» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn is coming off a walk-off win in the series finale vs. LSU Saturday.
- Brody Moore delivered the RBI single in the ninth, marking the third walk-off win this season.
- The Tigers held LSU to a season-low two hits in the finale.
- Auburn matched a season-high with four home runs in the middle game against LSU and totaled seven homers in the series, marking the most homers in a series since also homering seven times vs. Northeastern in 2018.
- The Tigers rank second in the SEC and sixth in the NCAA with 69 home runs this season.
- Ryan Bliss has multiple hits in five straight games and is 12-for-24 with six runs, six doubles, two homers and six RBI during the span.
- Bliss leads the SEC with 24 multi-hit games this season, three more than any other player.
- Tyler Miller leads the SEC and ranks 10th in the country with 53 RBI, tied for the fourth most by an Auburn player since 2011.
- Steven Williams needs one more home run to enter the top 10 in program history.
- His 34 career home runs are the most by an Auburn player since Kevin Patterson (2008-11).



Butch Thompson enters his sixth season at the helm of the program in 2021, posting a record of 154-115 in his first five seasons. He led the program to the first College World Series appearance in 22 years in 2019 and has taken the Tigers to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his sixth season with the Tigers in 2021.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 30 Division I All-Americans and 39 all-conference performers. He has seen 16 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including 10 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 32 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018. With Tanner Burns also going as a supplemental first round pick in 2020, Auburn became one of four programs with a pair of pitchers drafted in the first round in the last three years.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 13 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008, which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

In 28 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 19 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached eight College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 17 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in five seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 154-115 overall record and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals for the first time in program history. After advancing to the College World Series in 2019 and a winner-take-all game three in the Gainesville Super Regional in 2018, the Tigers have finished each of the last two full seasons ranked as high as No. 8 and No. 9, respectively. It marked the third time in program history the team has finished back-to-back seasons in the top 10.

Entering the 2019 postseason as the No. 2 seed in the Atlanta Regional, Auburn became the only program to sweep a regional on the road in each of the last two potseasons before also becoming the first team to defeat North Carolina in a Chapel Hill Super Regional in 2019, punching its ticket to Omaha for the first time since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine



innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a thirdplace finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.

He earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters --- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail.

- He joins Steven Williams (178), Ryan Bliss (163), Rankin Woley (147) and Judd Ward (144) on the 100 hits list.
- Auburn and Wake Forest are the only teams in the country with five current players with 100+ career hits.

BLISSTERING BASEBALLS

- Shortstop Ryan Bliss has started and played in all but two games in his Auburn career.
- Bliss has multiple hits in 50 of 97 games since April 1, 2019 and is hitting .348 (139-for-399) during the span.
- He has hit safely in 95 of 125 career games with 55 multi-hit efforts.
- Dating back to the beginning of last season he has recorded a hit in 51 of 59 games with 33 multi-hit contests.
- Bliss has multiple hits in five or more consecutive games for the second time this season.

IS T-MILL FOR REAL?

- Tyler Miller has hit 13 home runs and has driven in 53 runs through the team's first 43 games, marking the most in the first 43 games of a season since SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris (13 HR, 55 RBI) and Brian Flecter (13 HR) in 2010.
- Miller leads the SEC and ranks 10th in the NCAA in RBI. He is also tied for the SEC lead with 15 multi-RBI games.

SENIOR CLASS FINALIST

- Rankin Woley was named one of 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award this week.
- Woley graduated with a 3.92 GPA last summer, earning his bachelor's degree in Business Administration, and took classes this semester to prepare for medical school.
- He was named the 2020 SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and CoSIDA Academic All-America while also being named an All-American on the field by Collegiate Baseball News.
- The graduate third baseman is hitting .330 (76-for-230) with 40 runs, 18 doubles, eight home runs and 41 RBI since the start of 2020.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON

- Junior infielder Brody Moore is the son of former Auburn and All-SEC shortstop Brandon Moore (1991-94).
- Brody ranks second on the team in hits (27) and third in average (.310) in SEC play.
- Brandon hit .332 in four years and 242 games in an Auburn uniform. Brody is a .311 career hitter in parts of three seasons and 72 games.

BULL'S BACK IN THE 'PEN

- Cody Greenhill returned to the Auburn bullpen three weeks ago and picked up his first save of the season vs. Samford.
- He is tied with former big leaguers Gregg Olson and Colter Bean for fourth on Auburn's all-time list with 20 career saves and would tie Austin Hubbard for third all-time with two more saves.

GLAV'S BEEN GIVIN' IT TO 'EM

- Peyton Glavine matched a career and season best with 3.0 perfect innings and five strikeouts at Georgia on Apr. 29.
- Glavine has excelled in relief this season, turning in a 2.28 ERA in 12 relief appearances. He has allowied just one earned run in his last seven relief appearances and 12.1 IP.
- The lefty has held opponents to six hits and a .143 average and has issued three walks with 14 strikeouts during the relief span.
