# **Auburn Women's Basketball Ouick Hitters**

- Auburn is playing its first games away from home this season
- Auburn is 2-0 all-time against Indiana, winning both ends of a home-and-home series in 2016 and 2017
- · This will be the first meeting between Auburn and Colorado State
- The Tigers are 5-5 in their last 10 games played the same day as the Iron Bowl
- Auburn's last five games played the same day as the Iron Bowl have all been decided by two points or less; the Tigers have won three of the last four
- Romi Levy, in her second game back from injury, scored a career-high 16 points and had 11 rebounds against Alabama State for her first career double-double
- Aicha Coulibaly recorded her first double-double of the season and sixth of her career with 24 points and 10 rebounds against Sam Houston
- Freshman Kaitlyn Duhon had a huge game vs. South Alabama with 17 points, 7 rebounds, 3 steals and 2 blocks
- Honesty Scott-Grayson matched a career-high with 5 steals vs. Sam Houston
- Mar'Shaun Bostic equaled a career-high with 9 points and 4 assists vs. Sam Houston
- Auburn forced 33 turnovers vs. Sam Houston, the most since forcing ULM into 35 during the 2017-18 season and tied for the 12th-most in a game in program history
- Auburn's 90 points against Sam Houston were the second-most under coach Johnnie Harris (91 vs. Charleston Southern)
- Kaitlyn Duhon, Kharyssa Richardson and Sydney Shaw were in the starting lineup for the season-opener vs. Sam Houston; it is believed to be the first time Auburn has started three true freshmen in a season-opener
- · Five players made their Auburn debut vs. Sam Houston (Duhon, Shaw, J. Johnson, Richardson, Pratcher)
- Auburn is in its 52nd season of women's basketball and has 965 program wins
- Auburn defeated Tuskegee 81-59 in an exhibition game Nov. 3
- Coulibaly was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection by the league's coaches
- Coulibaly is Auburn's leading returner with 17.1 points and 7.5 rebounds per game last season; she was named to the All-SEC Second Team following the 2022 season
- Sania Wells was the SEC's leading free-throw shooter in 2021-22 at 90.5% (76-84)
- · Auburn returns three starters and eight letterwinners from the 2021-22 season; the Tigers welcome 7 newcomers
- Auburn earned three wins over top-25 opponents in 2021-22 (#4 Tennessee, #18 Georgia Tech, #21 Georgia)
- Johnnie Harris enters her second season as head coach at Auburn
- In SEC preseason polls, Auburn was picked to finish 13th by both the media and the league's coaches

# **OPENING TIP**

- Auburn women's basketball hits the road for the first time in 2022-23 with a trip to the desert for two games in the Las Vegas Invitational. The Tigers will face No. 5/6 Indiana and Colorado State Friday and Saturday at The Mirage on the Las Vegas Strip.
- Auburn is 3-1 after a convincing 88-49 home win over Alabama State Sunday.
- Indiana is 5-0 and ranked No. 5 in the AP and No. 6 in the coaches' poll. The Hoosiers crushed Quinnipiac 92-55 Sunday in their last outing.
- Coloirado State is 3-1 on the year. The Rams dropped a tough 71-66 contest at Mississippi State on Sunday.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- » Redshirt sophomore Romi Levy had her first career double-double, and all 13 Auburn players scored as the Tigers ran away from Alabama State 88-49 Sunday afternoon at Neville Arena.
- The Tigers (3-1) shot a season-best 50.7percent and got plenty of production from the bench, who scored nearly half of Auburn's points on the night.
- Levy, coming off the bench, finished with a career-high 16 points and 11 rebounds for the first double-double of her career and Auburn's second of the season. She also filled the stat sheet with three steals, two assists and two blocks in just over 20 minutes of action.
- Aicha Coulibaly led all scorers with 21 points and matched a career-high with six steals; she also had seven rebounds. Sania Wells hit double-digits for the second time this season with 10 points to go with a pair of blocks. And freshman Sydney Shaw had a strong performance with eight points, a team-high six assists and two steals.

# **UP NEXT**

» Auburn closes out November with a Wednesday matinee at home against Little Rock Nov. 30. Tip is set for noon CT; the early start is to avoid conflict with the Super 7 high school football championships that begin later that day at Jordan-Hare Stadium.

# AN AUBURN WIN OVER INDIANA WOULD...

- » Improve the Tigers to 3-0 all-time against the Hoosiers.

# LAST MEETING: Dec. 3, 2017, at Bloomington Auburn 65, Indiana 53

>> Behind a career-high 25 points from Daisa

Alexander and clutch free-throw shooting in the fourth quarter, Auburn held off a late Indiana rally for a 65-53 win over the Hoosiers at Assembly Hall.

The Tigers saw a 15-point lead whittled down

- to just one point early in the fourth quarter, but Auburn's best free-throw shooting effort of the season saved the day as the Tigers hit 10-of-11 attempts at the line in the final period to seal the victory.
- Alexander shattered her previous career-high with 25 points, scoring 12 of those in the fourth quarter as the Tigers pulled away late. She was 9-of-14 from the floor and hit three 3-pointers, then knocked down all four of her free-throw attempts. Two of those came on drives to the basket where she was fouled, made the layup and calmly sank the free throw.
- Auburn shot 48.0 percent from the floor, including a 52.3-percent mark in the second half. The Tigers forced Indiana (4-4) into 23 turnovers, converting those into 25 points. The Hoosiers were 37.5 percent from the floor but kept the game in reach with strong outside shooting as they hit 5-of-10 3-point attempts in the second half.

- » Indiana is 5-0 on the year and ranked No. 6 in the AP and No. 5 by the coaches. The Hoosiers' signature win so far is a 79-67 road victory at Tennessee; it's the only game where they haven't scored at least 80 points.
- >> Indiana averages 89.2 points/game, which ranks 9th nationally.
- » Mackenzie Holmes with 17.4 points/game leads four Hoosiers that average double figures.

## **SCOUTING COLORADO STATE**

- >> Colorado State is 3-1 on the season and has big wins over BYU and Montana to its credit.
- >> The Rams are the national leader in 3-point percentage, hitting 51.1% from distance (48-94) this year. They also lead the nation in assist/turnover ratio (2.46) and fewest turnovers per game (6.5).
- McKenna Hofschild leads CSU with 17.2 points/game and ranks second in the nation with 9.0 assists/game.

# **SCOUTING AUBURN**

- Auburn is 3-1 with three wins at home over Sam Houston, South Alabama and Alabama State.
   Junior Aicha Coulibaly was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection after earning a nod to the postseason All-SEC Second Team last season. She is Auburn's leading returner in scoring (17.1 ppg), rebounding (7.5 rpg) and steals (2.2 spg). She ranked ninth in the SEC in scoring last season. She scored 24 points and had 10 rebounds in the season-opener vs. Sam Houston for her sixth career double-double and leads the Tigers with 18.8 points/game.
- » Redshirt senior Honesty Scott-Grayson returns for her third season on the court for Auburn. Through four games, she leads the Tigers with 3.8 assists/game and averages 8.8 points. She was second on the team with 13.0 points and 5.7 rebounds per game last year, starting 27 of 28 games.

- Senior Sania Wells was the SEC's leading free-throw shooter in 2021-22, hitting 90.5% of her attempts (76-84). That percentage ranked sixth in the nation. Wells has topped the 10-point mark twice in four games and is 7-8 at the FT line so far this season.
- » Redshirt sophomore Romi Levy returns to action after missing the 2021-22 season with a torn ACL. In just her second game back, she scored a career-high 16 points along with 11 rebounds vs. Alabama State for her first career double-double.
- Auburn's newcomers have all made an immediate impact with three freshmen - Kaitlyn Duhon, Sydney Shaw and Kharyssa Richardson starting each of the first four games. Duhon scored 17 points in the win over South Alabama, and Shaw is second on the team with 3.0 assists per game.
- Auburn returns 3 starters and 8 letterwinners from the 2021-22 team that finished 10-18 overall and 2-14 in SEC play, doubling their win total from the previous season. The Tigers earned three wins over top-25 opponents last season, defeating No. 4 Tennessee, No. 18 Georgia Tech and No. 21 Georgia.

#### **SEEING DOUBLE**

- yy Junior Aicha Coulibaly recorded the Tigers' first double-double of the season with 24 points and 10 rebounds in the season-opener vs. Sam Houston. It was the sixth of Coulibaly's career.
- Redshirt sophomore Romi Levy made the most of her second appearance of the season, scoring a career-high 16 points along with 11 rebounds in Auburn's win over Alabama State on Nov. 20 for the first double-double of her career.

# **DEFENSE CREATING OFFENSE**

Auburn forced Sam Houston into 33 turnovers in the season opener Nov. 8, turning those into 31 points. The 33 turnovers were the most by an Aubun opponent since the 2017-18 season when ULM had 35.

- » Unique Thompson, a 2021 graduate, averaged 29.7 points and 15.1 rebounds for the Albury-Wodonga Bandits of Australia's NBL1 over the (northern hemisphere) summer. # Johnnie HARRIS

Head Coach

Second Season at Auburn • 24th Season in college coaching

Johnnie Harris enters her second year as head coach for Auburn women's basketball in 2022-23. A long-time Southeastern Conference assistant and 2018 WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year, Harris was named Auburn women's basketball head coach on April 3, 2021.

Her first season on the Plains saw Auburn double its win total from the previous season and pick up three victories over nationally ranked opponents. Her first top-25 win came Nov. 21 with a 59-51 win at Georgia Tech, Auburn's first road win over a ranked foe since 2014. The biggest win of the season, and one of Auburn's biggest in decades, came Jan. 27 when the Tigers shocked No. 4 Tennessee 71-61 at home for their first SEC win of the season and their first win over a top-5 opponent since 1997. The Tigers added one more top-25 win, a 65-60 victory over No. 21 Georgia on Feb. 20. Sophomore Aicha Coulibaly was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and the Tigers landed a consensus top-25 recruiting class for 2022-23.

Prior to her arrival at Auburn, Harris spent 16 years combined at Arkansas, Texas A&M and Mississippi State, and spent the 2020-21 season as the Associate Head Coach at the University of Texas. She helped Texas to an Elite Eight appearance during the 2020-21 season, and she worked alongside Longhorn head coach Vic Schaefer the previous 10 years assisting Mississippi State to a pair of NCAA Championship game appearances. She was a central part of Mississippi State's success those eight seasons and is considered one of the nation's top recruiters.

Harris helped lead Mississippi State to a 221-62 [.781] record and five NCAA Tournament berths, including NCAA Championship Game appearances in 2017 and 2018. During that time, the Bulldogs also won the program's first Southeastern Conference regular-season championship and SEC Tournament Championship.

Harris' pupils in the post were some of the best in Mississippi State school history, led by Teaira McCowan, who Harris mentored during McCowan's record-setting junior and senior campaigns from 2017-19. The 2019 SEC Player of the Year and a consensus First-Team All-American, McCowan finished her career as Mississippi State's leader in rebounds and field-goal percentage, while ranking second in blocks and fourth in points and field-goals made.

The individual development McCowan showed during Mississippi State's run to a second consecutive national title game caught the attention of the coaching community, as Harris was tabbed the WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year for the 2017-18 season.

In 2018-19, Harris helped transfer forward Anriel Howard combine with McCowan to create one of the best front courts in the country. In her lone season with the Bulldogs, Howard earned first-team All-SEC recognition by the AP and league coaches after averaging 16.4 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. Both McCowan [No. 3, Indiana Fever] and Howard [No. 24, Seattle Storm] were selected in the 2019 WNBA Draft.

Another Harris product, Chinwe Okorie, was an integral part of the Bulldogs' runs to the Final Four and 2016 Sweet 16 and finished her MSU career sixth in program annals in field-goal percentage, shooting 52.1 percent over 109 games. She raised her scoring average and field goal percentage each season of her three-year career, capped by her 7.5 ppg average on 56.4 percent shooting as a senior.

Harris helped guide Texas A&M to four Sweet 16 appearances in her five seasons, including the program's first national championship in 2010-11. During her tenure with the Aggies, Harris helped sign and mentor junior college All-Americans Danielle Adams and Tanisha Smith.

Prior to her stop in College Station, Harris spent three seasons at Arkansas, landing some of the Lady Razorbacks' top recruiting classes in program history. She signed Laura Ervin, a junior college All-American who went on to garner Second Team All-SEC accolades, as well as Freshman All-SEC selection Donica Cosby.

Harris has had the opportunity to learn from some of the game's top coaches, including Hall of Famer Kay Yow at N.C. State. She joined the program in the 2003-04 season and assisted the squad to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in two years. Her first recruiting class in Raleigh was rated as one of the best in the nation. She also garnered a commitment from Gillian Goring, the nation's No. 1 post player who went on to play for the Washington Mystics.

Prior to jumping to the Division I level, Harris made her mark on the junior college level as an assistant coach at Arkansas-Fort Smith, where she brought in key players who led the school to the NJCAA Final Four in 2004. In two seasons coaching under the legendary Louis Whorton, she inked the nation's No. 1 class and a 34-8 record. UAFS's 2002-03 team went 26-2 and won a share of the Bi-State Conference championship.

The Arkansas-Fort Smith position kept the Pine Bluff native in her home state after she started her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Little Rock. Her hard work at UALR earned her a promotion to a full-time assistant position in 2000.

Harris is the mother of two children, Marcus and Kiera, and the legal guardian of Lily. She also has two grandchildren, Samarah and Kaiden.
