TIGERS FACE ROAD TEST AT NO. 8 LSU

Another top 10 matchup faces the No. 6 Auburn gymnastics team as the Tigers travel to No. 8 LSU Saturday, Feb. 5. The two teams will go head-to-head at 3 p.m. CT on ESPNU inside the Pete Maravich Assembly Center.

"It's a tough place to compete," head coach Jeff Graba said. "We have to be prepared to face a loud crowd and be mentally tough. LSU is obviously a very talented team that thrives at home so we just need to focus on ourselves and on what we can control."

"We're really focusing on leveling up this week and taking it up a notch," junior Piper Smith said. "We like the environment at LSU and are looking forward to competing this Saturday in front of another big crowd."

The contest will be the second-straight top 10 meet for the Tigers. Auburn topped No. 9 Alabama last week Friday at home with a season high 197.525.

"The SEC is tough and there is no question about it," Graba added. "But being in these environments and matchups prepares us for postseason."

Head coach Jeff Graba has put the Auburn gymnastics program on the map throughout his 10+ years on the Plains. Now entering his 12th season at the helm in 2022, Graba and the Tigers are looking to build on their accomplishments to reach bigger feats in the sport.

The Minnesota native was named SEC Coach of the Year in 2014 and 2015 and SEC co-Coach of the Year in 2012.

Most recently, Graba and his staff guided Derrian Gobourne to the 2021 SEC Co-Specialist of the Year as she excelled on vault, bars, and floor. She was a first team All-American and All-SEC on floor as well. In addition, they helped Drew Watson and Cassie Stevens to All-SEC recognition.

The coaching staff guided a pair of Tigers to All-America honors in 2020. Watson picked up first team recognition on vault and finished with an NQS of 9.92 in the event to finish in a tie for seventh nationally. Her selection marked the first All-America honor for a Tiger in the category since 2016.

Gobourne was placed on the second team on bars in 2020. Her All-America honor in the event is the first for any Tiger on bars at the conclusion of the regular season. Gobourne finished tied for 14th nationally with a 9.905.

The 2020 squad enjoyed a wealth of accomplishments throughout the season, including a win over Alabama in Auburn Arena to kick off the home schedule.

Auburn's performances in 2019 was one for the books as they reached the sport's first-ever Sweet Sixteen and finished 16th in the final rankings. Auburn reached the second round of the NCAA Regional Championship with a 197.075 in Baton Rouge, marking the highest regional score in program history.

The program saw its first national champion in 2019 when Gobourne came in a tie for first at that 2019 National Championship on vault. The then-freshman scored a career-best 9.95, picking up All-America honors along the way. In addition, Gobourne earned All-SEC and Freshman All-SEC recognition.

Samantha Cerio secured SEC Scholar Athlete of the Year for the sport in 2019.

Graba and the 2016 team added to the list of firsts for the program under his guidance. The Tigers snapped the 117-meet losing skid to Alabama in February of that season, defeating the Crimson Tide at home (197.275-197.250). Auburn also defeated Georgia in Athens for the first time in program history, setting a new program-high road score on the way (197.325).

In addition, the Tigers earned the program's first No. 1 NCAA regional seed and captured the NCAA Ann Arbor Regional title with a 196.525.

Auburn enjoyed a breakout season in 2015 as Graba led the Tigers to the NCAA Championship Super Six for the first time in 22 years. That season, Auburn broke or tied 52 program records that season.

Auburn's sixth place finish at the Super Six was the Tigers' second best in history and highest since 1993 with a NCAA nationals record score of 197.075. The Tigers also had a program record Super Six score of 195.625.

Auburn reached the 2015 NCAA Championship for the first time since 2003 and for only the fourth time overall.

In 11 seasons, Graba has led his student-athletes to 16 All-America honors (both NACGC/W and NCAA) and 22 All-SEC recognitions. Leading the way was Caitlin Atkinson who amassed nine All-America nods and named SEC Gymnast of the Year in 2016.

With the help of continuous progress, Graba and the Tigers have enjoyed growth when it comes to home attendance each season. Each season, the team's attendance average has climbed higher and higher and after averaging just 3,583 fans in his first season, Auburn finished the 2020 season with a new program record average of 6,364 fans. In addition, the Tigers have enjoyed 10 sellouts of Auburn Arena (7,424).

Away from competition, Graba's teams have also been outstanding in the classroom. In total, the Tigers have totaled 45 NACGC/W Scholastic All-America nods and 105 SEC Academic Honor Roll recognitions.

Graba was named Auburn head coach on August 16, 2010 after spending five years as an assistant coach at Utah. While with the Utes, he earned the 2009 West Region Assistant Coach of the Year while coaching bars, collaborating on floor routines and serving as the recruiting coordinator.

During his first four years as an assistant, Utah finished as the NCAA runner-up three times and placed third once. Graba has also coached nine NCAA All-American gymnasts to 20 All-America performances.

As Utah's bars coach, he tutored Kristina Baskett to a 2006 NCAA uneven bars title as a freshman in his first trip to the NCAA Championships.

Prior to his stint at Utah, Graba spent two years as an assistant coach at Utah State. In 2005, he coached the Aggies to their first Western Gymnastics Conference championship and their first regional appearance in three years. In addition to his coaching duties, he served as the head of recruiting and assisted with the strength and conditioning program.

From 1995-2003, Graba was the co-owner and head coach of Midwest Gymnastics Club in Arden Hills, Minn. He had three gymnasts qualify Elite in his last three years with the club and had several level 8, 9 and 10 regional and national competitors.

Graba's collegiate coaching career began at Hamline University from 1992-98. While in St. Paul, Minn., his highlights included six-consecutive trips to the Division III National Championships and a runner-up finish in 1996. Eleven of his gymnasts combined to win 26 National Collegiate Gymnastics Association (NCGA) All-America citations.

Graba is a native of Forest Lake, Minn., and graduated from the University of Minnesota in 1992 with a bachelor's degree in economics and earned his M.B.A. from Salem International University in 2011. He and his wife, Bridget, have five children: Bryan, Jaymie, Jason, Kyla and Shayla.

AUBURN POTENTIAL LINEUPS

Depth and experience with a mix of new talent is what the Tigers will bring to the table in 2022.

Auburn will kick things off on bars as the visiting team. The squad's top 8 is highlighted by a wealth of experience as seniors Drew Watson and Derrian Gobourne as well as juniors Cassie Stevens, Piper Smith, Aria Brusch and Adeline Sabados all have potential to compete.

Freshmen Sunisa Lee and Sophia Groth are also among the top 8 for the first rotation. Lee and Gobourne have shared the bars title in the last two meets.

The Tigers will head to vault for the second rotation with Gobourne and Watson once again leading the charge. Watson has a 9.95 under her belt already this year. Junior Piper Smith has also worked her way on the list.

Youth will be the name of the game for the rest of the spots as sophomores Gabby McLaughlin and Tara Walsh with freshmen Sara Hubbard, Lee and Groth round out the rest of the eight.

Auburn will move on to floor for rotation three and will feature a well-rounded group of athletes. Gobourne, Watson and Lee highlight the group with veterans Stevens and Brusch provided depth. Freshmen Groth, Hubbard and Ananda Brown all have potential to compete.

The final rotation of the day will be beam for the Tigers. The top 8 remains mostly the same with McLaughlin and Lee leading the charge.

Brusch, Stevens, Groth and Smith along with sophomore Olivia Hollingsworth add big experience and Hubbard joins them on the list.

GYMNAST TO WATCH: ARIA BRUSCH

IN THE RANKINGS

The Auburn gymnastics team enters the week at No. 6 per RoadToNationals.com.

The placement marks the highest ranking for the program since 2016 when the squad finished the regular season ranked No. 6.

Auburn put together a 197.525-197.125 win over No. 9 Alabama last Friday in Auburn Arena. That score was not only a season best for the team, but also came in at second highest in program history.

Michigan, Oklahoma, and Utah hold the top spots in the country. Florida is ranked fourth with Minnesota coming in fifth. Auburn is the second-highest ranked Southeastern Conference squad at sixth with LSU at No. 8 and Alabama at ninth. Missouri (11), Kentucky (12) and Arkansas (t-13) are also in the top 15.

Auburn continues to soar up the beam rankings after posting a season-best 49.450 vs. Alabama last week. The Tigers are tied for fifth nationally with a 49.288 average.

The team also moved up the floor rankings following another season high last week. The team posted a 49.550 to move up to ninth overall with a 49.288 average.

In addition, the squad is eighth on vault (49.231) and 11th on bars (49.238).

Individually, freshman Sunisa Lee is third nationally in the all-around with a 39.700. She is also tied for 19th on bars (9.887), 21st on vault (9.875) and 24th on floor (9.900).

Senior Derrian Gobourne is tied for 11th on floor with a 9.931 average and has captured the floor title in all meets competed so far.

SEC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Freshman Sunisa Lee of the No. 6 Auburn gymnastics team was named SEC Freshman of the Week, the Southeastern Conference

announced Tuesday.

The St. Paul, Minnesota product guided the Tigers to a big win Friday night, topping rival and No. 9 Alabama at home with a season-high 197.525. That score marked the second highest in program history.

In her all-around debut, Lee won the title with a 39.700. That score marked the second highest in the SEC this season and was the third highest all-around total in program history.

In addition to her all-around win, she captured a tie for first on beam with a career-high 9.975.

Lee kicked off the meet with her first career appearance on vault, scoring a 9.875 to come in second. She added a 9.925 on bars and on floor to finish in a tie for second in each event.

Her performance on beam helped the Tigers score a season best in the event with a 49.450. That ranked third in program history. In addition, her floor score guided Auburn to a season-best 49.550, which is also third in program history.

LAST TIME VS. LSU – FEB. 5, 2021

It was a record-breaking night for Auburn as the squad scored a 197.075 in Auburn Arena. No. 2 LSU took home the win with a 197.550.

Auburn saw 18 routines either set or tie career or season highs. In addition, the overall team score was the first time the Tigers cracked 197 since the 2019 NCAA Regional Semifinal in Baton Rouge.

Highlighting the night were event wins from Derrian Gobourne and Gabby McLaughlin. Gobourne stole the night with an outstanding performance on floor in the anchor position, winning the event with a career-best

9.975. She also picked up the event title on vault with a 9.9.

McLaughlin earned the first event title of her career, taking home the beam crown with a 9.925.

In addition to individual performances, Cassie Stevens set a career high in the all-around with a 39.425. Piper Smith earned her first start in the all-around and put together a 38.700.

BIG RIVALRY WIN

Defeating Alabama for the third time in their past four meetings on the Plains, No. 8 Auburn earned the second highest score in program history Friday at sold-out Auburn Arena to outdistance the ninth-ranked Crimson Tide 197.525-197.125.

Freshman Sunisa Lee won her collegiate all-around debut, scoring a 39.7.

Lee shared event titles on bars with Derrian Gobourne and Alabama's Luisa Blanco, and with Blanco on beam.

Gobourne won the floor title with another crowd-pleasing routine that earned a 9.95 from the judges. Freshman Sophia Groth scored a career-best 9.9 on floor. Sophomore Gabby McLaughlin tied her career high with a 9.925 on beam.

With each event, Auburn increased its score, earning a 49.175 on vault, 49.350 on bars, 49.450 on beam and 49.550 on floor, thrilling the 9,121 fans in attendance.

RECORD ROAD SCORE

The Tigers kicked off their SEC schedule at then-No. 15 Arkansas, Jan. 14, topping the Razorbacks, 197.250-197.200. That score was the second-highest road score in program history.

In addition, the Tigers finished with a

49.400 on bars. That ranked second on the road on bars in program history.

The squad also went 49.375 on beam, finishing in the top 10 in program history.

BEAM DREAM TEAM

Auburn has found success on beam early this season and the team ranks tied for fifth nationally and first regionally with a 49.288 average.

Four Tigers rank regionally in the event with freshman Sophia Groth leading the way. She is tied for seventh with a 9.875 average.

Sophomore Gabby McLaughlin has returned to form on beam, picking up where she left of last year and has scored a 9.9 or better in the last three meets. She is 13th regionally with a 9862 average.

Junior Aria Brusch is 14th regionally at 9.856 and classmate Cassie Stevens is among the top 20 at 9.825.

Freshman Sunisa Lee is coming off a huge score against Alabama, earning a 9.975 to win her first beam title of the season.

GOBOURNE SHINES

Senior Derrian Gobourne has put on a show on floor in every meet so far this season.

The Sarasota, Fla., product has won all four floor titles in 2022 and has recorded three-straight scores of 9.925 or better.

Against Iowa State (Jan. 21), she tied her career high with a 9.975. Last week against Alabama, she earned a 9.95.

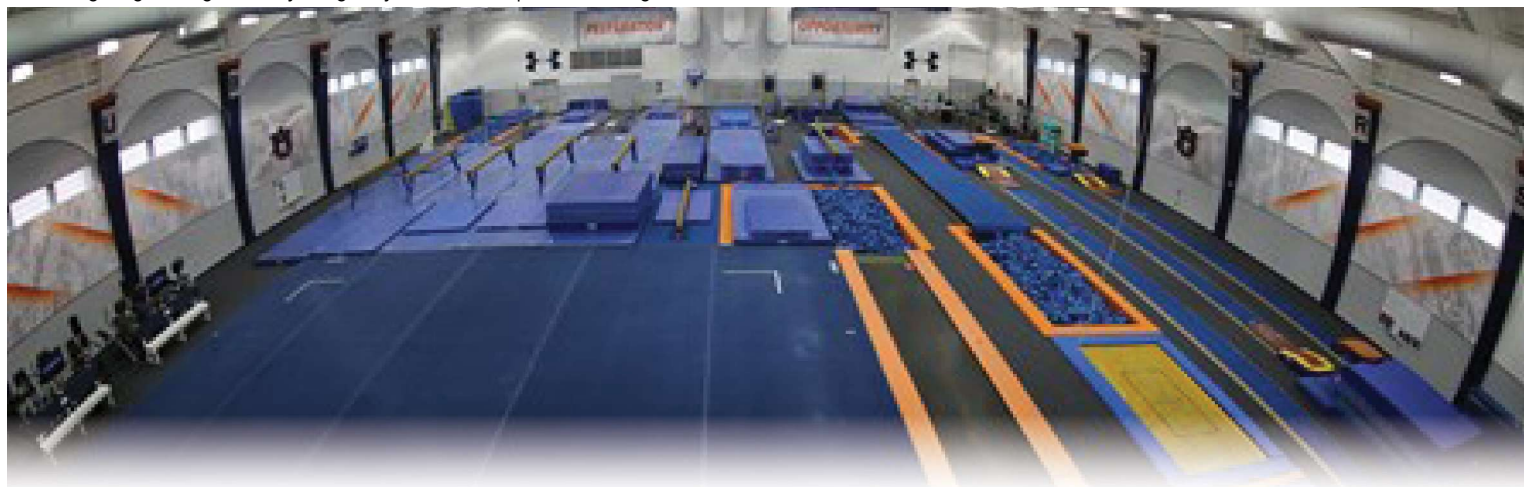
Gobourne's energetic routine has her ranked 11th nationally with a 9.931 average.
