# Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- Auburn begins a six-game home stand which will close out non-conference play for 2022-23
- · This is the third all-time meeting between Auburn and Little Rock in women's basketball
- The teams have split the two previous meetings; Little Rock won 57-49 last season at home
- Last week, Auburn went 1-1 in the Las Vegas Invitational with a 96-81 loss to No. 6/5 Indiana and a 74-73 win over Colorado State
- · Aicha Coulibaly and Honesty Scott-Grayson shared the team lead in scoring in both games in Las Vegas with each scoring 22 points against Indiana and 16 against Colorado State
- With a 74-73 win over Colorado State in Las Vegas, the Tigers are 6-5 in their last 11 games played the same day as the
- · Auburn's last six games played the same day as the Iron Bowl have all been decided by two points or less; the Tigers have won four of the last five
- The Tigers rank 16th nationally with 5.7 blocks per game and 12th in the country with 16.8 offensive rebounds per
- · Aicha Coulibaly is second in the SEC in scoring (18.8 ppg) and steals (3.2 spg)
- · Romi Levy, in her second game back from injury/illness, scored a career-high 16 points and had 11 rebounds against Alabama State for her first career double-double
- · Aicha Coulibaly recorded her first double-double of the season and sixth of her career with 24 points and 10 rebounds against Sam Houston
- Freshman Kaitlyn Duhon had a huge game vs. South Alabama with 17 points, 7 rebounds, 3 steals and 2 blocks
- Honesty Scott-Grayson matched a career-high with 5 steals vs. Sam Houston
- Mar'Shaun Bostic equaled a career-high with 9 points and 4 assists vs. Sam Houston
- Auburn forced 33 turnovers vs. Sam Houston, the most since forcing ULM into 35 during the 2017-18 season and tied for the 12th-most in a game in program history
- · Auburn's 90 points against Sam Houston were the second-most under coach Johnnie Harris (91 vs. Charleston Southern)
- Kaitlyn Duhon, Kharyssa Richardson and Sydney Shaw were in the starting lineup for the season-opener vs. Sam Houston; it is believed to be the first time Auburn has started three true freshmen in a season-opener
- · Auburn is in its 52nd season of women's basketball and has 966 program wins
- · Auburn defeated Tuskegee 81-59 in an exhibition game Nov. 3
- Coulibaly was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection by the league's coaches
- · Coulibaly is Auburn's leading returner with 17.1 points and 7.5 rebounds per game last season; she was named to the All-SEC Second Team following the 2022 season

- Honesty Scott-Grayson needs 143 points for 1,000 in her career (Auburn + Baylor)
- Honesty Scott-Grayson is 14th in the SEC among active career leaders with 783 points (at Auburn)
- Aicha Coulibaly is 19th in the SEC among active career leaders with 709 points
- Aicha Coulibaly is 20th in the SEC among active career leaders with 314 rebounds
- Sania Wells is at 82.4% free-throw shooting for her career (112-136); needs to attempt 14 more free throws to qualify for the Auburn career top 10 list (would currently rank 1st)

- Auburn is 4-2 after splitting a pair of games in Las Vegas last weekend, falling 96-81 to No. 6/5 Indiana and winning 74-73 over Colorado State.
- Little Rock is 1-3 on the year; the Trojans fell at home to Oral Roberts 74-62 in their last game.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Honesty Scott-Grayson got the most important of her 16 points with one second to play as she knocked down the game-winning free throw, leading Auburn to a 74-73 win over Colorado State at The Mirage.
- "In a game that saw eight ties and 18 lead changes, the Tigers (4-2) made clutch shots in the closing minutes to hold off the high-octane Rams (4-2) who entered the weekend leading the nation in 3-point shooting.
- Trailing 66-65 at the time of an injury delay, Auburn came back onto the court with a 6-0 run, getting buckets from Jakayla Johnson, Aicha Coulibaly and Kaitlyn Duhon to take a 71-66 lead. The Rams would tie the game at the free throw line with 21 seconds left. Holding for a final shot, Coulibaly missed a jumper in the lane, but Scott-Grayson got the rebound and was fouled with one second to play as she attempted the putback. She made the first, missed the second, and after CSU called timeout to advance with 0.7 seconds left, Precious Johnson got a finger on the inbound pass and time expired with the Rams unable to get a shot away.
- Scott-Grayson and Coulibaly led the Tigers with 16 points apiece; Coulibaly also had a teambest five assists. Richardson was the team's leading rebounder with nine. Sydney Shaw and Sania Wells scored nine points apiece.

- The Auburn women's basketball team was unable to climb out of an early hole at Little Rock, falling to the Trojans 57-49 at the Jack Stephens Center.
- The Tigers trailed nearly from start to finish, cutting the deficit from double-digits to as little as one point, but could never get over the hump as Little Rock had an answer every time.
- >> Sania Wells led Auburn with 11 points and Aicha Coulibaly added 10, but buckets were hard to

come by for the Tigers as Auburn shot 32.2 percent (19-59) from the field. Honesty Scott-Grayson was Auburn's leading rebounder with seven, but early foul trouble limited her offensive output and she finished with six points.

Auburn out-rebounded Little Rock 39-36 and converted 16 Trojan turnovers into 20 points, but the Trojans shot 45.8 percent from the field and were 3-of-9 from 3-point range.

## **SCOUTING LITTLE ROCK**

- Little Rock is 1-3 on the season and playing on the road for the first time. Two of their three losses have come to SEC opponents Ole Miss and Arkansas.
- >> The Trojans average 52.8 points/game and shoot 34.2% from the field. Tia Harvey leads Little Rock with 12.3 points/game.
- >> Head Coach Joe Foley is the third-winningest active coach in Division I with 834 career wins.

# **SCOUTING AUBURN**

- >> Auburn is 4-2 after going 1-1 in the Las Vegas Invitational last weekend.
- >> The Tigers rank 16th nationally with 5.7 blocks per game and 12th in the country with 16.8 offensive rebounds per contest.
- yy Junior Aicha Coulibaly is second in the SEC in scoring (18.8 ppg) and steals (3.2 spg). Those numbers rank her 40th nationally in scoring and 23rd in steals. She was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection after earning a nod to the postseason All-SEC Second Team last season. She is Auburn's leading returner in scoring (17.1 ppg), rebounding (7.5 rpg) and steals (2.2 spg). She ranked ninth in the SEC in scoring last season. She scored 24 points and had 10 rebounds in the season-opener vs. Sam Houston for her sixth career double-double.
- Redshirt senior Honesty Scott-Grayson returns for her third season on the court for Auburn. Through six games, she averages 12.2 points to rank second on the team. She was second on the team with 13.0 points and 5.7 rebounds per game last year, starting 27 of 28 games.
- >> Senior Sania Wells was the SEC's leading free-throw shooter in 2021-22, hitting 90.5% of her attempts (76-84). That percentage ranked sixth in the nation. Wells has topped the 10-point mark twice this year and is 8-10 at the FT line so far this season.
- Auburn's newcomers have all made an immediate impact with three freshmen Kaitlyn Duhon, Sydney Shaw and Kharyssa Richardson starting each of the first four games. Duhon scored 17 points in the win over South Alabama, and Shaw leads the team with 3.3 assists per game. Richardson had a season-high 9 rebounds vs. Colorado State before leaving the game with injury.
- Redshirt sophomore Romi Levy returns to action after missing the 2021-22 season with a torn ACL. In just her second game back, she scored a career-high 16 points along with 11 rebounds vs. Alabama State for her first career double-double.
- Auburn returns 3 starters and 8 letterwinners from the 2021-22 team that finished 10-18 overall and 2-14 in SEC play, doubling their win total from the previous season. The Tigers earned three wins over top-25 opponents last season, defeating No. 4 Tennessee, No. 18 Georgia Tech and No. 21 Georgia.

# Johnnie HARRIS

Head Coach

Second Season at Auburn • 24th Season in college coaching

Pine Bluff, Ark. • Arkansas Baptist, 1996

Johnnie Harris enters her second year as head coach for Auburn women's basketball in 2022-23. A long-time Southeastern Conference assistant and 2018 WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year, Harris was named Auburn women's basketball head coach on April 3, 2021.

Her first season on the Plains saw Auburn double its win total from the previous season and pick up three victories over nationally ranked opponents. Her first top-25 win came Nov. 21 with a 59-51 win at Georgia Tech, Auburn's first road win over a ranked foe since 2014. The biggest win of the season, and one of Auburn's biggest in decades, came Jan. 27 when the Tigers shocked No. 4 Tennessee 71-61 at home for their first SEC win of the season and their first win over a top-5 opponent since 1997. The Tigers added one more top-25 win, a 65-60 victory over No. 21 Georgia on Feb. 20. Sophomore Aicha Coulibaly was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and the Tigers landed a consensus top-25 recruiting class for 2022-23.

Prior to her arrival at Auburn, Harris spent 16 years combined at Arkansas, Texas A&M and Mississippi State, and spent the 2020-21 season as the Associate Head Coach at the University of Texas. She helped Texas to an Elite Eight appearance during the 2020-21 season, and she worked alongside Longhorn head coach Vic Schaefer the previous 10 years assisting Mississippi State to a pair of NCAA Championship game appearances. She was a central part of Mississippi State's success those eight seasons and is considered one of the nation's top recruiters.

Harris helped lead Mississippi State to a 221-62 [.781] record and five NCAA Tournament berths, including NCAA Championship Game appearances in 2017 and 2018. During that time, the Bulldogs also won the program's first Southeastern Conference regular-season championship and SEC Tournament Championship.

Harris' pupils in the post were some of the best in Mississippi State school history, led by Teaira McCowan, who Harris mentored during McCowan's record-setting junior and senior campaigns from 2017-19. The 2019 SEC Player of the Year and a consensus First-Team All-American, McCowan finished her career as Mississippi State's leader in rebounds and field-goal percentage, while ranking second in blocks and fourth in points and field-goals made.

The individual development McCowan showed during Mississippi State's run to a second consecutive national title game caught the attention of the coaching community, as Harris was tabbed the WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year for the 2017-18 season.

In 2018-19, Harris helped transfer forward Anriel Howard combine with McCowan to create one of the best front courts in the country. In her lone season with the Bulldogs, Howard earned first-team All-SEC recognition by the AP and league coaches after averaging 16.4 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. Both McCowan [No. 3, Indiana Fever] and Howard [No. 24, Seattle Storm] were selected in the 2019 WNBA Draft.

Another Harris product, Chinwe Okorie, was an integral part of the Bulldogs' runs to the Final Four and 2016 Sweet 16 and finished her MSU career sixth in program annals in field-goal percentage, shooting 52.1 percent over 109 games. She raised her scoring average and field goal percentage each season of her three-year career, capped by her 7.5 ppg average on 56.4 percent shooting as a senior.

Harris helped guide Texas A&M to four Sweet 16 appearances in her five seasons, including the program's first national championship in 2010-11. During her tenure with the Aggies, Harris helped sign and mentor junior college All-Americans Danielle Adams and Tanisha Smith.

Prior to her stop in College Station, Harris spent three seasons at Arkansas, landing some of the Lady Razorbacks' top recruiting classes in program history. She signed Laura Ervin, a junior college All-American who went on to garner Second Team All-SEC accolades, as well as Freshman All-SEC selection Donica Cosby.

Harris has had the opportunity to learn from some of the game's top coaches, including Hall of Famer Kay Yow at N.C. State. She joined the program in the 2003-04 season and assisted the squad to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in two years. Her first recruiting class in Raleigh was rated as one of the best in the nation. She also garnered a commitment from Gillian Goring, the nation's No. 1 post player who went on to play for the Washington Mystics.

Prior to jumping to the Division I level, Harris made her mark on the junior college level as an assistant coach at Arkansas-Fort Smith, where she brought in key players who led the school to the NJCAA Final Four in 2004. In two seasons coaching under the legendary Louis Whorton, she inked the nation's No. 1 class and a 34-8 record. UAFS's 2002-03 team went 26-2 and won a share of the Bi-State Conference championship.

The Arkansas-Fort Smith position kept the Pine Bluff native in her home state after she started her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Little Rock. Her hard work at UALR earned her a promotion to a full-time assistant position in 2000.

Harris is the mother of two children, Marcus and Kiera, and the legal guardian of Lily. She also has two grandchildren, Samarah and Kaiden.


