» QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn is coming off its first SEC home series win after taking two of three from Texas A&M.
- The Tigers would claim the No. 12 in the SEC Tournament if the season ended today.
- · A win Tuesday would mark Auburn's 15th straight season with a winning record at home. The Tigers haven't had a losing record at home since 1983 (10-16).
- Auburn homered eight times against Texas A&M, including six in the middle game, and has totaled 15 home runs in the last two series and 16 homers in the last seven games.
- The Tigers rank second in the SEC and fourth in the country with 78 home runs.
- The 78 home runs are the fifth most in a season in program history and the most since 2010.
- Tyler Miller, Ryan Bliss and Steven Williams each have 13 or more home runs, marking the fourth time in program history three players have hit 13 or more home runs in the same season.
- · Williams entered Auburn's top 10 in career home runs with the 35th and 36th of his career Saturday against Texas A&M. He is tied for seventh all-time.
- Miller's 56 RBI are the third most by an Auburn player since 2010 only Edouard Julien has more.
- Auburn's bullpen went 2-1 with a 3.18 ERA in the series against Texas A&M.



Butch Thompson enters his sixth season at the helm of the program in 2021, posting a record of 154-115 in his first five seasons. He led the program to the first College World Series appearance in 22 years in 2019 and has taken the Tigers to three straight regionals for the first time since 2001-03.

Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach on October 22, 2015 and enters his sixth season with the Tigers in 2021.

Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returned to The Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 30 Division I All-Americans and 39 all-conference performers. He has seen 16 of his former pitchers make their Major League Baseball debuts, including 10 since 2014. Thompson has also turned 32 pitchers who went undrafted out of high school into MLB draft picks.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds in 2014 and five pitchers drafted, including three in the top 10 rounds, in 2013. He added a first-round selection in the 2016 draft, a third-round pick in Keegan Thompson in 2017 and the first No. 1 overall pick in program history in Casey Mize in 2018. With Tanner Burns also going as a supplemental first round pick in 2020, Auburn became one of four programs with a pair of pitchers drafted in the first round in the last three years.

Along with his pitching pedigree, Thompson is also considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured 13 recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game, including the No. 5 signing class in 2017 and a program record No. 4 class in 2018. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally, including the No. 5 class in 2008, which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

In 28 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 19 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached eight College World Series participants, including leading the Tigers to the program's first trip to the College World Series in 22 years in 2019. Thompson has also coached one national champion and a national runner-up, won nine conference championships and made 17 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

Thompson was named the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year while at Auburn and the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

Thompson has returned the Tigers to prominence in five seasons on The Plains as he has guided the team to a 154-115 overall record and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time since 2001-03, including back-to-back super regionals for the first time in program history. After advancing to the College World Series in 2019 and a winner-take-all game three in the Gainesville Super Regional in 2018, the Tigers have finished each of the last two full seasons ranked as high as No. 8 and No. 9, respectively. It marked the third time in program history the team has finished back-to-back seasons in the top 10.

Entering the 2019 postseason as the No. 2 seed in the Atlanta Regional, Auburn became the only program to sweep a regional on the road in each of the last two potseasons before also becoming the first team to defeat North Carolina in a Chapel Hill Super Regional in 2019, punching its ticket to Omaha for the first time since 1997.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of his last four seasons in Starkville, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine



innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent four seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004. While there, he guided the development of future Major Leaguers Josh Fields, Mitchell Boggs and Brooks Brown.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference Championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.

Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a thirdplace finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference Championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity as a pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Georgia and has been a part of the league for the past 17 seasons.

Thompson currently serves as the large-school representative for the Alabama Baseball Coaches Association and is an All-American committee member representing the South region for the ABCA.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.

He earned a Bachelor's Degree in History at BSC in 1992 and completed a Master's Degree in Sports Administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters --- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail.

- · Auburn infielders Tyler Miller (1B), Brody Moore (2B), Rankin Woley (3B) and Ryan Bliss (SS) have anchored the Auburn infield in 40 of the last 42 games.

- Ryan Bliss and Tyler Miller are the top two hitters on the team and have hit first and second in the lineup in the last 17 games.
- Bliss leads the SEC with 24 multi-hit games this season and Miller leads the league with 16 multi-RBI performances.

DIGGING THE LONG BALL

- Auburn's 78 homers this season rank second in the SEC, fourth in the country and fifth in program history, trailing 2010 (131), 2009 (103), 1998 (87) and 1997 (85).
- The Tigers homered six times in the middle game against Texas A&M, tying a six-homerun game vs. Northeastern for the most homers in a game since setting the record with seven home runs vs. MSU in 2010.
- Tyler Miller (15), Ryan Bliss (13) and Steven Williams (13) have hit a combined 41 home runs and are the first trio of Auburn players with 13 or more homers in a season since 2010. They're just the fourth trio all time to accomplish the feat.

BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK JACKS

- Ryan Bliss, Tyler Miller and Rankin Woley hit back-to-back-to-back home runs to start the middle game against Texas A&M.
- It marked the first time with back-to-backto-back home runs since Fletcher, Morris and Patterson in 2010.

100 HIT CLUB

- Kason Howell became the fifth current Auburn player to record his 100th career hit at Alabama on Apr. 16.
- He joins Steven Williams (182), Ryan Bliss (165), Rankin Woley (152) and Judd Ward (145) on the 100 hits list.
- Auburn and Wake Forest are the only teams in the country with five current players with 100+ career hits.

BLISSTERING BASEBALLS

- Shortstop Ryan Bliss has started and played in all but two games in his Auburn career.
- Bliss has multiple hits in 50 of 101 games since April 1, 2019 and is hitting .341 (141-for-413) during the span.
- He has hit safely in 97 of 129 career games with 55 multi-hit efforts.
- Dating back to the beginning of last season he has recorded a hit in 53 of 63 games with 33 multi-hit contests.
- Bliss has multiple hits in five or more consecutive games twice this season and lead with SEC with 24 multi-hit contests.

IS T-MILL FOR REAL?

• Tyler Miller has hit 15 home runs and has driven in 56 runs this season, marking the most in the first 47 games of a season since SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris (17 HR, 61 RBI) in 2010.

- Miller ranks second in the SEC and 11th in the NCAA in RBI. He also leads the SEC lead with 16 multi-RBI games.
- He has three or more hits in nine games this season and three or more RBI in eight games.
- Through 47 games this season, Miller's 56 RBI are the third most by an Auburn player since 2011.

SWING IT, STEVEN

- Steven Williams is hitting .290 (20-for-69) with 17 runs, nine home runs and 19 RBI in the 19 games since the Tigers' midweek win at Georgia Tech on Apr. 13.
- William's turned in the first multi-homer game of his career in the middle game against Texas A&M, marking the 35th and 36th long balls of his Auburn career.
- He is tied with Kevin Chabot (1993-95) for seventh on Auburn's all-time home run list.
- Williams ranks second among active SEC players in hits (182), home runs and RBI (135).

SENIOR CLASS FINALIST

- Rankin Woley was named one of 10 finalists for the Senior CLASS Award earlier this week.
- Woley graduated with a 3.92 GPA last summer, earning his bachelor's degree in Business Administration, and took classes this semester to prepare for medical school.
- He was named the 2020 SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year and CoSIDA Academic All-America while also being named an All-American on the field by Collegiate Baseball News.
- The graduate third baseman went 5-for-10 with five runs, two homers and three RBI against Texas A&M. He is hitting .333 (81-for-243) with 45 runs, 18 doubles, 10 home runs and 44 RBI since the start of 2020.

LIKE FATHER. LIKE SON

- Junior infielder Brody Moore is the son of former Auburn and All-SEC shortstop Brandon Moore (1991-94).
- Brody went 4-for-8 against Texas A&M before exiting the finale with an injury and ranks second on the team in hits (33) and average (.311) in SEC play.
- Brandon hit .332 in four years and 242 games in an Auburn uniform. Brody is a .317 career hitter in parts of three seasons and 75 games.

FILL IT UP, FRESHMEN

- Freshmen Carson Swilling and Joseph Gonzalez are tied for the team lead with 19 appearances this season.
- Swilling has posted a 1.98 ERA with two saves and 20 strikeouts in 13.2 innings and 10 appearances since Apr. 13.
- Gonzalez earned his second win in the series finale vs. Texas A&M and is 2-0 with a 2.89 in his last eight appearances and 18.2 IP dating back to Apr. 21 vs. Jacksonville State.

NEED MORE LIKE MORRISON

- Will Morrison earned his first career save by striking out the final batter in the middle game vs. Florida (Apr. 25) and picked up his first career win by recording the final eight outs in a 14-inning win at Georgia on Apr. 30.
- He has held opponents scoreless in 10 of 14 appearances this season and ranks second on the team with 11 appearances in SEC play.

SKIP TO MY LOU

- Carson Skipper has earned either a win or a save in his last three outings
- He is 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA and 11 strikeouts with one walk in 6.2 IP during the span.

BULL'S BACK IN THE 'PEN

- Cody Greenhill returned to the Auburn bullpen three weeks ago and picked up his first save of the season vs. Samford.
- He is tied with former big leaguers Gregg Olson and Colter Bean for fourth on Auburn's all-time list with 20 career saves and would tie Austin Hubbard for third all-time with two more saves.

GLAV'S BEEN GIVIN' IT TO 'EM

- Peyton Glavine matched a career and season best with 3.0 perfect innings and five strikeouts at Georgia on Apr. 29.
- Glavine has excelled in relief this season, turning in a 2.28 ERA in 12 relief appearances. He has allowied just one earned run in his last seven relief appearances and 12.1 IP.
- The lefty has held opponents to six hits and a .143 average and has issued three walks with 14 strikeouts during the relief span.

BATTERY OF ONE


- Nate LaRue made his collegiate pitching debut vs. Jacksonville State on Apr. 21 and struck out the first batter he faced.

Seeding

The two division champions shall be automatically seeded number one and number two based on winning percentage in conference competition. The rest shall be seeded numbers three through 12 based on winning percentage without regard to division. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

- $\ensuremath{\text{1}}$. Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken
 - A. Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - B. If two-teams are divisional opponents:
 - (1) Won-lost percentage within their division (over the 18-game SEC division schedule).
 - (2) Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the No. 1 team in their division (and proceeding through the No. 7 team, if necessary).
 - C. If two teams are not divisional opponents:
 - (1) Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary).
 - (2) Coin flip by the Commissioner
- $2.\ \mbox{Three-Team}$ Tie (or more). The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.
 - A. If all three teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
 - B. Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary, using common opponents only.

 C. If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.


