## Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- This is the fourth all-time meeting between Auburn and Samford in women's basketball
- Auburn is 3-0 all-time against Samford; all three prior meetings have been at Auburn Arena
- The Tigers held USC Upstate to 41 points in the opener, the lowest for an opponent since Feb. 17, 2019 vs. Alabama (77-38)
- Auburn's 41-point margin of victory over USC Upstate was its largest since a 56 -point win at Elon (96-44) on Dec. 22, 2018; it tied for the fifth-largest winning margin at Auburn Arena
- Ten players made their Auburn debuts in the win over USC Upstate; three newcomers were in the starting lineup
- Aicha Coulibaly became the eighth Auburn player since 2005 and fourth under Coach Flo to earn a starting nod in their first game as a true freshman
- Redshirt sophomore Jala Jordan scored a career-high 16 points off the bench to share the team lead in her Auburn debut vs. USC Upstate; the WVU transfer also hit 4-of-6 3-pointers on the night
- Auburn is 41-9 all-time in season openers and 29-3 when playing its first game of the season at home
- Auburn has won 42 straight home openers, dating back to 1977-78
- Coach Terri Williams-Flournoy is 9-1 in season-openers at Auburn and 13-4 in her career
- Auburn is in its 50 th season of women's basketball and has 948 program wins
- Auburn is $8-1$ all-time on Nov. 28 and 144-43 all-time in the month of November; Coach Flo is $35-16$ in November at

- Auburn returns one starter and five letterwinners from 2019-20; the Tigers have 10 newcomers
- Auburn is $87-36$ in non-conference games under Terri Williams-Flournoy
- Senior forward Unique Thompson was a consensus preseason first-team All-SEC selection (coaches \& media)
- Thompson is the SEC's active leader in career double-doubles (42), rebounds (895) and steals (139)
- Thompson is Auburn's leading returner in nearly all statistical categories, including scoring (16.2) and rebounds (11.4)
- Thompson is the nation's leading returner in double-doubles with 22 last season, one shy of the national lead in 2020
- Thompson has averaged a double-double for two straight seasons, the first in Auburn history to do that
- Among Auburn's 10 newcomers are two NJCAA All-Americans (Keya Patton \& Kira Lowery), a local product from Columbus, Ga. (Alycia Reese), three Division I transfers (Honesty Scott-Grayson, Jala Jordan, Alaina Rice), and four true freshmen (Aicha Coulibaly, Riley Donahue, Romi Levy, and Carsen McFadden)
- Coach Terri Williams-Flournoy begins her ninth season at Auburn, her 17th as a head coach, and her 29th overall in college coaching
- Auburn finished 11-18 overall in 2019-20, 4-12 in SEC play and tied for 12th in the SEC standings
- In SEC preseason polls, Auburn was picked to finish 13th by the media and 14th by the league's coaches

" The Auburn Tigers look to build on a big season-opening win as they host Samford at 6 p.m. CT Saturday, Nov. 28, at Auburn Arena. The game time was pushed back from its original start time of noon CT.
" Auburn is 1-0 after defeating USC Upstate 8241 Wednesday night at home to open the season.
" Samford fell to 0-1 after dropping its season opener at Alabama 83-68.

## LAST TIME OUT

" The new-look Auburn women's basketball team showcased its depth, speed and balance in their season-opener, running away with an 82-41 win over USC Upstate Wednesday night at Auburn Arena.
" All 14 players dressed on the roster saw action for the Tigers (1-0), 11 of the 14 found the scoresheet, and 12 players grabbed at least one rebound. Auburn's trademark defense was back, too, turning 25 USC Upstate (0-1) turnovers into 21 points.
" Senior Unique Thompson and redshirt sophomore Jala Jordan shared the team lead with 16 points apiece. Thompson also pulled down seven rebounds to lead the Tigers, but the Tigers' 45 rebounds were spread amongst 13 players as Auburn did a great job crashing the boards.
" Auburn's newcomers made an immediate impact. Along with Jordan's 16 points and three rebounds, freshman Romi Levy turned some heads with eight points, three rebounds, two assists and two steals. Sophomore transfer Honesty ScottGrayson finished with seven points and two assists in her Auburn debut. And fellow newcomers Keya Patton, Kira Lowery, Aicha Coulibaly, Alaina Rice and Alycia Reese all found their way onto the scoresheet. Rice was the team's assist leader with five on the night, and Coulibaly had Auburn's only blocked shot.

" Auburn forced a season-high 29 turnovers and turned in their best defensive performance of the season in a 73-46 win over Samford at Auburn Arena.
" The Tigers improved to 5-0 at home and won
their 12th straight home non-conference game, and did so in convincing fashion despite shooting below 40 percent for the first time.
". Senior Janiah McKay scored a game-high 20 points, her second straight game with at least 20 in the scoring column. She also had a team-leading four steals and four assists. Daisa Alexander added 16 points. Unique Thompson was Auburn's leading rebounder with six.

## SCOUTING SAMFORD

") Samford returns two starters and six letterwinners from its 2020 Southern Conference championship team. The Bulldogs dropped their season opener at Alabama 83-68 on Wednesday.
" The Bulldogs were picked to finish third in the SoCon in a vote of the league's coaches and second by the media.
") Senior Natalie Armstrong was a preseason all-SoCon selection. She had a double-double with 25 points and 10 rebounds against Alabama Wednesday. Armstrong was Samford's leading scorer last season, averaging 14.5 points/game. She also had a double-double in the last meeting between Auburn and Samford with 10 points and 16 rebounds.
" Samford senior guard Shauntai Battle is the daughter of former Auburn men's basketball player Ronnie Battle, an all-SEC guard for the Tigers from 1990-93.

## SCOUTING AUBURN

" With 10 newcomers and just five returning letterwinners (one returning starter), there are plenty of new faces on the Auburn bench as the 2020-21 season begins.
" Senior forward Unique Thompson, an honorable-mention All-American and first-team All-SEC performer a year ago, is Auburn's Ione returning starter. She averaged a double-double for the second straight year with 16.2 points and 11.4 rebounds, leading Auburn in both categories. Thompson is also the nation's leading returner in double-doubles with 22 last season. Thompson had 16 points and 7 rebounds in the season opener vs. USC Upstate.
" Two redshirt sophomore transfers that sat out last season are set to make an immediate impact. Honesty Scott-Grayson (Baylor) and Jala Jordan (West Virginia) both look to earn significant playing time. Scott-Grayson earned her first career start and scored 7 points in Wednesday's opener. Jordan tied for the team lead with 16 points and hit 4-of-6 3-pointers vs. USC Upstate.
") Four other returners saw game action for Auburn last season: redshirt junior Kiyae' White and sophomores Annie Hughes, Morgan RobinsonNwagwu and Sania Wells. Wells and RobinsonNwagwu played significant minutes in the opener; Robinson-Nwagwu had a career-high four steals and matched career-highs with 6 points and 4 rebounds.

") Of the 15 players on the roster, 10 of them wore an Auburn uniform for the first time in game action vs. USC Upstate. All 10 newcomers saw the floor in the Tigers' 82-41 win on Nov. 25.
" 2019-20 transfers Jala Jordan and Honesty Scott-Grayson were eligible for the first time Wednesday night. Jordan shared the team lead with 16 points and hit 4-of-6 3-pointers against

" Last season, Thompson was second in the SEC and 10th nationally in rebounding (11.4/game), led the SEC and was 8th nationally in offensive rebounds (4.4/game), and was third in the SEC and 15th nationally in field goal percentage ( $58.2 \%$ ).
