
# Auburn Women's Basketball Quick Hitters

- Auburn is in the midst of a six-game home stand which will close out non-conference play for 2022-23
- This is the second all-time meeting between Auburn and UCF in women's basketball
- The teams previously met in 1985 when No. 8 Auburn downed UCF 95-74 at Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum
- Romi Levy had 18 points and 13 rebounds both career highs for her second career double-double in Auburn's 70-48 win over Little Rock Nov. 30
- · Honesty Scott-Grayson has led Auburn in scoring three straight games 22 vs. Indiana, 16 vs. Colorado State, 20 vs.
- Last week, Auburn went 1-1 in the Las Vegas Invitational with a 96-81 loss to No. 6/5 Indiana and a 74-73 win over
- With a 74-73 win over Colorado State in Las Vegas, the Tigers are 6-5 in their last 11 games played the same day as the Iron Bowl
- · Auburn's last six games played the same day as the Iron Bowl have all been decided by two points or less; the Tigers have won four of the last five
- · The Tigers rank 8th nationally with 6.0 blocks per game and 22nd in the country with 16.0 offensive rebounds per
- Aicha Coulibaly is fourth in the SEC in scoring (17.0 ppg) and second in steals (2.9 spg)
- · Coulibaly recorded her first double-double of the season and sixth of her career with 24 points and 10 rebounds against Sam Houston
- Freshman Kaitlyn Duhon had a huge game vs. South Alabama with 17 points, 7 rebounds, 3 steals and 2 blocks
- Honesty Scott-Grayson matched a career-high with 5 steals vs. Sam Houston
- Mar'Shaun Bostic equaled a career-high with 9 points and 4 assists vs. Sam Houston
- · Auburn forced 33 turnovers vs. Sam Houston, the most since forcing ULM into 35 during the 2017-18 season and tied for the 12th-most in a game in program history
- Auburn's 90 points against Sam Houston were the second-most under coach Johnnie Harris (91 vs. Charleston South-
- Kaitlyn Duhon, Kharyssa Richardson and Sydney Shaw were in the starting lineup for the season-opener vs. Sam Houston; it is believed to be the first time Auburn has started three true freshmen in a season-opener
- · Auburn is in its 52nd season of women's basketball and has 966 program wins
- · Auburn defeated Tuskegee 81-59 in an exhibition game Nov. 3
- Coulibaly was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection by the league's coaches
- · Coulibaly is Auburn's leading returner with 17.1 points and 7.5 rebounds per game last season; she was named to the All-SEC Second Team following the 2022 season

- Honesty Scott-Grayson is 14th in the SEC among active career leaders with 803 points (at Auburn)

- **Aicha Coulibaly** is 20th in the SEC among active career leaders with 316 rebounds
- **Aicha Coulibaly** is 9th in the SEC among active career leaders with 101 steals
- Sania Wells is at 82.4% free-throw shooting for her career (112-136); needs to attempt 14 more free throws to qualify for the Auburn career top 10 list (would currently rank 1st)

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Pinch-hitting for Auburn head coach Johnnie Harris, who was ill, associate head coach Damitria Buchanan led the Tigers to victory for the second time this season with a 70-48 win vs. Little Rock Wednesday afternoon at Neville Arena.
- Veterans Honesty Scott-Grayson and Romi Levy led the way, combining for 38 points. Scott-Grayson led Auburn with 20 points on 8-of-11 shooting while Levy scored 18 points and grabbed a game-high 13 rebounds, notching her second career double-double.
- Leading 37-24 at the half, Auburn pulled away in the third quarter, outscoring the Trojans 21-10 in the period to build a 24-point lead.
- Making her first career start, Jakayla Johnson scored the first four points of the third quarter. Levy's jumper and free throw gave the Tigers a 20-point lead on their way to leading by as many as 26. Kaitlyn Duhon populated the box score in multiple categories, scoring eight points on 3-of-4 shooting while contributing three rebounds, three steals and three blocked shots.

#### **UP NEXT**

After a week off for final exams, the Tigers return to action Sunday, Dec. 11, as they host Louisiana-Lafayette. Game time is 2 p.m. CT at Neville Arena.

### **AUBURN-UCF SERIES**

- This is the second meeting between Auburn and UCF in women's basketball. The teams previously met Nov. 25, 1985, in Auburn, a 95-74 Tiger win.
- "In that first meeting, Sharon Stewart had a double-double with 22 points and 10 rebounds to lead the Tigers in the 1985-86 season-opener.

#### **SCOUTING UCF**

- >> UCF is 6-0 on the season, one win shy of matching their best start in program history.
- >> The Knights have one mutual opponent with Auburn so far this season; Auburn defeated Sam Houston 90-76 in the season opener Nov. 8, and UCF downed the Bearkats 67-55 Thursday night.
- "UCF averages 70.8 points per game while holding opponents to 52.7. The Knights are 4th nationally in field goal defense, holding opponents to 30.7% shooting. They are also the AAC's top rebounding team and 18th nationally with 45.3/ game.
- Destiny Thomas averages a double-double to lead UCF with 13.8 points and 11.2 rebounds per

game. She is third nationally in offensive rebounds per game with 5.5, and she has four double-doubles in six games to rank 12th nationally.

Head coach Sytia Messer is in her first year at UCF. A longtime Baylor assistant, Messer has faced Auburn as a head coach once before, in 2011 when she was head coach at Tennessee Tech (Auburn won 68-54 in the first round of the WNIT).

#### **SCOUTING AUBURN**

- Auburn is 5-2 after a home win over Little Rock Wednesday. The Tigers also have wins over Sam Houston, South Alabama, Alabama State and Colorado State to their credit so far this season.
- >> The Tigers rank 9th nationally with 6.0 blocks per game and 23rd in the country with 16.0 offensive rebounds per contest. Auburn is also top-50 nationally in turnover margin at +5.6 (48th).
- » Junior Aicha Coulibaly is fourth in the SEC in scoring (17.0 ppg) and second in steals (2.9 spg). Those numbers rank her 89th nationally in scoring and 37th in steals. She was a preseason All-SEC Second Team selection after earning a nod to the postseason All-SEC Second Team last season, when she ranked 9th in the SEC in scoring (17.1 ppg). She scored 24 points and had 10 rebounds in the season-opener vs. Sam Houston for her sixth career double-double.
- >> Through seven games, Redshirt senior Honesty Scott-Grayson returns for her third season on the court for Auburn. Through six games, she averages 12.2 points to rank second on the team. She was second on the team with 13.0 points and 5.7 rebounds per game last year, starting 27 of 28 games.
- Redshirt sophomore Romi Levy has been lights-out in the Tigers' last two home games with double-doubles against both Alabama State and Little Rock. In Wednesday's game vs. Little Rock, she had career-highs in points (18) and rebounds (13) for her second career double-double.
- Senior Sania Wells was the SEC's leading free-throw shooter in 2021-22, hitting 90.5% of her attempts (76-84). That percentage ranked sixth in the nation. Wells has topped the 10-point mark twice this year and is 8-10 at the FT line so far this season.
- Auburn's newcomers have all made an immediate impact with three freshmen Kaitlyn Duhon, Sydney Shaw and Kharyssa Richardson starting each of the first four games. Duhon scored 17 points in the win over South Alabama, and Shaw leads the team with 3.3 assists per game. Richardson had a season-high 9 rebounds vs. Colorado State before leaving the game with injury.

# **SEEING DOUBLE**

- yy Junior Aicha Coulibaly recorded the Tigers' first double-double of the season with 24 points and 10 rebounds in the season-opener vs. Sam Houston. It was the sixth of Coulibaly's career.
- » Redshirt sophomore Romi Levy made the most of her second appearance of the season, scoring a career-high 16 points along with 11 rebounds in Auburn's win over Alabama State on Nov. 20 for the first double-double of her career.
- Levy picked up her second double-double of the season and of her career with 18 points and 13 rebounds - both career-highs - in Auburn's win over Little Rock Nov. 30.

# Johnnie HARRIS

Head Coach

Second Season at Auburn • 24th Season in college coaching

Pine Bluff, Ark. • Arkansas Baptist, 1996

Johnnie Harris enters her second year as head coach for Auburn women's basketball in 2022-23. A long-time Southeastern Conference assistant and 2018 WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year, Harris was named Auburn women's basketball head coach on April 3, 2021.

Her first season on the Plains saw Auburn double its win total from the previous season and pick up three victories over nationally ranked opponents. Her first top-25 win came Nov. 21 with a 59-51 win at Georgia Tech, Auburn's first road win over a ranked foe since 2014. The biggest win of the season, and one of Auburn's biggest in decades, came Jan. 27 when the Tigers shocked No. 4 Tennessee 71-61 at home for their first SEC win of the season and their first win over a top-5 opponent since 1997. The Tigers added one more top-25 win, a 65-60 victory over No. 21 Georgia on Feb. 20. Sophomore Aicha Coulibaly was named to the All-SEC Second Team, and the Tigers landed a consensus top-25 recruiting class for 2022-23.

Prior to her arrival at Auburn, Harris spent 16 years combined at Arkansas, Texas A&M and Mississippi State, and spent the 2020-21 season as the Associate Head Coach at the University of Texas. She helped Texas to an Elite Eight appearance during the 2020-21 season, and she worked alongside Longhorn head coach Vic Schaefer the previous 10 years assisting Mississippi State to a pair of NCAA Championship game appearances. She was a central part of Mississippi State's success those eight seasons and is considered one of the nation's top recruiters.

Harris helped lead Mississippi State to a 221-62 [.781] record and five NCAA Tournament berths, including NCAA Championship Game appearances in 2017 and 2018. During that time, the Bulldogs also won the program's first Southeastern Conference regular-season championship and SEC Tournament Championship.

Harris' pupils in the post were some of the best in Mississippi State school history, led by Teaira McCowan, who Harris mentored during McCowan's record-setting junior and senior campaigns from 2017-19. The 2019 SEC Player of the Year and a consensus First-Team All-American, McCowan finished her career as Mississippi State's leader in rebounds and field-goal percentage, while ranking second in blocks and fourth in points and field-goals made.

The individual development McCowan showed during Mississippi State's run to a second consecutive national title game caught the attention of the coaching community, as Harris was tabbed the WBCA National Assistant Coach of the Year for the 2017-18 season.

In 2018-19, Harris helped transfer forward Anriel Howard combine with McCowan to create one of the best front courts in the country. In her lone season with the Bulldogs, Howard earned first-team All-SEC recognition by the AP and league coaches after averaging 16.4 points and 8.4 rebounds per game. Both McCowan [No. 3, Indiana Fever] and Howard [No. 24, Seattle Storm] were selected in the 2019 WNBA Draft.

Another Harris product, Chinwe Okorie, was an integral part of the Bulldogs' runs to the Final Four and 2016 Sweet 16 and finished her MSU career sixth in program annals in field-goal percentage, shooting 52.1 percent over 109 games. She raised her scoring average and field goal percentage each season of her three-year career, capped by her 7.5 ppg average on 56.4 percent shooting as a senior.

Harris helped guide Texas A&M to four Sweet 16 appearances in her five seasons, including the program's first national championship in 2010-11. During her tenure with the Aggies, Harris helped sign and mentor junior college All-Americans Danielle Adams and Tanisha Smith.

Prior to her stop in College Station, Harris spent three seasons at Arkansas, landing some of the Lady Razorbacks' top recruiting classes in program history. She signed Laura Ervin, a junior college All-American who went on to garner Second Team All-SEC accolades, as well as Freshman All-SEC selection Donica Cosby.

Harris has had the opportunity to learn from some of the game's top coaches, including Hall of Famer Kay Yow at N.C. State. She joined the program in the 2003-04 season and assisted the squad to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in two years. Her first recruiting class in Raleigh was rated as one of the best in the nation. She also garnered a commitment from Gillian Goring, the nation's No. 1 post player who went on to play for the Washington Mystics.

Prior to jumping to the Division I level, Harris made her mark on the junior college level as an assistant coach at Arkansas-Fort Smith, where she brought in key players who led the school to the NJCAA Final Four in 2004. In two seasons coaching under the legendary Louis Whorton, she inked the nation's No. 1 class and a 34-8 record. UAFS's 2002-03 team went 26-2 and won a share of the Bi-State Conference championship.

The Arkansas-Fort Smith position kept the Pine Bluff native in her home state after she started her coaching career as a graduate assistant at Little Rock. Her hard work at UALR earned her a promotion to a full-time assistant position in 2000.

Harris is the mother of two children, Marcus and Kiera, and the legal guardian of Lily. She also has two grandchildren, Samarah and Kaiden.




