

#### NO. 14 AUBURN HOSTS NO. 1 FLORIDA TO KICK OFF 2021

The No. 14 Auburn gymnastics team returns to competition and kicks off the 2021 season in Auburn Arena, hosting No. 1 Florida Friday. The Tigers and the Gators will square off in the season opener at 7 p.m. CT and the meet will be streamed live on SEC Network+.

"We are so excited and thankful to be starting the season Friday," head coach Jeff Graba said. "Obviously, this season is going to look and feel different, but we are looking forward to competing in front of a crowd again. We might be young, but we have an extremely talented squad that is ready to compete.

"With an SEC-only schedule this year, it's going to be a challenge each week," Graba added. "Florida is the top team in the country for a reason and will be ready to come out and hit on all cylinders. We just need to keep our blinders on and focus on what we're doing Friday and I think we can be very successful."

The 2021 Auburn gymnastics team will open the year at No. 14, the Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association announced

"It is exciting to see that our competitors believe we will be even more competitive this year after a crazy offseason and the departure of a large senior class," Graba said. "I feel very good about our team this year and we are very much looking forward to finally competing again after such an abrupt end to the 2020 season."

Two Southeastern Conference teams are ranked in the Top 5, while all eight schools are among the Top 20. Defending SEC champion Florida is on top of the list at No. 1, while LSU ranks No. 3. Alabama stands at No. 6 with Georgia (No. 10), Kentucky (No. 12), #WarEagle

#### **GYMNAST TO WATCH: DERRIAN GOBOURNE**

Arkansas (No. 15) and Missouri (No. 16) all being among the top programs nationally.

The 2021 regular season will feature an all-SEC schedule, seeing the Tigers face a Top 25 team each week.

#### **AUBURN LINEUP**

The Auburn lineup is full of youth as 17 of 24 routines will come from sophomores or freshmen.

Being the home squad, Auburn will kick things off on vault in the first rotation. Four of the six competitors in the lineup will be competing the event for the first time in their careers.

Freshman Olivia Hollingsworth is down as leadoff for the Tigers, while sophomore Piper Smith got the nod in the event and will be second. The opening pair will both be competing in the Auburn lineup for the first time Friday.

Sophomores Adeline Sabados and Aria Brusch will go third and fourth on vault, securing their first career starts in the event. Sophomore Cassie Stevens is set in the fifth slot. The Phoenix, Ariz., product secured SEC All-Freshman team accolades for her performances on vault last season. Anchoring the event will be junior Derrian Gobourne, who was the 2019 NCAA champion on vault and an All-American.

The Tigers head to bars for rotation two and will be sophomore heavy. Sophomore Anna Sumner is making her first start in the event after competing in exhibition last season, leading off for the squad. Smith will follow with Stevens, Sabados and Brusch going in spots three through five. The trio were regulars in the bars lineup last season with Brusch being one of the top bars workers in the NCAA Central Region.

Gobourne will anchor once again, securing the spot after an outstanding 2020 in the event. As the anchor last season, Gobourne secured second team All-America honors on bars and recorded a career-best 9.925 on three occasions.

Rotation three has Auburn on beam and will feature a good mix of experience and youth. Senior Drew Watson will lead things

off, making her 31st start in the event. Smith will once again go second in her first beam start, while senior Meredith Sylvia is down for third. Sylvia, who has competed in every meet in the event so far in her career, has a pair of 9.925s under her belt.

Gobourne is set in the fourth spot, making her return to the beam lineup this year after only competing in the event once in 2020. Freshman Gabby McLaughlin earned the starting nod for the team and Stevens will anchor.

The final rotation will be floor and is once again a mix of experience and new faces. Leading off will be junior Sabrina Cheney. The Port Orange, Fla., product competed in the event three times last season for the squad. Sophomore Morgan Leigh Oldham is slated to go second with Sabados going third. Oldham had one start on floor last year, while the appearance for Sabados in the event is the first of her career.

Stevens and Brusch, who each competed in the event in every meet in 2020, will go fourth and fifth. Gobourne closes out the rotation as anchor. The Sarasota, Fla., product finished with a 9.875 NQS last season, scoring a career-best 9.95 twice during her sophomore campaign.

The Tigers will have two exhibitions per event Friday. Senior Jada Glenn and freshman Payton Smith will go on vault, while McLaughlin and Sylvia are exhibitioning on bars. Oldham and Brusch are down for beam and McLaughlin and Watson will cap the night in exhibition on floor.

#### **EXPERIENCED ALL-AROUNDERS**

Junior Derrian Gobourne and sophomore Cassie Stevens are set to compete in the all-around for the Tigers Friday night.

It will be Gobourne's first appearance in the all-around after last competing in the category during the first meet of 2020. As a freshman in 2019, Gobourne won at least a share of the all-around five times.

Stevens had a Top 40 all-around average as a freshman last year, competing on all four events in all but one meet. Notched a career-best 39.300 vs. Missouri and picked up a pair of all-

around titles - at Georgia, vs. TWU.

#### **2020 IN REVIEW**

The Tigers finished the shortened 2020 season at No. 17 in the national rankings with a 196.490 NQS. The squad reached a season-best 196.7 on two occasions and kicked off their home schedule with a 196.625 victory over Alabama in Auburn Arena (1/10/20).

Auburn enjoyed being at home as the team set the program attendance record. The Tigers saw an average of 6,364 fans inside Auburn Arena over five meets competed. That included a sellout (7,424) vs. the Crimson Tide.

Individually, junior Drew Watson and sophomore Derrian Gobourne each earned All-America honors at the conclusion of the year as well as All-SEC recognition.

Watson was a first team All-American and All-SEC performer on vault, finishing with a 9.92 NQS in the event. She scored 9.9 or higher seven times, including a 9.975 at Arkansas (Feb. 21).

Gobourne was second team All-American and All-SEC performance on bars after concluding the year with a 9.905 NQS. She reached a career-best 9.925 in the event three times, including in the team's win over Alabama.

#### **VAULT PREVIEW**

Auburn will be looking to the youth of its roster to fill some big shoes from last year's solid vault season. The 2020 Tigers finished tied for 10th nationally in the event and does return three 10.0 vaults from last season in Drew Watson, Derrian Gobourne and Cassie Stevens. Watson was a first team All-American in the event, while Gobourne captured the 2019 national championship. Stevens returns as an SEC All-Freshman performer in the event.

"I think vault will be another bright spot this year," Graba said.
"We actually have some depth this year and in our mind, we should have some predictable consistency this season. As long as we stay healthy, we should be able to do some really good things on vault."

#### **BARS PREVIEW**

Auburn bars workers will have big shoes to fill with the

departure of Gracie Day last season. But the crew is up to the task as Gobourne and sophomore trio Adeline Sabados, Aria Brusch and Stevens also return. Gobourne secured second team All-America honors in the event at the end of 2020.

"We're really focusing on developing more depth on bars this year," Graba said. "The returning group of starters are doing well in the gym and have really improved their routines this year. We're excited to develop that depth, while also encouraging the top six to really go for it this year."

#### **BEAM PREVIEW**

Beam is an event that the Tigers boast a wealth of depth on. With returners like seniors Drew Watson and Meredith Sylvia and sophomores Brusch and Stevens, the team is looking to refine this group into a consistent rotation that does well under pressure.

"We have a lot of people who could do beam, but the real trick is to figure out who's capable in the moment," Graba said. "We're starting to see some people rise to the occasion in practice and were really excited to see how this group continues to improve this year."

#### **FLOOR PREVIEW**

Auburn's floor rotation lost big hitters in Skyler Sheppard and Day as well as Emma Slappey from last season and will be full of youth in 2021.

Leading the way is Gobourne, who notched a career-best 9.95 on two occasions last year. She's expected to bring another fun routine with big skills this season. Joining her will be Watson, Stevens and Brusch who all competed in the event last year.

"We're feeling really good about where we are on floor as long as we stay healthy," Graba said. "We have solid returners in this group that have been consistent and we also have people stepping up with really good routines. We're excited to see what happens."

#### **UP NEXT**

The Tigers take to the road for two-straight road meets, starting at No. 12 Kentucky. Auburn and the Wildcats will face off Friday, Jan. 15, at 6 p.m. CT in Lexington. The meet will be televised on SEC Network.

#### **GYMNAST TO WATCH:** Meredith Sylvia

Head coach Jeff Graba has put the Auburn gymnastics program on the map throughout his 10 years on the Plains. Now entering his 11th season at the helm in 2021, Graba and the Tigers are looking to build on their accomplishments to reach bigger feats in the sport.

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

Most recently, Graba and his staff guided a pair of Tigers to All-America honors in 2020. Drew Watson picked up first team recognition for her performances on vault and finished with an NQS of 9.92 in the event to finish in a tie for seventh nationally. Her selection marked the first All-America honor for a Tiger in the category since 2016.

Derrian Gobourne was placed on the second team for her efforts on bars in 2020. Her All-America honor in the event is the first for any Tiger on bars at the conclusion of the regular season. Gobourne finished tied for 14th nationally with a 9.905.

The 2020 squad enjoyed a wealth of accomplishments throughout the season, including a win over Alabama in Auburn Arena.

Auburn's performances in 2019 was one for the books as the squad reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen. Auburn reached the second round of the NCAA Regional Championship with a 197.075 in Baton Rouge, marking the highest NCAA Regional score in program history.

The program saw its first national champion in 2019 when Gobourne came in a tie for first at that 2019 National Championship on vault. She scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way. In addition, Gobourne earned All-SEC and Freshman All-SEC recognition.

In nine seasons, Graba has led his student-athletes to 15 All-America honors (both NACGC/W and NCAA) and 19 All-SEC recognitions. Leading the way was Caitlin Atkinson who amassed nine All-America nods and named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

With the help of continuous progress, Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance each season. Each season, the team's attendance average has dimbed higher and higher and after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season, Auburn finished the 2020 season with a new program record average of 6,364 fans. In addition, the Tigers have enjoyed 10 sellouts of Auburn Arena (7,424).
