The University of South Alabama men's basketball team travels for its first road game of the year to Auburn for a marquee match with the Tigers in Auburn Arena with tipoff scheduled for 8 p.m., Friday night with the game airing on SEC Network.

The Tigers have claimed victory in the last four meetings of the series with the most recent South Alabama win happening just over two decades ago when USA triumphed 68-66 on Dec. 1, 2000. The last meeting was decided by a single point when the teams met in the Mitchell Center on Nov. 12, last year. #### **SOUTH ALABAMA'S LAST GAME**

#### South Alabama 86, Emmanuel (Ga.) 47 • December 1, 2020

MOBILE, Ala. — Michael Flowers led six University of South Alabama men's basketball players in double figures Tuesday as the Jaguars picked up an 86-47 non-conference victory over Emmanuel (Ga.) at the Mitchell Center.

Flowers recorded a game-high 17 points, making 6-of-10 from the floor, to go along with five assists as South improved to 3-1 on the year. Three Jags approached a double-double with Kayo Goncalves recording 14 points and eight rebounds, Jamal West supplying 12 points and nine boards, and Tyreke Locure ending the contest with 12 points and eight rebounds. David Walker and KK Curry contributed 14 and 10 points, respectively, as well.

Tyonn Stuckey was the only Lion in double-digits in the scoring column after posting 14 while hitting 4-of-9 attempts from beyond the arc. Kyler Ingram and Jayvion Rucker pulled down six rebounds each to lead EC on the glass.

#### **GAME FACTS**

- -USA allowed just one field goal in the first five-and-a-half minutes while jumping out to a 17-3 advantage.

  -The lead was still 11, 25-14, midway through the opening half, with Flowers contributing a team-best eight points during the opening stretch of the contest.
- -South was up 42-21 at the intermission after limiting the Lions to just 25.9 percent shooting from the floor over the first 20 minutes.
- -The Jags scored 25 points off 21 EC turnovers with four individuals Curry, Flowers, John Pettway and West recording multiple steals.
- -South limited the Lions to a 26.4 percent mark from the field for the game.

#### **AUBURN'S LAST GAME**

#### UCF 63, Auburn 55 • November 30, 2020

**ORLANDO,** Fla. — It was a strong effort defensively from Auburn on Monday night. But the Tigers struggled offensively and didn't have enough firepower to win on the road as they dropped a 63-55 decision to UCF to wrap up a three-game stretch in Florida.

"Defensively I thought our kids played hard. I thought we had a good game plan," Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl said. "To hold Central Florida down to 63 points, 37 percent shooting, turning them over 19 times — I thought we did a really good job there. Offensively, it was a disaster. There's no other way of putting it. We played much better in Fort Myers than we did tonight."

The lone bright spot offensively for Auburn was junior guard Jamal Johnson who finished with a career-high 18 points and made 5 of 12 shots from beyond the arc.

The Tigers got down by as many as 12 early in the second half, but Johnson responded with a 3 to jumpstart a 5-point possession and swing the momentum back in their favor. Later in the half, he drained another 3 to cut the UCF lead to six. He also added five rebounds and two assists to along with his game-high 18 points.

"He had two assists, no turnovers. He shot a good percentage. He had five rebounds. I thought Jamal played really well," Pearl said. "This is his fourth year of college basketball. He's really my only experienced college player. I think that's shown. I thought he played pretty well against Gonzaga, and I thought he played well again tonight."

As a team, though, Auburn struggled shooting the ball. The Tigers shot 32 percent (20-62) from the field and just 21 percent (7-34) from beyond the arc. They were 8 of 22 from the free throw line.

However, it was Auburn's effort on the defensive end and on the glass that kept the Tigers in it. They forced 19 turnovers, blocked five shots and held UCF to 37 percent shooting. They also pulled down 19 offensive rebounds and won the battle on the glass, 48-40.

After spending the past week in the Sunshine State, the Tigers (1-2) will return home to make their 2020-21 debut in Auburn Arena on Friday night against South Alabama.

"It will be good to get this team back home," Pearl said. "Maybe we'll play better at home just from the familiarity of it. It's going to be a great weekend at Auburn with the Texas A&M football game on Saturday. South Alabama gave us all we wanted a year ago. We'll see if we can continue to learn and get better."

The game is scheduled to tip at 8 p.m. CT and will be televised on SEC Network.

#### **OPENING TIP**

- USA enters the matchup with a 3-1 record after dispatching Emmanuel (Ga.), 86-47, Tuesday night in the Mitchell Center.
- Auburn won its first game of the year, beating Saint Joseph's in overtime 96-91, but followed that up
  with a 23-point loss to the No. 1 team in the country in the Associated Press Poll, Gonzaga, and an eightpoint defeat to Central Florida most recently.
- South spread around the scoring last time out with six players getting into double figures. Michael Flowers led the way for USA, a feat he has accomplished in all four of the Jags' contests, with 17. Kayo Goncalves scored 14 with four threes and a field goal, while Jamal West and Tyreke Locure had 12 each.
  KK Curry and David Walker were the other two Jags to make it into double digits, while both came off the bench; it was the first time either player had scored 10 or more this season.
- Replacing 84.5 percent of their scoring, Jaguar newcomers Flowers, Goncalves, Walker and West contributed with 191 of South's 322 points scored over the four games. Returners John Pettway and Locure with first-year player Sam Iorio made up the bulk of the remainder with 118 points between the three.
- The Jaguars have taken care of the ball in the past three games, with under 10 turnovers in each contest,
   and won the turnover battle by an average of nine per game.
- No Jaguar has managed a double-double this year, but a few have been very close. Locure needed two
  rebounds or less in three of the four games and West was one point and a rebound shy of the mark
  against Mobile while falling a rebound short against Emmanuel. Goncalves was two rebounds shy against
  Emmanuel, with an eight-point, eight-rebound effort against FAU on opening night.
- After a drama filled offseason, Flowers introduced himself to South Alabama with a go-ahead three with
  one second left in the opening-night game against Florida Atlantic. The senior from Southfield, Mich., has
  averaged 20.3 points per game over the season.
- Including his seasons at Southeastern Oklahoma State, Goncalves set a career high with four blocks
  against Emmanuel (Ga.). That total is twice as many as any other player on the team has on the season.
- lorio is hopeful to return to action against the Tigers Friday night. Scoring 16 points in the first game off
  nearly perfect shooting, 5-of-6 from the field with 2-of-2 from behind the arc and 4-of-4 from the free
  throw line, lorio went down injured in the opening minutes against Mobile, coming off the court after
  making two free throws.



#### Richie Riley Head Coach Eastern Kentucky, 2005 3rd Season

It took just one season for Richie Riley to turn the fortunes of the South Alabama men's basketball program around as he led the Jaguars to its best record in five years and has them poised to become a force in the Sun Belt Conference.

The gains in year one were modest, but important. The Jags increased their win total by three to 17, which was their most since 2012-13, set a new school record for 3-pointers with 285, and had two players — Josh Ajayi and Trhae Mitchell — named all-Sun Belt for the first time since 2009.

Ajayi and Mitchell paced a group of five players in double digits, a first for the program since 1996-97, led by Ajayi's career-best 16.4 points per game. Ajayi, who led the Sun Belt in field-goal percentage and ranked in the league's top in both scoring and rebounding, was voted to the second team, while Mitchell, the school's second-ever player — and first since 1988-89 — to record 200 rebounds and 100 assists in the same season.

The offense, which posted a scoring average of 72.9, USA's highest since 2007-08, was firing on all cylinders in December during a span that saw South Alabama go 6-2. Starting Dec. 8, the Jaguars recorded 79 points or more and posted a positive assist/turnover ratio in six straight outings, neither of which had been done since the end of the 1990-91 campaign. In addition, the Jags also shot 50 percent or better in five straight games during that span, which also had not been done since 1990-91.

A recruiting strategy based heavily on the transfer market brought in highly-regarded players from California, Florida and South Carolina, and all-conference honorees from American, High Point and Howard.

Riley was announced on March 8, 2018 as the 10th head coach in the history of the program after helping Nicholls to its first regular-season Southland Conference championship since 1998.

Riley was the head coach the previous two seasons at Nicholls, compiling a 35-28 overall record and a 22-14 mark in the Southland Conference. In his last season, he led the Colonels to the regular-season co-championship with a 15-3 record in league play and an overall mark of 21-11; it was the program's first winning season since the 2008-09 campaign.

Nicholls led the conference in scoring with an average of 82.5 points per game, and was among the top three in the league in eight other statistical categories including second in field-goal percentage (47.2%), 3-point field goals per game (8.1), steals per game (9.6) and scoring margin (+7.2 ppg). Not only was the team among the top five in the country in total steals, steals per game and turnovers forced, it ranked among the top 25 nationally in scoring average and top 50 in field-goal percentage as well.

Under his guidance, Roddy Peters became the Colonels' first first-team all-league selection since 2013 this season, with two other student-athletes earning all-Southland recognition during Riley's two years at the helm of the program.

Peters, who was also the league's newcomer of the year, joined fellow all-Southland honoree Tevon Saddler in the top six in the conference in scoring, with 19.7 and 15.8 points per game, respectively. Peters was second in scoring and sixth with 4.2 assists per contest, while Saddler, a second-team selection, was sixth in points and ninth with 6.6 rebounds per game.

The Colonels' tenacity on defense led to three players listed in the conference's top 11 in steals, including all-defensive team member Jahvaughn Powell, who led the SLC in steals per game (2.3), and Kevin Johnson, who ranked third (1.9).

The season before, the team went 7-11 in league play and 14-17 overall, but led the Southland in both blocks (6.1) and 3-pointers (9.0) per game. The Colonels were fourth in steals per game (7.5), but Powell was second individually (2.0), and Johnathan Bell ranked third (1.9).

Powell paced the SLC in assists per game (5.0) and Liam Thomas was the statistical champion in blocks (4.2)

Prior to taking over at Nicholls, he was an assistant for two seasons at Clemson. In his first season on the staff, he helped the Tigers to eight Atlantic Coast Conference wins — with one coming at NCAA Sweet 16 participant North Carolina State — as well as a pair of victories over NCAA Tournament teams from the SEC, including a top-25 Arkansas squad. The following year Clemson won 10 ACC games for only the fifth time in program history, while his efforts in recruiting helped the Tigers sign both ESPN 4-star top-100 prospect Ty Hudson and the No. 2 national junior-college prospect. Legend Robertin.

As an assistant at Alabama-Birmingham from 2012-14, Riley played a key role in the Blazers signing a top-25 recruiting class that would provide the core of a team that advanced to the third round of the 2015 NCAA Tournament; the group included three individuals who would go on to earn all-Conference USA honors as well as the league's 6th Man-of-the-Year Award. His time at UAB was highlighted by a 63-59 victory over No. 16 North Carolina during the 2013-14 season.

Riley's efforts with the Blazers led to his selection to attend the prestigious Villa 7 Conference for rising

In his lone season at Eastern Kentucky in 2011-12, he was part of a staff that led the Colonels to a 16-16 record. But his efforts in recruiting for the program played a part in signing a class that would help EKU advance to the NCAA Tournament in 2015; the group included Corey Walden, who would go on to twice be chosen the Ohio Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Year and the 2014 OVC Tournament Most Valuable Player in addition to being voted first-team all-league in '15.

Riley's first experience at the NCAA Division I level came at Coastal Carolina, where he was an assistant on Cliff Ellis' staff from 2009-11. In his two years with the program, the Chanticleers posted a 56-13 mark overall and 31-5 record in the Big South Conference, winning a pair of regular-season titles, advancing to the conference tournament championship game twice and making an appearance in the National Invitation Tournament each season.

After beginning his coaching career as an assistant at Georgetown (Ky.) from 2003-05, Riley also served as an assistant at Hawai'i-Pacific during the 2005-06 campaign before a three-season stint at Pikeville (Ky.) from 2006-09. While at PC he received the honor of 'Top NAIA Assistant' from RecruitingRumors.com.

A 2005 Eastern Kentucky graduate with a degree in special education and human behavior, Riley and his wife Jess have two sons, Reese and Rock.
