ras (RHP/OF) as its No. 9 newcomer in the SEC.

2019 ROSTER SPANS THE CONTINENT

- Alabama's 2019 crop of student-athletes features players from 12 different states and Canada, creating a very diverse roster.
- The new edition of the Crimson Tide has less than half of its total student-athletes from Alabama, with only 17 of the 35 total players from the Yellowhammer State.
- Georgia (Byars, Cobb, Vainer) and Texas (Breaux, Shavers, Smith) are the two most well-represented states with three players each, matching the total for Canada (Carinci, King, Morris).
- The state of Tennessee (Gentry, Shamblin) has two players on the 2019 squad to round out the multiples.
- Alabama's 2019 roster has one player apiece from seven other states, including: California (Auerbach), Florida (Rukes), lowa (Hawk), Mississippi (Wood), New Jersey (Ras), Ohio (Randolph) and Washington (McCullough).

THE TIDE'S NEW-LOOK ROSTER

- The 2019 roster returned just 13 letterwinners from a season ago, including three positional starters and two starting pitchers. The Tide welcomed 22 newcomers, which consists of nine freshmen and a group of new players that is made up of 10 junior college transfers, one graduate transfer (Jeremy Randolph) and two players who began their Division I baseball careers after already having been on campus (Chase Lee, Tyrell Shavers).
- Randolph came to Tuscaloosa after a four-year stint at Wright State (Ohio) from 2015-18. He wrapped up his career with a 16-5 record and five saves, maintaining a 3.05 ERA during that time. His efforts helped the Raiders to three Horizon League championships and three NCAA Regional appearances.
- Lee, a redshirt freshman, earned his spot on the roster through walk-on tryouts during the fall of 2018. He spent his freshman academic year as part of the Alabama Club Baseball Team, where he was selected as the team's Most Valuable Player thanks to a perfect 7-0 record with a 0.21 ERA. His efforts also earned him Rawlings National Club Baseball Association First Team All-America honors and NCBA South Atlantic First Team All-Region recognition.
- Shavers joined the Alabama baseball team as a sophomore in class status based on his time spent at the Capstone already. His eligibility clock began in 2017 when he joined the Crimson Tide's football team. Shavers redshirted his first season at UA before seeing time in all 15 games a season ago.
- Alabama entered the new season with a roster that features only six players with SEC experience. Of that six, only Joe Breaux, Keith Holcombe and Sam Praytor have significant starting experience. Gene Wood is next on that list, with injuries limiting his playing time during his four years at UA. Also included in the group of fielders are Walker McCleney and John Trousdale, who have both seen playing time, primarily in a reserve role, during their first two years with the Tide.
- On the hill, Alabama returned seven players with SEC experience, including starters Sam Finnerty and Garret Rukes. The duo started 10 games apiece in conference play a year ago. The relief group is headed by Brock Love, who has seen time as both a reliever and a starter this season, along with Deacon Medders. Love was hampered by injuries in 2018 but still managed six appearances overall with one start, including two relief outings in SEC pairings. Medders led all relievers in appearances during league play in 2018 with 14 and finished with 20 relief appearances overall. The relief group also features Kyle Cameron, Brock Guffey and Davis Vainer who made an impact in 2018.

- Brad Bohannon was hired as Alabama's 32nd head baseball coach on June 1, 2017, and formally introduced at The University of Alabama on Monday, June 5.
- Bohannon immediately made his mark on the Alabama program in 2018. His first season saw the Crimson Tide get off to a perfect 9-0 start, with Bohannon matching Wallace Wade (1924) for the second-best start to an Alabama head coaching career.
- Under his direction in 2018, Alabama improved its win total by eight from the previous season, including three more victories in SEC play, to
 finish 27-29 overall and 8-22 in SEC action. The 27 wins were highlighted by six victories over top-25 teams, including a series win over then-No.
 7 Kentucky.
- In 2018, Sewell-Thomas Stadium also became a favorable spot for the Crimson Tide once again. UA closed out its home slate with a 22-13 (.629) mark at The Joe compared to a 14-22 record in 2017.
- Since 2008, all of Bohannon's recruiting classes have been ranked in the top 25 by Perfect Game USA. His first recruiting class at Alabama, the Crimson Tide's current freshmen, was ranked No. 23 by Perfect Game USA, No. 15 by Baseball America and as high as No. 10 by Collegiate Baseball News, despite just over one year to recruit to UA.
- Bohannon came to Tuscaloosa with 14 years of Southeastern Conference coaching experience after having served as an assistant at Kentucky from 2004-15 and Aubum from 2016-17.
- He played a pivotal role in turning around both Kentucky and Auburn within three years on the job. The Wildcats became the first team in SEC history to go from worst to first in only one season, winning 44 games and the program's first SEC title in 2006, while the Tigers won 12 more games in 2017 than in 2016 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- While at Kentucky, Bohannon served under two SEC Coach of the Year winners in John Cohen and Gary Henderson. Along with winning the school's only league title, Bohannon was a part of a trio of record-breaking win seasons, capped off by the 2012 team that won 45 games to set the UK program mark.
- A combined 69 Wildcat student-athletes were chosen in the Major League Baseball Draft or signed as a free agent during Bohannon's tenure as
 recruiting coordinator. He had nine recruits selected in the 2012 draft, as well, setting a new Kentucky record and ranking as the second-most in the
 NCAA. The 2018 MLB Draft saw seven former recruits from Bohannon's time in Lexington chosen to begin their professional careers, four of which
 went in the top-10 rounds, highlighted by junior right-hander Sean Hjelle, a second-round selection of the San Francisco Giants.
- Regarded as one of the best recruiters in the nation, Bohannon was responsible for signing 13 Kentucky Wildcat student-athletes that went on to play in the Major Leagues, including 2014 Golden Spikes Award winner A.J. Reed. Bohannon was key in the development of Reed, the 2014 consensus national player of the year. The 2012 Freshman All-American continued to improve each year under Bohannon's watch and went on to lead the NCAA in home runs and slugging percentage as a junior, while leading the SEC in wins by a pitcher.
- Prior to his time at UK, Bohannon worked for two seasons as Wake Forest where the Demon Deacons advanced to the NCAA Tournament twice and captured the ACC title in 2001.
- Bohannon earned an undergraduate degree from Berry College in 1998 and then graduated with a master's from Wake Forest in 2002. He began his collegiate career playing at Vanderbilt and Georgia Tech before ending up at Berry.
- A native of Rome, Ga., Bohannon is married to the former Kim Traylor.
