» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn is 51-14 in non-conference play, including 28-6 against non-conference foes on the weekend, since the start of the 2017 season.
- The Tigers are 9-1 at Plainsman Park this season and 38-7 at home since the start of 2018.
- Auburn's six-game winning streak is its longest of the season and longest since also winning six straight games from Apr. 15-24 last year.
- The Tigers started the 2018 season 15-0. Off to an 11-2 start this season, it marks the first time the program has started back-to-back seasons 11-2 or better since 2000-01 (14-2; 16-2).
- The team's sweep of Cincinnati marked the fourth sweep of a non-conference foe in the last seven series. Auburn is 18-3 overall in those last seven non-conference series.
- Auburn's starting pitchers struck out 29 batters and didn't issue a walk last weekend. As a staff, the team's 37 strikeouts were the most in a three-game series since 1997 and the two walks allowed were the fewest in a three-game series since 1995.
- Auburn has turned in three shutouts in the last five games for the first time since 2017.

Butch Thompson enters his fourth season at the helm of the program in 2019. Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to the Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his fourth season with the Tigers in 2019.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

Widely regarded as one of the premier pitching coaches in the country, he has seen 14 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including eight since 2014. Thompson has also turned 29 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a firstround selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 12 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008.


A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 26 Division I All-Americans and 38 all-conference performers. He has made 16 postseason appearances, including seven trips to the College World Series, and guided Birmingham-Southern to a NAIA National Championship in 2001 and was a national runner-up at Mississippi State in 2013.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has already made his mark in his first three seasons at Auburn as he became the fourth head coach in program history to notch his 100th win in his third season at the helm. Thompson has guided the Tigers to a 103-82 overall record and has taken the team to back-to-back NCAA regionals for the first time in 15 years. After tying the 2010 team for the most wins (43) in a season since 1999 and advancing to its first super regional since that same season, Auburn's 2018 team finished the year ranked No. 9 by USA TODAY, marking the program's highest ranking to end a season since 1998.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of the last four seasons, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent five seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World



Series in 2004. While there he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a thirdplace finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games, four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.

- He has multiple hits in three of the last five contests and in six of his first 13 games in an Auburn uniform.
- Woley was named a NJCAA First Team All-American in 2018 and set the Chattahoochee Valley single-season record for hits (93), doubles (27) and RBI (93).

BACK TO OUR WINNING WAYS

- Auburn has won 91 games dating back to the start of the 2017 season, and the team's 80 wins from 2017-18 marked the most wins since winning 87 games from 1999-2000.
- The Tigers 91 wins are the fifth most in the SEC during the span - trailing Florida (110), Arkansas (103), LSU (100) and Texas A&M (94).

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

- Auburn started the 2018 season 15-0, marking the second-best start in program history, and went 22-4 overall in non-conference play, including 11-1 on the weekend.
- Dating back to the 2017 season, the Tigers are 51-14 in the non-conference and 28-6 against non-conference foes on the weekend.

HOME SWEET HOME

- Auburn went 29-6 in games played at Plainsman Park last season, marking the most home wins in a season since 1997 (30) and the second-most home wins all-time.
- The Tigers are 38-7 at home since the start of the 2018 season and 61-20 at home since 2017.

CANADIAN CRUSHER

- Edouard Julien ranks tied for second in the conference and 10th in the country with five home runs this season.
- Julien, who broke Frank Thomas' freshman RBI record and led the SEC with 69 RBI a season ago, has recorded 21 HR and 80 RBI in his first 72 games at Auburn.

LATE-INNING LEAD

- Auburn is 10-0 when leading after seven and 11-0 when leading after eight this season.
- The Tigers are 95-8 when ahead after seven and 110-6 when ahead after eight under Thompson.
- Conversely, Auburn is 0-1 when trailing after seven and 0-2 when trailing after eight this season. The Tigers are 7-63 and 2-67, respectively, under Coach Thompson.

CORE POWER

- The Tigers return 41 home runs between the core trio of Julien (17), Will Holland (12) and Williams (12). The 41 home runs between the three players are the most among any returning trio in the SEC this season.
- Julien, Holland and Williams also drove in a combined 172 runs last season, totaling 16 more RBI than any other returning trio in the SEC this season.

DYNAMIC BULLPEN DUO

- Cody Greenhill and Elliott Anderson have made a combined 10 relief appearances this season and have posted a combined 1.21 ERA in 22.1 innings pitched.
- Anderson didn't allow a run in his first 13.1 innings this season and 15.2 innings dating back to last season. He has struck out 17 batters in 13.1 innings pitched and is holding opponents to a .188 average.
- Greenhill, who was named a Freshman All-American by multiple publications a season ago and appeared on the 2019 NCBWA Preseason Stopper of the Year watch list, leads the team with two saves and is holding hitters to a .172 average.

SUPER SOPHOMORES

- Auburn returned a quartet of players who earned Freshman All-America and SEC All-Freshman Team honors a season ago in Burns, Greenhill, Julien and Williams.
- The four freshmen All-Americans were the most in program history and tied with Vanderbilt for the most in the country last year.
- Burns and Greenhill combined for 13 wins and a 2.72 ERA in 38 trips to the mound. The duo struck out 132 batters in 145.1 innings of work.
- Julien and Williams combined to hit 29 home runs with 121 RBI.

PRESEASON RECOGNITION

- Burns and Holland garnered a wealth of preseason recognition, including becoming the first Auburn duo to be named to the Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list in the same season.
- Burns: Preseason First Team All-SEC, Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list, Second Team Preseason All-American by D1 Baseball, Third Team Preseason All-American by Collegiate Baseball.
- Holland: Golden Spikes Award preseason watch list, Second Team Preseason All-American by Perfect Game, Third Team All-American by D1 Baseball and NCBWA.

WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE

- The team's 43 returning home runs are the most since 2011 (62) and its 214 RBI are the most since 2016 (246).
- The Tigers also bring back 156 appearances, 25 wins, 362.0 innings pitched and 330 strikeouts. Those are the highest totals returning since 2016, 2014, 2014 and 2012, respectively.

SEC SLATE

- Eight of Auburn's 10 SEC series are against NCAA Regional teams from a year ago, including four NCAA Super Regional teams and two teams that advaned to the College World Series in Arkansas and Mississippi State.
- The Tigers five road trips in league play are to Mississippi State, South Carolina, Texas A&M, Vanderbilt and LSU. All Five teams made the 2018 NCAA Tournament and three Mississippi State, South Carolina and Vanderbilt advanced to a super regional.

BIG LEAGUE TIGERS

• In 2018, former Auburn pitcher Trey Wingenter became the 51st player in Auburn history to appear in the Major Leagues. He made his debut for the New York Yankees on July 14. Cooper, who has since been traded to the Miami Marlins, joined Toronto's Josh Donaldson and Los Angeles' Grant Dayton as former Tigers in the big leagues last season. Dayton has also since been traded to the Atlanta Braves.


TIGERS IN THE DRAFT
