

#### NO. 9 AUBURN FACES FIRST ROAD TEST OF 2021 AT NO. 8 KENTUCKY

The No. 9 Auburn gymnastics team hits the road for the first time in 2021, traveling to No. 8 Kentucky for a Friday night conference meet. The SEC rivals will go head-to-head at 6 p.m. CT in Memorial Coliseum, Jan. 15, and the meet will be televised live on SEC Network.

"This trip is not going to be easy," head coach Jeff Graba said. "I think we can get better on the road this week and it's going to be a great opportunity for mental success. We haven't had much success at Kentucky and we're hoping to get a good meet in and come away an even stronger, more cohesive team."

"Kentucky is a lot like us right now as far as talent and youth," Graba added. "They are extremely talent and we're going to have to stay tough to get through Friday with a solid score."

#### IN THE RANKINGS

The Auburn gymnastics team enters the week at No. 9 per RoadtoNationals.com. The weekly rankings are based on the overall team score from the season-opening weekend.

"It feels good to have a good meet under out belt and to be ranked in the Top 10," head coach Jeff Graba said. "As always, we are focusing on the road ahead and this Friday will be a great test. Not only is it a tough road meet, but also because we have room to improve as well."

This week's top five has Florida (No. 1) and Oklahoma (No. 2) separated by .050 points. Utah is third, while Alabama and LSU are fourth and fifth, respectively.

Arkansas (No. 6) and Georgia (No. 7) are also among the top 10 with Missouri ranked No. 14.

Junior Derrian Gobourne is ranked tied for third on bars (9.900) and tied for fourth on floor (9.925). The Sarasota, Fla., product is also tied for third in the all-around (39.425). Sophomore Cassie Stevens is tied for 12th in the all-around (39.225) for the Tiaers.

#### **AUBURN LINEUP**

The Auburn lineup once again features a wealth of youth as 15 of 24 routines will come from sophomores and freshmen at Kentucky.

Auburn will have a pair of Tigers competing in the all-around with junior Derrian Gobourne leading the charge. She's coming off a 39.425 last week in the category, which was just .050 off her career high.

Joining her will be freshman Olivia Hollingsworth. The allaround nod will be the first of her career.

Being on the road, the Tigers will go bars, vault, floor and beam.

Freshman Gabby McLaughlin will lead things off on bars, competing in the event for the first time in her career. Hollingsworth will follow in the second spot and is also making her first start on bars.

Three sophomores follow in the event with Anna Sumner going third. The Sumner, Ga., product led off last week with a 9.75. Classmate Piper Smith is fourth with Adeline Sabados going fifth. Gobourne will anchor the event following a 9.9 vs. Florida. That score gave her the event title.

The Tigers move on to the vault in the second rotation and have two freshmen kicking off the event. Getting her first start as a Tiger will be Payton Smith who will lead off. Hollingsworth will go second with Piper Smith going third. Smith finished with a 9.8 vs. Florida in her first start.

Sabados is slated for fourth and put together a 9.85 last week on her Yurchenko full. Senior Drew Watson is fifth and Gobourne will anchor.

Auburn will head to floor for rotation three and junior Sabrina Cheney is down in the lead off position. McLaughlin will earn her first start on floor and will go second. Hollingsworth, who led off last week with a 9.75, is down in the third.

Sabados and Watson will go fourth and fifth for the Tigers in the third rotation. Watson earned a 9.85 last week for the squad. Gobourne will anchor following a 9.925 performance vs. Florida.

The Tigers close out their first road trip on beam with Watson leading off for the second-straight meet. Hollingsworth and Piper Smith will make their first starts in the event and will go second and third.

Senior Meredith Sylvia is slotted at fourth on beam. Gobourne will go fifth and McLaughlin will anchor. McLaughlin kicked off her career on beam vs. Florida, scoring a 9.825.

#### **GOBOURNE SHINES VS. FLORIDA**

Junior Derrian Gobourne competed in the all-around for the first time last week (Jan. 8) since the first meet of 2020. The Sarasota, Fla., put together a 39.425 to finish second in the category at the end of the night. That score was just .050 off her career high and ranks tied for third in the country.

"Derrian has improved on all four events and it's so nice to have her back in the all-around," head coach Jeff Graba said. "She's a steady and solid performer in our lineup."

Gobourne finished the night with four solid scores, starting with a 9.925 on floor. She won the bars title with a 9.9 and finished with a 9.875 on yault and 9.725 on beam.

"She's not even close to what she could do this year so that's a good sign of things to come," Graba said. "She continues to rise to the occasion and is a phenomenal competitor."

#### **YOUTHFUL TIGERS**

With the departure of a solid group of seniors at the end of last year, the Tigers are looking to lean heavily on its youth to fill the gaps.

Leading the charge is a dynamic group of sophomores - Aria Brusch, Morgan Leigh Oldham, Elise Panzner, Adeline Sabados, Piper Smith, Cassie Stevens and Anna Sumner.

Stevens and Brusch were primary competitors throughout 2020

with Stevens competing in the all-around and Brusch going in three of four events. Sabados competed on bars in every meet as a freshman, while the rest of the crew provided much-needed depth.

Auburn's freshman class features a group of athletes expected to make big strides in 2021. The group of Brooke Butler, Olivia Hollingsworth, Gabby McLaughlin, Payton Smith and Tara Walsh.

Hollingsworth is set to make her first start in the all-around vs. Kentucky, while McLaughlin will compete in three of four events. Payton Smith will compete on vault for the squad.

"Olivia wasn't training at full speed in December so we wanted to get her out there against Florida and get her warmed up," head coach Jeff Graba said. "At the last minute, we moved lineups around because she was warming up really well. She's rising to the occasion and improving really quickly. We needed her to step up and she's continuing to do that.

"Gabby exceled on beam for us and putting a freshman fifth on beam is an act of faith, especially in the first meet," Graba said. "She's proving that she's a gamer."

#### **VAULT PREVIEW**

Auburn will be looking to the youth of its roster to fill some big shoes from last year's solid vault season. The 2020 Tigers finished tied for 10th nationally in the event and does return three 10.0 vaults from last season in Drew Watson, Derrian Gobourne and Cassie Stevens. Watson was a first team All-American in the event, while Gobourne captured the 2019 national championship. Stevens returns as an SEC All-Freshman performer in the event.

"I think vault will be another bright spot this year," Graba said.
"We actually have some depth this year and in our mind, we should have some predictable consistency this season. As long as we stay healthy, we should be able to do some really good things on vault."

#### **BARS PREVIEW**

Auburn bars workers will have big shoes to fill with the departure of Gracie Day last season. But the crew is up to the task as Gobourne and sophomore trio Adeline Sabados, Aria Brusch and Stevens also return. Gobourne secured second team

All-America honors in the event at the end of 2020.

"We're really focusing on developing more depth on bars this year," Graba said. "The returning group of starters are doing well in the gym and have really improved their routines this year. We're excited to develop that depth, while also encouraging the top six to really go for it this year."

#### **BEAM PREVIEW**

Beam is an event that the Tigers boast a wealth of depth on. With returners like seniors Drew Watson and Meredith Sylvia and sophomores Brusch and Stevens, the team is looking to refine this group into a consistent rotation that does well under pressure.

"We have a lot of people who could do beam, but the real trick is to figure out who's capable in the moment," Graba said. "We're starting to see some people rise to the occasion in practice and were really excited to see how this group continues to improve this year."

#### **FLOOR PREVIEW**

Auburn's floor rotation lost big hitters in Skyler Sheppard and Day as well as Emma Slappey from last season and will be full of youth in 2021.

Leading the way is Gobourne, who notched a career-best 9.95 on two occasions last year. She's expected to bring another fun routine with big skills this season. Joining her will be Watson, Stevens and Brusch who all competed in the event last year.

"We're feeling really good about where we are on floor as long as we stay healthy," Graba said. "We have solid returners in this group that have been consistent and we also have people stepping up with really good routines. We're excited to see what happens."

#### **UP NEXT**

Auburn continues its road swing, traveling to rival and No. 4 Alabama next Friday, Jan. 22. The two squad will face off at 7:30 p.m. CT in Tuscaloosa on SEC Network.

Head coach Jeff Graba has put the Auburn gymnastics program on the map throughout his 10 years on the Plains. Now entering his 11th season at the helm in 2021, Graba and the Tigers are looking to build on their accomplishments to reach bigger feats in the sport.

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

Most recently, Graba and his staff guided a pair of Tigers to All-America honors in 2020. Drew Watson picked up first team recognition for her performances on vault and finished with an NQS of 9.92 in the event to finish in a tie for seventh nationally. Her selection marked the first All-America honor for a Tiger in the category since 2016.

Derrian Gobourne was placed on the second team for her efforts on bars in 2020. Her All-America honor in the event is the first for any Tiger on bars at the conclusion of the regular season. Gobourne finished tied for 14th nationally with a 9.905.

The 2020 squad enjoyed a wealth of accomplishments throughout the season, including a win over Alabama in Auburn Arena.

Auburn's performances in 2019 was one for the books as the squad reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen. Auburn reached the second round of the NCAA Regional Championship with a 197.075 in Baton Rouge, marking the highest NCAA Regional score in program history.

The program saw its first national champion in 2019 when Gobourne came in a tie for first at that 2019 National Championship on vault. She scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way. In addition, Gobourne earned All-SEC and Freshman All-SEC recognition.

In nine seasons, Graba has led his student-athletes to 15 All-America honors (both NACGC/W and NCAA) and 19 All-SEC recognitions. Leading the way was Caitlin Atkinson who amassed nine All-America nods and named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

With the help of continuous progress, Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance each season. Each season, the team's attendance average has climbed higher and higher and after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season, Auburn finished the 2020 season with a new program record average of 6,364 fans. In addition, the Tigers have enjoyed 10 sellouts of Auburn Arena (7,424).
