## BY THE NUMBERS

**1** Auburn is the only program in the SEC to have two attackers ranked in the top five in kills/set average as Rebekah Rath (5.08) and Liz Reich (3.83) rank first and fifth, respectively.

**3** Making the move to middle blocker to begin the season, Tatum Shipes currently ranks third among Division I athletes with a 1.92 blocks/set average.

**99** Head coach Brent Crouch is on the cusp of a major milestone in his coaching career as he is one victory shy from recording his 100th win as a Division I head coach.

## QUICK HITS

- Standing at the top of the SEC standings with Ole Miss as the only remaining undefeated programs in the conference. Auburn is off to its first 4-0 start since 2015. Having not drop a set in 2021, Auburn has now opened the season with four straight sweeps for the first time since 2009.
- After totaling 32 kills to continue her stranglehold as the SEC's leader in kills/set, Rebekah Rath was named SEC Offensive Player of the Week. Since is the first Tiger to win the award since Brenna McLroy won the award on Oct. 30, 2017.
- Ranked second in the conference with a 5.33 digs/set average, Bella Rosenthal is off to a hot start to her senior campaign with four straight 10+ dig matches. She is looking to become just the 15th Tiger in program history to record 1,000 career digs. Rosenthal would be the first to do so since Brenna McLroy (2015-2018). She enters the weekend with 780 career digs.
- Defense has been key to Auburn's early success to begin the season. The Tigers lead the SEC and rank eighth nationally with a 3.21 blocks/set average. The Tigers also lead the league by holding opponents to a .087 hitting percentage and rank second in the SEC with a 13.33 digs/set average.

**GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA**

>> Auburn Arena is in its seventh season as home of Auburn volleyball. The Tigers are 53-49 since moving to the Arena in 2013. The facility seats approximately 2,000 fans for volleyball and 9,121 for basketball.



**FIRST SERVE**

» One of two remaining undefeated SEC programs, Auburn puts its unblemished record on the line Thursday night against North Alabama at 6 p.m. CT

» Thursday's contest will be streamed via the SEC Network+ with Lynn Rollins and Paige Wetzel on the call. Thursday's contest will also be available on WEGL 91.1.

» In its 49th full season of volleyball, Auburn's all-time record stands at 659-675-4 (.494).

» Brent Crouch (4-8) enters his second season as the head coach for the Tigers after a two-year stint at USC. Entering his eighth overall season as a head coach, Crouch holds a 99-99 career record. He's the 11th head coach in Auburn program history.

» Auburn's 2021 schedule features four 2020-21 NCAA Volleyball Tournament participants: Jackson State, Missouri, Florida and reigning national champion Kentucky.

» The Tiger roster features a wealth of fresh faces as six of Auburn's 12 total student-athletes on roster will be taking the court in Blue and Orange for the first time in their careers with a combination of four true freshmen and two transfers.

**UP NEXT**

» Auburn continues its home stand on Sunday, hosting Santa Clara in Auburn Arena at 1:30 p.m. CT. The contest was added to the schedule following the cancellation of a midweek match with New Orleans due to the aftermath of Hurricane Ida. Due to conflicts with additional athletic events on campus, Sunday's match will not be streamed.

**LAST TIME OUT**

» Behind another strong blocking performance at the net, Auburn volleyball remained unbeaten as the Tigers swept Southeastern Louisiana in straight sets (25-14, 25-10, 25-20) Friday night at Auburn Arena.

» The victory marked the first time the Tigers have started as season 4-0 since 2015. It also marked the first time Auburn has swept four straight to open a season since 2009.

» The Tigers held Southeastern Louisiana to a .050 attack percentage with help from 10.5 total team blocks. Senior Tatum Shipes led the charge at the net with a career high eight blocks. Shipes also chipped in four kills for the Tigers.

» Rebekah Rath continued to pace the Auburn offense as she matched her season high output in kills with 16. Rath has now recorded double-digit kills in four straight matches. Also matching her season high in kills, Liz Reich totaled 13 on a .458 hitting percentage.

**PLAYER TO WATCH: REBEKAH RATH**

» The reigning SEC Offensive Player of the Week, Rebekah Rath enters the weekend as the SEC leader in kills/set (5.08) and points/set (6.08). Rath has recorded at least 10+ kills in every match to begin the 2021 campaign.



» Jackie Barrett handled setting duties for the Tigers, dishing out 28 assists. Barrett led the Auburn offense to a .300 team hitting percentage. Barrett recorded six digs, a pair of blocks and added three kills to match her career high.

» Bella Rosenthal turned in her fourth straight match with double-digit digs as the libero recorded a match-leading 16. Freshman Fallan Lanham set her career high with 10 digs.

**SEC REVAMPS CONFERENCE SCHEDULING FORMAT FOR 2021 CAMPAIGN**

» The Southeastern Conference announced a new scheduling format for its conference slate ahead of the 2021 campaign.

» The SEC schedule consists of 18 matches in which each member institution will play each other at least once. The order of opponents for each team was determined by a random computer draw.

» Two-match series may be played Wednesday/Thursday, Thursday/Friday, Friday/Saturday or Saturday/Sunday per the league office.

**SCOUTING NORTH ALABAMA**

» After dropping its first four matches of the season, North Alabama has found its rhythm to win two of its last three matches. Last weekend at the Music City Invitational, the Lions fell to Belmont before edging out Alcorn State in a five-set thriller.

» Offensively, North Alabama is evenly spread as three Lions have recorded 50+ kills through the first two weeks of the season. Katy Floyd leads that group with 56, averaging 2.55 kills/set.

» Floyd is also strong at the service line with a team-leading 10 aces. As a team, North Alabama has recorded 48 aces in seven matches.

» Setting duties have been split thus far between Breylee Linder and Camryn Kling. Linder has the slightest of edges with a 4.92 assists/set average. Linder is also hitting .267 this season with four kills and has added six aces for the Lions.

» Defensively, North Alabama is strong at the net with 46.0 total blocks. Anna Katherine Griggs has been a part of half of North Alabama's blocks as she leads the team with 22.0 total. Mattrice Harris is just behind with 20.0.

» The Lions have six members of the roster with 30+ digs. Tatum Fouche leads the effort with 66 and averages a team-leading 2.54 digs/set.

**AUBURN-NORTH ALABAMA SERIES**

» Auburn and North Alabama have met a total of 11 times in program history, but Thursday's match will be the first between the two squads in over 40 years.

» The last meeting on the court was on Sept. 29, 1979, as the Tigers swept North Alabama, 15-6, 15-7, 15-9.

» Auburn has won the last three consecutive meetings all via the sweep and lead the all-time series, 6-4-1.

**RATH NAMED SEC OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

» After a second straight week of serving as Auburn volleyball's top attacker, Rebekah Rath was selected as Southeastern Conference Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 7.

» Rath helped the Tigers to back-to-back sweeps over Cal State Fullerton and Southeastern Louisiana last week. Auburn volleyball is now off to its first 4-0 start since the 2015 season. The Tigers have won all four of their contests in straight sets, marking the first time the program has started a season with four consecutive sweeps since 2009.

» Against the Titans, Rath led the team with 16 kills, matching her season high, and hit at a .262 percentage. She added an ace from the service line. Defensively, she recorded 10 digs for her first double-double as a Tiger.

» Rath followed up that performance with another 16-kill effort versus the Lady Lions. Rath closed the night with a .275 attack percentage and an ace. Rath totaled four stuff blocks at the net and rounded out her defensive play with seven digs.

» She is the only Tiger this season to record double-digit kills in every match to start the 2021 season. She currently leads the SEC in both kills per set (5.33) and points per set (6.08). She ranks fourth and third, respectively, in the NCAA in both categories.

» The recognition is the first in Rath's career since transferring to the Plains. The Altamonte Springs, Fla., native is the first Auburn Tiger to be named SEC Offensive Player of the Week since Brenna McIlroy won the award on Oct. 30, 2017.

**HOT START**

» The Tigers opened the 2021 season with four consecutive sweeps through the first two weeks of play and now joins Ole Miss as the only two remaining SEC

programs that are undefeated.

» Auburn has matched the 2015 season's 4-0 start. The last time a Tiger team started 5-0 was in 2012. The Tigers opened the 2021 season 8-0 before suffering their first loss.

» The Tigers have won all four of their contests in straight sets, marking the first time the program has started a season with four consecutive sweeps since 2009.

**FEEL THE RATH**

» Rebekah Rath made a statement in her debut season as a Tiger and put the league on notice that she is an offensive powerhouse that should be on everyone's radar.

» The reigning SEC Offensive Player of the Week has recorded 10+ kills in all four matches to begin her Auburn career. She has totaled 16 kills in three of her four matches.

» Rath leads the Southeastern Conference in points/set (6.08) and kills/set (5.08). She currently ranks third and fourth, respectively, in the country in the two categories.

» Rath also ranks second in the league in attacks/set (11.92) and 15th in blocks/set (1.08).

**CAN YOU DIG IT?**

» Bella Rosenthal picked up right where she left off with a strong performance as starting libero to kick off her senior campaign.

» Rosenthal paced the Tigers with 31 total digs to earn a spot on the War Eagle Invitational All-Tournament Team. Rosenthal currently ranks second in the league with a 5.17 digs per set average. Rosenthal is the only Tiger this season to record at least 10 digs in every match.

» With 780 career digs to her credit, Rosenthal is just 220 shy of becoming just the 15th Tiger in program history to join the 1,000 digs club. Rosenthal would be the first Tiger to hit the mark since Brenna McIlroy in 2018.

» The Yorktown, Ind., native stands fifth in program history with a 3.21 career digs/set mark.

» Rosenthal currently ranks second in the SEC with a 5.33 digs/set average to begin the season.

**BLOCK PARTY**

» Play at the net has been key in Auburn's 4-0 start to the season.

» Auburn totaled 38.4 blocks in its first four matches of the season. The Tigers currently lead the SEC and rank eighth in the country with a 3.21 blocks/set average.

» The Tigers have been able to hold opponents to a miniscule .080 hitting percentage this season with its improved defense. The mark leads the SEC and is the sixth lowest opponent hitting percentage in Division I.

**PLAYER TO WATCH: TATUM SHIPES**

» Making the move to middle blocker has been an easy transition to Tatum Shipes. Shipes enters the week leading the SEC and third among all NCAA Division I athletes with a 1.92 blocks/set average.





» Making the move to middle block to begin her senior season, Tatum Shipes has shined in the position and has shattered her career high for blocks in a single game with 8.0 versus Southeastern Louisiana (9/3).  
 » With 23.0 total blocks already to her credit, Shipes leads the SEC and ranks third in the nation with a 1.92 blocks/set average.

### NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

» New is the name of the game for the Tigers this fall as six of Auburn's 12 student-athletes on roster will take the court in Orange and Blue for the first time in their careers.  
 » The revamped Tiger roster added experience after going coast-to-coast with a pair of transfers: Liz Reich and Rebekah Rath.  
 » A four-year letterwinner at Portland, Reich used her final year of eligibility granted by COVID-19 protocols to transfer as a graduate student. An opposite hitter from Colorado Springs, Colo., appeared in over 100 career matches. She ended her career with the Pilots with over 800 career kills.  
 » Rath comes to the Plains after a two-year stint at Maryland. The outside hitter played in 43 matches for the Terps. She closed her freshman season third on the squad with 266 total kills.  
 » Auburn's roster also boast four true freshmen: defensive specialist/libero Fallan Lanham, setter Jordan Sinness, defensive specialist/libero Kate Curtis and outside hitter Cassidy Tatum.

### TAKE TWO: CROUCH LEADS TIGERS IN FIRST FULL COMPETITION SEASON

» After his first season came to a halt after the abbreviated fall campaign, Brent Crouch is set to lead the Tigers onto the court for his first full season of competition.  
 » Crouch was named the 11th head coach in Auburn volleyball history in January of 2020 after spending the last two seasons at the helm of USC.  
 » He led the Trojans to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances last season. He guided three Trojans to AVCA All-America nods and helped setter Raquel Lazaro to PAC-12 Freshman of the Year.  
 » Crouch is just one victory away from the 100th of his coaching career. He holds a 99-99 overall career record in his eighth season as a head coach.

### AUBURN PICKED 13th IN PRESEASON POLL

» Auburn was selected to finish 13th in the Southeastern Conference in the annual preseason coaches' poll. The Tigers earned 12 points from the league's coaches.  
 » Reigning national champion Kentucky (139 pts.) edged out Florida (138 pts) by one point as the favorite to win the SEC Championship. Kentucky secured seven first-place votes. Florida finished with six.  
 » LSU was tabbed to finished third, while Tennessee and Arkansas rounded out the top five.

### TIGER TRACKS

» Air Green! Val Green set Takawanda High School's high jump record. She's also a second generation collegiate volleyball athlete. Her mother, Paula, played at Miami-Ohio.  
 » Tatum Shipes holds a wealth of athletic talent in her family's history. Her mother, Laurel, played basketball at Kentucky. Her father lettered in basketball at The Master's University. Her brother, T.J., was a member of Georgia State's basketball team. Her grandfather, Don Hudgens, and great grandparents, Ira and Opal, all played collegiate basketball.  
 » Jackie Barrett is the daughter of Martin J. Barrett, a former football star at the University of Buffalo. Martin was a two-time AP All-American and set 14 career UB records as a quarterback. He was inducted into Buffalo's Hall of Fame in 1989.  
 » Full Circle Moment: Liz Reich was originally recruited to Portland and competed her freshman season under Brent Crouch.  
 » Audrey Douglas is fluent in American Sign Language.  
 » Jordan Sinness is not the first member of her family to play collegiate sports in the state of Alabama. Her older sister, Jade, plays softball at Troy University.  
 » Associate head coach Alex Dunphy is the daughter of Volleyball Hall of Famer and American Volleyball Coaches Association Hall of Famer, Marv Dunphy. Dunphy has led Pepperdine to five NCAA Men's Division I Championships. Marv was an assistant coach for Team USA Women's Volleyball at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, helping the squad to a gold medal.

Brent Crouch enters his second season as the head coach of the Auburn volleyball team after guiding the program through the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic during his first season on The Plains.

Crouch made his Auburn coaching debut against No. 4 Florida on Oct. 21, 2020, to open the shortened fall volleyball schedule. Crouch led the Tigers on the court for eight total matches.

The fall season was highlighted by Auburn setting the program record for blocks in a four-set match as the Tigers recorded 17 at South Carolina on Oct. 29, 2020. The previous mark of 14 was set on Nov. 9, 2014 against Tennessee. The total tied for the second-most blocks in a match in Auburn program history as was the most by the Tigers since 2009.

Due to injuries and opt-out, the Tigers were unable to compete in the spring portion of the amended 2020-21 schedule.

Crouch previously served as the head coach at the University of Southern California. In two seasons at USC, Crouch led the program to consecutive NCAA second round appearances, including a second-place finish in the Pac-12, and a No. 21 ranking in the season's final AVCA poll in his first season on campus in 2018. This past season, the Trojans were 18-14, while outside hitter Kholia Lanier became the fifth player in Pac-12 history to record 2,000 kills and 1,000 digs in career.

Under Crouch in 2018, the Trojans finished 22-11 overall with a 13-7 record in Pac-12 matches. USC played one of the toughest schedules in the nation and faced 18 ranked opponents in the regular season and were awarded the No. 11 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament. Setter Raquel Lazaro was named the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year and outside hitter Brooke Borikin was chosen for second-team AVCA All-America honors. Lazaro and Lanier were each tabbed for All-America honorable mention.

Under Crouch's tutelage, outside hitter Emilia Weske was tabbed to the Pac-12's All-Freshman Team while middle blocker Jasmine Gross added All-Pac 12 honors.

Prior to arriving at Troy, Crouch was the 2016 West Coast Conference Coach of the Year. He inherited a winless Portland program and within two seasons guided the Pilots to their winningest season in 25 years. Crouch first took over at Portland in 2014 after the Pilots went 0-27 the previous season. After going 7-23 in his debut season, he guided the Pilots to a 16-15 mark in 2015 (its most victories since 1991) and then improved upon that in 2016 with a 17-13 mark. His 2017 team, which was hampered by injuries, was 15-15, with five losses coming in five-set matches. His overall four-year record at Portland was 55-66.

The 48 victories in his final three years was Portland's best three-season total since 1984-86. The Pilots' 10-8 third place WCC finish in 2016 was its most league wins since 1985 and highest conference finish since 1989. He led Portland to the program's first-ever victories over Top 10, Top 15, and Top 25 opponents. Crouch coached three All-WCC first team players and a WCC All-Freshman team pick, along with three WCC All-Academic first teamers. He also helped establish beach volleyball as a varsity sport at Portland in 2016.

Crouch arrived at Portland after four seasons (2010-13) at Saint Mary's College, where he was an assistant with the indoor program and head coach of the beach team.

During his time at SMC, the Goels' indoor team went 73-40 overall, finished in the top three in the WCC standings each season by winning 73.4 percent of its league matches (47-17) and earned a berth into the NCAA Tournament in 2012, advancing to the second round. Besides being involved in the team's offense and defense, recruiting, scouting, practice planning, statistical and video analysis and scheduling, he provided academic support, as he mentored several WCC All-Academic honorees and helped the team to the athletic department's highest grade point average, an NCAA Public Recognition Award, and an AVCA academic award.

Crouch also coached the inaugural Saint Mary's beach team in 2013, guiding the Goels to an 8-2 record, the best mark among all Northern California teams, as well as a No. 9 national ranking and a bid to the AVCA national championship for the program's top pairs team.

Crouch played for Texas A&M's club team from 1993 to 1997. He earned his bachelor's degree in history in 1998 and his master's in philosophy in 2000, both from Texas A&M, then a doctorate in philosophy from Oregon in 2006.

He competed on the beach from 2005 to 2007 in AVP and CBVA events and placed second at the 2005 California Cup state championship.

He has held various teaching positions in philosophy at Oregon, San Diego City College, and Saint Mary's College since 2000.

Crouch and his wife Marcy have two sons, Jonathan and William.
