#### **TIGERS FACE GEORGIA IN ATHENS FRIDAY**

The No.7 Auburn gymnastics team takes to the road again in Southeastern Conference action, facing Georgia Friday night in Stegeman Coliseum. The Tigers and Bulldogs will face off at 6:30 p.m. CT on SEC Network.

"We're looking forward to competing at Georgia," head coach Jeff Graba said. "They are a team that is starting to find its stride. The goal is to get a few more people some experience and work on our depth. When we're on the road and focused, we need to do the job we're there to do and hopefully we come away with a good score and a win."

Auburn is looking to find success in Athens as the squad has only won once when facing the Bulldogs on the road.

"It's a tough place to compete and there is a lot of history within the program," Graba said. "Sure, we want to win, but we also want to make sure we come away with a good road score that will help set us up for success down the road."

"We've proven that we are a good team that can consistently score well," junior Piper Smith said. "Now it's time for us to make those little decisions that will push us to the next level no matter where we are competing. We're really excited for Friday to see what we can do in a tough environment."

Head coach Jeff Graba has put the Auburn gymnastics program on the map throughout his 10+ years on the Plains. Now entering his 12th season at the helm in 2022, Graba and the Tigers are looking to build on their accomplishments to reach bigger feats in the sport.

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

Most recently, Graba and his staff guided Derrian Gobourne to the 2021 SEC Co-Specialist of the Year as she exceled on vault, bars, and floor. She was a first team All-American and All-SEC on floor as well. In addition, they helped Drew Watson and Cassie Stevens to All-SEC recognition.

The coaching staff guided a pair of Tigers to All-America honors in 2020. Watson picked up first team recognition on vault and finished with an NQS of 9.92 in the event to finish in a tie for seventh nationally. Her selection marked the first All-America honor for a Tiger in the category since 2016.

Gobourne was placed on the second team on bars in 2020. Her All-America honor in the event is the first for any Tiger on bars at the conclusion of the regular season. Gobourne finished tied for 14th nationally with a 9.905.

The 2020 squad enjoyed a wealth of accomplishments throughout the season, including a win over Alabama in Auburn Arena to kick off the home schedule.

Auburn's performances in 2019 was one for the books as they reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen and finished 16th in the final rankings. Auburn reached the second round of the NCAA Regional Championship with a 197.075 in Baton Rouge, marking the highest regional score in program history.

The program saw its first national champion in 2019 when Gobourne came in a tie for first at that 2019 National Championship on vault. The then-freshman scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way. In addition, Gobourne earned All-SEC and Freshman All-SEC recognition.

Samantha Cerio secured SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year for the sport in 2019.

Graba and the 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program under his guidance. The Tigers snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama in February of that season, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. That season, Auburn broke or tied 52 program records that season.

Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' second best in history and highest since 1993 with a NCAA nationals record score of 197.075. The Tigers also had a program record Super Six score of 195.625.

Auburn reached the 2015 NCAA Championship for the first time since 2003 and for only the fourth time overall.

In 11 seasons, Graba has led his student-athletes to 16 All-America honors (both NACGC/W and NCAA) and 22 All-SEC recognitions. Leading the way was Caitlin Atkinson who amassed nine All-America nods and named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

With the help of continuous progress, Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance each season. Each season, the team's attendance average has climbed higher and higher and after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season, Auburn finished the 2020 season with a new program record average of 6,364 fans. In addition, the Tigers have enjoyed 10 sellouts of Auburn Arena (7,424).

Away from competition, Graba's teams have also been outstanding in the classroom. In total, the Tigers have totaled 45 NACGC/W Scholastic All-America nods and 105 SEC Academic Honor Roll recognitions.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010 after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he earned the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year while coaching bars, collaborating on floor routines and serving as the recruiting coordinator.

During his first four years as an assistant, Utah finished as the NCAA runner-up three times and placed third once. Graba has also coached nine NCAA All-American gymnasts to 20 All-America performances.

As Utah's bars coach, he tutored Kristina Baskett to a 2006 NCAA uneven bars title as a freshman in his first trip to the NCAA Championships.

Prior to his stint at Utah, Graba spent two years as an assistant coach at Utah State. In 2005, he coached the Aggies to their first Western Gymnastics Conference championship and their first regional appearance in three years. In addition to his coaching duties, he served as the head of recruiting and assisted with the strength and conditioning program.

From 1995-2003, Graba was the co-owner and head coach of Midwest Gymnastics Club in Arden Hills, Minn. He had three gymnasts qualify Elite in his last three years with the club and had several level 8, 9 and 10 regional and national competitors.

Graba's collegiate coaching career began at Hamline University from 1992-98. While in St. Paul, Minn., his highlights included six-consecutive trips to the Division III National Championships and a runner-up finish in 1996. Eleven of his gymnasts combined to win 26 National Collegiate Gymnastics Association (NCGA) All-America citations.

Graba is a native of Forest Lake, Minn., and graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1992 with a bachelor's degree in economics and earned his M.B.A. from Salem International University in 2011. He and his wife, Bridget, have five children: Bryan, Jaymie, Jason, Kyla and Shayla.

#### AUBURN POTENTIAL LINEUPS

Depth and experience with a mix of new talent is what the Tigers will bring to the table.

The Tigers kick off the meet on bars in rotation one. The squad ranks 11th nationally in the event this season.

Auburn's top eight for bars includes fifth year Drew Watson and senior Derrian Gobourne. Freshman Sunisa Lee is 11th nationally in the event with a 10.0 under her belt.

Juniors Adeline Sabados, Piper Smith and Cassie Stevens are also among the top eight, while sophomore Gabby McLaughlin and freshman Sophia Groth both have potential to compete.

The team heads to vault for the second rotation and ranks seventh nationally in the event.

Auburn will once again be led by Watson and Gobourne. Lee, Groth and freshman Sara Hubbard are also set to provide big vaults, while Smith, Stevens and sophomore Tara Walsh have also worked to get on the list.

Auburn moves on to floor for rotation three and the team is ninth nationally with a 49.321 average. Gobourne leads the team on floor with a 9.921 mark, while Lee and Groth are also among the top 50 nationally.

Watson and Stevens are also among the team's top competitors. Hubbard, junior Morgan Leigh Oldham and freshman Ananda Brown are on pace to compete for a spot.

The Tigers close out the meet on beam where the squad is second in the nation at 49.388.

Groth and Smith are among the country's top 15 in the event, while Lee and McLaughlin each have a 9.975 this season. Stevens is coming off a 9.95 and sophomore Olivia Holling-

sworth has led off the last five meets. Fifth year Allie Riddle makes her debut in the top eight, while Oldham is also on the list.

#### IN THE RANKINGS

Auburn remains No. 7 this week per RoadTo-Nationals.com.

"We're going into a big road meet this Friday at Georgia and we still have plenty to work on," head coach Jeff Graba said. "We need to improve our execution as well as make some upgrades. These next few weeks are going to be extremely important for us to improve our scoring potential and develop our depth. If we can improve, we will be in really good shape for a late push in the postseason."

The Tigers continue to climb the event rankings, moving up to second on beam following their program-record score on Friday. The squad holds a 49.388 average just behind Florida's 49.392.

Auburn is seventh on vault (49.288), ninth on floor (49.321) and 11th on bars (49.254).

Individually, freshman Sunisa Lee is third in the all-around with a 39.700 average. She's also 11th on bars (9.908), tied for 18th on floor (9.919) and tied for 25th on vault (9.875).

Senior Derrian Gobourne is tied for 15th on floor (9.921) and tied for 23rd on vault (9.879). Freshman Sophia Groth is in the top 50 on all three of her events, including 19th on beam (9.895). Fifth year Drew Watson is 18th on vault (9.883) and junior Piper Smith is tied for 13th on beam (9.900).

#### LAST TIME VS. GEORGIA - FEB. 19, 2021

The No. 19 Auburn gymnastics team picked up a big win in Auburn Arena, topping No. 12 Georgia, 197.050-196.150.

Georgia at home with the last coming in January of 2019.

Auburn set season bests on three of four events and saw nine routines either set or tie career bests. Highlighting the night was the team's performance on bars where the Tigers finished with a 49.475, tying for the fifth-highest bars score in program history. Four of the six competitors in the event either set or tied their career highs.

Leading the Tigers on the evening was Cassie Stevens who won the all-around with a career-best 39.450. She had top scores on bars (9.875), beam (9.875) and floor (9.875).

Derrian Gobourne, of Sarasota, Fla., won three of the four individual event titles, including the bars crown with a career-best 9.95.

#### **RECORDS FALL IN BATON ROUGE**

It was a fun Saturday afternoon in the Pete Maravich Assembly Center, Feb. 5, as Auburn tied a program record with a 197.750 and freshman Sunisa Lee earned perfect score on bars and a program best in the allaround.

The team's score tied the program's record set on Feb. 27, 2015 in Auburn Arena.

Lee captured the all-around title with a 39.825, setting an Auburn record in the category. That score also tied for the nation's best so far this season.

Her 10.0 on bars marked the first time since 2004 that a Tiger was awarded a perfect score. In addition, Lee captured the beam crown with a 9.975. She added career highs on vault and floor, scoring a 9.9 and 9.95.

As a team, Auburn put together big scores in every category. The team's 49.475 on vault finished as the third-best score in program history, while the 49.550 on beam came in a tie for second.

Senior Derrian Gobourne and freshman Sophia Groth also had big performances for the Tigers. Groth scored a 9.9 or better to earn career highs on every event competed. She came in second on beam with a 9.95 and added a pair of 9.9s on vault and floor.

Gobourne led the team on vault with 9.95 to tie her career best. She followed with a 9.925 on floor, earning her fourth-straight score of 9.925 or better in the event. Gobourne chipped in a 9.875 on bars.

#### **CONSISTENCY IS KEY**

This year's edition of Auburn gymnastics has see the squad put together consistent team scores.

The Tigers tied the program record with a 197.750 at LSU two weeks ago, while four of the five top scores in program history have come this season.

Auburn is coming off a 197.575 against Missouri, Feb. 11, which ranks third in program history. The team's 197.525 in a win vs. Alabama (1/28) came in fourth and the 197.350 vs. Iowa State is fifth.

#### **BEAM DREAM TEAM**

Auburn's beam squad has been making big progress throughout the season, culminating with a program record score last week against Missouri. The team finished with a 49.625 against the visiting Tigers and Auburn stands second nationally with a 49.388 average.

"I'm really proud of the beam team because they just don't back down," associate head coach Ashley Johnton said. "They show up at practice ready to make changes and are open and willing to do whatever it takes to get everything out of their Friday performance.

"Moving forward, this team just has to keep working and keep getting better," Johnson said. "I think the most important thing is to continue on the quest of being as mentally tough as they can."

Three of Auburn's top five scores in the event have come this season. Including last week's record score, the team's 49.550 at LSU (Feb. 5) and 49.450 vs. Alabama (Jan. 28) all rank in the top.

Auburn has seen three 9.975s this year with two coming from freshman Sunisa Lee. Sophomore Gabby McLaughlin set her career high with a 9.975 last week against Missouri.

Junior Piper Smith is tied for 13th nationally with a 9.9 average, while freshman Sophia Groth is 19th with a 9.895 mark. The West Des Moines, Iowa product has a career-best 9.95 under her belt.

Juniors Aria Brusch and Cassie Stevens are among the nation's best at 9.860 and 9.854, respectively. Stevens also set a career best against Missouri with a 9.95.

McLaughlin has a 9.858 average so far, while Lee is at 9.838 with a fall.

#### **GOBOURNE SHINES ON FLOOR**

Senior Derrian Gobourne has had an outstanding season so far on floor for the Tigers as she ranks tied for 15th nationally with a 9.921 average.

Highlighting her season so far was the 9.975 against lowa State, tying her career high.

Gobourne has captured four floor titles this season and has scored a 9.925 or better in four times.

The Tigers return to Auburn Arena next Friday, hosting No. 10 Kentucky on Feb. 25. The two teams will face off at 6:30 p.m. CT on SEC Network.
