# Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- · This is the 21st meeting between Auburn and Alabama State
- · Auburn has won all 20 prior meetings with the Hornets, including a 12-0 mark in Auburn (3-0 at Neville Arena)
- Aicha Coulibaly recorded her first double-double of the season and sixth of her career with 24 points and 10 rebounds against Sam Houston
- · Freshman Kaitlyn Duhon had a huge game vs. South Alabama with 17 points, 7 rebounds, 3 steals and 2 blocks
- Honesty Scott-Grayson matched a career-high with 5 steals vs. Sam Houston
- Mar'Shaun Bostic equaled a career-high with 9 points and 4 assists vs. Sam Houston
- Auburn forced 33 turnovers vs. Sam Houston, the most since forcing ULM into 35 during the 2017-18 season and tied for the 12th-most in a game in program history
- Auburn's 90 points against Sam Houston were the second-most under coach Johnnie Harris (91 vs. Charleston Southern)
- Kaitlyn Duhon, Kharyssa Richardson and Sydney Shaw were in the starting lineup for the season-opener vs. Sam Houston; it is believed to be the first time Auburn has started three true freshmen in a season-opener
- Five players made their Auburn debut vs. Sam Houston (Duhon, Shaw, J. Johnson, Richardson, Pratcher)
- · Auburn is 42-10 all-time in season openers and 29-4 when playing its first game of the season at home
- Auburn has won 43 of its last 44 home openers
- Auburn is in its 52nd season of women's basketball and has 964 program wins
- Auburn defeated Tuskegee 81-59 in an exhibition game Nov. 3
- · Coulibaly was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection by the league's coaches
- Coulibaly is Auburn's leading returner with 17.1 points and 7.5 rebounds per game last season; she was named to the All-SEC Second Team following the 2022 season
- Sania Wells was the SEC's leading free-throw shooter in 2021-22 at 90.5% (76-84)
- Auburn returns three starters and eight letterwinners from the 2021-22 season; the Tigers welcome 7 newcomers
- Auburn earned three wins over top-25 opponents in 2021-22 (#4 Tennessee, #18 Georgia Tech, #21 Georgia)
- Johnnie Harris enters her second season as head coach at Auburn
- In SEC preseason polls, Auburn was picked to finish 13th by both the media and the league's coaches

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- » Auburn turned a 15-point first-half deficit into a fourth-quarter lead, but the Tigers could not finish off the comeback in a 57-51 loss to Georgia Tech at Neville Arena Thursday night.
- "> The Tigers (2-1) struggled to score early, allowing the Yellow Jackets (3-0) to build an early cushion. Auburn chipped away late in the second and through the third, briefly moving ahead midway through the fourth quarter, but Tech used a 10-2 run from there to hold off the comeback.
- Aicha Coulibaly and Honesty Scott-Grayson led Auburn with 11 points each. Freshman Mya Pratcher came off the bench to grab a team-leading 10 rebounds while finishing with six points. Freshman Kaitlyn Duhon contributed six points as well. Coulibaly led Auburn with four assists and four steals.
- >> It was a rough shooting night for the Tigers, who missed 17 of their first 18 shots to post a season-low 26.3% (20-76), including just 2-of-19 from 3-point range. But the Tigers crashed the boards, winning the rebounding battle for the first time this season, 51-39. Auburn turned 29 offensive rebounds into 22 second-chance points, and they forced Tech into 22 turnovers that turned into 14 points for the Tigers.

- » Honesty Scott-Grayson recorded her second straight double-double, Kiyae' White matched a career-high in scoring, and Auburn gave coach Johnnie Harris her first victory as a head coach with a 74-45 win over Alabama State.
- The Tigers held a double-digit lead for most of the game and pulled away late, finishing the game on a 13-0 run and outscoring Alabama State 24-7 in the final period.
- Scott-Grayson led all scorers with 21 points and pulled down a game-high 10 rebounds for her second double-double in as many games, also

the second of her career. White scored 15 points to match a career-high and contributed seven rebounds along with three steals.

Aicha Coulibaly narrowly missed her secondstraight double-double with a 9-point, 9-rebound night that also included a team-leading five steals. Annie Hughes added nine points and six rebounds, and Sania Wells scored eight points with a careerhigh seven assists. Coulibaly, White and Jala Jordan each had two blocks.

# **SCOUTING ALABAMA STATE**

- » Alabama State is 0-3 after three road losses to open the season; two of their three setbacks came against SEC opponents in Georgia and Mississippi State.
- >> The Hornets were picked to finish second in the SWAC behind Jackson State. ASU went 15-15 last year, 12-6 in SWAC play and finished third in the conference.
- Ayana Emmanuel, Shmya Ward and Jayla Crawford were selected to the preseason All-SWAC team. Emmanuel leads ASU with 11.3 ppg; Crawford averages 10.7 ppg.

# **SCOUTING AUBURN**

- Auburn is 2-1 after a pair of home wins over Sam Houston and South Alabama and a hardfought loss to Georgia Tech.
- Auburn returns 3 starters and 8 letterwinners from the 2021-22 team that finished 10-18 overall and 2-14 in SEC play, doubling their win total from the previous season. The Tigers earned three wins over top-25 opponents last season, defeating No. 4 Tennessee, No. 18 Georgia Tech and No. 21 Georgia.
- Junior Aicha Coulibaly was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection after earning a nod to the postseason All-SEC Second Team last season. She is Auburn's leading returner in scoring (17.1 ppg), rebounding (7.5 rpg) and steals (2.2 spg). She ranked ninth in the SEC in scoring last season. She scored 24 points and had 10 rebounds in the season-opener vs. Sam Houston for her sixth career double-double and leads the Tigers with 18.0 points/game.
- » Redshirt senior Honesty Scott-Grayson returns for her third season on the court for Auburn. She was second on the team with 13.0 points and 5.7 rebounds per game last year, starting 27 of 28 games. She had 12 points, 5 assists and 5 rebounds in the opener.
- >> Senior Sania Wells was the SEC's leading free-throw shooter in 2021-22, hitting 90.5% of her attempts (76-84). That percentage ranked sixth in the nation. Wells was Auburn's third-leading scorer with 9.1 points per game and led the Tigers with 2.6 assists/game. Wells is 5-5 at the line so far this season.
- » Redshirt sophomore Romi Levy returns to action after missing the 2021-22 season with a torn ACL. As a freshman in 2020-21, she averaged 5.4 points and 3.9 rebounds and was named to the SEC All-Freshman Team. She made her first appearance of the regular season Nov. 16 vs. Georgia Tech after missing the first two games with illness.
- » Auburn's newcomers will look to make an immediate impact. Freshmen Sydney Shaw, Kaitlyn Duhon and Kharyssa Richardson were all in the starting lineup opening night. All were highlyrated recruits that helped make up the Tigers' top-25 class last fall. Freshman Mya Pratcher and junior Jakayla Johnson also look to play significant

# Johnnie **HARRIS**

Head Coach

Second Season at Auburn • 24th Season in college coaching

Pine Bluff, Ark. • Arkansas Baptist, 1996

Johnnie Harris enters her second year as head coach for Auburn women's basketball in 2022-23. A longtime Southeastern Conference assistant and 2018 WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year, Harris was named Auburn women's basketball head coach on April 3, 2021.

Her first season on the Plains saw Auburn double its win total from the previous season and pick up three victories over nationally ranked opponents. Her first top-25 win came Nov. 21 with a 59-51 win at Georgia Tech, Auburn's first road win over a ranked foe since 2014. The biggest win of the season, and one of Auburn's biggest in decades, came Jan. 27 when the Tigers shocked No. 4 Tennessee 71-61 at home for their first SEC win of the season and their first win over a top-5 opponent since 1997. The Tigers added one more top-25 win, a 65-60 victory over No. 21 Georgia on Feb. 20. Sophomore Aicha Coulibaly was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and the Tigers landed a consensus top-25 recruiting class for 2022-23.

Prior to her arrival at Auburn, Harris spent 16 years combined at Arkansas, Texas A&M and Mississippi State, and spent the 2020-21 season as the Associate Head Coach at the University of Texas. She helped Texas to an Elite Eight appearance during the 2020-21 season, and she worked alongside Longhorn head coach Vic Schaefer the previous 10 years assisting Mississippi State to a pair of NCAA Championship game appearances. She was a central part of Mississippi State's success those eight seasons and is considered one of the nation's top recruiters.

Harris helped lead Mississippi State to a 221-62 [.781] record and five NCAA Tournament berths, including NCAA Championship Game appearances in 2017 and 2018. During that time, the Bulldogs also won the program's first Southeastern Conference regular-season championship and SEC Tournament Championship.

Harris' pupils in the post were some of the best in Mississippi State school history, led by Teaira McCowan, who Harris mentored during McCowan's record-setting junior and senior campaigns from 2017-19. The 2019 SEC Player of the Year and a consensus First-Team All-American, McCowan finished her career as Mississippi State's leader in rebounds and field-goal percentage, while ranking second in blocks and fourth in points and field-goals made.

The individual development McCowan showed during Mississippi State's run to a second consecutive national title game caught the attention of the coaching community, as Harris was tabbed the WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year for the 2017-18 season.

In 2018-19, Harris helped transfer forward Anriel Howard combine with McCowan to create one of the best front courts in the country. In her lone season with the Bulldogs, Howard earned first-team All-SEC recognition by the AP and league coaches after averaging 16.4 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. Both McCowan [No. 3, Indiana Fever] and Howard [No. 24, Seattle Storm] were selected in the 2019 WNBA Draft.

Another Harris product, Chinwe Okorie, was an integral part of the Bulldogs' runs to the Final Four and 2016 Sweet 16 and finished her MSU career sixth in program annals in field-goal percentage, shooting 52.1 percent over 109 games. She raised her scoring average and field goal percentage each season of her threeyear career, capped by her 7.5 ppg average on 56.4 percent shooting as a senior.

Harris helped guide Texas A&M to four Sweet 16 appearances in her five seasons, including the program's first national championship in 2010-11. During her tenure with the Aggies, Harris helped sign and mentor junior college All-Americans Danielle Adams and Tanisha Smith.

Prior to her stop in College Station, Harris spent three seasons at Arkansas, landing some of the Lady Razorbacks' top recruiting classes in program history. She signed Laura Ervin, a junior college All-American who went on to garner Second Team All-SEC accolades, as well as Freshman All-SEC selection Donica Cosby.

Harris has had the opportunity to learn from some of the game's top coaches, including Hall of Famer Kay Yow at N.C. State. She joined the program in the 2003-04 season and assisted the squad to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in two years. Her first recruiting class in Raleigh was rated as one of the best in the nation. She also garnered a commitment from Gillian Goring, the nation's No. 1 post player who went on to play for the Washington Mystics.

Prior to jumping to the Division I level, Harris made her mark on the junior college level as an assistant coach at Arkansas-Fort Smith, where she brought in key players who led the school to the NICAA Final Four in 2004. In two seasons coaching under the legendary Louis Whorton, she inked the nation's No. 1 class and a 34-8 record. UAFS's 2002-03 team went 26-2 and won a share of the Bi-State Conference championship.

The Arkansas-Fort Smith position kept the Pine Bluff native in her home state after she started her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Little Rock. Her hard work at UALR earned her a promotion to a full-time assistant position in 2000.

Harris is the mother of two children, Marcus and Kiera, and the legal guardian of Lily. She also has two grandchildren, Samarah and Kaiden.


