QUICK HITS

- Auburn was selected to its seventh straight and 16th overall NCAA Regional as the two seed in the Tallahassee Regional. This weekend marks Auburn's third postseason appearance in Tallahassee. Auburn is 33-32 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.
- One of 15 finalists for NFCA National Freshman of the Year/Schutt Sports, Shelby Lowe enters the postseason with 175 strikeouts, the second most by a Tiger freshman in program history. Lowe also moved into 10th in Auburn single-season history. Lowe's 175 strikeouts are the most by an Auburn pitcher since 2010.
- Behind a perfect 15-for-15 mark in stolen base attempts, Makayla Packer ranks eighth in the SEC in total stolen bases. Her 15 steals are the second most by an Auburn freshman in school history. She enters the postseason tied for eighth in stolen bases in Auburn single-season history.

BY THE NUMBERS

100

For the first time in program history, Auburn has two freshmen pitchers

over the 100-strikeout mark in the same season as Shelby Lowe and Maddie Penta both surpassed the mark in the regular season.

206

With two hits during Auburn's SEC Tournament game, Alyssa Rivera jumped

into the top 10 in Auburn career history in hits. Rivera is just the 11th Tiger in program history to record at least 200 hits over their career.

4

With just seven strikeouts over 126 at-bats, Tyler King ranks as the fourth toughest player in the SEC to strike out. She averages just one every 18 at bats.

King ranks second on the squad in total hits with 37.

INTERVIEW POLICY

Coach Dean, assistant coaches and select student-athletes are available for interviews by contacting Taylor Shirey in the communications office. All interviews during the week will be conducted via phone or through ZOOM. Weekly media availabilities will be conducted approximately 30 minutes prior to Tuesday practices throughout the season unless otherwise specified. ZOOM information will be emailed to the media on Mondays. Specific interview request should be made at least 24 hours in advance to ensure availability. **Due to COVID protocols, all practices during the 2021 season are CLOSED.**

Postgame interviews with Coach Dean and requested players will be conducted via ZOOM following a brief cooling-off period. ZOOM links will be emailed out to media on game days.

CREDENTIALS

Media members wishing to cover Auburn softball should contact Taylor Shirey at least 48 hours prior to each home contest. Due to COVID-19, seating at Jane B. Moore Field is extremely limited. There will be an estimated 1-2 seats available for reporters (including visiting media) for home contests. In addition, there will be a very limited number of photo/video credentials.

All credentials will be issued on a game-by-game basis. No passes will be issued in advance. Credentials will be available for pick up on game days at Media Will Call located at the main entrance of Jane B. Moore Field. You will receive email confirmation following the 48 hour deadline of which game(s) you have been approved to cover. Due to limitations on spacing, media seating will be outdoors this season. Please dress accordingly. With the limited space, media member may only be selected to attend one game per weekend series

based on demand to ensure an opportunity for all members of the media to cover a contest in person.

All persons at Jane B. Moore Field are required to wear face coverings and observe social distancing.

No media will have access to field level at any time.

PLAYER TO WATCH: SHELBY LOWE

» An All-SEC performer and finalist for Shutt Sports/NFCA National Freshman of the Year, Shelby Lowe continues her dominance in the circle. She leads the SEC in walks allowed per seven innings (1.19) and strikeout-to-walk ratio (6.48) while ranking second in ERA (1.32). Her 175 strikeouts are the 10th most in Auburn single-season history and the most by a Tiger pitcher since 2010.

FIRST PITCH

» Auburn softball has punched a ticket to its seventh straight and 16th overall NCAA Tournament as the Tigers head to the Tallahassee Regional as the two seed among the tournament field.

» The Tigers open play on Friday against UCF in the opening game of the Tallahassee Regional. First pitch is set for 1 p.m. CT. The winner of Friday's contest will face the winner of Kennesaw State and host Florida State, the overall 10th seed in the NCAA Tournament, on Saturday. The two losing teams will face off in an elimination game on Saturday.

» Friday's contest will be televised nationally on ESPN2 with Jenn Hildreath and Brittany McKinney on the call. Fans can also tune into the Auburn Sports Network as Brit Bowen and JJ Jackson will have radio coverage from Tallahassee.

» Auburn enters the NCAA Tournament with a 33-32 (.508) all-time tournament record. Auburn is making its third appearance in the Tallahassee Regional. The Tigers last appeared in the Tallahassee Regional in Mickey Dean's first year on the Plains back in 2018. Auburn has advanced to Super Regionals on three occasions (2015, 2016, 2017). Auburn holds an 11-18 all-time record as the two seed in a NCAA Regional.

AN AUBURN WIN WOULD...

- » Be Auburn's fourth NCAA Regional win.
- » Be Auburn's first advancement to NCAA Super Regionals since 2017.

INSIDE THE SERIES: UCF

» Auburn matches up with UCF for just the third time in program history and the first time since the 2016 season. Auburn is 2-0 against the Knights with a pair of wins in Orlando. Both Tiger victories have been shutout wins.

» In the last meeting between the two squads, Auburn edged out UCF for a 2-0 win in Orlando on Feb. 17, 2016. Friday marks the first time the two teams have ever met in the postseason.

INSIDE THE SERIES: FLORIDA STATE

» After splitting a pair of games against the Seminoles back in March, Auburn trails in the all-time series, 10-17-1. This weekend would mark Auburn's first trip

to Tallahassee since the 2018 Tallahassee Regional. The Seminoles walked off a 2-1 win in the eighth innings en route to their regional win. Florida State would go on to win the 2018 Women's College World Series. Auburn is 4-9 all-time in games played at Seminole Stadium.

» The two teams squared off back in March in the War Eagle Battle. Charlotte was forced to pull out of the tournament due to positive COVID-19 cases among the team. Florida State joined the tournament following a cancellation of its conference series against North Carolina following positive COVID-19 cases. It was a tale of two games as then ranked No. 13 Florida State run ruled the Tigers, 10-1, in five innings. Auburn bounced back the next day for a 2-1 win behind a phenomenal performance in the circle from Shelby Lowe.

» Auburn has never beat Florida State in an NCAA Regional. Florida State holds a 4-0 advantage in postseason meetings.

INSIDE THE SERIES: KENNESAW STATE

» Also squaring off in the regular season, Auburn and Kennesaw State will come head-to-head again after splitting a pair of games in March. Auburn holds a 5-2 advantage over the Owls. Auburn holds a 1-0 advantage in games played at a neutral site.

» Back in March, Kennesaw State traveled to the Plains to compete in the War Eagle Battle. The Owls took the opening game, 2-0, before a gritty Auburn team came back the following day to edge out a 4-3 victory.

» Auburn holds a 1-0 record over Kennesaw State in NCAA Regional games. The two teams met back in the opening game of the 2018 Tallahassee Regional with Auburn taking a 5-2 victory.

LOWE ADVANCES INTO FINAL 15 FOR SCHUTT SPORTS/NFCA NATIONAL FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

» Behind an All-Southeastern Conference performance during the regular season, Shelby Lowe advanced as one of 15 finalists for the 2021 National Fastpitch Coaches Association/Schutt Sports Division I National Freshman of the Year award.

» The NFCA/Schutt Sports Division I National Freshman of the Year award was created in 2014 to honor outstanding athletic achievement among Division I freshmen

softball student-athletes. Former Tiger Kasey Cooper and Tennessee's Annie Aldrete shared the award in its inaugural season. Cooper is Auburn's lone winner of the award.

» To be eligible, student-athletes must be nominated by their member head coach. With the cancellation of last year's season due to COVID-19, candidates hail from the 2020 and 2021 freshman classes. Due to having two freshman classes eligible for the award, an additional five players have been added to the traditional top 25. Lowe was one of three honorees from the Southeastern Conference, which was the most candidates by any conference as the list of finalists was trimmed in half. Lowe was also one of seven true freshmen to advance to the final 15 nominees.

» The final three candidate will be released on May 27. The 2021 Schutt Sports / NFCA Division I National Freshman of the Year will be announced on June 1.

FIVE TIGERS PICK UP SEC HONORS

» Highlighted by freshman pitcher Shelby Lowe's selection to the All-Southeastern Conference Second Team, a total of five Auburn softball student-athletes were chosen for postseason accolades from the league office.

» Lowe is the first Tiger to earn All-SEC honors as a freshman since Kasey Cooper in 2014. She is the first Auburn pitcher to bring home an All-SEC honor since 2018. She is the only Auburn freshman pitcher in school history to be named to the All-SEC team.

» Along with being named to the All-SEC Second Team, Lowe was one of a program-record four Auburn freshmen named to the SEC All-Freshman Team. Lowe was joined by fellow hurler Maddie Penta, infielder Sydney Cox and outfielder Makayla Packer. Cox is Auburn's first infielder to make the All-Freshman Team since Taylon Snow in 2018, while Packer is the first Auburn outfielder honored since Alyssa Rivera in 2017.

» Lowe and Penta's selections mark the first time in school history that Auburn had two freshmen pitchers on the SEC All-Freshmen team. They are the first pitchers to win the honor since Anna Thompson in 2007.

» Maddison Koepke rounded out Auburn's conference honors as she was tabbed to the SEC All-Newcomer Team.

THE LOWE DOWN: SHELBY JUMPS INTO AUBURN SINGLE-SEASON HISTORY

» During Auburn's regular-season finale at LSU, Shelby Lowe continued to add to her impressive resume as she recorded her 175th strikeout of her freshman season. Lowe now has the second most strikeouts ever recorded by an Auburn freshman in program history. She also now ranks 10th overall in Auburn single-season history. Her 175 strikeouts are the most by an Auburn pitcher since 2010.

» Lowe became just the fifth Auburn freshman to record 100 strikeouts over their debut season during the Arkansas series. She was the first Auburn freshman to hit the mark since Marcy Harper in 2013. Anna Thompson holds Auburn's freshman strikeout record with 291.

» Lowe is just the 22nd Auburn Tiger to program history to hit 100 career strikeouts. Lowe already stands 16th in school history for career strikeouts.

» Lowe leads all SEC freshmen and ranks second overall in the league with a 1.32 ERA. It is currently the second lowest ERA (min. 40 innings pitched) by an Auburn freshman in program history. Lowe also now qualifies for Auburn single-season records with over 100 innings pitched in 2021. No Auburn pitcher has ever closed a season with an ERA under 1.00. Kristen Keyes (2004) holds the program record with a 1.06 ERA. Lowe's ERA currently stands second in single-season history.

MS. STEAL YO BAG

» Makayla Packer's speed has proven lethal on the base paths as she enters the NCAA Tournament with a perfect 15-for-15 mark in stolen base attempts over her freshman season. She is eighth in the SEC for most stolen bases this season.

» Packer's 15 stolen bases are the second most by an Auburn freshman in program history. Shannon Anderson (2002) holds the record of 21. Packer is tied for eighth in Auburn single-season history with Ashley Griffin (2005) and Chris Steiner (1997) for steals.

THIS SEASON IS BROUGHT TO YOU BY THE LETTER "K"

» Led by a dynamic freshman duo, Auburn's pitching staff has put the nation on notice that it is one of the best in the country.

» Auburn ranks fourth in the Southeastern Conference and 21st in the nation with a 1.99 team earned run average. The Tiger pitching staff has recorded eight shutouts this season. The Tigers rank third in the SEC with 367 strikeouts this season. Alabama leads the league with 448 while Mississippi State (402) rounds out the top two.

» The dynamic duo of Maddie Penta and Shelby Lowe has carried the bulk of the work in the circle, combining for 22 of Auburn's 27 wins. The duo have both surpassed

100 strikeouts this season, marking the first time in program history that Auburn has two freshman pitchers with 100+ strikeouts. The pair currently hold two of the top five highest season strikeout totals by a freshman in program history. The duo also rank fourth and 12th in total strikeouts as Lowe has fanned 175 while Pent has struck out 105.

FIRST BASE ON LOCK: PERRY CONTINUE TO CLIMB AUBURN'S RECORD BOOK

» With 263 putouts this season, Justus Perry reached a career milestone that only five other Tigers in program history have ever eclipsed: 1,000 career putouts.

» During Auburn's final trip of the regular season, Perry climb another spot in Auburn's career putout list as she now stands fourth in school history with 1,202. She needs just 10 to jump Mary Petrie for third in program history. Charged with just three errors in 275 chances this season, Perry is tied for fourth in school history with Sara Dean (2002-05) with a .989 career fielding percentage.

THE DEAN OF SUCCESS: MICKEY DEAN EARNS 600TH CAREER WIN

» Fourth-year head coach Mickey Dean had guided the Tigers to several firsts in program history and his added to his already lofty resume in the process. The historic moments continued as the Tigers played spoiler in the series finale at Ole Miss on April 25, 2021 to earn Dean's 600th career victory as a Division I Head Coach.

» Earlier this season, Dean guided the Tigers to a 5-4 upset victory of then ranked No. 19 South Carolina to open the Osprey/Dolphin Invitational on Feb. 21, 2021. The victory was the 100th win for Dean during his tenure at Auburn.

» During his short time at Auburn, Mickey Dean has already gathered a long list of coaching feats, all while he continues to overhaul the program's culture and return Auburn softball to the top of the SEC.

HER-STORY IN THE MAKING: RIVERA OVERHAULS AUBURN'S RECORD BOOK

» Entering the postseason on a high note, Alyssa Rivera jumped into the top 10 in two Auburn offensive category behind her strong performance in the SEC Tournament. Rivera went 2-for-3 at the plate to bring her career hit total to 206, jumping into 10th in Auburn career history for total hits. The outing was also her 52nd multi-hit game of her Auburn career, which also moved her into a tie for 10th in school history with Michelle Martin (1998-2001).

» Rivera enters the weekend ranked in the top 10 in seven other offensive categories, including tied for third in career stolen bases (42), tied for seventh in stolen base percentage (.808), eighth in multi-RBI games (34), ninth in games played (239) and RBI (129) and 10th in home runs (30) and total bases (333).

» Rivera is also one of just six student-athletes in program history to record at least 110 runs scored, 120 RBI and 200 hits over their careers.

PENTA, KOEPKE MAKE HISTORY WITH PAIR OF SEC WEEKLY HONORS

» Powering Auburn softball to four wins and its second consecutive Southeastern Conference series win with an upset of No. 12 Kentucky, Maddie Penta and Maddison Koepke earned weekly honors from the conference office.

» Penta earned her third SEC Freshman of the Week honor of the season, which sets Auburn's program record. She shared the award with Missouri's Jenna Laird. Koepke is the first Tiger this season to win the SEC's Newcomer of the Week award. The award was established for the 2021 season and only sophomores are eligible. Koepke was also tabbed a co-winner and shared the award with LSU's Raeleen Gutierrez.

» Koepke started all five games at third base for the Tigers, turning in a perfect fielding percentage behind four putouts and three assists. The Dacula, Ga., native went 3-for-6 at the with her first collegiate double, two RBI and a run scored.

» Penta returned to dominance in the circle as she picked

up a pair of wins for the Tigers, including her first in conference play. Penta turned in a team-low 1.08 earned run average in her two appearances. She gave up just six hits in her 13.0 innings of work to hold opponents to a .143 average at the plate. She struck out 15 and combined with teammate KK Dismukes for a shutout.

CLOSING TIME

- » Giving Auburn a lead late has proved a costly mistake this season as sophomore KK Dismukes thrived in her reliever role as the "nail in the coffin" as the Tiger closer this season.
- » Dismukes ranks tied for second in the SEC with 16 games finished this season and has made 21 total relief appearances for the Tigers. She ranks fifth in the SEC and 12th nationally with four saves in 2021.
- » Her four saves are tied with six other Tigers for sixth in Auburn single-season history and are the most by an Auburn pitcher since Kaylee Carlson in 2017. She needs just two to crack the top 10 in Auburn career history.
- » Ranking fourth in the SEC with a 1.54 ERA, Dismukes has allowed just 12 earned runs this season. She has struck out 52 batters in her 54.2 innings of work.

BATTLED TESTED

- » Entering the postseason, Auburn has played the seventh-toughest schedule in the country according to the NCAA. The Tigers' opponents have combined for 1,592 wins this season and hold a .625 win percentage.
- » Auburn has played 22 games against nationally ranked opponents this season. Thirty-one of Auburn's 49 games this season have been played against teams in the top 50 of the latest NCAA RPI release.
- » Auburn's schedule is ranked the fifth toughest among all SEC teams behind just LSU, Mississippi State, Florida and Alabama.

LOWE TABBED D1 SOFTBALL FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK, EARNS SECOND SEC FOTW AWARD

- » Earning her second victory over a top-25 opponent behind her shutout performance at No. 18 Missouri, Shelby Lowe was tabbed DI Softball Freshman of the Week and earned her second Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Week honor of the season. Both honors were announced Tuesday.
- » An Auburn freshman has been named SEC Freshman of the Week a program-record four times this season. Lowe and Maddie Penta, have now each won the award twice to join Anna Thompson (2007) as the only Auburn pitchers to be named SEC Freshman of the Week multiple times in the same season.
- » She is the first Auburn freshman in program history to be named DI Softball Freshman of the Week. DI Softball began its coverage during the 2020 season.
- » Lowe earned two starts at Missouri, allowing just one

run in 14.1 total innings for a 0.49 earned run average. She struck out a team-leading 17 batters and did not issue a single walk over the weekend. Her weekend performance was highlighted with a 3-0 shutout victory Sunday's series finale to carry Auburn to its first victory in Southeastern Conference play this season. The win was also Auburn's first in Columbia, Mo., since the 2015 season.

FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

- » Despite having nine student-athletes on the roster that are entering their fourth, fifth or sixth seasons, it has been the Auburn freshmen class that has paved the way for early success.
- » The Tiger freshmen have combined for 161 starts this season, including the pitching combo of Maddie Penta and Shelby Lowe starting 44 of Auburn's 49 games in the circle.
- » Fighting her way into a starting role, Sydney Cox has started the last 43 games at second. Cox leads the team with eight doubles this season. She also leads the freshman class in total starts.
- » Makayla Packer has made 36 total starts - all of which have come in centerfield. The speedy Packer has made numerous diving plays in the outfield and leads the team with 15 stolen bases, good for eighth in the SEC. Her 15 steals are the second most by an Auburn freshman in program history and ranks tied for eighth in Auburn single season history. She currently leads the team with a .308 batting average.
- » Kelsey Schmidt has made 28 starts, splitting time in left, right and at designated player. Denver Bryant has also seen starting time with 10 starts at third base.

LOWE EARNS AUBURN'S THIRD SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONOR IN '21

- » Picking up three wins in the circle during the Tigers' undefeated performance at the Auburn Invitational, freshman pitcher Shelby Lowe was selected Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Week, the league office announced Monday.
- » This marks the third time this season an Auburn freshman has brought home the award, setting the program record for most SEC Freshman of the Week honors in a single season. Lowe's selection also marks the first time in program history that multiple Auburn freshmen have won the award in the same season. Lowe's teammate in the circle Maddie Penta has earned the honor twice in 2021.
- » Lowe was the workhorse for Tigers in the circle during the Auburn Invitational as the left-handed pitcher earned three of Auburn's five wins. Lowe tossed 15.1 total innings and gave up just three walks while striking out a team-high 26 batters.

ANOTHER ONE: PENTA EARNS SECOND SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONOR

- » Tossing her second no-hitter in three weeks, freshman pitcher Maddie Penta was named the Southeastern Conference Freshman of the Week for the second time this season.
- » Penta is the first Auburn Tiger to win multiple SEC Freshman of the Week honors in the same season since Kasey Cooper in 2014. She is the first Auburn pitcher to win the award multiple times in a season since Anna Thompson in 2007.
- » The Chesapeake City, Md., native tossed two complete-game shutouts for Auburn over the Tiger Invite. Penta allowed just four hits and four walks over her 14.0 innings of work, while striking out 27 batters.

OH NO-NO, SHE DIDN'T

- » With just three weeks of collegiate play under her belt, Maddie Penta has tossed two no-hitter with another lights outs performance - this time against IUPUI.
- » Penta struck out 16 consecutive batters over the first six innings. She carried a perfect game bid into the top of the seventh before issuing a walk. She closed the game with her 17th strikeout to secure her second no-hitter of the season.
- » The right-hander's 17 strikeouts tied for the second most in a single game in Auburn history. She was one shy from the program's record single-game record of 18.
- » She is the first Auburn pitcher to toss multiple no-hitters in the same season since Marcy Harper (2) in 2014.

NO-NO SEMO

- » In her first collegiate start, Maddie Penta made a little history, tossing the 26th no-hitter in program history. It was the first no-hitter for the Tigers since Makayla Martin vs. Maryland on Feb. 18, 2018.
- » Penta allowed just four base runners, all via walks, over her five innings of work. She struck out seven to secure an 8-0 season-opening victory.
- » She is just the third Auburn freshman to toss a solo no-hitter and the last since Marcy Harper vs. Savannah State on March 14, 2013.
- » She is the first freshman in program history to toss a no-hitter in a season opener.

PENTA-THLETE: MADDIE EARNS SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

- » After a phenomenal collegiate debut in the circle in Auburn softball's sweep of Southeastern Missouri, freshman pitcher Maddie Penta was named the Southeastern Conference Co-Freshman of the Week on Monday, sharing the award with Georgia's Sydney Chambley.
- » Picking up two wins and a shutout over opening weekend, Penta posted a 0.00 earned run average as she allowed just one unearned run in 12 innings of work. She

held opponents to a .051 batting average and struck out a team-high 13.

» She is the first freshman to win the honor since her teammate Carlee McCondichie was named Co-Freshman of the Week on March 2, 2020. This is the third SEC Freshman of the Week honor during the Mickey Dean era.

» The friendly confines of Jane B. Moore Field has wrecked havoc against opponents during Mickey Dean’s tenure at the helm.

» Auburn has won at least 18 games at home in three of Dean’s four seasons on the Plains, excluding the shortened 2020 season. The Tigers went 11-2 at home before the season was suspended in March.

» The Tigers closed the 2021 season with an 18-9 record at Jane B. Moore Field.

» Dean holds the second-highest winning percentage in home games by a head coach in program history with an .796 mark.

HEAD COACH MICKEY DEAN

Mickey Dean enters his fourth season as the head coach of the Auburn softball program. In 13 years at the collegiate level, Dean has coached nine NCAA Tournament teams, including one super regional participant, and won nine conference championships.

A native of Elkton, Va., Dean has guided 78 all-conference players, 43 all-region honorees and eight all-Americans, including 2017 National Player of the Year, Megan Good. He has also been touted as the conference coach of the year eight times.

During his time on The Plains, Dean has guided the Tigers to a 96-49 overall record and two NCAA Regional appearances. Dean's resume at Auburn also includes three NFCA All-Region selections and two All-SEC selections. He also guided slugger Kendall Veach to All-America honors from Softball America in 2019.

Dean's third season at Auburn was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Before the 2020 season was halted, Dean helped the Tigers to 16 wins, highlighted by victories over No. 25 Northwestern and No. 16 Minnesota. The Tigers made program history on March 2, 2020, when Alyssa Rivera (Player), Samantha Yarbrough (Pitcher) and Carlee McCondie (Freshman) swept the SEC's weekly awards. It marked the first time Auburn has swept all three SEC awards.

Auburn closed the 2019 season with a 39-21 overall record, earning its sixth straight NCAA Tournament bid. The Tigers closed the conference slate with a 10-14 mark and earned a spot in the 2019 SEC Softball Tournament semifinals. Dean guided Kendall Veach to All-SEC and NFCA All-Region team honors. The program made history as the senior class was drafted in the 2019 National Pro Fastpitch Draft.

Dean led Auburn to a 15-0 start to open the 2018 season, which tied the best start in program history and were the most wins in SEC history among first-year head coaches. He earned his 500th career win during the Wilson/DeMarini Classic when Auburn earned a shutout win over Western Illinois on Mar. 4. He led the Tigers to their 800th win in program history with a 2-1 victory over Kennesaw State on April 4.

Dean came to Auburn after five seasons as the head coach at James Madison. During his five-year stint at James Madison, Dean compiled a record of 237-56 (.809).

He amassed five 40-win seasons, including the final two campaigns with 52 and 50 victories, respectively. The Dukes broke 104 program records, including over 40 pitching records while boasting one of the nation's top staffs under Dean's guidance.

Prior to his reign in Harrisonburg, Va., Dean spent six seasons as the head coach at Radford where he took the Highlanders to their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearances in 2009 and 2010.

Before taking the position at Radford, Dean served as an assistant coach at Akron (2001-02), Indiana (2002-04) and Longwood (2005-06).

In addition to his collegiate coaching experience, Dean has also worked on the professional and international level.

He was the pitching coach for the Venezuelan National Team (2002-08) and the head coach for the Chicago Bandits (2004-10) that finished as the National Pro Fastpitch regular season champions five times and won the title in 2008.

Dean was named NPF Manager of the Year three times and coached world-renowned pitcher Jennie Finch, who was the NPF's Co-Pitcher of the Year in 2005 and has a gold and silver medal from her two Team USA Olympic appearances.

A 1987 graduate of Elon University, Dean was a pitcher on the baseball team where he was a four-year letterwinner.

Dean and his wife, Liz, have one son, Isaac, and one daughter, Caroline.
