Opening statement...

"First of all, I just want to thank our crowd. They were loud and outstanding on Homecoming. It was a big victory for us. Our goal was to improve each game and we did that. Overall, we talked about covering kicks and special teams. I think we did a very good job with that. Defensively, holding Kent State to 16 points was good to see because they have some playmakers. Offensively, we were able to run the football. We talked about being better on first down and we definitely did that tonight. I think the quarterback keeping it early opens things up the middle. I thought our offensive line did an excellent job. They played their best game tonight. Bailey Sharp made his first state for Prince Tega Wanogho. He was a little banged up from last week. I'm just really proud of Bailey and like I said, our offensive line played well. Overall, it was a good win for us. We're 3-0 and we get into our conference season. We have a very important game next week against a very, very good team."

On playing a lot of backups...

"It was really good. It was really good for developing depth, it was good for morale, and for some of those young guys to get out there and show what they can do. We talked about being able to get more running backs involved and we were able to do that. All the running backs played except D.J. Williams. He is still a little banged up and we'll see about him next week. Joey Gatewood got a chance to get in there and I think everybody can see that when he pulls the ball, it's a lot of fun to watch. I thought it was good to get those guys some reps. Even our backup offensive line did a solid job when they got in there and got some push."

On Bo Nix keeping it on the read...

"I think it just depends on what the defense gives you. I think it's more of him just getting more experience too. I think he made some really good decisions. He stuck his foot in the ground and went north and south once he pulled it. I think that really made a big difference."

On getting confidence going in the running game tonight...

"It's really important when we're running the football and playing with pace. That's when we are at our best. It opens things up. It was a really good night. I think more than anything, it was just a commitment to run the football. We were very committed to doing that tonight and I think that helped also."

On the defensive effort...

"They threw some new things at us. That happened the first two weeks too. Our guys adjusted. The great thing about our guys is we have a veteran group over there that can adjust, and they did a great job. We had some twos and threes in there the last little bit and we just want to make sure those guys some experience."

On how he feels about the team after three games...

"We have a veteran defense and we have a lot of experience back on offense. It was good to have Anthony Schwartz back out there and he was still playing with the cast. Hopefully, that will be different next week. When he's on the field, it really changes things. I'll be really excited once we get his cast off
