After slugging only 22 total home runs in 2021, Auburn has hit 17 total through its first 10 games of the 2022 season. Eight of Auburn's 17 homers have been hit by freshmen.

After two weeks of play, Auburn has three student-athletes ranked in the top 15 in the SEC in slugging percentage.

Freshman Bri Ellis leads Auburn and ranks ninth in the SEC with a .923 slugging percentage behind three doubles and four home runs.

INTERVIEW POLICY

Coach Dean, assistant coaches and select student-athletes are available for interviews by contacting Taylor Shirey in the communications office. All interviews during the week will be conducted via phone or through ZOOM. Weekly media availabilities will be conducted approximately prior to Tuesday practices throughout the season unless otherwise specified. ZOOM information will be emailed to the media on Mondays. Specific interview request should be made at least 24 hours in advance to ensure availability.

Postgame interviews with Coach Dean and requested players will be conducted in-person following a brief cool-down period. Media will be directed to enter the stands behind home plate to conduct socially-distanced interviews. Student-athletes and coaches will remain on the field. No media will have field access.

Windows inside the press box will be open at all times, regardless of weather. Please dress accordingly. No media will have access to field level at any time. All media policies are subject to change throughout the regular season based on the university's COVID-19 policies and procedures.

The Tigers face a doubleheader slate on Saturday with Delaware State at 2:30 p.m. CT and Bradley at 5 p.m. CT. Auburn concludes the tournament on Sunday against Syracuse at 11:30 a.m. CT and a rematch against ULM at 2 p.m. CT.

» Saturday's doubleheader will air on the SEC Network+ with J.J. Jackson and Graham Doty on the call. Jackson will be joined by Amy Rief for Sunday's doubleheader - also streamed on the SEC Network+.

» Fans can also catch Brit Bowen with the radio call on the Auburn Sports Network.

AN AUBURN WIN WOULD...

» Keep the Tigers undefeated at home.

INSIDE THE SERIES: ULM

» Auburn has faced ULM just once in program history with the Tigers defeating the Warhawks, 9-2, at Jane B. Moore Field on Feb. 8, 2014. (FUN FACT: ULM's SID for the 2014 meeting is now your friendly neighborhood Auburn SID.)

INSIDE THE SERIES: DELAWARE STATE

» Auburn is meeting Delaware State for the first time in program history. The Tigers have a 1-0 record against first-time opponents in 2022 with its season-opening victory over Seton Hall.

INSIDE THE SERIES: BRADLEY

» Auburn is also meeting Delaware State for the first time in program history.

» Under head coach Mickey Dean, Auburn is 13-1 in meetings against first-time opponents. Other first-time opponents during the Mickey Dean era include: Binghamton, Colorado State, Delaware, Illinois, IUPUI, Missouri State, Oregon State, San Jose State, Southeast Missouri State, St. Francis (Pa.), UNCW, Villanova and Seton Hall with Missouri State delivering Auburn's lone loss.

INSIDE THE SERIES: SYRACUSE

» Auburn has faced Syracuse four times previously with the Tigers holding a 4-0 record in those contests. In those

four meetings, Auburn has outscored Syracuse, 28-1.

» The two teams last meet in Kissimmee, Fla., on March 1, 2014 with Auburn knocking off the Orange, 10-1. Syracuse is making the trip to Auburn for the first time since 2001 - the first meeting between the two squad. Auburn shut out the Orange, 7-0.

PENTA-THLETE: MADDIE PUTS THE LEAGUE ON NOTICE

» The hard-throwing Maddie Penta returned for her sophomore season with better control and a masterful change up. It's lead to a hot start to the 2022 season.

» Penta has earned a victory in all five of her starts to open the season and alongside Shelby Lowe leads the SEC and ranks fourth in the country in victories.

» Penta is the only SEC student-athlete to record over 50 strikeouts this season as she leads the league with 52. Her strikeout total is good for ninth nationally. Penta also ranks sixth in the league with a pair of shutouts through her five starts to bring her career total to five.

» She leads the Tigers and ranks ninth in the league with a 0.98 earned run average, allowing just 5 earned runs in 35.2 innings pitched.

#BRIBOMBS: ELLIS BRINGS THE POWER

» Just 11 games into her collegiate career, Bri Ellis's power at the plate has established herself as a threat in the SEC. Ellis is tied with sophomore Makayla Packer for the team lead in home runs with four total, as the duo both rank second in the SEC. Ellis and Packer are two of just six players to hit at least four home runs this season. Auburn is the only SEC program to have two players with four or more home runs through the first 11 games.

» Ellis currently leads the Tigers in slugging percentage (.923) and tied for the team lead in RBI (12). With nine hits to her credit, Ellis has slugged seven extra-base hits with four home runs and three doubles.

» Her slugging numbers are some of the highest in the league as she currently ninth in the SEC in slugging percentage. Ellis also ranks second in the third in home runs per game, fifth in runs batted in per game and 11th in total bases (24).

» Ellis has some lofty shoes to fill as she attempts to chase down Auburn's freshman home run record that was set by Kasey Cooper in 2014. That season, Cooper slugged 18 home runs. Cooper also holds the freshman record for RBI (77), slugging percentage (.780), batting average (.418), hits (74), runs scored (70), total bases (138) and walks (24).

TOP 25: TIGERS ON THE RISE AFTER A TOP-15 VICTORY

» After two-hitting No. 11 Texas to clinch a 6-2 victory to claim the program's first victory over a ranked opponent this season, Auburn saw itself ranked in all four major softball polls for the first time this season. Auburn has now been ranked in back-to-back weeks.

» Auburn made its 2022 debut in the USA Today/NFCA Coaches Poll at No. 21. The Tigers jumped four spots to No. 21 in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Top 25.

» Rounding out the rankings, Auburn checked in at No. 21 in D1 Softball's Top 25 and No. 22 in Softball America's Top 25.

BY THE NUMBERS: TIGER OFFENSE SEES DRAMATIC IMPROVEMENT

» Struggles at the plate last season proved costly for the Tigers, as Auburn lost 11 games by one run and was at the bottom of the SEC in virtually every offensive category.

» Through the first 11 games of the season, Auburn ranks second in the SEC and eighth in the country in slugging percentage. Auburn has three student-athletes ranked in the top 15 in slugging. Auburn leads the league in total home runs and triples, while ranking third in doubles and scoring. Auburn has outscored its 2021 opponents 87 to 20.

» Through the first 11 games of the season, Auburn is already showing incredible improvement at the plate compared to its 2021 numbers.

NOTEBOOK

» The league office announced Lowe as co-winner of the award with Tennessee's Ashley Rogers on Monday. The award is Lowe's first Pitcher of the Week accolade. Lowe was a two-time SEC Freshman of the Week winner last season. Lowe is Auburn's first SEC Pitcher of the Week honoree since her teammate Samantha Yarbrough won the award on March 2, 2020.

» The Carrollton, Ala., native started three games in the circle, picking up victories in each. Lowe did not allow a single earned run over opening weekend to post a 0.00 earned run average. In her 13.0 total innings of work, Lowe allowed just five hits and one unearned run. Lowe struck out a total of 23 batters and did not issue a walk. She held opponents to a .109 average at the plate.

» Her weekend performance was highlighted by her season debut against St. John's on Feb. 11. Lowe tossed her first collegiate no-hitter and the 28th no-hitter in Auburn softball history. Lowe's no-hitter was Auburn's first since Maddie Penta versus IUPUI on Feb. 27, 2021.

» Lowe was also honored as the SEC Pitcher of the Week by DI Softball.

PACK THE PLAINS

» Returning to full capacity for the first time since 2020, Jane B. Moore Field and the Auburn Family was in full force over opening weekend.

» Auburn ranks ninth in the country in accumulated attendance (5,766), which is the fifth highest mark in the SEC. Auburn's average attendance of 1,444 is good for fourth in the nation behind Alabama (3,804), Arizona (1,921) and Texas A&M (1,457).

LOWE DOWN: SHELBY CONTINUES TO LEAVE MARK ON RECORD BOOK

» After turning in one of the best freshman campaign by a pitcher in program history, Shelby Lowe picked up right where she left off, tossing her first collegiate no-hitter and the 28th no-hitter in program history in her sophomore season debut versus St. John's on Feb. 11.

» Starting three games over opening weekend, Lowe solidified herself as one of the top arms in the league and earned Co-SEC Pitcher of the Week honors following opening weekend after not allowing a single earned run to score.

» Lowe continued her dominance over the St. Pete Clearwater Elite, picking up two wins and save. She is the only pitcher in the SEC with at least five wins this season.

» Along with her meteoric rise as one of the top pitchers in league as a true freshman, Lowe solidified herself as

one of the most dominating pitchers Auburn has seen in over a decade. Lowe recorded the most total strikeouts by any Tiger since 2010 and was just the fifth freshman in program history to surpass 100 strikeouts in a season. Lowe surpassed 200 career strikeouts on Feb. 13 versus UMass Lowell. She is just the 15th Tiger in program history to surpass the milestone.

» Etching her name on both freshman and single-season records, Lowe is also on pace to move into top 10 in several career rankings during her sophomore campaign after putting up monster numbers as a freshman. Lowe needs 156 additional innings pitch to qualify for certain career categories (earned run average, walks per seven innings etc.).

MS. STEAL YOUR BASE

» The speedster has returned is already wrecking havoc on the base paths. Makayla Packer has opened her sophomore campaign a perfect 6-for-6 in stolen base attempts. Packer currently ranks fifth in the SEC in total stolen bases and seventh in stolen bases per game (0.55).

» Last season, Packer's 16 steals were the second most recorded by a Tiger freshman and ranks seventh overall in program single-season history. Packer set the program record for highest stolen base percentage (min. 15 attempts) with a flawless 1.000.

» A perfect 22-for-22 in stolen base attempts in her career, Packer already ranks tied for 18th in Auburn career history for steals. Packer needs just nine additional stolen bases to move herself into the top 10 in program history.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

» Boasting the youngest roster in the SEC, Auburn will rely heavily on a group of talented underclassmen during the 2022 season.

» The Tigers lead the SEC with the highest total of true freshmen and sophomore with 16 total. Auburn's underclassmen accounts for over 69 percent of its roster make-up, that percentage also leads the league.

» Auburn returns eight members of its sophomore class with the quartet of Makayla Packer, Sydney Cox, Maddie Penta and Shelby Lowe leading the charge. The foursome were tabbed to the 2021 SEC All-Freshman team last season. Auburn led the league with its four selections.

» The freshman class has thrived at the plate, slugging eight of Auburn 17 home runs. The freshman class has solidified themselves in starting rolls, combining for 39 starts.

» Bri Ellis is one of just six SEC student-athletes to slug at least four home runs this season as she ranks ninth in the SEC in slugging percentage. Ellis also ranks third in home runs per game, fifth in runs batted in per game and 11th in total bases. Fellow slugger, Jessie Blaine ranks 21st in the league with her two homers and .760 slugging clip.

» Nelia Peralta holds steady at 21st in the league in home runs while standing in 12th in the league with a 1.09 runs batted in per game average. She is the only other Tiger freshman to hit multiple homers this season with two. Aubrie Lisenby currently sits in fifth in the SEC in doubles per game (0.44).

FOR JANE: SEASON DEDICATED TO LONG-TIME SUPPORTER DR. JANE B. MOORE

» Dr. Jane B. Moore, one of the most influential women in Auburn Athletics history, passed away on July 9, 2021. Auburn's softball complex was named Jane B. Moore Field in her honor in 2002 and dedicated on April 26, 2003, in recognition of Moore's service to athletics at Auburn.

» Born in 1935 in Dozier, Alabama, Moore came to Auburn in 1969 after earning her Doctorate of Education in physical education from the University of Alabama. In 1975, Moore became the first woman to serve on the Auburn University Committee on Intercollegiate Athletics. She served on multiple athletics committees for men's and women's sports for more than 40 years.

» Moore was instrumental in the establishment of WINGS (Women Inspiring and Nurturing Greatness in Student-Athletes), which promotes and supports women's athletics at Auburn by creating programs for female

student-athletes.

» Moore made significant professional contributions to Auburn University over a 28-year career on the faculty of the College of Education and the Department of Health and Human Performance (now the School of Kinesiology).
 » Her service to Auburn has been recognized with the Lifetime Achievement Award, the Algernon Sydney Sullivan Award and the Pamela Wells Sheffield Award, which recognizes Auburn women exemplifying grace, character and a selfless service and commitment to Auburn University and the Auburn family.
 » Throughout the 2022 season, Auburn softball will wear helmet stickers in honor of Dr. Moore and will host the inaugural Jane B. Moore Memorial tournament on Mar. 4-6. During the tournament, Auburn softball plans to unveil the Jane B. Moore Endowment Fund. More details on the endowment will be released leading into the tournament.

AT THE HELM: DEAN ENTERS FIFTH SEASON ON THE PLAINS

» Head coach Mickey Dean enters his fifth season on the Plains. Dean has guided to several firsts during his tenure, adding to his lofty coaching resume in the process.
 » The 2021 campaign feature two major milestone victories. Dean earned his 100th career victory as head coach of the Tigers as Auburn knocked off No. 19 South Carolina, 5-4 on Feb. 21. Dean also recorded his 600th career victory as a Division I head coach on April 25 as Auburn defeated Ole Miss, 3-1.
 » Behind Auburn's 10-0 road victory at Jacksonville State, Dean led Auburn to its 900th program victory.
 » During his tenure on the Plains, Mickey Dean continues to overhaul the program's culture to return to the Tigers back to the top of the SEC and gathered a long list of honors and firsts along the way:

» Once again, Auburn will be a feature in the national spotlight as the Tigers are set to appear in 13 nationally televised broadcasts in 2021.
 » Auburn will have four games at Jane B. Moore Field broadcasted nationally, including games from its SEC series against Texas A&M, South Carolina and Florida. Nine of Auburn's road contests will also air on ESPN's family of networks, including three of Auburn's contests at the St. Pete Clearwater Elite Invitational.
 » The Tigers will be featured on the SEC Network 11 times and on both ESPNU and the Longhorn Network once.
 » Also available to stream on the ESPN app, Auburn will have 22 additional home games on SEC Network+.

TIGERS SELECTED 11TH IN PRESEASON SEC COACHES POLL

» Auburn was tabbed to finish 11th in the Southeastern Conference in the annual preseason coaches' poll. The Tigers collected 36 points from the league's 13 coaches.
 » Receiving seven first-place votes, Alabama was selected as the preseason favorite to win the league with Florida coming in at second with three first-place votes.
 » With a pair of first-place votes, Arkansas was tabbed to finish third in the league. Tennessee, also earning one first-place vote, rounded out the top four.

IN REVIEW: 2021 CAMPAIGN

» Auburn closed the 2021 season with a 27-24 overall record with a 7-17 mark in SEC play. The Tigers punched their ticker for its 16th overall NCAA regional with an appearance in Tallahassee.
 » Auburn earns its first victories in Columbia, Mo., College Station, Texas and Baton Rouge, La., all for the first time since 2015. The 2021 season was also highlighted by Auburn's upsetting No. 12 Kentucky, taking the series in

two games at Jane B. Moore Field.

» The 2021 season was highlighted by the breakout performances from pitching freshman duo Shelby Lowe and Maddie Penta as the pair combined for five SEC Freshman of the Week honors. Lowe and Penta both surpassed 100 strikeouts during their freshman campaigns, marking the first time in school history that Auburn had two freshman pitchers surpass 100+ strikeouts in the same season.
 » The duo was honored alongside fellow freshmen Makayla Packer and Sydney Cox as members of the 2021 SEC All-Freshman Team, setting Auburn's program record with the four selections. Lowe added All-SEC Second Team honors to become the only freshman pitcher in program history to be honored with all-conference honors during their debut season. Maddison Kopeke rounded out the SEC accolades with a selection to the SEC All-Newcomer Team.

HEAD COACH MICKEY DEAN

Mickey Dean enters his fifth season as the head coach of the Auburn softball program. In 14 years at the collegiate level, Dean has coached 10 NCAA Tournament teams, including one super regional participant, and won nine conference championships. He is one of four active head coaches to led three different programs to the NCAA Tournament.

A native of Elkton, Va., Dean has guided 79 all-conference players, 44 all-region honorees and eight all-Americans, including 2017 National Player of the Year, Megan Good. He has also been touted as the conference coach of the year eight times.

During his time on the Plains, Dean has guided the Tigers to a 123-73 overall record and three NCAA Regional appearances. Dean's resume at Auburn also includes four NFCA All-Region selections and three All-SEC selections. He also guided slugger Kendall Veach to All-America honors from Softball America in 2019.

In his fourth season at Auburn, Dean navigated the Tigers through the uncertainties of playing a season during the heart of COVID-19 pandemic. He carried Auburn to 27 victories, highlighted by the program's first victories in Columbia, Mo., College Station, Texas, and Baton Rouge, La., since 2015. The Tigers also upset No. 12 Kentucky picking up the series win at Jane B. Moore Field.

Dean would earn his 100th victory as head coach of the Tigers on Feb. 20, 2021, as Auburn upset No. 10 South Carolina 5-4 in non-conference competition during the Osprey/Dolphin Invitational in Jacksonville, Fla. Dean would add his 600th career head coaching victory on April 25, 2021, when Auburn took a 3-1 victory over Ole Miss in Oxford, Miss.

The 2021 season was highlighted by the breakout performances from pitching freshman duo Shelby Lowe and Maddie Penta. The pair combined for a total of five SEC Freshman of the Week honors becoming just the second and third Auburn freshman pitchers to win the award multiple times in a season. Penta set the program record with three freshman weekly honors from the league office.

After becoming the first Auburn freshman pitcher to toss a no-hitter in a season opener in Auburn's 8-0 win over Southeast Missouri State, Penta would close her debut season with a pair of no-hitters. Penta would toss Auburn's first seven-inning no-hitter since 2012 in a 5-0 victory over IUPUI. She was the first Auburn pitcher since Marcy Harper in 2014 to pitch multiple no-hitters in the same season.

Lowe turned in one of the most dominating pitching performances by an Auburn freshman in school history. Lowe closed the year setting Auburn's single-season record for fewest walks allowed per seven innings (1.18), while also ranking sixth in single-season history for earned run average (1.48), eighth for longest scoreless innings streak (24.1) and 10th in strikeouts (179) and complete games (15). Her 179 strikeouts were the most by an Auburn pitcher in over a decade. Lowe recorded the second most strikeouts and second lowest ERA by an Auburn freshman pitcher in program history.

Lowe and Penta both surpassed 100 strikeouts during their freshman campaigns, marking the first time in school history that Auburn had two freshman pitchers surpass 100+ strikeouts in the same season.

The duo was honored alongside fellow freshmen Makayla Packer and Sydney Cox as members of the 2021 SEC All-Freshman Team, setting Auburn's program record with the four selections. Lowe added All-SEC Second Team honors to become the only freshman pitcher in program history to be honored with all-conference honors during their debut season. Maddison Kopeke rounded out the SEC accolades with a selection to the SEC All-Newcomer Team.

Lowe would go on to be one of 15 finalists for the Schutt Sports/

NFCA Division I National Freshman of the Year award and would secure NFCA All-Southeast Region Third Team honors.

Dean's third season at Auburn was shortened due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Before the 2020 season was halted, Dean helped the Tigers to 16 wins, highlighted by victories over No. 25 Northwestern and No. 16 Minnesota. The Tigers made program history on March 2, 2020, when Alyssa Rivera (Player), Samantha Yarbrough (Pitcher) and Carlee McCondichie (Freshmen) swept the SEC's weekly awards. It marked the first time Auburn has swept all three SEC awards.

Auburn closed the 2019 season with a 39-21 overall record, earning its sixth straight NCAA Tournament bid. The Tigers closed the conference slate with a 10-14 mark and earned a spot in the 2019 SEC Softball Tournament semifinals. Dean guided Kendall Veach to All-SEC and NFCA All-Region team honors. The program made history as the senior class was drafted in the 2019 National Pro Fastpitch Draft.

Dean led Auburn to a 15-0 start to open the 2018 season, which tied the best start in program history and were the most wins in SEC history among first-year head coaches. He earned his 500th career win during the Wilson/DeMarini Classic when Auburn earned a shutout win over Western Illinois on Mar. 4. He led the Tigers to their 800th win in program history with a 2-1 victory over Kennesaw State on April 4.

Dean came to Auburn after five seasons as the head coach at James Madison. During his five-year stint at James Madison, Dean compiled a record of 237-56 (.809). He amassed five 40-win seasons, including the final two campaigns with 52 and 50 victories, respectively. The Dukes broke 104 program records, including over 40 pitching records while boasting one of the nation's top staffs under Dean's guidance.

Prior to his reign in Harrisonburg, Va., Dean spent six seasons as the head coach at Radford where he took the Highlanders to their first-ever NCAA Tournament appearances in 2009 and 2010. Before taking the position at Radford, Dean served as an assistant coach at Akron (2001-02), Indiana (2002-04) and Longwood (2005-06).

In addition to his collegiate coaching experience, Dean has also worked on the professional and international level.

He was the pitching coach for the Venezuelan National Team (2002-08) and the head coach for the Chicago Bandits (2004-10) that finished as the National Pro Fastpitch regular season champions five times and won the title in 2008.

Dean was named NPF Manager of the Year three times and coached world-renowned pitcher Jennie Finch, who was the NPF's Co-Pitcher of the Year in 2005 and has a gold and silver medal from her two Team USA Olympic appearances.

A 1987 graduate of Elon University, Dean was a pitcher on the baseball team where he was a four-year letterwinner.

Dean and his wife, Liz, have one son, Isaac, and one daughter, Caroline.
