### Series History

» Auburn and Alabama are set to meet on the hardwood for the 163rd time Saturday morning. Alabama leads the all-time series, 97-65, but Auburn has won six of the last nine in the series. The Tigers have won seven of the last eight on The Plains, including the last five. In the last eight games at home, Auburn has outscored Alabama 82.5-72.1.

» Auburn has the most games of 15 or more 3s since head coach Bruce Pearl took over prior to the 2014-15 season. The Tigers have 16 games of 15 or more 3s since 2014-15, while the rest of the league has 41 combined.

» After scoring 21 vs. Arkansas and 20 at Texas A&M, Jamal Johnson became the first Auburn player to have consecutive 20-point games off the bench since Rasheem Barrett in 2005-06. Johnson earned his first start as an Auburn Tiger at Ole Miss.

» Jaylin Williams is one of five underclassmen forwards in the country to average 10 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game this season. In addition, Williams is one of just two big men in the SEC to average three assists per game so far this campaign, joining LSU's Trendon Watford.

» Allen Flanigan has improved his scoring from 3.2 points per game last season to 13.5 points this season, the third-biggest improvement among SEC players. Flanigan has reached double figures in nine of 11 games this season, including seven of the last eight contests.

» Auburn lost 84.1 percent of its scoring from a season ago - the fifth-most in the country - and graduated the winningest class in program history in 2020 (99 wins).

- Has advanced to postseason play in 20 of 25 years as a head coach. Following a second-place finish in the SEC with a 25-6 record, including 12-6 in league play, that would be 21 of 25 had the postseason not been canceled due to COVID

- Set single-season wins records at four different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008; 30 at Auburn in 2019)

- Pearl has achieved a top-5 national ranking at Southern Indiana, Tennessee and Auburn. He has been in the top five in 10 seasons (1994-2001 at Southern Indiana, 2007-08 at Tennessee, 2019-20 at Auburn)

- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 17 of the 25 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg

- One of 12 coaches to lead three different DI programs to the Sweet 16, joining Rick Barnes, Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Lon Kruger, Frank McGuire, Ralph Miller, Rick Pitino, Bill Self, Tubby Smith, Eddie Sutton and Bruce Weber. Including his stint at DII Southern Indiana, Pearl is one of only three coaches to take four programs (with three at the DI level) to the Sweet 16, joining Lon Kruger and Eddie Sutton

- With the win over Kentucky that sent Auburn to its first Final Four in program history, Pearl notched his 100th win as head coach of the Tigers. He is the first coach in Auburn history to have 100 wins in his first five seasons

- Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)

- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the sixth straight time in 2019-20, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came was 1999-2000

- In 25 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 17 times

- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 20 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg

- In the past four seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 47-5 (.904), while scheduling regular NCAA Tournament teams in Arizona, Davidson, Dayton, Duke, Iowa State, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech, UConn and Xavier

- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 29 graduates in six years – the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport

- Auburn recently secured its fourth perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history

- In the past five years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940

- Pearl started AURLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AURLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the AURLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease

- On Dec. 19, 2019, Children's Harbor in Birmingham, Ala. dedicated their on-site basketball court in honor of the charitable work done by Coach Pearl and the Pearl family over the last six years.

- Bruce Pearl has raised over \$1.2 million in only six golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl For the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families

- The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015

- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain

**AUBURN VS. ALABAMA SERIES**

» The Tigers and Crimson Tide are set to meet on the hardwood for the 163rd time Saturday morning. Alabama leads the all-time series, 97-65, but Auburn has won six of the last nine in the series.

» Auburn is 33-27 against Alabama at home, including 7-3 inside Auburn Arena. In total, the Tigers have won seven of the last eight on The Plains, including the last five. In the last eight games at home, Auburn has outscored Alabama 82.5-72.1.

» In last year's duel in Auburn Arena on Feb. 12, the Tigers emerged victorious, 95-91 in overtime. It was Auburn's fourth overtime game in the previous five games. The Tigers fended off an SEC record 22 3-pointers by the Crimson Tide and dominated the battle at the charity stripe, making 26 free throws compared to nine for Alabama.

» The Crimson Tide handed the Tigers their first loss of the season in Tuscaloosa in the first meeting between the two sides last year on Jan. 15, 83-64. Despite starting the season 15-0, Auburn had 21 turnovers and was limited to 32 percent shooting from the floor.

» Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl is 12-9 in his head coaching career against Alabama. Pearl 5-1 at home vs. the Crimson Tide while leading the Tigers. Pearl is 1-1 against Alabama head coach Nate Oats.

**LET IT FLY**

» Auburn set a program record with 22 3-pointers vs. South Alabama in the first home game of the season on Dec. 4. The Tigers lead the SEC and are 20th in the nation at 10.3 makes from downtown per game.

» As Coach Pearl has said, "As long as the 3 is worth more than the 2, we'll continue to take them." Below are all the games Auburn has hit at least 15 3-pointers as a team.

» Auburn has three players in the top 10 in the SEC in total 3-pointers made so far this season. Allen Flanigan is second in the league with 23 makes from downtown, Jamal Johnson is third with 23 and Justin Powell is ninth with 19.

**PLAYER TO WATCH: DYLAN CARDWELL**

Big man Dylan Cardwell has provided a spark off the bench in his first season in the orange and blue. The freshman touts a .750 field goal percentage, good for second in the SEC, trailing only Vanderbilt's Quentin Millora-Brown (.789). Cardwell has led Auburn in rebounding three times, including once in SEC play, and is averaging 4.4 boards in just 14.5 minutes per contest.

» Auburn has finished either first or second in the SEC in 3-pointers made in five of six seasons under Pearl, including setting a conference record with 454 in 2018-19 en route to a run to the Final Four. Last season, Auburn finished third in the league with 8.1 makes from behind the arc.

**TOUGH START, BUT PROMISING FUTURE**

» Auburn fell to 0-3 in SEC play for just the second time in the last decade. The last time the Tigers dropped their opening three games of league play was in 2016-17. During that season, Auburn won its fourth conference game over Missouri, 77-72. The Tigers closed out that year with a 7-11 record in league play and laid the foundation for what would be the winningest period in program history over the next three seasons.

**LOTS OF BALANCE**

» After losing a majority of its production from a season ago, Auburn has had to count on players to assume new roles for the 2020-21 season. In doing so, the Tigers have found balance across their lineup.

» Auburn is the only team in country to have three players averaging at least 10 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game.

» The Tigers are one of 15 teams to have multiple players achieve the criteria joining Bryant, Buffalo, The Citadel, Florida, Gonzaga, Louisville, Missouri State, New Mexico State, Northern Iowa, Ohio, Oklahoma State, Siena, South Dakota State and SMU. Auburn and Florida are the only schools to have multiple underclassmen average 10 points, 4.5 boards and 2.5 assists.

**JOHNSON LEADING BY EXAMPLE**

» As one of just two upperclassmen on the roster, junior Jamal Johnson has stepped up and provided a spark off the bench for the Tigers this season.

» Johnson is 11th in the SEC in scoring at 17.3 points per game in league action. He has produced back-to-back 20-point outings with a career-best 21 vs. Arkansas and 20 at Texas A&M.

» Johnson is the first Auburn player to have consecutive 20-point games off the bench since Rasheem Barrett, who scored 28 vs. Jacksonville State on Dec. 31, 2005 and 21 vs. Southern Miss on Jan. 4, 2006.

» Johnson is one of just seven players in the nation to tout multiple games of at least 20 points off the bench so far this season. He is joined by JD Notae (Arkansas), Trey Diggs (Bowling Green), Landers Nolley (Memphis), Quincy Olivari (Rice), Myron Gordon (Samford) and Emanuel Miller (Texas A&M).

» Against Ole Miss, Johnson earned his first start as an Auburn Tiger and his first since playing Cincinnati in the American Athletic Conference Tournament semifinals on March 10, 2018 as a member of the Memphis Tigers.

» Following an internship in the fall with 107.5 The Ticket, an ESPN affiliated radio station in Montgomery, Johnson earned bachelor's degree from the School of Communication and proudly wears an SEC Graduate patch. Johnson is now working towards a master's degree from the School of Communication.

**FLANIGAN ONE OF SEC'S MOST IMPROVED**

» With the departure of the five seniors and Isaac Okoro, who went No. 5 in the 2020 NBA Draft, there was plenty of opportunity for those that returned. Enter: Allen Flanigan. The Little Rock, Ark. native is Auburn's leading scorer at 13.5 points per game after averaging just 3.2 points per contest a season ago. Below is chart of the most improved players in the SEC, which includes Jaylin Williams.

» Flanigan has reached double figures in nine of 11 games this season, including seven of the last eight contests.

**JAY-WILL SHOWCASING HIS TALENT**

» In his second season in the program, Jaylin Williams is showcasing why he is one of the top talents in the Southeastern Conference.

» Williams is one of five underclassmen forwards in the country to average 10 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game this season.

» In addition, Williams is one of just two big men in the SEC to average three assists per game so far this campaign, joining LSU's Trendon Watford.

» Williams has scored in double figures seven times this season, including five of the last six games. Williams made a statement in his first collegiate start against Saint Joseph's on Nov. 26 when he had 18 points and 11 rebounds, good for his first career double-double. Most recently, Williams set a career-high with 24 points on 7-of-14 from the floor, including 6-of-10 from 3, and added four rebounds and four assists.

**JP IS A UNICORN**

» On Dec. 4, Auburn freshman Justin Powell made history with his performance against South Alabama. Powell had 26 points on 7-of-9 from the floor, with all of his shots behind the arc, and nine assists.

**CLASS OF THE SEC: MOST GRADUATES SINCE 2014**

When it comes to graduating players, nobody in the SEC has done it better than head coach Bruce Pearl and Auburn. Since 2014, the Tigers have had 31 student-athletes walk across the graduation stage and earn their degrees, which is the highest number in the SEC. » Powell's 26 points vs. South Alabama tied Eddie Johnson for the Auburn record for most points in a home debut by a freshman. Johnson had 26 points vs. Western Carolina 47 years to the day of Powell (Dec. 4, 1973).

» His nine assists and seven 3s vs. South Alabama were the most by a freshman in his home debut in program history.

» Powell is one of six freshman in the country since 2010 to have nine assists and seven 3s in a game, joining Trae Young (Oklahoma), Ky Bowman (Boston College), Shamorie Ponds (St. John's), Jordan Bohannon (Iowa) and Braden Norris (Oakland).

» He followed up that performance with 26 points and eight rebounds vs. Memphis, and was later awarded SEC Freshman of the Week.

» Powell became one of two freshman guards in the country to have an outing of 26 points and eight rebounds this season joining Robert Ford of Idaho State.

» In addition, Powell is the only player in the country to have performances of 25 or more points with eight rebounds and 25 or more points with nine assists this season.

» In his first 10 games in an Auburn jersey, freshman Justin Powell has attacked the glass as well as anyone in his position. Powell is tied for third in the country in rebounds per game among freshman guards.

**POWELL NAMED SEC FOTW**

» Justin Powell was selected as the SEC Freshman of the Week following his second consecutive 26-point performance in Auburn's 74-71 win vs. Memphis. He went 9 of 13 from the floor, including 4 of 6 from deep, in the victory. The Prospect, Ky. native scored the Tigers' first 11 points of the game and then had 15 of Auburn's 37 second-half points to lead a come-from-behind win in which the Tigers trailed by as many as eight.

**GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA**

Built at a cost of \$86 million, Auburn Arena seats 9,121 fans for basketball games. Auburn Arena replaced the old Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum as the home of Tiger basketball for the 2010-11 season. The furthest seat in Auburn Arena is just 43 feet away from the court. Two-thirds of the seats are less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside offering a home environment that is unrivaled.

» The Tigers have to replace the winningest class in program history as the 2020 seniors amassed 99 wins, besting the previous mark of 88 set by the 2001 seniors.

» The 2020 class also hold the most wins in a 3-year span with 81, most in a 2-year span with 56 and most in a single year with 30 in 2019.

**WELCOME TO THE JUNGLE**

» Known as one of the best homecourt environments in all of college basketball, Auburn has fed off of its consistently-packed crowds inside Auburn Arena, or as ESPN's Tom Hart has called it, "The Cathedral of Chaos."

» The Tigers finished the 2019-20 season at 16-1 at home, marking the most wins in Auburn Arena history and the second-most home wins ever in program history, trailing only the 18 by the 2008-09 team at Beard-Eaves-Memorial Coliseum.

» Auburn's 19-game home winning streak was snapped in the final home game of the season to Texas A&M, ending what was the eighth-longest active streak in the country.

» Auburn has won 33 straight regular season non-conference home games and holds perfect records over the last five seasons. Auburn is the only team in the SEC without a blemish at home against non-league foes since 2016-17.

» The Tigers' streak of 33 straight regular season non-conference home wins is tops in the SEC, leading Arkansas (20) and Georgia (18). The last time Auburn lost at home to a non-conference foe was Jan. 30, 2016 vs. Oklahoma State in the Big 12/SEC Challenge, 74-63.

### WHOLE LOTTA HEIGHT

» Auburn boasts the ninth-tallest team in the country, averaging 78.7 inches per player - nearly 6-foot-7.

» Auburn's average height of 78.7 inches on the 2020-21 roster is the tallest the Tigers have had over the last 15 seasons.

» Since 2007, Auburn has boasted an average height of 77 inches or more just four times: 77.1 in 2010-11, 77.9 in 2015-16, 77.3 in 2019-20 and 78.7 in 2020-21.

» Auburn's average height over the last 15 seasons is ranked in the middle of the pack nationally (160.5). The Tigers have had a roster in the top 100 in the country in terms of height just three times since 2007: 93rd in 2010-11, 48th in 2015-16 and ninth in 2020-21.

### TIGERS IN OVERTIME

» With a 96-91 win in overtime vs. Saint Joseph's, Auburn is 58-53 in overtime games all-time, including a 9-0 mark since the start of the 2018-19 season and 2-0 against Saint Joseph's.

» The Tigers are 12-2 in overtime under head coach Bruce Pearl, including a perfect 5-0 last season.

» Auburn's 9-game winning streak in overtime is currently the second-longest active winning streak behind Florida State (10). The all-time national record for consecutive overtime victories is 11 by Louisville (1968-75), UMass (1991-96) and Virginia (1991-96). Temple (seven) and Kansas (six) are next in the country in terms of longest active winning streaks in overtime.

### CLASS OF THE SEC

» In the last three seasons, no team in the SEC has won more than Auburn as the Tigers are one of just three programs to amass 70 wins. Listed below are the records of all 14 SEC teams from the 2017-18 season until now.

## OKORO MAKES HISTORY

Dreams became reality for former Auburn star Isaac Okoro Wednesday night when he was chosen with the No. 5 overall selection in the 2020 NBA Draft by the Cleveland Cavaliers.

Okoro's selection is tied for the third-highest selection in program history behind only Chris Morris (No. 4, 1988) and Chuck Person (No. 4, 1986). Charles Barkley was also chosen No. 5 in the 1984 NBA Draft.

The Powder Springs, Ga. native became the first one-and-done player in program history.

Okoro was just the sixth player in Southeastern Conference history to be named All-SEC, All-Defensive and All-Freshman in the same season.

Following Okoro's No. 5 selection and Chuma Okeke's No. 16 pick in the 2019 NBA Draft, Auburn has produced back-to-back first round draft picks for the first time in program history.

Okoro averaged 12.9 points, 4.4 rebounds, two assists, 0.9 steals and 0.9 blocks in 31.5 minutes per game while starting 28 games as a first-year player in senior-laden lineup. The Tigers posted a 25-6 record during the 2019-20 campaign.

Okoro scored in double figures 20 times and was named the SEC Freshman of the Week twice, becoming just the fourth freshman in program history to earn the conference distinction two times in a season.

Okoro is the second Tiger to be drafted by the Cavaliers, joining Mike Mitchell, who was taken with the 15th selection of the 1978 NBA Draft. Along with Mitchell (1978-82), former lettermen Eddie Johnson (1985-86) and Wesley Person (1997-2002) all played for the Cavs.

**AUBURN VS. TOP-25 OPPONENTS**

» Auburn is 70-215 against teams from the AP Top 25 all-time. In 2018-19, the Tigers set a program record by defeating six top-25 teams, including five in a row from the SEC Tournament title to a trip to the Final Four.

» The Tigers won two of their matchups against top-25 competition last season, taking down No. 13 Kentucky (75-66) and No. 18 LSU (91-90 in OT) in a span of seven days. Auburn lost its most recent top-25 battle at No. 8 Kentucky, 73-66.

» Auburn has won seven of its last nine games against the AP Top 25, which is the best stretch in program history by far. The next-closest similar streak was when the Tigers defeated six of nine ranked foes between the 1984-85 and 1985-86 seasons.

» Auburn is 14-23 as a ranked team vs. a ranked opponent all-time, but has won seven of the last nine occurrences.

**MAKE ROOM IN THE TROPHY CASE**

» Since the 2017-18 season, Auburn has won four trophies: 2018 SEC title, 2019 SEC Tournament crown, 2019 NCAA Midwest Regional championship and the 2019 Legends Classic.

» The Tigers lead the SEC in trophies in the last two-plus seasons. As a whole, the league has amassed 11 trophies through league championships, conference tournament championships, NCAA regional championships and in-season tournament championships. Auburn has four and Kentucky has three, while Florida, LSU, Tennessee and Texas A&M have all won one.

**AUBURN TO FORGO 2021 POSTSEASON**

» The Auburn men's basketball program will forgo postseason competition for the upcoming 2020-2021 season. The NCAA and the SEC have been notified.

» The athletics department and university administration, in conjunction with Coach Bruce Pearl, made the decision after careful deliberation and in light of the ongoing matter that surfaced in fall 2017 regarding former assistant coach Chuck Person. Auburn has cooperated with the NCAA and will continue to do so.

» We regret the impact this decision has on our student-athletes, yet it was made in the best long-term interest of the program. Because of the ongoing matter, we will not comment further but hope for swift consideration and resolution of the matter.

**Bruce Pearl Statement**

» "This was a difficult decision but the right decision. I hate it for our current players. They lost the opportunity for the postseason last year because of COVID, and now they will miss the post-season again. It's a two-year post-season penalty for them. However, we need to take this penalty now to put it behind us."

**BURCHAM ON THE CALL**

» Andy Burcham assumed his new role as Voice of the Auburn Tigers last season, taking the lead as the play-by-play radio broadcaster for the Auburn men's basketball, football and baseball programs. Burcham took over as Auburn's lead announcer this fall following the death in May of his best friend and baseball broadcast partner, Rod Bramblett.

» After calling Auburn women's basketball games for 31 seasons, Burcham made his debut as the primary men's basketball announcer in the season-opening win vs. Georgia Southern on Nov. 5 - what would have been Bramblett's 54th birthday.

» Over the years, Burcham handled play-by-play for a few men's basketball games when Bramblett was unavailable, most recently the season opener in 2013.

» Burcham is joined on the call with former Auburn head coach Sonny Smith. Smith was the head coach for 11 seasons from 1978-89 and led the Tigers to a 173-154 record in that span that included five straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 1984-88.
