### » QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn enters the weekend 5-0 and has outscored its opponents 61-8.
- The 53-run margin of victory is the largest through five games since 1951.
- The Tigers have scored 61 runs and struck out 62 batters in the first five games. Those numbers are the most through five games since 2000 and 1997, respectively.
- Ryan Bliss and Rankin Woley are tied for the league lead in hits. Woley also leads the league in doubles, while Bliss is tied for the lead in RBI.
- Bliss is one of two players in the country to rank in the top 10 in hits, runs, doubles and RBI.
- Auburn starting pitchers are 5-0 with a 2.05 ERA through five games. They have also struck out 35 batters and issued 10 walks in 22.0 innings.
- The Auburn pitching staff has struck out 10 or more batters in five straight games. The team hasn't accomplished the feat in six straight games since doing it seven times to open the 1997 season.

**Butch Thompson enters his fifth season at the helm of the program in 2020, posting a record of 141-110 in his first four seasons. He led the program to the first College World Series appearance in 22 years in 2019 and has taken the Tigers to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03.**

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his fifth season with the Tigers in 2020.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 27 Division I All-Americans and 39 all-conference performers. He has seen 14 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including eight since 2014. Thompson has also turned 31 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 13 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008, which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

In 27 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 18 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached eight College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 17 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in four seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 141-110 overall record and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals for the first time in program history. After advancing to the College World Series a season ago and a winner-take-all game three in the Gainesville Super Regional in 2018, the Tigers have finished each of the last two seasons ranked as high as No. 8 and No. 9, respectively. It marks the third time in program history the team has finished back-to-back seasons in the top 10.

Entering the postseason as the No. 2 seed in the Atlanta Regional, Auburn became the only program to swept a regional on the road in each of the last two seasons before also becoming the first team to defeat North Carolina in a Chapel Hill Super Regional, punching its ticket to Omaha for the first time since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine



innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.

He earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters, Anna, Olivia and Madelyn.

**SCOUTING THE KNIGHTS**

- UCF enters the weekend with a 4-1 record after sweeping Siena in a four-game series to start the season and dropping its midweek contest against Stetson.
- Offensively, the Knights are hitting .258 with 15 extra-base hits, including five home runs by different players. Nick Romano and Ben McCabe lead the way with .400 batting averages, while Jordan Rathbone leads the team from a power and run production standpoint with five RBI.
- On the mound, UCF has turned in a 2.40 ERA through five games. The Knights have struck out 66 batters in 45.0 innings of work, including 58 batters in four games against Siena. Friday night starter Colton Gordon struck out 10 batters in 6.1 innings in the season opener.

**SWINGING HOT STICKS**

- Auburn has scored 61 runs in its first five games, marking the most runs through five games since 2000.
- The Tigers lead the SEC and rank in the top five in the NCAA in average (.375), hits (66), doubles (22) and runs.
- The team has 10 or more hits in four straight contests and has scored 10 or more runs in three of five games this season. Auburn had 10 or more hits in five straight games in 2018 and in spans of six and eight straight games in 2016.

**DYNAMIC DUO**

- Rankin Woley and Ryan Bliss are a combined 22-for-43 (512) with 14 runs scored, 10 doubles and 18 RBI through five games this season.
- Bliss is one of two players in the country to rank in the top 10 in hits (11), runs (9), doubles (4) and RBI (10). He is tied for the SEC lead in both hits and RBI.
- Woley leads the league in doubles (6) and is tied with Bliss for the league lead in hits. He also ranks in the top five in total bases (17) and RBI (8).

**PUNCHING 'EM OUT**

- Auburn has struck out 62 batters in its first five games, marking the most strikeouts through five games since 1997.
- The team has recorded double digit strikeouts in all five games this season, marking the first time to accomplish the feat in five straight games since 2004.
- The Tigers rank fourth in the country in strikeouts and 14th in strikeouts per nine innings (13.0).

**PACKED PLAINSMAN PARK**

- Auburn has welcomed 16,342 fans through the gates of Plainsman Park this season, including 13,747 during opening weekend. The Tigers currently rank 10th in the country in total attendance and 16th in average attendance.
- The attendance of 3,753 on Opening Night was the third-largest recorded for a season opener in program history.
- The 2020 season marks the first time in program history that reserved season tickets have been sold out. The team has increased season ticket sales in each of head coach Butch Thompson's five seasons - 1,638 (2016), 1,645 (2017), 1,991 (2018), 2,163 (2019) and 2,297 (2020).

**WELCOME HOME, HUDDY**

- Former Auburn great and 17-year MLB veteran Tim Hudson returns to the Auburn baseball program as the volunteer assistant and pitching coach in 2020.
- Hudson posted a 222-133 record with a 3.49 ERA in his MLB career and is the winningest MLB pitcher in SEC history. Eligible for the Hall of Fame ballot next year, Hudson was a four-time All-Star and 2014 World Series champion with the San Francisco Giants. He is a member of the Atlanta Braves Hall of Fame and Alabama Sports Hall of Fame.

**HISTORIC RUN**

- Auburn's appearance in the 2019 College World Series was the team's fifth all-time and the first since 1997.
- The Tigers have been to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03 and two straight super regionals for the first time in program history.
- The team has won 118 games in the last three seasons, marking the most wins in a three-year span since winning 124 games from 1999-2001.

**STRONG STARTS**

- Auburn started the 2018 season 15-0, marking the second-best start in program history, and was 20-2 to start the 2019 season, which was tied for the best 22-game start in history.
- Auburn is 43-10 (.811) against non-conference opponents in the regular season dating back to 2018, including 25-3 (.893) on the weekend.

**PRESEASON RECOGNITION**

- Coming off an All-American campaign in 2019, junior right-hander Tanner Burns has been named preseason All-SEC, a preseason All-American by Baseball America, Collegiate Baseball, D1 Baseball and Perfect Game, and a member of the Golden Spikes Award watch list for the second straight season.
- Burns went 4-4 with a 2.82 ERA in 2019 and joined Casey Mize as just the second pitcher since 2000 to strike out 100 or more batters in a season.

**GAP-TO-GAP**

- Auburn ranks second in the country with 22 doubles this season (trailing Troy - 29).
- The 22 doubles are the most through five games in the Stat Crew era (since 1993) and the most in any five-game stretch since hitting 26 doubles in five games from Feb. 8-13, 2000.

**BULL IN THE PEN**

- Junior reliever Cody Greenhill recorded his 18th career save in Friday's season opener, ranking sixth in program history in the category. He would move into a tie for fourth in program history with two more saves.
- Greenhill ranked tied for second in the league with 12 saves in 2019, including seven in SEC play.
- He joined Burns as a preseason All-American, earning the recognition from NCBWA. He was also named preseason All-SEC and to the NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list for the second straight season.

**ALL-SEC TIGER TRIO**

- Senior infielder Rankin Woley joined Burns and Greenhill as a preseason All-SEC honoree, marking the first time Auburn had multiple members recognized by the league's head coaches in the preseason.
- The Tigers were one of four teams - joining Arkansas, Mississippi State and Vanderbilt - with three or more preseason all-SEC honorees.

**GARNERING ATTENTION**

- Auburn was picked by the league's head coaches to finish tied for third in the SEC West.
- The team picked up two first-place votes in the division and one vote as the overall conference champion.
- The third place finish is the highest Auburn has been picked in the sixth addition of the preseason coaches poll.

**WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE**

- Auburn returns seven everyday starters and 10 pitchers, including eighth who threw 35 or more innings, from last year's College World Series team.

**HOME SWEET HOME**

- Auburn opens the 2020 season with 23 consecutive games at Plainsman Park and has 37 home games on the schedule.
- The Tigers are 55-16 (.775) at home since the start of the 2018 season.

**TIGERS IN THE DRAFT**

- Auburn had five players selected in the 2019 MLB Draft, imarking the 14th straight season the team has had multiple players drafted
- The Tigers have also had at least one player selected for 45 straight years, which is tied for the longest streak in the SEC.

**BIG LEAGUE TIGERS**

- In 2018, former Auburn pitcher Trey Wingenter became the 51st player in Auburn history to appear in the Major Leagues. He made his MLB debut for the San Diego Padres on Aug. 7, 2018.
- Wingenter was one of three former Tigers to spend the entirety of the 2019 season on a big league roster, joining Josh Donaldson (Braves) and Garrett Cooper (Marlins). Grant Dayton also appeared for the Braves last season.
- Coming off a 2018 season in which he spent some time on the DL, Donaldson bounced back with the Braves and hit 37 home runs with 94 RBI en route to being named the NL Comeback Player of the Year.

**TAKE 'EM TO SCHOOL**

- Auburn has 12 players on its team that chose to attend Auburn rather than sign a professional contract, including four players who were selected in the 2019 draft in June.

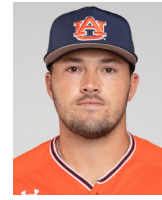
