Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- · This is the 44th meeting between Auburn and South Alabama in women's basketball
- South Alabama is Auburn's most-played non-conference opponent; the Tigers have faced Troy and UAB 36 times each
- · Auburn is 104-19 against current members of the Sun Belt Conference
- Auburn's 90 points against Sam Houston was the second-most under coach Johnnie Harris (91 vs. Charleston Southern)
- Aicha Coulibaly recorded her first double-double of the season and sixth of her career with 24 points and 10 rebounds against Sam Houston
- Honesty Scott-Grayson matched a career-high with 5 steals vs. Sam Houston
- Mar'Shaun Bostic equaled a career-high with 9 points and 4 assists vs. Sam Houston
- Auburn forced 33 turnovers vs. Sam Houston, the most since forcing ULM into 35 during the 2017-18 season and tied for the 12th-most in a game in program history
- Kaitlyn Duhon, Kharyssa Richardson and Sydney Shaw were in the starting lineup for the season-opener vs. Sam Houston; it is believed to be the first time Auburn has started three true freshmen in a season-opener
- Five players made their Auburn debut vs. Sam Houston (Duhon, Shaw, J. Johnson, Richardson, Pratcher)
- Auburn is 42-10 all-time in season openers and 29-4 when playing its first game of the season at home
- Auburn has won 43 of its last 44 home openers
- · Auburn is in its 52nd season of women's basketball and has 963 program wins
- Auburn defeated Tuskegee 81-59 in an exhibition game Nov. 3
- · Coulibaly was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection by the league's coaches
- Coulibaly is Auburn's leading returner with 17.1 points and 7.5 rebounds per game last season; she was named to the All-SEC Second Team following the 2022 season
- Sania Wells was the SEC's leading free-throw shooter in 2021-22 at 90.5% (76-84)
- · Auburn returns three starters and eight letterwinners from the 2021-22 season; the Tigers welcome 7 newcomers
- Auburn earned three wins over top-25 opponents in 2021-22 (#4 Tennessee, #18 Georgia Tech, #21 Georgia)
- Johnnie Harris enters her second season as head coach at Auburn
- In SEC preseason polls, Auburn was picked to finish 13th by both the media and the league's coaches

LAST TIME OUT

- Auburn gave head coach Johnnie Harris the best birthday present possible with a 90-76 win over Sam Houston Tuesday night to open the 2022-23 women's basketball season at Neville Arena.
- The Tigers (1-0) had four players in doublefigures and turned 33 Sam Houston turnovers into 31 points as Auburn won its home opener for the 43rd time in the last 44 seasons.
- Junior Aicha Coulibaly lived up to her billing as a preseason All-SEC selection with a 24-point, 10-rebound night for the sixth double-double of her career. She also contributed three assists, two steals and a block.
- » Seniors Honesty Scott-Grayson and Sania Wells along with freshman Sydney Shaw each finished with 12 points. Wells and Scott-Grayson, alongside sophomore Mar'Shaun Bostic, shared the team lead with four assists apiece, and Scott-Grayson matched a career-high with five steals.
- Despite cooling off in the fourth quarter, the Tigers shot 46.5 percent from the field and were a stellar 20-of-25 (80%) at the free-throw line in a game that featured a combined 57 fouls. Sam Houston won the rebounding battle 44-40, but the Tigers outscored the Bearkats in the paint 50-24 and were strong in the transition game as well with 27 points on fast breaks.

- A shorthanded Auburn women's basketball team fought its way back from an early doubledigit deficit to earn a 74-66 win over South Alabama at Auburn Arena.
- Led by 21 points and 15 rebounds from senior Unique Thompson, four players scored in doublefigures as the Tigers trailed by as many as 12 and

led by as many as 12 in a game that was truly a tale of two halves.

>> Thompson's double-double was her fourth of the season and 46th of her career; she's totaled 47 points and 37 rebounds over her last two games. Sophomore Sania Wells added a career-high 11 points, knocking down three 3-pointers and a pair of free throws to go along with a pair of assists. Sophomore Annie Hughes also poured in 11 points with a career-high three 3-pointers, and junior Kira Lowery added 10 points on the night. Freshman Romi Levy also had a strong performance with 8 points, 7 rebounds, 3 assists and 3 steals.

- >> South Alabama is 1-0 after a season-opening 89-45 win over Spring Hill Monday night.
- The Jaguars were 8-18 overall last season, 2-11 in Sun Belt play. They return nine players from last year's roster and were picked to finish 13th in the Sun Belt.
- Senior Nadia Howard is USA's leading returner in scoring (8.3 ppg) and Kiana Anderson is their top returning rebounder (3.9/game).

SCOUTING AUBURN

- Auburn is 1-0 after a season-opening win over Sam Houston Tuesday night.
- Auburn returns 3 starters and 8 letterwinners from the 2021-22 team that finished 10-18 overall and 2-14 in SEC play, doubling their win total from the previous season. The Tigers earned three wins over top-25 opponents last season, defeating No. 4 Tennessee, No. 18 Georgia Tech and No. 21 Georgia.
- yy Junior Aicha Coulibaly was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection after earning a nod to the postseason All-SEC Second Team last season. She is Auburn's leading returner in scoring (17.1 ppg), rebounding (7.5 rpg) and steals (2.2 spg). She ranked ninth in the SEC in scoring last season. She scored 24 points and had 10 rebounds in the season-opener vs. Sam Houston for her sixth career double-double.
- Redshirt senior Honesty Scott-Grayson returns for her third season on the court for Auburn. She was second on the team with 13.0 points and 5.7 rebounds per game last year, starting 27 of 28 games. She had 12 points, 4 assists and 5 rebounds in the opener.
- » Senior Sania Wells was the SEC's leading free-throw shooter in 2021-22, hitting 90.5% of her attempts (76-84). That percentage ranked sixth in the nation. Wells was Auburn's third-leading scorer with 9.1 points per game and led the Tigers with 2.6 assists/game. Wells is 3-3 at the line so far this season.
- » Redshirt sophomore Romi Levy returns to action after missing the 2021-22 season with a torn ACL. As a freshman in 2020-21, she averaged 5.4 points and 3.9 rebounds and was named to the SEC All-Freshman Team.
- >> Auburn's newcomers will look to make an immediate impact. Freshmen Sydney Shaw, Kaitlyn Duhon and Kharyssa Richardson were all in the starting lineup opening night. All were highly-rated recruits that helped make up the Tigers' top-25 class last fall. Freshman Mya Pratcher and junior Jakayla Johnson also look to play significant minutes.
- Freshman Audia Young will miss the 2022-23 season after suffering a torn achilles in preseason practice.

Johnnie Harris enters her second year as head coach for Auburn women's basketball in 2022-23. A long-time Southeastern Conference assistant and 2018 WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year, Harris was named Auburn women's basketball head coach on April 3, 2021.

Her first season on the Plains saw Auburn double its win total from the previous season and pick up three victories over nationally ranked opponents. Her first top-25 win came Nov. 21 with a 59-51 win at Georgia Tech, Auburn's first road win over a ranked foe since 2014. The biggest win of the season, and one of Auburn's biggest in decades, came Jan. 27 when the Tigers shocked No. 4 Tennessee 71-61 at home for their first SEC win of the season and their first win over a top-5 opponent since 1997. The Tigers added one more top-25 win, a 65-60 victory over No. 21 Georgia on Feb. 20. Sophomore Aicha Coulibaly was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and the Tigers landed a consensus top-25 recruiting class for 2022-23.

Prior to her arrival at Auburn, Harris spent 16 years combined at Arkansas, Texas A&M and Mississippi State, and spent the 2020-21 season as the Associate Head Coach at the University of Texas. She helped Texas to an Elite Eight appearance during the 2020-21 season, and she worked alongside Longhorn head coach Vic Schaefer the previous 10 years assisting Mississippi State to a pair of NCAA Championship game appearances. She was a central part of Mississippi State's success those eight seasons and is considered one of the nation's top recruiters.

Harris helped lead Mississippi State to a 221-62 [.781] record and five NCAA Tournament berths, including NCAA Championship Game appearances in 2017 and 2018. During that time, the Bulldogs also won the program's first Southeastern Conference regular-season championship and SEC Tournament Championship.

Harris' pupils in the post were some of the best in Mississippi State school history, led by Teaira McCowan, who Harris mentored during McCowan's record-setting junior and senior campaigns from 2017-19. The 2019 SEC Player of the Year and a consensus First-Team All-American, McCowan finished her career as Mississippi State's leader in rebounds and field-goal percentage, while ranking second in blocks and fourth in points and field-goals made.

The individual development McCowan showed during Mississippi State's run to a second consecutive national title game caught the attention of the coaching community, as Harris was tabbed the WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year for the 2017-18 season.

In 2018-19, Harris helped transfer forward Anriel Howard combine with McCowan to create one of the best front courts in the country. In her lone season with the Bulldogs, Howard earned first-team All-SEC recognition by the AP and league coaches after averaging 16.4 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. Both McCowan [No. 3, Indiana Fever] and Howard [No. 24, Seattle Storm] were selected in the 2019 WNBA Draft.

Another Harris product, Chinwe Okorie, was an integral part of the Bulldogs' runs to the Final Four and 2016 Sweet 16 and finished her MSU career sixth in program annals in field-goal percentage, shooting 52.1 percent over 109 games. She raised her scoring average and field goal percentage each season of her three-year career, capped by her 7.5 ppg average on 56.4 percent shooting as a senior.

Harris helped guide Texas A&M to four Sweet 16 appearances in her five seasons, including the program's first national championship in 2010-11. During her tenure with the Aggies, Harris helped sign and mentor junior college All-Americans Danielle Adams and Tanisha Smith.

Prior to her stop in College Station, Harris spent three seasons at Arkansas, landing some of the Lady Razorbacks' top recruiting classes in program history. She signed Laura Ervin, a junior college All-American who went on to garner Second Team All-SEC accolades, as well as Freshman All-SEC selection Donica Cosby.

Harris has had the opportunity to learn from some of the game's top coaches, including Hall of Famer Kay Yow at N.C. State. She joined the program in the 2003-04 season and assisted the squad to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in two years. Her first recruiting class in Raleigh was rated as one of the best in the nation. She also garnered a commitment from Gillian Goring, the nation's No. 1 post player who went on to play for the Washington Mystics.

Prior to jumping to the Division I level, Harris made her mark on the junior college level as an assistant coach at Arkansas-Fort Smith, where she brought in key players who led the school to the NJCAA Final Four in 2004. In two seasons coaching under the legendary Louis Whorton, she inked the nation's No. 1 class and a 34-8 record. UAFS's 2002-03 team went 26-2 and won a share of the Bi-State Conference championship.

The Arkansas-Fort Smith position kept the Pine Bluff native in her home state after she started her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Little Rock. Her hard work at UALR earned her a promotion to a full-time assistant position in 2000.

Harris is the mother of two children, Marcus and Kiera, and the legal guardian of Lily. She also has two grandchildren, Samarah and Kaiden.






