Auburn Women's Basketball Ouick Hitters

- Despite being separated by just 116 miles and a long football rivalry history, this is just the fifth meeting between Auburn and Georgia Tech in women's basketball, and just the second to be played in Auburn
- This is Georgia Tech's first visit to Auburn since the 1975-76 season
- Auburn has won all four previous meetings vs. Georgia Tech
- Last season, Auburn picked up its first road win over a ranked opponent since 2014 with a 59-51 win over No. 18 Tech in Atlanta on Nov. 21
- Auburn is 2-0 for the seventh time in the last 10 seasons
- Aicha Coulibaly is the SEC's second-leading scorer, averaging 21.5 points/game
- Coulibaly recorded her first double-double of the season and sixth of her career with 24 points and 10 rebounds against Sam Houston
- Freshman Kaitlyn Duhon had a huge game vs. South Alabama with 17 points, 7 rebounds, 3 steals and 2 blocks
- Honesty Scott-Grayson matched a career-high with 5 steals vs. Sam Houston
- Mar'Shaun Bostic equaled a career-high with 9 points and 4 assists vs. Sam Houston
- Auburn forced 33 turnovers vs. Sam Houston, the most since forcing ULM into 35 during the 2017-18 season and tied for the 12th-most in a game in program history
- Auburn's 90 points against Sam Houston were the second-most under coach Johnnie Harris (91 vs. Charleston Southern)
- Kaitlyn Duhon, Kharyssa Richardson and Sydney Shaw were in the starting lineup for the season-opener vs. Sam Houston; it is believed to be the first time Auburn has started three true freshmen in a season-opener
- Five players made their Auburn debut vs. Sam Houston (Duhon, Shaw, J. Johnson, Richardson, Pratcher)
- Auburn is 42-10 all-time in season openers and 29-4 when playing its first game of the season at home
- · Auburn has won 43 of its last 44 home openers
- Auburn is in its 52nd season of women's basketball and has 964 program wins
- Auburn defeated Tuskegee 81-59 in an exhibition game Nov. 3
- · Coulibaly was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection by the league's coaches
- Coulibaly is Auburn's leading returner with 17.1 points and 7.5 rebounds per game last season; she was named to the All-SEC Second Team following the 2022 season
- Sania Wells was the SEC's leading free-throw shooter in 2021-22 at 90.5% (76-84)
- · Auburn returns three starters and eight letterwinners from the 2021-22 season; the Tigers welcome 7 newcomers
- Auburn earned three wins over top-25 opponents in 2021-22 (#4 Tennessee, #18 Georgia Tech, #21 Georgia)
- Johnnie Harris enters her second season as head coach at Auburn
- In SEC preseason polls, Auburn was picked to finish 13th by both the media and the league's coaches

- » Auburn women's basketball plays its third of four straight home games to open the season as Georgia Tech visits Neville Arena for the first time Wednesday at 7 p.m. CT.
- >> Auburn is 2-0 after a 71-62 win over South Alabama last Thursday night.
- " Georgia Tech is also 2-0; the Yellow Jackets defeated Kennesaw State 65-39 on Sunday.

LAST TIME OUT

- Missing three key players and their head coach due to illness, the Auburn women's basketball team willed its way to a 71-62 victory over South Alabama Thursday night at Neville Arena.
- >> The Tigers (2-0) used a 15-0 run through the middle of the second quarter to turn an early deficit into a lead they would not relinquish. South Alabama (1-1) would not go quietly, however, getting as close as five points in the fourth quarter before Auburn made two key buckets down the stretch to seal the win.
- Head coach Johnnie Harris was unable to be on the sidelines, so associate head coach Damitria Buchanan assumed the reins for Thursday's game. Auburn was also without junior Precious Johnson, sophomore Romi Levy and freshman Mya Pratcher, all of whom missed the game with illness.
- "Freshman Kaitlyn Duhon had a monster game in her second collegiate appearance, scoring 17 points to go along with seven rebounds, three steals and a pair of blocks. Junior Aicha Coulibaly led the Tigers with 19 points and pulled down five boards on the night.
- » Kharyssa Richardson, another freshman, contributed nine points and seven rebounds, and classmate Sydney Shaw finished with eight points and shared the team lead with three assists. Senior Honesty Scott-Grayson knocked down two key 3-pointers, finishing with six points to go along with five rebounds and three assists.

UP NEXT

Auburn finishes off a season-opening fourgame home stand Sunday, Nov. 20, as they host Alabama State at 2 p.m. CT.

AN AUBURN WIN WOULD...

- » Give Auburn a 3-0 start for the fourth time in the last seven seasons.
- » Be Auburn's 9th straight home nonconference victory.
- Improve Auburn to 5-0 all-time against Georgia Tech.

AUBURN-GEORGIA TECH SERIES

» Despite being separated by just 116 miles, this is only the fifth meeting between Auburn and Georgia Tech in women's basketball, and the first visit to the Plains for Tech since the 1975-76 season. Auburn has won all four previous meetings.

LAST MEETING: Nov. 21, 2021, at Atlanta Auburn 59, #18 Georgia Tech 51

- Auburn's defense put together its best performance of the year, and Honesty Scott-Grayson turned in her second straight standout game as the Tigers upset No. 18 Georgia Tech 59-51 at McCamish Pavilion.
- The Tigers (2-2) jumped out to a big early lead – increasing it to as much as 22 in the second half – and held off a comeback bid by Tech (4-1) for

its first road win over a ranked opponent in nearly eight years.

- >> Honesty Scott-Grayson never came off the floor, scoring 18 points along with six rebounds and three assists. She had her best 3-point shooting game of her career as well, going 4-of-8 from long range. Aicha Coulibaly added 14 points with five boards, and Sania Wells delivered four clutch free throws in the final minute to clinch the victory; she finished with eight points.
- Auburn's win was its first over a ranked opponent since defeating Missouri at home in 2019, and its first over a ranked foe on the road since a 2014 victory at No. 16 Vanderbilt.

SCOUTING GEORGIA TECH

- Deorgia Tech is 2-0 after wins over in-state foes Georgia State and Kennesaw State to open the season.
- >> The Yellow Jackets were 21-11 overall, 11-7 in ACC play last year and earned a No. 9 seed in the NCAA Tournament. Tech was picked to finish 8th in the ACC in 2022-23.
- Tech returns two starters from 2021-22 but added a pair of top transfers in Bianca Jackson and Cameron Swartz, who was the ACC's Most Improved Player in 2022 at Boston College. Swartz is Tech's leading scorer through two games at 16.5 ppg.

ALL THE CONNECTIONS

- Georgia Tech head coach Nell Fortner, now in her fourth season on the Flats, spent eight seasons as head coach at Auburn, leading the Tigers to the 2009 SEC Championship, two NCAA Tournament appearances and a 145-106 record.
- >> Former Tiger Blanche Alverson (2009-13) is on the Jackets' bench as an assistant coach. Alverson is second in Auburn history in 3-point shooting (213 made) and was a two-time SEC Scholar-Athlete of the Year.
- >> Georgia Tech player development coach Shannon Jackson is a 2012 Auburn graduate.
- » Auburn director of operations Alex Stewart played at Georgia Tech from 1999-2004 and was an All-ACC third-team selection as a junior.

SCOUTING AUBURN

- Auburn is 2-0 after a pair of home wins over Sam Houston and South Alabama to open the 2022-23 season.
- » Auburn returns 3 starters and 8 letterwinners from the 2021-22 team that finished 10-18 overall and 2-14 in SEC play, doubling their win total from the previous season. The Tigers earned three wins over top-25 opponents last season, defeating No. 4 Tennessee, No. 18 Georgia Tech and No. 21 Georgia.
- " Junior Aicha Coulibaly was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection after earning a nod to the postseason All-SEC Second Team last season. She is Auburn's leading returner in scoring (17.1 ppg), rebounding (7.5 rpg) and steals (2.2 spg). She ranked ninth in the SEC in scoring last season. She scored 24 points and had 10 rebounds in the season-opener vs. Sam Houston for her sixth career double-double.
- Redshirt senior Honesty Scott-Grayson returns for her third season on the court for Auburn. She was second on the team with 13.0 points and 5.7 rebounds per game last year, starting 27 of 28 games. She had 12 points, 5 assists and 5 rebounds in the opener.

- » Redshirt sophomore Romi Levy returns to action after missing the 2021-22 season with a torn ACL. As a freshman in 2020-21, she averaged 5.4 points and 3.9 rebounds and was named to the SEC All-Freshman Team.
- Auburn's newcomers will look to make an immediate impact. Freshmen Sydney Shaw, Kaitlyn Duhon and Kharyssa Richardson were all in the starting lineup opening night. All were highlyrated recruits that helped make up the Tigers' top-25 class last fall. Freshman Mya Pratcher and junior Jakayla Johnson also look to play significant minutes.
- Freshman Audia Young will miss the 2022-23 season after suffering a torn achilles in preseason practice.

SEEING DOUBLE

y Junior Aicha Coulibaly recorded the Tigers' first double-double of the season with 24 points and 10 rebounds in the season-opener vs. Sam Houston. It was the sixth of Coulibaly's career.

DEFENSE CREATING OFFENSE

- Auburn forced Sam Houston into 33 turnovers in the season opener Nov. 8, turning those into 31 points. The 33 turnovers were the most by an Aubun opponent since the 2017-18 season when ULM had 35.

Second Season at Auburn • 24th Season in college coaching

Johnnie Harris enters her second year as head coach for Auburn women's basketball in 2022-23. A long-time Southeastern Conference assistant and 2018 WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year, Harris was named Auburn women's basketball head coach on April 3, 2021.

Her first season on the Plains saw Auburn double its win total from the previous season and pick up three victories over nationally ranked opponents. Her first top-25 win came Nov. 21 with a 59-51 win at Georgia Tech, Auburn's first road win over a ranked foe since 2014. The biggest win of the season, and one of Auburn's biggest in decades, came Jan. 27 when the Tigers shocked No. 4 Tennessee 71-61 at home for their first SEC win of the season and their first win over a top-5 opponent since 1997. The Tigers added one more top-25 win, a 65-60 victory over No. 21 Georgia on Feb. 20. Sophomore Aicha Coulibaly was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and the Tigers landed a consensus top-25 recruiting class for 2022-23.

Prior to her arrival at Auburn, Harris spent 16 years combined at Arkansas, Texas A&M and Mississippi State, and spent the 2020-21 season as the Associate Head Coach at the University of Texas. She helped Texas to an Elite Eight appearance during the 2020-21 season, and she worked alongside Longhorn head coach Vic Schaefer the previous 10 years assisting Mississippi State to a pair of NCAA Championship game appearances. She was a central part of Mississippi State's success those eight seasons and is considered one of the nation's top recruiters.

Harris helped lead Mississippi State to a 221-62 [.781] record and five NCAA Tournament berths, including NCAA Championship Game appearances in 2017 and 2018. During that time, the Bulldogs also won the program's first Southeastern Conference regular-season championship and SEC Tournament Championship.

Harris' pupils in the post were some of the best in Mississippi State school history, led by Teaira McCowan, who Harris mentored during McCowan's record-setting junior and senior campaigns from 2017-19. The 2019 SEC Player of the Year and a consensus First-Team All-American, McCowan finished her career as Mississippi State's leader in rebounds and field-goal percentage, while ranking second in blocks and fourth in points and field-goals made.

The individual development McCowan showed during Mississippi State's run to a second consecutive national title game caught the attention of the coaching community, as Harris was tabbed the WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year for the 2017-18 season.

In 2018-19, Harris helped transfer forward Anriel Howard combine with McCowan to create one of the best front courts in the country. In her lone season with the Bulldogs, Howard earned first-team All-SEC recognition by the AP and league coaches after averaging 16.4 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. Both McCowan [No. 3, Indiana Fever] and Howard [No. 24, Seattle Storm] were selected in the 2019 WNBA Draft.

Another Harris product, Chinwe Okorie, was an integral part of the Bulldogs' runs to the Final Four and 2016 Sweet 16 and finished her MSU career sixth in program annals in field-goal percentage, shooting 52.1 percent over 109 games. She raised her scoring average and field goal percentage each season of her three-year career, capped by her 7.5 ppg average on 56.4 percent shooting as a senior.

Harris helped guide Texas A&M to four Sweet 16 appearances in her five seasons, including the program's first national championship in 2010-11. During her tenure with the Aggies, Harris helped sign and mentor junior college All-Americans Danielle Adams and Tanisha Smith.

Prior to her stop in College Station, Harris spent three seasons at Arkansas, landing some of the Lady Razorbacks' top recruiting classes in program history. She signed Laura Ervin, a junior college All-American who went on to garner Second Team All-SEC accolades, as well as Freshman All-SEC selection Donica Cosby.

Harris has had the opportunity to learn from some of the game's top coaches, including Hall of Famer Kay Yow at N.C. State. She joined the program in the 2003-04 season and assisted the squad to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in two years. Her first recruiting class in Raleigh was rated as one of the best in the nation. She also garnered a commitment from Gillian Goring, the nation's No. 1 post player who went on to play for the Washington Mystics.

Prior to jumping to the Division I level, Harris made her mark on the junior college level as an assistant coach at Arkansas-Fort Smith, where she brought in key players who led the school to the NJCAA Final Four in 2004. In two seasons coaching under the legendary Louis Whorton, she inked the nation's No. 1 class and a 34-8 record. UAFS's 2002-03 team went 26-2 and won a share of the Bi-State Conference championship.

The Arkansas-Fort Smith position kept the Pine Bluff native in her home state after she started her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Little Rock. Her hard work at UALR earned her a promotion to a full-time assistant position in 2000.

Harris is the mother of two children, Marcus and Kiera, and the legal guardian of Lily. She also has two grandchildren, Samarah and Kaiden.
