BULLDOGS IN THE POLLS THIS WEEK

*In the D1Baseball.com Top 25, Georgia is ranked No. 8 This week the Bulldogs are ranked between No. 7-8 with an RPI of No. 6.

BEST RECORD SINCE...

*At 37-13, Georgia has posted its best record after 50 games since the 1990 national championship team was 40-10 at this point in the season. Georgia has four games this week, and after 53 games in 1990, that squad was 41-12.

The 1990 Bulldogs claimed the SEC's first baseball national title and finished with a record of 52-19. This season, Georgia is in the hunt for its first SEC title since 2008. The Bulldogs trail Vanderbilt by two games with six left to play. Georgia won the Vanderbilt series 2-1 in Athens.

Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach: Scott Stricklin is in his 6th season at UGA; 15th season overall. Rankings: #8 D1Baseball.com; #7 Baseball America; #8 Collegiate Baseball; #7 USA Today/ESPN;

*The No. 8 Bulldogs (37-13, 16-8 SEC) are on the road this week. It started with a 9-8 loss in 11 innings to Jacksonville State on Wednesday. Up next, it's an SEC series at Auburn (29-19, 12-12 SEC).

*Sophomore ace and SEC ERA leader **Emerson Hancock** (7-2, 1.04 ERA) along with leading hitter and closer **Aaron Schunk** (1-1, 2.14 ERA, 11 Saves; .339-7-31) will be returning for the Auburn series. However, sophomore LHP **C.J. Smith** (3-3, 4.30 ERA), who has been the No. 2 starter in the SEC rotation, will likely be out until the SEC Tournament due to a sore back. All three Bulldogs missed the UF series. With Schunk out, Georgia has played **Riley King** (.303-7-40) at third base. In four games last week, King batted a team-best .500 (6-for-12) with two doubles, two home runs and five RBI. Schunk returned to action against JSU this past Wednesday, seeing action for five innings at third base and pitched the 11th inning.

*With the aforementioned Hancock out of the rotation for the second straight SEC series and with C.J. Smith out, junior RHP **Tony Locey** (8-1, 2.63 ERA) made his first career SEC Friday night start and was sharp in beating Florida 6-4. Junior RHP **Tim Elliott** (6-3, 2.56 ERA) started game two of the UF series and picked up a series-clinching win while freshman **Cole Wilcox** (2-0, 4.17 ERA) posted an impressive outing in his first career SEC start, firing a complete game two-hitter to complete the sweep of the Gators and earn SEC Freshman of the Week honors. The pitching staff held Florida to a .150 batting average in the series, surrendering just six runs on 12 hits.

*Stellar defense has been one constant for this club as the Bulldogs are on pace to set a Fielding Percentage school record for the second year in a row. Currently, Georgia is fielding .980 overall and a league-best .986 in SEC action. Last year, the Bulldogs established the fielding mark at .979 overall. In the series sweep of No. 21 Missouri this year, the Bulldogs turned their first Triple Play since 1963!

*Senior 2B **LJ Talley** continues to lead the offense with a team-best .341 average, eight home runs and 38 RBI. Junior CF **Tucker Maxwell** leads the club with 10 home runs and ranks among the SEC leaders in stolen bases with a team best 19. He pulled a hamstring Sunday and aims to return for the Auburn series. In four games last week, junior SS **Cam Shepherd** (.226-4-25) smashed three home runs and drove in eight. Graduate designated hitter **John Cable** (.292-5-33) posted a career-high four-hit game with three RBI in the loss to JSU as the Bulldogs collected 15 hits. Shepherd, King and Talley along with freshman **Randon Jernigan** had two hits apiece

FYI, the longest game in NCAA history went 25 innings, featuring fifth-ranked Texas defeating Boston College 3-2 in an NCAA Regional in Austin on May 30, 2009. It lasted 7 hours and 3 minutes.

GEORGIA HEAD BASEBALL COACH SCOTT STRICKLIN

#10 SCOTT STRICKLIN

UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH 6TH SEASON AT UGA; 15TH OVERALL

Scott Stricklin is in his sixth season as the Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach at the University of Georgia. Since arriving at UGA, Stricklin, 47, has created an atmosphere of excitement around the program, starting with the current student-athletes, extending to former lettermen and to Georgia baseball fans around the state. He has organized numerous lettermen func-



tions to help reunite former players and steered the \$12 million Foley Field Revival project that was completed prior to the 2015 season. He has engaged the fan base with the annual First Pitch banquets featuring Hall of Famers John Smoltz, Phil Niekro and Chipper Jones, Braves standout Jeff Francoeur and Bulldog legends and Major Leaguers Gordon Beckham and Kyle Farmer.

Georgia's recruiting classes have steadily improved under Stricklin, according to *Perfect Game USA* national rankings. In fact, the class that made its debut in 2017 was ranked No. 3 nationally. Additionally, the Bulldogs have excelled in the classroom, posting a 3.08 GPA for the fall semester of 2016 and 3.01 GPA in the fall of 2017. A total of 19 Bulldogs made the 2017 SEC Academic Honor Roll and 21 earned a spot on the honor roll in 2018.

The 2018 campaign saw Georgia return to prominence as a regular in the Top 25 rankings, earning a top eight national seed and playing host to an NCAA Regional for the first time in a decade. After being picked to finish fifth in the East, Georgia posted 39-21 record and its 18-12 SEC mark tied for the second best in the league. The Bulldogs were NCAA Athens Regional Finalists and set four school records (.979 fielding percentage, holding opponents to a .236 batting average, 532 strikeouts by the pitching staff and seven grand slams by the offense). Three Bulldogs earned All-America honors, four made the All-SEC squad, 21 made the SEC Academic Honor Roll and three were selected in the 2018 MLB Draft.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. During a nine-year stint with the Golden Flashes, he posted a 350-188 record, winning five Mid-American Conference regular season crowns and five MAC Tournament titles. Also, the Golden Flashes were honored in Omaha in 2012 for having the highest team Grade Point Average of all the eight participants at the CWS, owning a 3.09 GPA.

Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, handled pitching staffs that were ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the nation in earned run average during his final two playing seasons at KSU. A 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons of professional baseball and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins.

Stricklin graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from Kent State in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (16) and Keaton (11), and a son, Cale (14).

2019 QUICK WEEKLY RECAPS

(Week 1): Georgia swept Dayton, outscoring the Flyers 28-9 while batting .343 with a 2.67 ERA and a .983 fielding percentage.

(Week 2): Georgia's road game at KSU was rained out. The Bulldogs swept UMass Lowell to improve to 6-0.

(Week 3): Georgia lost for the first time,1-0 to LIU Brooklyn on an unearned run. Georgia was held to two hits, both by Aaron Schunk. The Bulldogs bounced back with an 11-1 rout of KSU for Coach Stricklin's 500th career victory. Georgia won a road series at Ga. Southern.

(Week 4): Georgia dispatched Alabama State 11-3 and Jacksonville State 5-1. Then, the Bulldogs swept Presbyterian including playing their fourth straight weekend doubleheader due to rain.

(Week 5): Georgia beat Ga. State 6-3 and opened SEC play with its first-ever three-game sweep of No. 22 South Carolina in Columbia.

(Week 6): Georgia beat Ga. State 11-1 and then clinched a home series over No. 10 LSU at Foley Field in front of three sold out crowds. It marked the first series win over the Tigers since 2011.

(Week 7): The Bulldogs dropped the first of three meetings with Tech 11-2 in Atlanta. Then, Georgia won its third straight SEC series including second on the road, beating Kentucky 2-1 in Lexington.

(Week 8): A five-game week started with a 5-3 win at Clemson and a 7-6 victory at Kennesaw State (makeup game from Feb.). Then Georgia claimed another sold out SEC series at Foley Field, beating No. 5 Vanderbilt 2-1 for its first series over the Commodores since 2008.

(Week 9): Georgia evened its season series with rival Ga. Tech, crushing them 12-2 at Foley Field. The Bulldogs dropped their first series of the year, falling 2-1 to at UT. It was Georgia's first two-game losing streak.

(Week 10): Georgia opened the week with a school record 20-inning walk-off over No. 24 Clemson in a school record 6:33 and then swept No. 21 Missouri at home to maintain its SFC lead

(Week 11): No. 4 Georgia had its first four-game losing streak of the season. The Bulldogs dropped an 8-6 decision to #11 Ga. Tech at SunTrust Park and then was swept at #9 Miss. State.

(Week 12): No. 9 Georgia blanked The Citadel 9-0 on a combined one-hitter at SRP Park Tuesday and then swept Florida for the first time since 2006 (that was in Gainesville) and first time in Athens since 1983.
