- Bella Rosenthall enters her senior campaign with 716 career digs. She is looking to become just the 15th Tiger in program history to record 1,000 career digs. Rosenthall would be the first to do so since Brenna McIlroy (2015-2018).
- Fresh faces will take the court for the Tigers this fall as Auburn welcomed six newcomers during the offseason. Transfers Liz Reich (Portland) and Rebekah Rath (Maryland) add big-time volleyball experience to the young Tiger team. Auburn's roster also features four true freshmen: Fallan Lanham, Cassidy Tanton, Jordan Sinness and Kate Curtis.
- With one double-double performance during Auburn's abbreviated fall season, Tatum Shipes leads all returning Tigers with seven career double-double performances.

GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA

» Auburn Arena is in its seventh season as home of Auburn volleyball. The Tigers are 49-49 since moving to the Arena in 2013. The facility seats approximately 2,000 fans for volleyball and 9,121 for basketball.



FIRST SERVE

- Taking the court for its first full fall season under head coach Brent Crouch, Auburn opens the 2021 fall campaign hosting The Citadel, Tennessee Tech and Jackson State at Auburn Arena for the War Eagle Invitational.
- The Tigers take the court for the first time this fall on Friday against The Citadel at 7 p.m. CT. Fans can stream the match on SEC Network+, JJ Jackson and Kele Evelan will have the call for Friday's season opener.
- Auburn returns to action for a Saturday doubleheader slate, beginning with a 10:30 a.m. CT first serve against Tennessee Tech. The Tigers return to the court Saturday night against Jackson State at 7:30 p.m. CT. Saturday's nightcap against the Lady Tigers of Jackson State will also be available on SEC Network+ with JJ Jackson and Diego Castaneda.
- Friday's season opener marks the first time Auburn has taken the court since Nov. 19, 2020. Due to a combination of injuries and opt-outs, Auburn did not compete during the COVID-19 altered spring season.
- In its 49th full season of volleyball, Auburn's all-time record stands at 655-675-4 (.493).
- Brent Crouch enters his second season as the head coach for the Tigers after a two-year stint at USC. Entering his eighth overall season as a head coach, Crouch holds a 95-99 career record. He's the 11th head coach in Auburn program history.
- Auburn's 2021 schedule features four 2020-21 NCAA Volleyball Tournament participants: Jackson State, Missouri, Florida and reigning national champion Kentucky.
- The Tiger roster features a wealth of fresh faces as six of Auburn's 12 total student-athletes on roster will be taking the court in Blue and Orange for the first time in their careers with a combination of four true freshmen and two transfers.

UP NEXT

The Tigers make the lone road trip of their nonconference slate as Auburn treks to Hammond, La., for the 2021 Southeastern Showdown. Auburn will open the tournament on Friday, Sept. 3 with a pair of matches against Southern University (10 a.m. CT) and Southeastern Louisiana (7 p.m. CT). The Tigers round out the tournament against Cal State Fullerton on Saturday, Sept. 4 at 11 a.m. CT.

LAST TIME OUT

In the final match of the shortened fall season, Auburn fell in straight sets to Tennessee inside Auburn Arena.

- The first set was a back-and-forth affair from the opening serve with seven ties before the media timeout. A 4-0 run by the Lady Volunteers separated the two squads, giving Tennessee a 11-15 lead at the timeout.
- Service errors plagued both teams after the timeout, but Tennessee found a late advantage and won the set 20-25. The Lady Volunteers would take the final two sets by 12-25 and 14-25 finals.
- Tatum Shipes recorded a season-high 12 kills for her second double-digit kill effort of the season. She added one block and seven digs. Senior Jaeden Brown, earning her first start at outside hitter, came on late in the match with six kills.
- Middle blockers Chesney McClellan and Audrey Douglas were Auburn's most effective hitters as the duo closed the night with hitting percentages of .400. McClellan racked up five kills while Douglas tallied four. Douglas led the team with two blocks.
- At setter, Jackie Barrett dished out 27 assists and added one block and seven digs.
- Right side Lauren Dorrell led the defense with a career-high 12 digs, her first double-digit dig performance of her career. Dorrell added one block and four kills. Bella Rosenthall closed the night with nine digs.

SEC REVAMPS CONFERENCE SCHEDULING **FORMAT FOR 2021 CAMPAIGN**

- The Southeastern Conference announced a new scheduling format for its conference slate ahead of the 2021 campaian.
- The SEC schedule consists of 18 matches in which each member institution will play each other at least once. The order of opponents for each team was determined by a random computer draw.
- Two-match series may be played Wednesday/ Thursday, Thursday/Friday, Friday/Saturday or Saturday/Sunday per the league office.

SCOUTING THE CITADEL

- The Citadel posted a 9-12 recorded during the COVID-altered 2020-21 season. The Bulldogs finished with a 7-9 mark in Southern Conference play. Senior outside hitter Sharlissa De Jesus returns after becoming the first Bulldog in program history to earn First Team All-
- de Jesus finished the 2020-21 season with 314 kills, 245 digs, 35 service aces and 38 total blocks. She recorded double digits in kills in 16 of the 21 matches and finished the year with 13 double-doubles. She was tabbed to the Preseason All-SoCon team earlier this

SCOUTING TENNESSEE TECH

» Tennessee Tech returns to the court after posting a 9-7 record in 2020-21. For the second straight year, returning junior middle blocker Taylor Dorsey was honored as a member of the Preseason All-OVC Team, fresh off claiming her first career All-OVC First Team honor in the spring during the league's abbreviated 2020-21 season.

Dorsey led the Ohio Valley Conference with 70.0 total blocks and ranked second in blocks per set with a mark of 1.17. She also registered 141 kills and 181.5 points. Her .306 hitting percentage ranked seventh in the league.

A WIN OVER TENNESSEE TECH WOULD...

> Be Auburn's third straight against the Golden Eagles.

AUBURN-TENNESSEE TECH SERIES

» Auburn leads the all-time series against Tennessee Tech, 2-0, with Friday's season opener marking the first time the Golden Eagles have made the trip to Auburn, Ala.

>> The two squads last met on Sept. 12, 2015, during the Memphis Invitational. Auburn swept the Golden Eagles in straight sets to claim the tournament title.

SCOUTING JACKSON STATE

» Jackson State claimed the 2021 SWAC
Championship after an undefeated regular season. The
conference championship was the fourth under head
coach Rose Washington. The Lady Tigers were selected
to finished third in the SWAC behind Alabama A&M and
Alabama State and finished with seven first-place votes.

» Be Auburn's first win over the Lady Tigers in program history.

- » Saturday's meeting against the Lady Tigers marks the first time in over 40 years that Auburn and Jackson State have faced off on the court.
- >> The two teams have met just once on Nov. 6, 1979. Auburn won the first set, 15-11, before Jackson State battled from behind to take the final two sets to win the match, 2-1.

SHIPES RETURNS AS TOP TIGER

- » Auburn's 2020 leader in kills (59), digs (47) and blocks (16), Tatum Shipes returns to the court for her senior campaign and carries the title as the most experienced offensive player returning among Tiger letterwinners.
- Shipes leads all returners with 23 career double-digit kill performances, including a pair of 10+ kill efforts during the shortened 2020 season. Shipes also leads all returners with 475 career kills.
- » Shipes also leads all returning Tigers with seven career double-double performances to her credit. Shipes was the lone Tiger to record a double-double last fall with 11 kills and 10 total digs at South Carolina on Oct. 28, 2020.

CAN YOU DIG IT?

- >> The most experienced defensive player returning for the Tigers, Bella Rosenthall enters her senior season on the cusp of joining an elite group of Tiger student-athletes.
- With 716 career digs to her credit, Rosenthall is just 284 shy of becoming just the 15th Tiger in program history to join the 1,000 digs club. Rosenthall would be the first Tiger to hit the mark since Brenna McIllroy in 2018.
- » Rosenthall is on pace to break into Auburn's record book for career digs. She needs to record 320 during her senior campaign to jump Sarah Watson for 10th in program history.
- >> The Yorktown, Ind., native enters the fall fifth in program history with a 3.10 career digs/set mark.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- » New is the name of the game for the Tigers this fall as six of Auburn's 12 student-athletes on roster will take the court in Orange and Blue for the first time in their careers.
- The revamped Tiger roster added experience after

- A four-year letterwinner at Portland, Reich used her final year of eligibility granted by COVID-19 protocols to transfer as a graduate student. An opposite hitter from Colorado Springs, Colo., appeared in over 100 career matches. She ended her career with the Pilots with over 800 career kills.
- Rath comes to the Plains after a two-year stint at Maryland. The outside hitter played in 43 matches for the Terps. She closed her freshman season third on the squad with 266 total kills.
- Auburn's roster also boast four true freshmen: defensive specialist/libero Fallan Lanham, setter Jordan Sinness, defensive specialist/libero Kate Curtis and outside hitter Cassidy Tatum.

TAKE TWO: CROUCH LEADS TIGERS IN FIRST FULL COMPETITION SEASON

- After his first season came to a halt after the abbreviated fall campaign, Brent Crouch is set to lead the Tigers onto the court for his first full season of competition.
- Crouch was named the 11th head coach in Auburn volleyball history in January of 2020 after spending the last two seasons at the helm of USC.
- He led the Trojans to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances last season. He guided three Trojans to AVCA All-America nods and helped setter Raquel Lazaro to PAC-12 Freshman of the Year.
- Crouch is just five victories away from the 100th of his coaching career. He holds a 95-99 overall career record in his eighth season as a head coach.

AUBURN PICKED 13th IN PRESEASON POLL

- Auburn was selected to finish 13th in the Southeastern Conference in the annual preseason coaches' poll. The Tigers earned 12 points from the league's coaches.
- Reigning national champion Kentucky (139 pts.) edged out Florida (138 pts) by one point as the favorite to win the SEC Championship. Kentucky secured seven first-place votes. Florida finished with six.
- LSU was tabbed to finished third, while Tennessee and Arkansas rounded out the top five.

- Air Green! Val Green set Takawanda High School's high jump record. She's also a second generation collegiate volleyball athlete. Her mother, Paula, played at Miami-Ohio.

- Jackie Barrett is the daughter of Martin J. Barrett, a former football star at the University of Buffalo. Martin was a two-time AP All-American and set 14 career UB records as a quarterback. He was inducted into Buffalo's Hall of Fame in 1989.
- Full Circle Moment: Liz Reich was originally recruited to Portland and competed her freshman season under Brent Crouch
- Audrey Douglas is fluent in American Sign Language.
- Jordan Sinness is not the first member of her family to play collegiate sports in the state of Alabama. Her older sister, Jade, plays softball at Troy University.
- Associate head coach Alex Dunphy is the daughter of Volleyball Hall of Famer and American Volleyball Coaches Association Hall of Famer, Mary Dunphy. Dunphy has led Pepperdine to five NCAA Men's Division I Championships. Marv was an assistant coach for Team USA Women's Volleyball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, helping the squad to a gold medal.

Brent Crouch enters his second season as the head coach of the Auburn volleyball team after guiding the program through the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic during his first season on The Plains.

Crouch made his Auburn coaching debut against No. 4 Florida on Oct. 21, 2020, to open the shortened fall volleyball schedule. Crouch led the Tigers on the court for eight total

The fall season was highlighted by Auburn setting the program record for blocks in a four-set match as the Tigers recorded 17 at South Carolina on Oct. 29, 2020. The previous mark of 14 was set on Nov. 9, 2014 against Tennessee. The total tied for the second-most blocks in a match in Auburn program history as was the most by the Tigers since 2009.

Due to injuries and opt-out, the Tigers were unable to compete in the spring portion of the amended 2020-21 schedule.

Crouch previously served as the head coach at the University of Southern California. In two seasons at USC, Crouch led the program to consecutive NCAA second round appearances, including a second-place finish in the Pac-12, and a No. 21 ranking in the season's final AVCA poll in his first season on campus in 2018. This past season, the Trojans were 18-14 while outside hitter Khalia Lanier became the fifth player in Pac-12 history to record 2,000 kills and 1,000 digs in career.

Under Crouch in 2018, the Trojans finished 22-11 overall with a 13-7 record in Pac-12 matches. USC played one of the toughest schedules in the nation and faced 18 ranked opponents in the regular season and were awarded the No. 11 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament. Setter Raquel Lázaro was named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and outside hitter Brooke Botkin was chosen for second-team AVCA All-America honors. Lázaro and Lanier were each tabbed for All-America honorable mention

Under Crouch's tutelage, outside hitter Emilia Weske was tabbed to the Pac-12's All-Freshman Team while middle blocker Jasmine Gross added All-Pac 12 honors.

Prior to arriving at Troy, Crouch was the 2016 West Coast Conference Coach of the Year. He inherited a winless Portland program and within two seasons guided the Pilots to their winningest season in 25 years. Crouch first took over at Portland in 2014 after the Pilots went 0-27 the previous season. After going 7-23 in his debut season, he guided the Pilots to a 16-15 mark in 2015 (its most victories since 1991) and then improved upon that in 2016 with a 17-13 mark. His 2017 team, which was hampered by injuries, was 15-15, with five losses coming in five-set matches. His overall four-year record at Portland was

The 48 victories in his final three years was Portland's best three-season total since 1984-86. The Pilots' 10-8 third place WCC finish in 2016 was its most league wins since 1985 and highest conference finish since 1989. He led Portland to the program's first-ever victories over Top 10, Top 15, and Top 25 opponents. Crouch coached three All-WCC first team players and a WCC All-Freshman team pick, along with three WCC All-Academic first teamers. He also helped establish beach volleyball as a varsity sport at Portland in 2016.

Crouch arrived at Portland after four seasons (2010-13) at Saint Mary's College, where he was an assistant with the indoor program and head coach of the beach team.

During his time at SMC, the Gaels' indoor team went 73-40 overall, finished in the top borning its linite of and into detail industries in the HVC standings each season by winning 73.4 percent of its league matches (47-17) and earned a berth into the NCAA Tournament in 2012, advancing to the second round. Besides being involved in the team's offense and defense, recruiting, scouting, practice planning, statistical and video analysis and scheduling, he provided academic support, as he mentored several WCC All-Academic honorees and helped the team to the athletic department's highest grade point average, an NCAA Public Recognition Award, and an AVCA academic award

Crouch also coached the inaugural Saint Mary's beach team in 2013, guiding the Gaels to an 8-2 record, the best mark among all Northern California teams, as well as a No. 9 national ranking and a bid to the AVCA national championship for the program's top pairs team.

Crouch played for Texas A&M's club team from 1993 to 1997. He earned his bachelor's degree in history in 1998 and his master's in philosophy in 2000, both from Texas A&M, then a doctorate in philosophy from Oregon in 2006.

He competed on the beach from 2005 to 2007 in AVP and CBVA events and placed second at the 2005 California Cup state championship.

He has held various teaching positions in philosophy at Oregon, San Diego City College, and Saint Mary's College since 2000.

Crouch and his wife Marcy have two sons, Jonathan and William.
