- Mississippi State represents Auburn's third top-five foe in the first four weeks of SEC play.
- Six of Auburn's first nine SEC games have been decided by one run and all but one have been decided by two runs or less.
- This weekend marks the second time Auburn has used the same starting rotation back-to-back weeks this season.
- The Tigers' starting rotation turned in a combined 1.56 ERA and .127 batting average against at No. 1 Arkansas last weekend.
- Tyler Miller, Brody Moore, Rankin Woley and Ryan Bliss have anchored Auburn's infield in 20 straight games and are the team's top four hitters with a .352 combined average.
- Auburn trails Mississippi State 93-110-1 all-time in the series but are 51-40 against the Bulldogs at Plainsman Park.
- The Tigers are looking for its second straight home series win against the Bulldogs.



Butch Thompson enters his sixth season at the helm of the program in 2021, posting a record of 154-115 in his first five seasons. He led the program to the first College World Series appearance in 22 years in 2019 and has taken the Tigers to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his sixth season with the Tigers in 2021.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 30 Division I All-Americans and 39 all-conference performers. He has seen 16 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including 10 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 32 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018. With Tanner Burns also going as a supplemental first round pick in 2020, Auburn became one of four programs with a pair of pitchers drafted in the first round in the last three years.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 13 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008, which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

In 28 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 19 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached eight College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 17 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in five seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 154-115 overall record and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals for the first time in program history. After advancing to the College World Series in 2019 and a winner-take-all game three in the Gainesville Super Regional in 2018, the Tigers have finished each of the last two full seasons ranked as high as No. 8 and No. 9, respectively. It marked the third time in program history the team has finished back-to-back seasons in the top 10.

Entering the 2019 postseason as the No. 2 seed in the Atlanta Regional, Auburn became the only program to sweep a regional on the road in each of the last two potseasons before also becoming the first team to defeat North Carolina in a Chapel Hill Super Regional in 2019, punching its ticket to Omaha for the first time since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine



innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a thirdplace finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

- This weekend's rotation of Greenhill, Owen and Gonzalez marks just the second time this season the Tigers have used the same rotation back-to-back weekends.
- The Tigers have also used 22 different starting lineups through 25 games.

TOUGH TESTS

- Mississippi State represents Auburn's third top-five opponents in its first four SEC series.
- The Tigers have played 10 games against ranked opponents this season and are scheduled to play seven more games against opponents ranked in any of the six major polls.

DIGGING THE LONG BALL

- Auburn's 37 homers through 25 games are one shy of the pace the 2010 team that set the single season program record with 131 home runs was on thru 25 games.
- Kason Howell became the 11th player to homer in a game with his first career long ball at Lipscomb on Mar. 16. The Tigers haven't had 11 players homer in a season since 2010.
- Brody Moore became the 10th Auburn player to hit multiple home runs with a solo homer in the series opener at Arkansas.
- The Tigers have homered in 18 games this season with two or more homers in 12 contests.

100 HIT CLUB

- Auburn has four players with 100+ hits in an Auburn uniform Williams (161), Bliss (135), Ward (133) and Woley (130).
- Auburn and Wake Forest are the only two teams with four players with 100+ hits.
- Both teams have a fifth player approaching 100 career hits as Auburn center fielder Kason Howell and Wake Forest infielder Michael Turnconi each have 92 career hits.

IS T-MILL FOR REAL?

- Tyler Miller reached base in nine straight plate appearances from Feb. 27-Mar. 5, going 8-for-8 with four runs, a double, triple, homer and four RBI during the stretch.
- Miller ranks second in the SEC with a .376 average, .731 slugging percentage and 35 RBI and is tied for second in home runs.
- The Spanish Fort, Alabama, native has multiple hits in 11 games and multiple RBI in nine contests this season, including six games with three or more RBI.

BLISSTERING BASEBALLS

- Shortstop Ryan Bliss has started and played in all but two games since stepping foot on campus in 2019.
- Bliss has multiple hits in 40 of 79 games since April 1, 2019 and is hitting .343 (111-for-324) during the span.
- He has multiple hits in nine of the last 12 games and is hitting .379 (22-for-58) during the current stretch of games.

RANKIN IS ROLLIN'

- Rankin Woley snapped a career best 12game hitting streak in the series opener against Kentucky but has a hit in 17 of the last 18 games and is hitting .380 (27-for-71) during the stretch.
- His 12-game hitting streak was the longest by an Auburn player since Jonah Todd (16) and Dylan Ingram (13) in 2017.
- The graduate third baseman is hitting .369 (59-for-160) with 32 runs, 16 doubles, four home runs and 34 RBI in 41 games since the start of last season.

SWING IT. STEVEN

- Senior outfielder Steven Williams ranks second among active SEC players in hits (161), home runs (27) and RBI (116).
- Williams would enter the top 10 in program history with eight or more home runs.

GETTING IT STARTED

- Despite both missing time with injuries this season, Ryan Bliss and Judd Ward have hit first and second in the Auburn lineup in 58 of the last 69 games dating back to 2019.
- During the 58-game span, the duo has hit .318 (153-for-481) with 105 runs, 24 doubles, three triples, 17 home runs and 80 RBI.

PROVEN VETERANS

- Seniors Cody Greenhill and Jack Owen entered the season as two of eight SEC pitchers with a career sub-4.00 ERA and 100+ IP.
- Greenhill entered 2021 with a 2.63 ERA in 133.2 IP while Owen had turned in a 3.76 clip in 124.1 IP.

MISSING PIECES

- Auburn's potential opening weekend rotation of Richard Fitts, Cody Greenhill and Jack Owen have all missed time due to injuries this season.
- Owen made his first start of the season at Arkansas, while Greenhill missed a start vs. Boston College and Fitts hasn't started a game since Mar. 5.
- The trio entered the season with 112 combined appearances in their careers but have combined to make just 15 appearances through seven weeks.

WEALTH OF EXPERIENCE

- The Tigers return 12 position players, including seven players who started 10 or more games, and 10 pitchers from last year's team.
- The returning position players accounted for 76 percent of the runs, 77 percent of the RBI and 79 percent of the Tigers' hits in 2020.
- Despite losing two weekend starters in Tanner Burns and Bailey Horn, the returning pitchers accounted for 62 percent of the strikeouts, 66 percent of the innings pitched and 71 percent of the team's appearances in 2020.
