» Auburn has won five of the last seven overall vs. Mississippi State and seven of the last eight matchups on The Plains.

» Auburn has won three of its last four regular season home finales. The Tigers defeated Missouri in 2017 (89-78), South Carolina (79-70) and No. 5 Tennessee in 2019 (84-80). Auburn's lone loss in that span was to Texas A&M last season (78-75) when the Aggies spoiled what would have been a perfect record at home. The Tigers ended last season 16-1 inside Auburn Arena.

» In what is usually reserved as Senior Day, this year's home finale will not hold a ceremony as the Tigers are without a senior. In fact, Auburn has just two upperclassmen on its roster, which is tied with UC Irvine for the fewest in the country.

» With a win last Saturday against his former employer Tennessee, Bruce Pearl is just one win away from the 600th of his career. Pearl needs only one win to become the 63rd coach in NCAA Division I history to achieve 600 victories.

» Allen Flanigan is one of just three players in the SEC to average 14 points, five rebounds and two assists per game, joining Tre Mann (Florida) and Trenderon Watford (LSU).

» In his last three games, Jamal Johnson has dished out 13 assists. In the 23 games prior, he had 16 assists total.

» Jaylin Williams is one of only 10 players in the country with at least 50 assists, 30 blocks and 15 steals this season.

- Has advanced to postseason play in 20 of 25 years as a head coach. Following a second-place finish in the SEC with a 25-6 record, including 12-6 in league play, that would be 21 of 25 had the postseason not been canceled due to COVID

- Set single-season wins records at four different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008; 30 at Auburn in 2019)

- Pearl has achieved a top-5 national ranking at Southern Indiana, Tennessee and Auburn. He has been in the top five in 10 seasons (1994-2001 at Southern Indiana, 2007-08 at Tennessee, 2019-20 at Auburn)

- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 17 of the 25 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg

- One of 12 coaches to lead three different DI programs to the Sweet 16, joining Rick Barnes, Gene Bartow, John Calipari, Lon Kruger, Frank McGuire, Ralph Miller, Rick Pitino, Bill Self, Tubby Smith, Eddie Sutton and Bruce Weber. Including his stint at DII Southern Indiana, Pearl is one of only three coaches to take four programs (with three at the DI level) to the Sweet 16, joining Lon Kruger and Eddie Sutton

- With the win over Kentucky that sent Auburn to its first Final Four in program history, Pearl notched his 100th win as head coach of the Tigers. He is the first coach in Auburn history to have 100 wins in his first five seasons

- Bruce Pearl is the 11th coach in SEC history to win four conference crowns (overall or division) in a 10-year span. He is on the same list as Adolph Rupp (UK), Babe McCarthy (MSU), Billy Donovan (UF), Dale Brown (LSU), Joe Hall (UK), John Calipari (UK), Nolan Richardson (ARK), Rick Pitino (UK), Rick Stansbury (MSU) and Tubby Smith (UK)

- Auburn sold out of season tickets for the sixth straight time in 2019-20, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came was 1999-2000

- In 25 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 17 times

- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 21 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg

- In the past four seasons, Auburn has the best non-conference record in the SEC during the regular season at 47-5 (.904), while scheduling regular NCAA Tournament teams in Arizona, Davidson, Dayton, Duke, Iowa State, Middle Tennessee, Murray State, Oklahoma, Texas Tech, UConn and Xavier

- His teams have been just as successful off the court as Auburn has had 29 graduates in six years – the most in the SEC. In 2018, Auburn received an Academic Progress Rate Public Recognition Award marking the first time the Tigers have been honored since the award began tracking data in 2004. The NCAA annually honors teams earning multiyear Academic Progress Rates in the top 10 percent of all squads in each sport

- Auburn recently secured its fourth perfect APR score of 1,000 in mid-May, something that has never been accomplished in program history

- In the past five years, Auburn men's basketball has averaged an APR of 995 (out of 1,000). In the previous four seasons before Pearl and his staff arrived, Auburn's APR average score was 940

- Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease

- On Dec. 19, 2019, Children's Harbor in Birmingham, Ala. dedicated their on-site basketball court in honor of the charitable work done by Coach Pearl and the Pearl family over the last six years.

- Bruce Pearl has raised over \$1.2 million in only six golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl For the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families

- The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015

- The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain

AUBURN VS. MISSISSIPPI STATE SERIES

» The Tigers and Bulldogs are set to square off for the 149th time in series history on Tuesday. Auburn holds a 78-70 advantage all-time and has won five of the last seven, including four of the last five overall.

» Auburn is 47-23 vs. Mississippi State on The Plains, which includes a 5-1 record inside Auburn Arena. The Tigers have won seven of the last eight in the series at home. In those games, the average score has been 81.4-75 in favor of the home team with Auburn amassing five games over 80 points, including three over 90.

» Head coach Bruce Pearl is 10-5 against the Bulldogs in his career and is 5-3 vs. Mississippi State head coach Ben Howland with all eight of the matchups coming with both coaches at their current schools.

» Last season, Auburn won at Humphrey Coliseum for just the third time in 18 tries since 2001. The Tigers had five in double figures led by J'Von McCormick's career-high of 28 - 20 of which came in the second half - en route to opening SEC play 1-0 and improving to 13-0 to begin the 2019-20 campaign.

PEARL APPROACHING 600

» With a win last Saturday against his former employer Tennessee, Bruce Pearl is just one win away from the 600th of his career. Pearl needs just one win to become the 63rd coach in NCAA Division I history to achieve 600 victories.

» Pearl won 231 games at Southern Indiana from 1992-2001, 86 at Milwaukee from 2001-05, 145 at Tennessee from 2005-11 and has 137 at Auburn from 2014 until now.

Allen Flanigan has played at an All-SEC level in his second season on The Plains. Flanigan is averaging 14.2 points per game in league action, good for 15th in the conference. Overall, the Little Rock, Ark. native is one of just three players in the SEC to average 14 points, five rebounds and two assists per game, joining Tre Mann (Florida) and Trendon Watford (LSU).

» Pearl became the sixth-fastest coach in NCAA history to reach 100 career wins (118 games), third-fastest to reach 200 career wins (240 games) and tied for the seventh-fastest to 300 career wins (382 games).

» Pearl recently passed his mentor Dr. Tom Davis, who he spent 14 seasons with at various stops that included Boston College, Stanford and Iowa.

SCORCHING THE NETS

» Auburn has consistently been one of the highest-scoring teams in the SEC under head coach Bruce Pearl. At 77.2 points per game, the Tigers are fifth in the league in scoring.

» Auburn is nearly on pace to average 78 points per game for the fifth consecutive season. That has only been accomplished one time ever from the 1973-74 season through the 1977-78 campaign. The Tigers averaged 78 points per game last season, 79.7 in 2018-19, 81.9 in 2017-18 and 80.4 in 2016-17.

» Auburn has amassed five 90-point games so far this season, which is tied for the 19th-most in college basketball and third in the SEC behind only Arkansas and LSU, who each have six so far this season.

» Auburn's record of 90-point games in one season is eight held by five teams: 2018-19, 2017-18, 1998-99, 1991-92 and 1970-71.

80-PIECE

» The Tigers have eclipsed the 80-point plateau 99 times under head coach Bruce Pearl, which is the 17th-most in college basketball since the 2014-15 season.

» Over the last three-plus seasons, Auburn has scored over 80 points in a game 65 times in 131 games (49.6 percent) since the start of the 2017-18 campaign. That mark is tied for sixth-best in the country in that span with Marshall and is second among major college basketball behind only Duke. The Tigers lead the SEC in the span, ahead of LSU (59), Arkansas (50), Arkansas (49) and Tennessee (44).

FIREWORKS IN COLUMBIA

» Speaking of offense, Auburn produced one of the best offensive performances not only in recent memory but also in program history.

» The Tigers had 109 points on 52 percent from the floor, including 52 percent from 3, and 94 percent from the charity stripe.

» Auburn's 109 points are the most the Tigers have ever scored in an SEC road game and the sixth-most they have scored against an SEC opponent at any location. It is the Tigers' first 100-point game in an SEC game since a 102-61 victory over Alabama on Feb. 13, 1999, and their first in an SEC road game since a 100-89 win at No. 8 Arkansas on Jan. 23, 1993.

» The 109 points are the fifth-most points the Tigers have scored in a game under head coach Bruce Pearl. It also marked the eighth time Auburn has reached triple digits under Pearl, which is 13 percent of the Tigers' total 100-point games (61).

» Since the start of the 2010-11 season, it was only the second time the Tigers have shot 50 percent from the field, 50 percent from 3-point range and 90 percent from the free-throw line and first time since Jan. 26, 2019 at Mississippi State (53% FG, 52% 3-pt, 91% FT).

LET IT FLY

» Auburn set a program record with 22 3-pointers vs. South Alabama in the first home game of the season on Dec. 4. The Tigers are third in the SEC and are 33rd in the nation at 9.1 makes from downtown per game.

» Auburn's 16 games of 15 or more 3-pointers since 2014-15 is tied for 11th in the country with Furman. The Tigers trail only Citadel (36), Villanova (28), Belmont (26), Central Michigan (26), North Florida (25), Savannah State (22), VMI (20), IPFW (19), Winthrop (19) and Akron (18).

» Auburn has two players in the top 15 in the SEC in total 3-pointers made so far this season. Jamal Johnson is fourth at 52, while Allen Flanigan is 15th at 41 makes from 3.

» Auburn has finished either first or second in the SEC in 3-pointers made in five of six seasons under Pearl, including setting a conference record with 454 in 2018-19 en route to a run to the Final Four. Last season, Auburn finished third in the league with 8.1 makes from behind the arc.

HOME FINALE

» Auburn has won three of its last four regular season home finales. The Tigers defeated Missouri in 2017 (89-78), South Carolina (79-70) and No. 5 Tennessee in 2019 (84-80). Auburn's lone loss in that span was to Texas A&M last season (78-75) when the Aggies spoiled what would have been a perfect record at home. The Tigers ended last season 16-1 inside Auburn Arena.

CLASS OF THE SEC: MOST GRADUATES SINCE 2014

When it comes to graduating players, nobody in the SEC has done it better than head coach Bruce Pearl and Auburn. FLANIGAN ONE OF SEC'S MOST IMPROVED

» With the departure of the five seniors and Isaac Okoro, who went No. 5 in the 2020 NBA Draft, there was plenty of opportunity for those that returned. Enter: Allen Flanigan. The Little Rock, Ark. native is one of Auburn's top scorers at 14 points per game after averaging just 3.2 points per contest a season ago. Below is a chart of the most improved players in the SEC, which also includes Jaylin Williams.

» Flanigan has reached double figures in 21 of 26 games this season, including 19 of the last 23 contests. Flanigan has eclipsed the 20-point plateau five times: vs. No. 1 Gonzaga (20), vs. Kentucky (21), at South Carolina (24), at Kentucky (23) and vs. No. 25 Tennessee (23).

» Flanigan's 21 double-digit scoring outputs is tied for the second in the SEC with Jaden Shackelford (Alabama), trailing only Moses Moody (Arkansas), D.J. Stewart (Mississippi State) and Cameron Thomas (LSU) with 22 each.

THERE'S A NEW SHARIFE IN TOWN

» In his first 12 career games, Sharife Cooper has scored or assisted on 471 of Auburn's 996 points (47.2 percent).

» Auburn has averaged 83 points on 44.2 percent shooting in Cooper's 12 games in the lineup. The Tigers have recorded 15.4 assists per game and are 217-of-275 (78.9 percent) from the free-throw line in those contests. In the other 14 games, Auburn is averaging 72.1 points and 14.3 assists per game while shooting 187-of-299 (62.5 percent) from the charity stripe.

» Cooper is one of three freshman in the nation with five games of 25 or more points. The Powder Springs, Ga. native is tied with Oklahoma State's Cade Cunningham for second behind only LSU's Cameron Thomas, who has 13.

» Cooper's impressive display of passing and his vision has contributed to 97 assists in just 12 games, which has already vaulted him to third in the SEC and 82nd in the country. While he ranks ninth in total assists among freshmen nationally, his 8.1 assists per game is tied for second-best among all players in the entire country during the 2020-21 campaign.

» Cooper scored 202 points and dished out 87 assists in his first 10 career games. The only other freshman over the last decade to average 20 points and eight assists over any 10-game stretch is Trae Young (Oklahoma), according to ESPN Stats & Info.

» Cooper made his highly-anticipated debut in an Auburn uniform vs. Alabama, and it will go down as one of the best debuts by a freshman in program history. The consensus 5-star signee had 26 points, nine assists, four rebounds and three steals in 33 minutes for the Tigers.

Cooper is one of three freshmen in the Auburn record books to score at least 20 points in their debut, joining Johnson and Jay Heard, who had 20 points vs. Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 13, 1998.

» In addition, Cooper matched Justin Powell and Eddie Johnson for the most points scored by a freshman in their first home game. Cooper's nine dimes tied Powell for the record in a home debut by a freshman in program history.

» For his efforts, Cooper was named the SEC Freshman of the Week after competing in his first competitive basketball game in 315 days.

» Cooper followed up his first career game with a sensational performance at Georgia. The Powder Springs, Ga. native had 28 points and dished out 12 assists to go along with five boards and two steals.

» Cooper had 16 points and 12 assists in a 109-86 rout at South Carolina. He had a double-double in the first half with 10 points and 11 assists.

» More recently, Cooper had 15 points and 14 assists vs. Ole Miss. It is the third point-assist double-double in his first nine career games. He has three of the four point-assist double-doubles accomplished by a freshman at Auburn since the assist became an official statistic prior to the 1983-84 season. Assistant coach Wes Flanigan has the only other one at Tennessee on Jan. 22, 1994.

» Cooper is the first Auburn player with a points-assists double-double since Jared Harper had 12 points and 10 assists against Murray State on Dec. 22, 2018. He is the first Tiger with a 20-point, 10-assist game since Harper had 20 points and 13 assists against South Alabama on Nov. 6, 2018, in the 2018-19 season opener.

» Cooper is one of two Tigers to have three point-assist double-doubles in a season since the assist became an official NCAA statistic prior to the 1983-84 season. Moochie Norris had three such games during the 1994-95 season.

» Cooper's three point-assist double-doubles are tied for the sixth-most among all players in the country and trailing only Oakland's Jalen Moore (10), Georgia's Sahvir Wheeler (six), SMU's Kendric Davis, Little Rock's Markquis Nowell and Winthrop's Chandler Vaudrin (four).

» Against Missouri, Cooper had 28 points, eight rebounds and seven assists. He is one of only seven in the country to have such a stat line this season, joining Hayden Brown (Citadel), DeVante Carter (Norfolk State), Mark Freeman (Tennessee State), Austin Reaves (Oklahoma), Anthony Tarke (Coppin State) and Noah Williams (Washington State)

» In that same game, Cooper set an Auburn record after going 18-of-21 from the charity stripe. Cooper's mark bested the 17 that was set by John Mengelt vs. Kentucky (March 2, 1970), Wally Tinker vs. Vanderbilt (Jan. 15, 1968) and Ray Groover vs. Florida State (Dec. 10, 1960). Cooper's 21 free throw attempts tied the single-game record with Ray Groover vs. Florida State (Dec. 10, 1960) and Bryant Smith vs. Georgia (Jan. 3, 1998).

JAY-WILL SHOWCASING HIS TALENT

» In his second season in the program, Jaylin Williams is showcasing why he is one of the top talents in the Southeastern Conference.

» Williams is one of only 10 players in the country with at least 50 assists, 30 blocks and 15 steals this season.

GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA

Built at a cost of \$86 million, Auburn Arena seats 9,121 fans for basketball games. Auburn Arena replaced the old Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum as the home of Tiger basketball for the 2010-11 season. The furthest seat in Auburn Arena is just 43 feet away from the court. Two-thirds of the seats are less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside offering a home environment that is unrivaled.

» In addition, Williams is one of just 12 underclassmen forwards in the country to average 10.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game this season.

» Williams made a statement in his first collegiate start against Saint Joseph's on Nov. 26 when he had 18 points and 11 rebounds, good for his first career double-double.

» Over his last 11 games, the Nahunta, Ga. native is averaging 11.5 points per game on 53 percent from the floor (49-of-93), including 35 percent from 3 (14-of-40). Williams is also adding in 5.5 rebounds per tilt during that stretch. He has 16 blocks and three steals in that span.

CAMBRIDGE STAYING HOT

» In the last 15 games, Cambridge has reached double figures 11 times en route to averaging 10.5 points per game. He's shooting 42.5 percent from the floor (57-of-134) while playing 26.5 minutes per game.

» Cambridge reached double figures three times in the 11 games prior to that and averaged 7.4 points per contest while shooting 31.8 percent from the field (28-of-88) in 22.7 minutes per game.

JOHNSON LEADING BY EXAMPLE

» As one of just two upperclassmen on the roster, junior Jamal Johnson has stepped up and provided a scoring punch for the Tigers this year.

» Against Tennessee, Johnson stepped up to play point guard in the absence of Sharife Cooper, a position he hadn't played more than a few minutes, and filled in admirably. He had 14 points, three rebounds, three assists and just one turnover while leading the Tigers to score 77 points on the Vols, who were only allowing 63 points per game.

» In his third game as the primary point guard at Alabama, Johnson had a career-high seven dimes. In his last three games, the junior has dished out 13 assists. In the 23 games prior, he had 16 assists total.

» Johnson produced back-to-back 20-point outings with a career-best 21 vs. Arkansas and 20 at Texas A&M, both coming off the bench.

» Johnson is the first Auburn player to have consecutive 20-point games off the bench since Rasheem Barrett, who scored 28 vs. Jacksonville State on Dec. 31, 2005 and 21 vs. Southern Miss on Jan. 4, 2006.

» Against Ole Miss, Johnson earned his first start as an Auburn Tiger and his first since playing Cincinnati in the American Athletic Conference Tournament semifinals on March 10, 2018 as a member of the Memphis Tigers.

» At Vanderbilt, Johnson saw the rim as wide as the ocean. The junior had 19 points on 5-of-10 from the floor, including 5-of-8 from downtown. At one point, Johnson scored 12 consecutive points for Auburn.

» Prior to the first Kentucky matchup, Johnson had scored in double figures in six consecutive games to extend a career-best streak. His previous best streak was two games, which he accomplished twice in his freshman season at Memphis.

» Following an internship in the fall with 107.5 The Ticket, an ESPN affiliated radio station in Montgomery, Johnson earned bachelor's degree from the School of Communication and proudly wears an SEC Graduate patch. Johnson is now working towards a master's degree from the School of Communication.

THOR HAS WHALE OF A GAME AT UK

» JT Thor had a career game at Kentucky last Saturday with 24 points on 8-of-11 from the floor, including 5-of-6 from downtown, and added nine rebounds and two blocks.

» Thor became the only freshman in the last decade to post a stat line of 24 points and nine rebounds in Rupp Arena. He is one of just four players overall to do that since at least 2010, joining ETSU's Isiah Brown, UT Arlington's Brandon Edwards and LSU's Trendon Watford.

» A 5-star in the class of 2021, Thor should still be in high school as a senior at Norcross High School in Norcross, Ga., but decided to reclassify and join Auburn this past summer.

OKORO MAKES HISTORY

Dreams became reality for former Auburn star Isaac Okoro Wednesday night when he was chosen with the No. 5 overall selection in the 2020 NBA Draft by the Cleveland Cavaliers.

Okoro's selection is tied for the third-highest selection in program history behind only Chris Morris (No. 4, 1988) and Chuck Person (No. 4, 1986). Charles Barkley was also chosen No. 5 in the 1984 NBA Draft.

The Powder Springs, Ga. native became the first one-and-done player in program history.

Okoro was just the sixth player in Southeastern Conference history to be named All-SEC, All-Defensive and All-Freshman in the same season.

Following Okoro's No. 5 selection and Chuma Okeke's No. 16 pick in the 2019 NBA Draft, Auburn has produced back-to-back first round draft picks for the first time in program history.

Okoro averaged 12.9 points, 4.4 rebounds, two assists, 0.9 steals and 0.9 blocks in 31.5 minutes per game while starting 28 games as a first-year player in senior-laden lineup. The Tigers posted a 25-6 record during the 2019-20 campaign.

Okoro scored in double figures 20 times and was named the SEC Freshman of the Week twice, becoming just the fourth freshman in program history to earn the conference distinction two times in a season.

Okoro is the second Tiger to be drafted by the Cavaliers, joining Mike Mitchell, who was taken with the 15th selection of the 1978 NBA Draft. Along with Mitchell (1978-82), former lettermen Eddie Johnson (1985-86) and Wesley Person (1997-2002) all played for the Cavs.

» Auburn is one of seven programs to have back-to-back first round picks in the last two drafts (Auburn, Florida State, Kentucky, North Carolina, USC, Vanderbilt, Washington)

» Auburn is one of four SEC programs to have top-16 picks in back-to-back drafts (Auburn (2019-20), Florida (2007-08), Kentucky (1996-97 & 2010-19) and Vanderbilt (2019-20))

BLOCK PARTY

» The Tigers lead the nation with 157 blocks and are second in blocks per game at 6.0, trailing only Kentucky (6.1).

» The Tigers have posted the two highest block totals by any team in the country this season with 14 at Georgia and vs. Missouri. Those marks are the most by an Auburn team in a SEC game in program history. The next highest total of blocks by a team this season is 13 accomplished by UC Irvine at Cal State Fullerton (Feb. 20).

» Auburn has totaled at least nine blocks in a game five times: 14 at Georgia (Jan. 13), 14 vs. Missouri (Jan. 26), 10 vs. Alabama (Jan. 9), nine at Arkansas (Jan. 20) and nine at LSU (Feb. 20).

» At Georgia, Jaylin Williams and Devan Cambridge each racked up five swats, a career high for both players. It is the first time two Tigers blocked at least five shots in a game since Rob Chubb and Willy Kouassi each blocked five shots against Nicholls State on Nov. 25, 2011.

» Against Missouri, Babatunde Akingbola blocked a career-best five shots in only eight minutes. He is the only player in the country to have at least five blocks in eight or fewer minutes this season and is one of just five players to accomplish the feat in the last decade, joining Johndre Jefferson (South Carolina, 2011), Ajdin Penava (Marshall, 2018), Len Springs (Northern Arizona, 2014) and Nicholas West (Alabama A&M, 2014).

YOUNG SQUAD GAINING EXPERIENCE

» In terms of experience, the Auburn Tigers are the youngest team in head coach Bruce Pearl's career. The team averages 0.75 years of experience, which ranks as the youngest team in the country to play a game this season.

» Auburn has 45 starts combined by freshmen this season, which is eighth in the country behind only Kentucky (68), Kansas State (62), Washington State (61), Duke (56), Arizona (51), North Carolina (51) and Montana (45) through games played through March 3.

NBA DEBUTS: CHUMA OKEKE AND ISAAC OKORO

Former Auburn standouts Chuma Okeke and Isaac Okoro made their professional debuts as the 2020-21 NBA season officially tipped off on Nov. 23. Okeke and Okoro become the 24th and 25th players in program history to play in the NBA. The duo became the first pair of former Tigers to play in the same season since Marquis Daniels (Indiana) and Pat Burke (Phoenix) in 2006-07.

**KNOCKING DOWN THE FREEBIES**

» Auburn has improved tremendously since Jan. 1 in its free throw shooting. In the last 17 games, the Tigers are shooting 75.8 percent (279-of-368) from the free throw line.

» Auburn's 75.8 free throw percentage is fourth in the SEC since the turn of the new year behind Florida at 77.4 percent (209-of-270), Texas A&M at 77.2 percent (95-of-123) and Kentucky at 76.3 percent (258-of-338).

» In the first nine games of 2020-21, Auburn shot just 60.7 percent (125-of-206) from the charity stripe.

THE REPLACEMENTS

» Auburn is having to replace over 84 percent of its scoring from last season. That mark stands as the fifth-highest in the country.

» Auburn and Kentucky are the only two SEC programs to not return a player that averaged five or more points per game from a season ago.

» The Tigers have to replace the winningest class in program history as the 2020 seniors amassed 99 wins, besting the previous mark of 88 set by the 2001 seniors.

» The 2020 class also hold the most wins in a 3-year span with 81, most in a 2-year span with 56 and most in a single year with 30 in 2019.

WHOLE LOTTA HEIGHT

» Auburn boasts the ninth-tallest team in the country, averaging 78.7 inches per player - nearly 6-foot-7.

» Auburn's average height of 78.7 inches on the 2020-21 roster is the tallest the Tigers have had over the last 15 seasons.

» Since 2007, Auburn has boasted an average height of 77 inches or more just four times: 77.1 in 2010-11, 77.9 in 2015-16, 77.3 in 2019-20 and 78.7 in 2020-21.

» Auburn's average height over the last 15 seasons is ranked in the middle of the pack nationally (160.5). The Tigers have had a roster in the top 100 in the country in terms of height just three times since 2007: 93rd in 2010-11, 48th in 2015-16 and ninth in 2020-21.

TIGERS IN OVERTIME

» Auburn is 58-53 in overtime games all-time, including a 9-1 mark since the start of the 2018-19 season. The Tigers defeated Saint Joseph's in overtime in the season opener, but fell to Ole Miss on a buzzer beater in its most recent game that went to overtime.

» The Tigers are 12-3 in overtime under head coach Bruce Pearl.

» Auburn had a 9-game winning streak in overtime snapped when Ole Miss' Devontae Shuler hit a fadeaway buzzer beater on Feb. 6. The Tigers' streak was the second-longest active overtime winning streak behind Florida State (10).

STABILITY ON THE BENCH

» Auburn head coach Bruce Pearl is in his seventh season on the bench for the Tigers. He currently sits as the third-longest-tenured coach in the league behind only Kentucky's John Calipari (12) and South Carolina's Frank Martin (nine). No other current coach has been in the SEC in 13 of the last 16 seasons other than Pearl.

» Pearl has won six titles in 12 full seasons in the SEC, which includes three division titles, two regular season championships and one league tournament crown.

» Since 2014-15, there have been 13 coaching changes among the 14 programs in the SEC. Only Auburn, Kentucky and South Carolina have kept the same head coach in the SEC.

» In the six seasons Pearl was at Tennessee (2005-11), there were nine coaching changes among the 12 teams in the SEC. Only Florida, Mississippi State, Tennessee and Vanderbilt had the same head coach from 2005-11.

IMPRESSIVE DUO COMING NEXT SEASON

» Auburn signed consensus five-star and top-5 player Jabari Smith, as well as four-star Trey Alexander to join the Tigers next season on the Plains.

» Smith, a Tyrone, Ga. native, was named a McDonald's All-American on Feb. 23 - just the fourth of which to sign with Auburn, joining Sharife Cooper (2020), Korvotney Barber (2005) and Frank Ford (1983).

» With the signing of Smith and Cooper, the Tigers have signed McDonald's All-Americans in consecutive seasons for the first time in program history.

» Smith was also named a finalist for the Jersey Mike's Naismith High School Trophy for Boys Player of the Year earlier this month.

» Alexander is the consensus No. 1 player from the state of Oklahoma and has earned recognition as a top-100 player from all the major recruiting service. He was tabbed as a McDonald's All-American candidate, along with Smith.

AUBURN VS. TOP-25 OPPONENTS

» Auburn is 72-217 against teams from the AP Top 25 all-time. In 2018-19, the Tigers set a program record by defeating six top-25 teams, including five in a row from the SEC Tournament title to a trip to the Final Four.

» Auburn has won nine of its last 14 games against the AP Top 25, which is the best stretch in program history by far. The next-closest similar streak was when the Tigers defeated six of nine ranked foes between the 1984-85 and 1985-86 seasons. Auburn is 2-2 against the top 25 this year, dropping a 90-67 decision vs. No. 1 Gonzaga in Fort Myers and an 84-72 result at No. 2 Baylor. Auburn defeated No. 12 Missouri by a score of 88-82 and No. 25 Tennessee, 77-72.

» Auburn is 13-21 vs. the Top 25 under head coach Bruce Pearl, while Pearl is 38-46 all-time against ranked teams.

TOP OF THE PACK

» Auburn is at the top of the SEC in terms of non-conference wins. The Tigers were the only team in the league to have won at least 10 non-conference regular season games from 2016-20. Auburn's 47 non-league victories from 2016-2020 are a school record in a 4-year span.

» Auburn center Babatunde Akingbola has been named to the Southeastern Conference Men's Basketball Community Service Team. The Ogun, Nigeria native has used his infectious outgoing personality to be a great teammate and ambassador for Auburn University.

» In just his second year, Akingbola has been involved in a variety of community service projects. He has been a mentor for students at nearby Drake Middle School and has ready to children in the surrounding area at Cary Woods Elementary and Ogletree Elementary.

» Akingbola has also participated in an encouragement zoom with Our House - an after-school ministry that provides a Christ-centered, home environment in which children can grow spiritually, academically, and socially. He also visited with and provided encouragement to children with serious illnesses at Children's Hospital of Alabama in Birmingham. Akingbola has also assisted with the SAAC annual food and toiletry drives.

» On the court, Akingbola has played in every game this season and is averaging 1.9 points and 2.6 rebounds per game while shooting 48 percent from the floor. The sophomore is third on the team with 25 blocks and 35 offensive rebounds.

ANOTHER 20-WIN SEASON

» The Tigers have recorded three straight 20-win seasons for the second time all-time after first accomplishing the feat from 1983-84 to 1985-86. After a win against LSU last year, Auburn secured its third consecutive 21-win season, a first in program history for the Tigers.

» Bruce Pearl joins Cliff Ellis and Sonny Smith as the only head coaches to lead Auburn to three 20-win seasons.

» In the 25 seasons that Bruce Pearl has been a head coach, including the 2019-20 campaign, his teams have amassed 20 20-win seasons. In simple math, Coach Pearl has won at least 20 games in a season in 80 percent of his seasons as the head coach.

BURCHAM ON THE CALL

» Andy Burcham assumed his new role as Voice of the Auburn Tigers last season, taking the lead as the play-by-play radio broadcaster for the Auburn men's basketball, football and baseball programs. Burcham took over as Auburn's lead announcer this fall following the death in May of his best friend and baseball broadcast partner, Rod Bramblett.

» After calling Auburn women's basketball games for 31 seasons, Burcham made his debut as the primary men's basketball announcer in the season-opening win vs. Georgia Southern on Nov. 5 - what would have been Bramblett's 54th birthday.

» Over the years, Burcham handled play-by-play for a few men's basketball games when Bramblett was unavailable, most recently the season opener in 2013.

» Burcham is joined on the call with former Auburn head coach Sonny Smith. Smith was the head coach for 11 seasons from 1978-89 and led the Tigers to a 173-154 record in that span that included five straight NCAA Tournament appearances from 1984-88.

MAKE ROOM IN THE TROPHY CASE

» Since the 2017-18 season, Auburn has won four trophies: 2018 SEC title, 2019 SEC Tournament crown, 2019 NCAA Midwest Regional championship and the 2019 Legends Classic.

» The Tigers lead the SEC in trophies in the last two-plus seasons. As a whole, the league has amassed 11 trophies through league championships, conference tournament championships, NCAA regional championships and in-season tournament championships. Auburn has four and Kentucky has three, while Florida, LSU, Tennessee and Texas A&M have all won one.
