• Auburn begins its 125th season of baseball, including its 72nd at Plainsman Park, with a threegame series against Presbyterian this weekend.

• Head coach Butch Thompson begins his sixth season at the helm of the program in 2021. He needs 14 wins to become the third winningest coach in program history.

Auburn is 89-33-2 all-time in season openers and has won 10 straight dating back to 2011.

The Tigers are 52-15 (.776) against non-conference opponents in the regular season since the start of the 2018 season, including 31-6 (.838) on the weekend.

• Senior right-hander Cody Greenhill is set to make his first career start Friday night. Greenhill has made 53 career relief appearances and ranks sixth in program history in saves (19).

• This series marks the third all-time between Auburn and Presbyterian. The Tigers took two of three games from the Blue Hose in 2014 and 2017 a won a midweek matchup in 2012.

Butch Thompson enters his sixth season at the helm of the program in 2020, posting a record of 154-115 in his first five seasons. He led the program to the first College World Series appearance in 22 years in 2019 and has taken the Tigers to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his sixth season with the Tigers in 2021.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 30 Division I All-Americans and 39 all-conference performers. He has seen 16 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including 10 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 32 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018. With Tanner Burns also going as a supplemental first round pick in 2020, Auburn became one of four programs with a pair of pitchers drafted in the first round in the last three years.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 13 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008, which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.


In 28 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 19 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached eight College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 17 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in five seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 154-115 overall record and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals for the first time in program history. After advancing to the College World Series in 2019 and a winner-take-all game three in the Gainesville Super Regional in 2018, the Tigers have finished each of the last two full seasons ranked as high as No. 8 and No. 9, respectively. It marked the third time in program history the team has finished back-to-back seasons in the top 10.

Entering the 2019 postseason as the No. 2 seed in the Atlanta Regional, Auburn became the only program to sweep a regional on the road in each of the last two potseasons before also becoming the first team to defeat North Carolina in a Chapel Hill Super Regional in 2019, punching its ticket to Omaha for the first time since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine



innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a thirdplace finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.

He earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters --- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail.

· Thirty-three games are scheduled to be played at Plainsman Park in 2021, including 13 of the first 17 contests. • The Tigers are 87-34 (.719) at home since the start of the 2017 season and 64-21 (.753) at home since the start of the 2018 season.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

• Auburn is 52-15 (. 776) against non-conference opponents in the regular season since 2018, including 31-6 (.838) on the weekend.

PROVEN VETERANS

· Seniors Cody Greenhill and Jack Owen are two of eight SEC pitchers with a career sub-4.00 ERA and 100+ IP. Greenhill has posted a 2.59 ERA in 128.2 IP while Owen has turned in a 3.76 clip in 124.1 IP.

PROLIFIC OFFENSE

· Auburn finished the shortened 2020 season as the national leader in batting average (.330) and also ranked in the top 10 in the country in hits (210), doubles (51), runs (158) and on-base percentage (.421).

RACE TO 100

• Ryan Bliss (84 games) and Rankin Woley (82 games) have each accounted for 99 hits since the start of the 2019 season, marking the sixth most in the SEC during that time and the second most among active players.

 With a hit Friday, Bliss would become the fastest Auburn player to arrive as a true fresman to reach 100 career hits since Jordan Ebert did it in 83 career games (2013-14).

· Comparatively, it took Auburn's career hits leader Jay Waggoner 92 games to record his 100th career hit.

• Auburn greats Gabe Gross, Frank Thomas and Josh Donaldson reached their 100th career hits in 70, 81 and 93 games, respectively.







GETTING IT STARTED

• Judd Ward and Ryan Bliss have hit first and second in the Auburn lineup in 44 straight games dating back to 2019.

• During the 44-game span, the duo is hitting .313 (115-368) with 80 runs, 21 doubles, three triples, nine home runs and 64 RBI.

SWING IT, STEVEN

• Senior outfielder Steven Williams enters the 2021 season ranked second among active SEC players in hits (140), home runs (23) and RBI (99).

• Williams would enter the top 10 in program history with 12 or more home runs this season.

HOLDING IT DOWN

 Outfielders Judd Ward, Kason Howell and Steven Williams have started together in 65 of 84 games dating back to the start of the 2019 season, including 61 of 66 games during the Tigers' run to Omaha.

A NEW ROLE

• Senior right-hander Cody Greenhill is set to make his first career start in the season opener Friday vs. Presbyterian.

• Greenhill has made 53 career relief appearances since 2018 and ranks sixth in program history in saves (19) and tied for 10th in ERA (2.59).

• The class was highlighted by Cole Foster, who was rated by PBR as the No. 26 player in the class and was recently tabbed by Perfect Game as the No. 4 college prospect for the 2023 MLB Draft.

• Transfers Bryson Ware, Josh Hall and Bobby Peirce look to make an impact on the field at at the plate, while freshmen Cam Hill and Joseph Gonzalez will look to carve out a role on the mound.

HISTORIC RUN

• Auburn's appearance in the 2019 College World Series was the team's fifth all-time and the first since 1997.

Eligible for the Hall of Fame ballot next year, Hudson was a four-time All-Star and 2014 World Series champion with the San Francisco Giants. He is a member of the Atlanta Braves Hall of Fame and Alabama Sports Hall of Fame.

AUBURN IN THE MLB DRAFT

• The 2020 MLB Draft marked the 46th consecutive year Auburn had at least one player selected, tied for the longest active streak in the SEC.
