THREE HITS

Senior Lauren Diaz finished the regular season with a 12-1 mark in Horsemanship, having six MOPs in the event. Freshman McKayla Langmeier holds a 19-0 mark on the year in Hunter Seat action. She stands at 10-0 in Equitation on the Flat and 9-0 in Equitation Over Fences.

The 2018-19 senior class is looking to capture their second SEC title in their careers. The crew was a part of the 2016 team that took home the conference crown.

NO. 1 AUBURN KICKS OFF POSTSEASON AT SEC CHAMPIONSHIP

Postseason success is now on the eyes of the No. 1 Auburn equestrian team as the squad is set to compete in the 2019 SEC Championship this weekend, March 29-30. The two-day meet is being held at the Hildebrand Equine Complex on the campus of Texas A&M.

The Tigers are the No. 1 seed and will take on No. 4 seed South Carolina at 1:30 p.m. CT, March 29. The No. 2 seed Georgia Bulldogs and No. 3 seed Texas A&M will kick off the day at 9 a.m. CT. The two losing teams from the first day will face off in the consolation match at 9 a.m. CT Saturday with the two winners facing off for the championship at 1:30 p.m. CT.

"We are very ready to kick off postseason," head coach Greg Williams said. "Practices have been fantastics and ownership of the work level, riding level and competitive drive has been completely shifted to a team-driven mentality. My favorite part is when the vested interest the players put into a program translates to ownership."

AUBURN LINEUP

Highlighting the Auburn lineup (13-0, 6-0) is an experienced group of upperclassmen, including seven seniors that were a part of the program's first Southeastern Conference championship in 2016.

Seniors Ashton Alexander, Caitlin Boyle and Hayley lannotti will guide the Equitation Over Fences and Equitation on the Flat crew to kick things off vs. South Carolina Friday. The trio have been main competitors for the Tigers all four years and are among the program's best in each event.

Alexander has 19 wins on the year, while lannotti has 18. Boyle has 17 and is one win away from setting a new Auburn record in career wins in Fences.

Joining the three against the Gamecocks will be freshmen McKayla Langmeier and Emma Kurtz. Langmeier enters the postseason with a perfect 19-0 record, having 10 wins in Flat and nine in Fences. Kurtz stands at 14-2-0 with seven wins in each event.

On the Western side of competition, the Horsemanship corps is led by a pair of seniors in Lauren Diaz and Kelsey Jung. Diaz finished the regular season with a 12-1-0 record and a team-leading six MOPs in the event. She also set the Auburn career wins record at Texas A&M (March 1) and enters the weekend with 40 to her name.

Jung has had a great final season for the Tigers, holding a 10-2-1 mark. Sophomore Taylor Searles also has 10 wins, while classmate Deanna Green isn't far behind with eight. Junior Kara Kaufmann is also slated to compete, having six victories on the year.

Three seniors guide the squad in Reining - Ali Fratessa, Blair McFarlin and Betsy Brown. Fratessa has put together a solid season so far, leading the team with nine wins and three MOPs. McFarlin has eight victories, while Brown has seven.

Joining the three are sophomores Green and Terri-June Granger. Green has been consistent all season in the event for the squad and brings eight wins into the postseason. Granger has really found her stride in the second half of the year, having seven victories overall have winning four of her last five matches.

SEVENTEENTH SEASON OF VARSITY EQUESTRIAN

The 2018-19 season marks the 17th year of varsity equestrian at Auburn. Head coach Greg Williams has guided the Tigers since the program was recognized by the Athletics Department and has amassed an impressive 154-57 overall record.

In 16 years, Auburn has earned five NCEA Championships (2006, 2011, 2013, 2016, 2018), one Southeastern Conference title (2016), three Southern Equestrian Conference crowns (2004, 2010, 2011), four NCEA Hunt Seat championships (2008, 2011, 2013, 2018) and one NCEA Western championship (2018).

Individually, Auburn boasts 59 All-Americans and 67 All-SEC and SEC All-Freshman selections. The Southeastern Conference first began sponsoring equestrian in 2012-13.

UP NEXT

Postseason continues with the 2019 NCEA Championship. Action is slated for April 17-20 and will be held at the Extraco Event Center in Waco, Texas.

The Tigers hold the top spot, while Texas A&M and Oklahoma State are Nos. 2 and 3. Baylor and South Carolina round out the Top 5, while Georgia is eighth.

LAST REGULAR MEETING VS. SC - FEBRUARY 16, 2019

The No. 1 Auburn equestrian team used a strong first half to come away with a 14-6 victory on the road over No. 3 South Carolina Saturday, Feb. 16, at One Wood Farm.

A major highlight of the day was the performance of senior Lauren Diaz in Horsemanship. With her 73.5-69.5 victory, the Heath, Ohio, product collected her 37th career victory on the Plains. That total tied Griffin Knight's (2012-16) current program record in the event.

The Tigers kicked off the day with an 8-2 lead following Horsemanship and Equitation Over Fences.

Sophomore Deanna Green opened up Horsemanship with a 69.5-69 edge over SC's Alexa Thorpe. Classmate Taylor Searles followed with a 73-71 victory for her seventh-straight win. Diaz picked up her big win with 73.5 points, securing her fifth MOP honor of the season. Senior Kelsey Jung capped the event with a 72-71 win over Mackenzie Matthews, helping the Tigers finish 4-1 over the Gamecocks.

After SC took the first point in Fences, senior Ashton Alexander scored a career-high 94 points to take the win and MOP honors. Freshman McKayla Langmeier remained undefeated with her win over Caroline Bald, scoring a career-best 92 points. Sophomore Taylor St. Jacques and senior Caitlin Boyle put an exclamation on the first half with 89 and 91 points, respectively, in their wins.

Both Reining and Equitation on the Flat went 3-2 for the Tigers after the break.

Seniors Blair McFarlin and Betsy Brown got things started in Reining as each secured their sixth win on the season. McFarlin topped Bridgett White, 70.5-69, before Brown scored 72.5 points in her victory. Sophomore Terri-June Granger was awarded a 72.5 on her ride to take home the win.

The Flat corps was led by a trio of underclassmen in freshman Emma Kurtz, Langmeier and St. Jacques. Kurtz bested Madison Brayman, 86-81, and Langmeier topped her opponent with another 86 points. St. Jacques was awarded MOP, scoring 91

LAST TIME OUT VS. TEXAS A&M - MARCH 1, 2019

The No. 1 Auburn equestrian team used big performances Friday to take a 12-8 road win vs. No. 2 Texas A&M at the Hildebrand Equine Complex.

Highlighting the efforts was that of senior Lauren Diaz in Horsemanship. With her 76-75 win over Alex Albright, the Heath, Ohio, product became the winningest Tiger in the event. Her victory pushed her to 38 career wins, surpassing Griffin Knight's (2012-16) 37.

The Horsemanship corps finished the day with a 3-2 mark as two sophomores in Taylor Searles and Deanna Green also picked up wins for the Tigers. Searles bested her opponent by four points, 72-68, while Green edged hers with a 74.5-74 victory.

The Equitation Over Fences group also went 3-2 in the first half of competition. Freshman Emma Kurtz earned her sixth win of the year with an 83-77 victory over Grace Boston. Sophomore Taylor St. Jacques followed with an 86-85 edge over her opponent before freshman McKayla Langmeier scored 84 points in her win. Langmeier moved to a perfect 8-0-0 in the event.

After intermission, the Equitation on the Flat crew put together yet another dominating performance, sweeping the Aggies and picking up its fourth sweep in the last five meets.

Langmeier moved to 9-0 on the year with an 87-75 victory, while senior Hayley lannotti also earned her ninth victory of the year with an 87. Senior Ashton Alexander outscored her opponent, 86-83, before St. Jacques garnered MOP honors with a 92-82 victory. Senior Caitlin Boyle capped the event with an 85-74 win.

Sophomore Terri-June Granger picked up a victory in Reining for the Tigers. The Dothan, Ala., product earned MOP recognition for her 70-66.5 win over Ashton Dunkel.

LAST TIME OUT VS. GEORGIA - MARCH 8, 2019

The No. 1 Auburn equestrian team did something no other program has done in the modern history of the sport. The Tigers put together an undefeated regular season as the squad topped rival and No. 7 Georgia, 17-3, Friday at the Auburn University Equestrian Center.

Auburn also recognized the 15 members of the 2019 senior class during the meet. The group holds a 56-10 record over four seasons with two national championships and one conference title.

Auburn opened up the meet with a pair of 4-1 wins in Equitation on the Flat and Horsemanship. Senior Hayley lannotti kicked off the day with a 75-74 edge over her opponent before sophomore Taylor St. Jacques picked up her sixth MOP in the event this season with 81 points in her win. Senior Ashton Alexander and freshman Emma Kurtz capped Flat with a pair of victories.

In Horsemanship, senior Lauren Diaz continued her impressive final season on the Plains with a 71.5-69.5 victory. The win pushed the Heath, Ohio, product to 12-1 on the year.

Sophomore Taylor Searles followed with her MOP ride, scoring 76 points to best her opponent's 71. Senior Kelsey Jung edged Lexie Lane, 72.5-72, before sophomore Deanna Green earned 75.5 points to win her match.

The Equitation Over Fences corps continued the big day with another 4-1 win over the Bulldogs. Senior Caitlin Boyle edged her opponent with 82 points and was followed by a big ride from freshman McKayla Langmeier. The East Granby, Conn., product scored 86 points in her win, picking up MOP and remaining undefeated in the event. Alexander and St. Jacques followed with 80 and 84 points, respectively, to pick up wins for the Tigers.

Putting an exclamation on the day was the Reining crew as they swept Georgia, 5-0. Green and classmate Terri-June Granger opened up with wins before a trio of seniors capped things off. Senior Ali Fratessa bested her opponent by two points to earn her team-leading ninth win of the year. Classmate Blair McFarlin followed with another two-point victory and senior Betsy Brown sealed the deal with 72.5 points in her win for MOP.

EQUESTRIAN 101: SCORING AND RULES

GENERAL RULES

- In equitation/horsemanship classes, only the rider is being judged therefore no penalty should be assessed because of the horse's conformation, color or movement.
- 2. Falling off a horse results in elimination.
- 3. Three refusals over jumps by a horse results in elimination.
- 4. Any rider not having her mount under sufficient control shall be removed from the ring by the show stewards and shall be disqualified or remounted at their discretion.
- 5. Riders must remain on the same mount throughout all phases of an equitation or horsemanship class unless the judge or coaches requests a re-ride.

COMPETITION RULES

Riders from opposing teams compete on the same horse. Each rider receives a score. The competitor with the highest score receives one point for their team.

Each rider from each team is given a 4 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Equitation on the Flat and Equitation over Fences.

Riders from Home team will warm up with each other. Riders from Visiting Team will warm-up with each other. Riders in Equitation over Fences are only allowed to jump 4 fences in their warm-up.

Each rider from each team is given a 4 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Horsemanship.

Riders from Home team and Visiting Team will warm-up together at the same time if the size of the ring allows for this.

Each rider from each team is given a 5 minute warm-up on the horse she drew in Reining.

Riders from Home team will warm up with each other. Riders from Visiting Team will warm-up with each other.

HUNT SEAT RULES

General-- The rider should have a workmanlike appearance, seat and hands light and supple, conveying the impression of complete control.

Equitation on the Flat

Scoring: Scored out of 100. There are 9 movements as well as a collective mark. These are based out of 1-10 points for each movement and overall position. 1 meaning not executed and 10 meaning excellent.

Equitation over Fences

Scoring: Scored out of 100. Based on the rider's equitation, complete control of the horse, executing the jumps in correct form, and staying consistent.

WESTERN RULES

General-- The rider will be judged on seat, hands, and the ability to control and show the horse. Results as shown by the performance of the horse are not to be considered more important than the method used by the rider in obtaining them.

Reining

Scoring: Base score is a 70. There are 7-8 maneuvers depending on the pattern, as well as a collective mark. NRHA/AQHA patterns 1-10 must be used. In these patterns, there are spins, circles, lead changes, stops, rollbacks, and back. Within each maneuver one can score anywhere from a -1.5 to +1.5 points... -1.5 is extremely poor, +1.5 is excellent, and 0 points added to the maneuver means it was done correctly. There are also penalties such as kick outs, break of gait, missing leads, etc. that can be anywhere from -.5 to 5 penalty points.

Horsemanship

Scoring: Base score is a 70. There are 7-9 maneuvers depending on the pattern, as well a collective mark. Within each maneuver one can score anywhere from a -1.5 to +1.5 points... -1.5 is extremely poor, +1.5 is excellent, and 0 points added to the maneuver means it was done correctly. There are also penalties such as kick outs, break of gait, missing leads, etc. that can be 1,3 or 5 penalty points depending on severity.
