NO. 16 TIGERS HOST NO. 10 ALABAMA IN HOME OPENER

The No. 16 Auburn gymnastics team kicks off its 2020 home slate on a big note, hosting rival and No. 10 Alabama in Auburn Arena Friday, Jan. 10, at 8 p.m. CT.

"We're really excited to showcase our young and talented team on the big stage early in the season," head coach Jeff Graba said. "We get a significant home advantage when we pack Auburn Arena, but teams like Alabama can handle a loud, crazy atmosphere so we have to get ourselves ready to go and really feed off the energy of our fans Friday. I'm excited about this young team because they handled the pressure fairly well last week so I'm hoping we keep building and have fun Friday night with the rest of the Auburn Family."

The Tigers and the Tide will go head-to-head live on SEC Network. The meet will be the final contest of a gymnastics tripleheader.

Following the opening weekend, the Auburn gymnastics team sits at No. 16 with a 194.375 under its belt.

At last week's Collegiate Challenge, the Tigers found success on vault and put together a 48.925. That mark ranks seventh nationally and second in the Central Region, Junior Drew Watson and sophomore Derrian Gobourne finished in a tie for first in the event at the meet, earning a 9.9 each. Those scores rank tied for second nationally.

A trio of Tigers excelled on bars for the squad in Anaheim, starting with freshman Aria Brusch. Her 9.85 in the event ranks her second regionally and tied for 17th nationally. Senior Gracie Day's 9.825 is tied for third in the Central Region, while freshman Adeline Sabados earned a 9.8 to rank tied for sixth regionally.

Seniors Emma Slappey and Skyler Sheppard are among the Top 40 on beam after the pair each picked up a 9.8 during the first session of the Collegiate Challenge.

AUBURN LINEUP VS ALABAMA

A pair of Tigers will represent Auburn in the all-around Friday against Alabama in junior Drew Watson and freshman Cassie Stevens. This will be Watson's first appearance in the all-around this season, but the Tyler, Texas, product is no stranger to the task. She has competed in the all-around 20 times and set a career high in the category last season vs. Arkansas with a 39.625. The all-around slot for Stevens is the first of her career.

Auburn kicks things off on vault in rotation one with five of its six competitors capable of a 10.0 start value. Senior Skyler Sheppard leads things off with junior Jada Glenn following. Senior Gracie Day, who will make her team-best 42nd start in the event, is slated to go third with Stevens and Watson following. The 2019 NCAA Co-Champion in the event in sophomore Derrian Gobourne will anchor.

The Tigers move on to bars in the second rotation and Stevens is set to lead off. It'll be the Phoenix product's first appearance in the bars line up. She will be followed by a pair of classmates in Adeline Sabados and Aria Brusch. The duo opened their careers off strong last week, scoring a 9.8 and 9.85 in the event, respectively. Watson and Day will go fourth and fifth and Gobourne will once again anchor.

Senior Emma Slappey, who is coming of a 9.8 in the event last week, will open rotation three for Auburn on beam. Brusch and Stevens follow with junior Meredith Sylvia set to go fourth. Sylvia has competed on beam every meet since her freshman season. Watson will go fifth and Sheppard will anchor for the second-straight meet.

The final rotation has the Tigers on floor with Slappey once again leading off. Stevens and Brusch close out their busy evenings in spots two and three with Watson in the fourth slot. Sheppard follows and Gobourne will close out the night with her energetic routine in the anchor slot.

SCOUTING ALABAMA

Friday's contest will be the season opener for Alabama, who was ranked No. 10 in the WCGA Preseason Poll.

The Crimson Tide are led by a pair of seniors in Shea Mahoney and Maddie Desch along with junior Lexi Graber and Shallon Olsen. The four return as All-SEC performers, helping the Tide finish third at the conference championship in 2019. Olsen returns after a successful summer for Team Canada, securing a silver medal with her team as well as a bronze medal on vault at the 2019 Pan American Games.

Graber was the 2019 SEC Balance Beam Champion, while Desch has been a consistent performer on floor and Mahoney contributes on vault and bars.

Head coach Dana Duckworth is in her sixth season at the helm of the program.

AUBURN/ALABAMA SERIES HISTORY

Alabama has dominated the series with a 127-10 overall record. Last season, the Tigers were narrowly edged by the Tide in both regular season meetings as Alabama won in Tuscaloosa, 196.700-196.400, and at the annual Elevate the Stage meet, 197.100-196.775.

In 2016, Auburn earned the fourth-highest score in program history with a 197.275 to knock off Alabama at home.

A DECADE OF GRABA

The 2020 season marks the 10th with head coach Jeff Graba. The program's leader arrived on the Plains prior to the 2011 season and brought the Tigers to another level on the national stage.

For his efforts over the past nine seasons, the Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

Graba helped coach the program's first national champion in Derrian Gobourne (2019 - vault). In addition, the Tigers scored a program-best regional score in 2019 and had its best SEC regular season as the squad came in second prior to postseason.

He has led his student-athletes to 13 All-America honors (both NACGC/W and NCAA) and 16 All-SEC recognitions. Leading the way was Caitlin Atkinson, who amassed nine All-America nods and was named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance each season. Each season, the team's attendance average has climbed higher and higher and after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season, Auburn finished 2018 with an average of 6,334. That marked ranked seventh

nationally. In addition, the Tigers have enjoyed nine sellouts of Auburn Arena (7,424).

Away from competition, Graba's teams have totaled 53 NACGC/W Scholastic All-America nods and 100 SEC Academic Honor Roll recognitions.

FRESHMEN DEBUT

A trio of freshmen in Aria Brusch, Cassie Stevens and Adeline Sabados made their collegiate debut last week, contributing to the overall team score in each event competed.

Brusch, of Cincinnati, Ohio, competed in three events, starting with an great performance on bars as she scored a team-best 9.85. She followed with a 9.775 on beam and a 9.575 on floor.

Stevens earned a spot in two lineups, going on floor and vault. Her 9.8 on her vault was the third-best on the team and placed her tied for seventh in the Central Region. In addition, Stevens added a 9.525 on floor.

Sabados had a solid bars routine for the Tigers to kick off her collegiate career. The Castle Rock, Colo., product scored a 9.8 to come in third on the squad.

VAULT PREVIEW

The Tigers are looking forward to big strides in vault this season as the squad returns five of its six vaulters from 2019. Highlighting the crew are the trio of senior Gracie Day, junior Drew Watson and sophomore Derrian Gobourne. Both Watson and Gobourne have a career-high of 9.95 under their belts, while Gobourne is the defending national champion in the event. In addition to the returning talent, the rest of the Auburn vault crew has improved greatly in the offseason.

"I do think vault is possibly the event that has improved the most this year for us," Graba said. "I think our fans will see quite a bit more dynamic and powerful vaulting this year."

BARS PREVIEW

Auburn bars workers will have big shoes to fill, but the crew is up to the task.

Senior Gracie Day highlights the corps, recently setting a career high in 2019 with a 9.975. Joining her in experience is class-

mate Katie Becker, junior Drew Watson and sophomore Derrian Gobourne. Becker and Gobourne have proven to be consistent scorers for the squad, while Watson is capable of putting up a big score. Freshmen Adeline Sabados and Aria Brusch are also expected to make an impact on the Tigers this year.

"It's true that bars would appear to be the event hit hardest by the loss of last year's seniors," Graba said. "However, we have brought in quite a few talented freshmen and they should have an impact right away."

BEAM PREVIEW

Beam is another rotation that may have lost some big contributors in, but also returns some of the top talent from 2019.

Seniors Emma Slappey and Skyler Sheppard and junior Meredith Sylvia lead the way with a lot of experience and big numbers for the Tigers. Drew Watson competed in all events last season, while Gobourne earned a spot in the lineup in all but one. Freshmen Aria Brusch, Morgan Leigh and Cassie Stevens add depth and high skill to the lineup.

"Beam has quickly become our most competitive event in the gym," Graba said. "We brought back a lot of veterans, but we have really seen growth in the competition for spots on beam and that's pushing everyone to get better every day."

FLOOR PREVIEW

Auburn's floor rotation is set to be an exciting on in 2020 as the team brings back big routines with a lot of personality. Derrian Gobourne and Skyler Sheppard highlight the group of talented Tigers with seniors Emma Slappey and Gracie Day and junior Drew Watson bringing consistency and solid routines. Freshmen Aria Brusch, Cassie Stevens and Morgan Leigh Oldham are also among the group of talent and will be contributing to the success of the group early on.

"We're really excited about this group," Graba said. "We have a lot of routines that will be fun for our fans and the team has been working hard to improve their big skills this the offseason. It's going to be a fun group to watch."

Three-time SEC Coach of the Year Jeff Graba enters his 10th season at the helm of the Auburn gymnastics program in 2020 and has guided the Tigers record heights during his time on The Plains.

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

Auburn's performances in 2019 was one for the books as the squad reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen and finished 16th in the final rankings. Auburn reached the second round of the NCAA Regional Championship with a 197.075 in Baton Rouge, marking the highest NCAA Regional score in program history.

Auburn saw its first national champion in 2019 when Derrian Gobourne came in a tie for first at that 2019 National Championship on vault. She scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way. In addition, Gobourne earned All-SEC and Freshman All-SEC recognition.

The 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program. They snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. That season, Auburn broke or tied 52 program records that season.

Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' second best in history and highest since 1993 with a NCAA nationals record score of 197.075.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010. He came to The Plains after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he was named the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year while coaching bars, collaborating on floor routines and serving as the recruiting coordinator.
