SEASON OPENER IN NORTH CAROLINA

The No. 14 Auburn gymnastics team kicks off the 2022 season on the road, traveling to Chapel Hill, North Carolina for a tri meet. The Tigers take on host North Carolina and Bowling Green Friday at 6 p.m. CT in Carmichael Arena.

"It feels like we've been preparing for this week for a long time," head coach Jeff Graba said. "I think everyone is ready for competition and this team has done a great job getting ready for what this season might bring.

"We typically love to start on the road," Graba added. "With school not in session, this allows us time to do more team activities and help the squad get ready for what the season will look like. We're excited to see what we can put together this week."

"We're so ready to get going," junior Cassie Stevens said. "The offseason went really well and our freshmen are really talented. Our team chemistry is really good this year and we can't wait to get things started Friday."

Head coach Jeff Graba has put the Auburn gymnastics program on the map throughout his 10+ years on the Plains. Now entering his 12th season at the helm in 2022, Graba and the Tigers are looking to build on their accomplishments to reach bigger feats in the sport.

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

Most recently, Graba and his staff guided Derrian Gobourne to the 2021 SEC Co-Specialist of the Year as she exceled on vault, bars, and floor. She was a first team All-American and All-SEC on floor as well. In addition, they helped Drew Watson and Cassie Stevens to All-SEC recognition.

The coaching staff guided a pair of Tigers to All-America honors in 2020. Watson picked up first team recognition on vault and finished with an NQS of 9.92 in the event to finish in a tie for seventh nationally. Her selection marked the first All-America honor for a Tiger in the category since 2016.

Gobourne was placed on the second team on bars in 2020. Her All-America honor in the event is the first for any Tiger on bars at the conclusion of the regular season. Gobourne finished tied for 14th nationally with a 9.905.

The 2020 squad enjoyed a wealth of accomplishments throughout the season, including a win over Alabama in Auburn Arena to kick off the home schedule.

Auburn's performances in 2019 was one for the books as they reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen and finished 16th in the final rankings. Auburn reached the second round of the NCAA Regional Championship with a 197.075 in Baton Rouge, marking the highest regional score in program history.

The program saw its first national champion in 2019 when Gobourne came in a tie for first at that 2019 National Championship on vault. The then-freshman scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way. In addition, Gobourne earned All-SEC and Freshman All-SEC recognition.

Samantha Cerio secured SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year for the sport in 2019.

Graba and the 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program under his guidance. The Tigers snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama in February of that season, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. That season, Auburn broke or tied 52 program records that season.

Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' second best in history and highest since 1993 with a NCAA nationals record score of 197.075. The Tigers also had a program record Super Six score of 195.625.

Auburn reached the 2015 NCAA Championship for the first time since 2003 and for only the fourth time overall.

In 11 seasons, Graba has led his student-athletes to 16 All-America honors (both NACGC/W and NCAA) and 22 All-SEC recognitions. Leading the way was Caitlin Atkinson who amassed nine All-America nods and named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

With the help of continuous progress, Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance each season. Each season, the team's attendance average has climbed higher and higher and after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season, Auburn finished the 2020 season with a new program record average of 6,364 fans. In addition, the Tigers have enjoyed 10 sellouts of Auburn Arena (7,424).

Away from competition, Graba's teams have also been outstanding in the class-room. In total, the Tigers have totaled 45 NACGC/W Scholastic All-America nods and 105 SEC Academic Honor Roll recognitions.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010 after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he earned the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year while coaching bars, collaborating on floor routines and serving as the recruiting coordinator.

During his first four years as an assistant, Utah finished as the NCAA runner-up three times and placed third once. Graba has also coached nine NCAA All-American gymnasts to 20 All-America performances.

As Utah's bars coach, he tutored Kristina Baskett to a 2006 NCAA uneven bars title as a freshman in his first trip to the NCAA Championships.

Prior to his stint at Utah, Graba spent two years as an assistant coach at Utah State. In 2005, he coached the Aggies to their first Western Gymnastics Conference championship and their first regional appearance in three years. In addition to his coaching duties, he served as the head of recruiting and assisted with the strength and conditioning program.

From 1995-2003, Graba was the co-owner and head coach of Midwest Gymnastics Club in Arden Hills, Minn. He had three gymnasts qualify Elite in his last three years with the club and had several level 8, 9 and 10 regional and national competitors.

Graba's collegiate coaching career began at Hamline University from 1992-98. While in St. Paul, Minn., his highlights included six-consecutive trips to the Division III National Championships and a runner-up finish in 1996. Eleven of his gymnasts combined to win 26 National Collegiate Gymnastics Association (NCGA) All-America citations.

Graba is a native of Forest Lake, Minn., and graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1992 with a bachelor's degree in economics and earned his M.B.A. from Salem International University in 2011. He and his wife, Bridget, have five children: Bryan, Jaymie, Jason, Kyla and Shayla.

AUBURN LINEUP

Depth and experience with a mix of new talent is what the Tigers will bring to the table in 2022 as the squad lost just one routine from last season. The tentative lineup features two seniors, four juniors, one sophomore and three freshmen.

"We have a lot of depth right now and selecting lineups will be difficult," head coach Jeff Graba said. "We have a lot of experience returning, but also a lot of talented freshmen coming in that have to get opportunities. It will be a balance game to start the year. The depth is only really good if you develop it and that is what the month of January is about for us."

Juniors Aria Brusch and Cassie Stevens are slated to compete in the all-around for the Tigers, while senior Derrian Gobourne and freshman Sophia Groth will go in three events.

The Tigers kick things off on bars in the first rotation. Junior Adeline Sabados will lead things off, marking her 20th start in the event. Stevens will go second with fifth-year senior Drew Watson going third. Freshman Sunisa Lee will go fourth and Brusch is set for fifth. Gobourne is down in the anchor slot, making her 34th start for the Tigers.

Auburn will head to beam next with Brusch leading off rotation two. Junior Morgan Leigh Oldham is down for second with sophomore Olivia Hollingsworth going third. Lee is slated for fourth and classmate Sophia Groth is set to go fifth. Stevens will anchor the event for the Tigers following a solid finish in 2021. She earned All-SEC on beam for her performance at the conference postseason meet.

Rotation three will have Auburn compete on floor and freshman Sara Hubbard will make her collegiate debut in the lead off slot. Oldham will be second with Groth going third. Stevens and Brusch will follow with Gobourne anchoring the Tigers. Gobourne secured first team All-America honors in the event last season, reaching a 9.975 on two occasions.

Auburn will close out the final rotation on vault. Brusch and Groth will kick things off with Stevens going third to close out their busy evenings. Hubbard is set for fourth with Watson and Gobourne finishing off the meet.

OLYMPIAN ON CAMPUS

Freshman Sunisa Lee comes to the Plains with a wealth of accolades to her name.

As a member of Team USA this summer, Lee captured gold and was crowned the Olympic All-Around champion. She added silver as a member of the team and secured bronze on bars

Lee is a seven-time U.S. National Team Member and was the 2021 U.S. bars champion. In addition, she was runner up in the all-around and on beam at the 2021 U.S. Championship.

To go with her success in the gym, Lee recently competed on Dancing with the Stars. She reached the semifinals with her partner Sasha Farber.

IN THE RANKINGS

Auburn will open the year at No. 14 according to the Women's Collegiate Gymnastics Association preseason coaches' poll.

"It's always exciting when the preseason poll comes out because it means our season is right around the corner," head coach Jeff Graba said. "Being ranked No. 14 in the coaches' poll is as good a place as any to start. I'm excited for this team to get started and show what we're capable of."

Three Southeastern Conference schools are

in the Top 10 and all eight schools are in the Top 20. Florida will start the year at No. 2, while LSU and Alabama are at No. 5 and No. 6, respectively. Arkansas is 11th, Kentucky is at No. 13, Georgia is at No. 15 and Missouri rounds out the SEC schools at No. 16.

The Tigers will also face No. 1 and defending national champion Michigan in March.

NORTH CAROLINA SERIES

Auburn holds a 7-4 record against North Carolina in the all-time series, including a 2-1 mark in meets competed in Chapel Hill.

The two teams last met in 2015, facing off in a home-and-home series that season. Auburn traveled to the Tar Heels for the season opener, taking a 194.150-193.750 victory.

The squads last faced off in Auburn Arena that same season, seeing the Tigers earn a 197.100 to best UNC's 194.025.

The No. 7 Auburn gymnastics finished its regular season with a 197.100-194.025 victory against North Carolina in Auburn Arena

Caitlin Atkinson, MJ Rott and Bri Guy led the Tigers in the first rotation on vault with scores of 9.900, splitting the event title. Auburn scored a team total 49.425, the second highest vault total of the season.

On bars, Auburn scored a team total 49.125 led by Walker's 9.900. The score earned Walker her third event title on bars this season.

Walker led the Tigers on beam with a 9.900, earning her ninth total event title of the season. Sophomore Kullen Hlawek scored a career-high 9.925 on floor to earn her first ever event title and help the Tigers to a 49.300

team total on floor.

BOWLING GREEN SERIES

Auburn and Bowling Green have only met once in program history. The Tigers came away with a 165.55-159.95 victory in 1983.

SUPER SENIORS

A trio of Tigers returned for their fifth year in Jada Glenn, Allie Riddle and Drew Watson.

Watson is a three-time All-SEC competitor and captured first team All-American accolades in 2020 on vault. She holds the program's top score on vault with a 9.975.

In addition, Watson has 47 starts on vault and 42 on floor. She's competed in the all-around 29 times as a Tiger.

Glenn has been in the vault lineup 33 times during her career, while Riddle has competed on beam 21 times.

GOBOURNE READY TO SHINE

Senior Derrian Gobourne is coming off an outstanding 2021 and is ready to pick up where she left off.

The 2021 SEC Specialist of the Year finished the season with nine event titles during the season, including four on floor.

Gobourne was a first team All-American on floor after earning an NQS of 9.956 to finish fourth nationally. She reached a career-high 9.975 on two occasions.

In addition, Gobourne has earned first team All-America accolades on vault (2019) and second team on bars (2020).

She is also a three-time All-SEC performer.

SUPER JUNIORS

Auburn's junior class is expected to continue to be strong leaders for the Tigers this season.

Aria Brusch and Cassie Stevens will be strong competitors in teh all-around for Auburn, while Adeline Sabados, Piper Smith and Anna Sumner will provide expertise on bars. Smith and Morgan Leigh Oldham have experience on beam, while Oldham and Sabados have been strong on floor throughout their careers

YOUTH MOVEMENT

Auburn's five freshmen are expected to do big things this season for the squad.

Leading the charge is Olympic gold medalist Sunisa Lee. The St. Paul, Minnesota product is expected to provide a wealth of experience and depth on all four events, especially on bars and beam.

Another gymnast expected to make big moves in the all-around will be Sophia Groth. The West Des Moines, Iowa native is set to compete on vault, beam and floor in her first meet with potential on bars.
